There were few surprises at the first session of the three-day Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, held yesterday in Sydney. Domestic buyers and Redoute's Choice (Aus)

dominated, with the Arrowfield stallion accounting for the top three horses on the day. The sales topper was hip 169, a colt out of MSW Egyptian Ibis (NZ) (Straight Strike), who was purchased for A\$2 million by Melbourne-based agent Rob McAnulty.

Consigned by Coolmore, agent, the bay is a half to

Hong Kong Horse of the Year Grand Delight (Aus). Five youngsters made A\$1 million or more on opening day, compared with seven last year, but the clearance rate dropped from 90 percent to 74.4 percent, and several high-profile yearlings failed to reach their reserves. With an additional 39 yearlings offered in the 2007 catalogued, the average climbed 13.9 percent, from A\$260,663 to A\$296,958, and the gross rose to A\$49.2 million. "Eighty percent clearance is acceptable, and we are not far off it," asserted Inglis acting Managing Director Jamie Inglis. "It was 90 percent last year, but that is the stuff of dreams and will not happen again in my time." Woodlands Stud, leading buyer at Easter last year after spending A\$13.1 million on 27 yearlings, spent A\$4,570,000 on 10 yearlings Tuesday, and the team was also underbidder on many of the day's sales toppers. **Easter cont. p2; Toppers p3**

'WONDER LADY' RETIRED

Four-year-old **Wonder Lady Anne L** (Real Quiet--Ancho, by Wild Zone), heroine of last season's GI Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont Park, has been retired and will be bred to Giant's Causeway. The bay, campaigned by IEAH Stables and its partners, was freshened following an unplaced finish in Saratoga's GI Alabama S. Aug. 19 and resurfaced with a third-place finish in the Jan. 14 GII El Encino S. at Santa Anita most recently. "She'd basically been very hit or miss in her training of late, and rather than press on we decided to make sure we didn't miss the 2007 breeding season with her," said Michael Iavarone, co-president of IEAH Stables. "Obviously, we were thrilled with what she accomplished for us on the racetrack, and as much as we'd looked forward to racing her as a four-year-old, we are equally excited by adding her to our broodmare band and sending a Grade I winner to Giant's Causeway." Wonder Lady Anne L, winner of the GII Demoiselle S. at two, retires with a record of 14-3-2-5 and earnings of \$459,488.

LOOKING TO LAND THE VINERY MADISON

Trainer Eddie Kenneally, who saddled Kelly's Landing to victory in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, looks to annex another sprint stakes at Keeneland this afternoon. Kenneally sends out **Mary Delaney** (Hennessy) in the GII Vinery Madison S. at seven furlongs. The four-year-old, who started her career in England, has won four of her six starts since returning to the States. An allowance winner over the Madison track and trip in October, she faded to eighth when stretched to a mile for the Nov. 2 GII Chilukki S. at Churchill, but has been unbeatable since. The bay ended 2006 with a Turfway allowance score Dec. 15, picked up her first stakes win in the Jan. 13 Wishing Well S. and made it three in a row in the Mar. 24 Queen S. "She's an improving filly and she just keeps getting better," Kenneally told *Daily Racing Form*. **Madison field, p7**

Afternoon Delight...

The leading light came midway through the afternoon on day one at Easter, when Rob McAnulty outlasted underbidders including Walter Alteri of Newlands Stud and Bob Ingham's Woodlands to get the stunning dark bay by Redoute's Choice (Aus) out of Egyptian Ibis (NZ). The colt, sporting four white socks and a white blaze, cruised around the sale ring as though he had not a care in the world as his four would-be purchasers fought it out. McAnulty, sitting at the top of the auditorium, prevailed on behalf of a group of eight businessmen. "He is a beautiful, athletic colt, but he cost a bit more than I thought," said McAnulty, adding, "We have a group of people, but there will be a couple of shares in him to sell." Redoute's Choice had 18 yearlings go under the hammer yesterday, and they averaged A\$627,800. McAnulty also secured last year's first-day topper, a Redoute's Choice colt out of the Last Tycoon (Ire) mare Urge to Merge (Aus). That colt, named Allied Force (Aus), is trained by David Hayes.

Highgrove Switches Roles...

The yearling barn of prominent Queensland breeders Ron and Debbie Gilbert is just a few metres from that of Tyreel Stud in its customary spot closest to the sale ring at the Inglis Newmarket complex, so the Gilberts, from the Toowoomba farm Highgrove Stud, had plenty of opportunity to admire hip 29, Tyreel's filly by Redoute's Choice as she sashayed frequently in a week of inspections before the sale began. It did not go unnoticed, either, that the filly--out of the Woodman mare African Rain (Aus)--was bred on the same cross as likely Horse of the Year Miss Finland (Aus). Highgrove, frequently leading vendor on average, sold a yearling for A\$1.2 million at Easter last year, but they found themselves in the role of buyer yesterday, going to A\$1.6 million to take the top-selling filly home.

Ron Gilbert admitted the role-switch was slightly nerve-wracking, adding that A\$200,000 was the most he previously had paid for a filly at auction. "Pedigrees like that don't come along all that often, and I loved the filly," he said. "She is out of only a young mare, but from a great family and fillies like that are hard to buy. She is a big strong filly, just the type of filly I like, by the sire of the moment out of a Woodman mare. I am not saying she could be a Miss Finland, but we know that cross works and plenty don't. I knew I would have to go to a fair bit of money, I thought A\$1.2 million, but we are buying in a strong market." African Rain is a half to six stakes performers, including G1 VRC Oaks placegetter Rose O' War (Aus) (Danehill) and champion Hong Kong sprinter Mr Vitality (Aus) (Snippets {Aus}).

Belle of the Ball...

Tyreel's Jim Fleming said hip 29 was among the most popular in his consignment, but he was still pleasantly surprised by the final bid. "It was a little bit over what I expected, we were very happy with the price," said Fleming. "She was a very nice filly with a lot of lookers, over 100 inspections, so you know when you get that amount of interest you have got something special." Of the dam, who was winless in two starts, he added, "African Rain was a beautiful filly, but she had an accident and went over a fence when she was a yearling. We sent her to Lee Freedman, but she went sore every time--we could just never get her right. But she is a magnificent mare and she is throwing that conformation to her progeny." A colt by Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) out of African Rain brought A\$750,000 from Woodlands Stud at Easter in 2006.

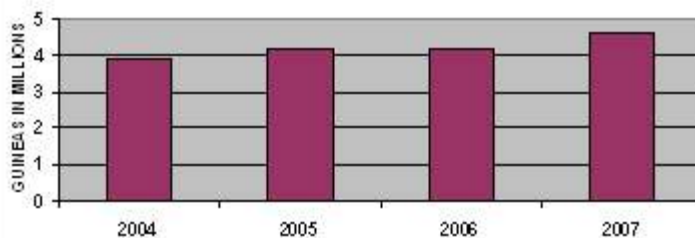

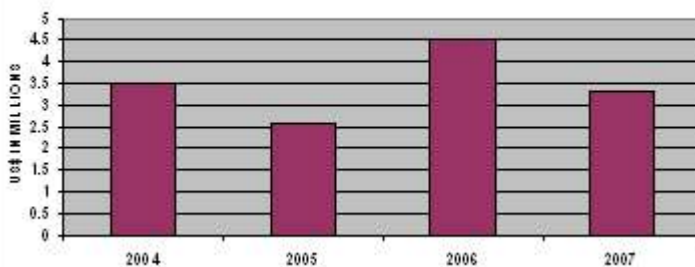

His Southern Hemisphere progeny include the exciting filly Camarilla (Aus), who will run back in this Saturday's G1 Champagne S. at Randwick after winning the G1 AJC Sires'

Produce S. last weekend. Elusive Quality had eight sell yesterday for A\$3,585,000, an average A\$448,125. Tim Stakemire, acting for Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Maktoum, went to A\$1.4 million to secure hip 79, a colt from Blue Quail (Aus) (Bluebird), a sister to G1 Coolmore Classic winner Flitter (Aus). The colt was offered by Haunui Farm, which sold its first million-dollar yearling at Karaka in January. Woodlands Stud, which paid A\$900,000 for Camarilla at Easter last year, was the underbidder on the Blue Quail colt. Haunui's Mark Chitty said it was a fantastic result for colt's breeder, Don McLaren. "Don's been a great supporter of Haunui, and it's a privilege when clients give you the chance to rear and look after horses of this calibre," Chitty said, adding that the colt's reserve was A\$200,000. "Not in my wildest dreams did I think he would make that much, but he was an absolutely lovely colt." Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's agent John Ferguson also picked up a daughter of the Darley star, going to A\$825,000 for a filly out of G1 VRC Oaks winner Bulla Borghese (Aus) (Belong to Me). "Elusive Quality is getting great results over Danzig line mares and she was a lovely filly from an Oaks winner," said Ferguson.

In addition to Holy Roman Emperor, the pairing accounted for the classy Milanova (Aus), a A\$700,000 Easter 2001 graduate who went on to become a Group 3 winner and who was also runner-up in the G1 Oaks.

LAWYER RON TO MET MILE Lawyer Ron (Langfuhr), winner of Saturday's GII Oaklawn H., will make his next start in the May 28 GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont Park, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The four-year-old won his 2007 bow, a Gulfstream allowance test Feb. 11, after a three-month break, and was making just his second start of the year at Oaklawn. Trainer Todd Pletcher feels the seven-plus weeks before the Met Mile will benefit the four-year-old. "He's a very consistent horse, and it seems like he's run well for us fresh both times, so that was sort of the game plan," Pletcher told *DRF*. "That's why we waited for the Oaklawn H. and gave him plenty of time, and the spacing from the Oaklawn to the Met is good." Lawyer Ron has won 10 of his 20 career starts, earning \$1,800,008 to date.

Wayne Hughes, said the three-year-old was sent to Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington Monday to be evaluated by Dr. Larry Bramlage. "We don't know what's wrong, but we're going to find out," said Hughes, who was in Lexington Monday to attend an under-tack show for the Keeneland sale of two-year-olds in training. Al Stall Jr. trains Ketchikan, who has won two of his four career races and has earned \$175,000. "After we threw up our Easter dinner, we decided to try and figure out what was wrong and go straight to the clinic rather than waste time with field units," Stall said.

Miller Hoping Domini-can in Blue Grass

Silverton Hill LLC's **Dominican** (El Corredor) is perfect in two tries over the Polytrack and looks to keep that record intact in Saturday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland. A troubled fourth as a maiden to GII Arkansas Derby hopeful Officer Rocket (GB) in the GIII Arlington-Washington Breeders' Cup Futurity S. last September, Dominican graduated in his Polytrack debut at Keeneland Oct. 12. Fourth to possible Blue Grass foe **Zanjero** (Cherokee Run) in a Nov. 2 allowance at Churchill and third in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov.

25, the \$150,000 OBS March juvenile resurfaced to take Turfway Park's Rushaway S. by five impressive lengths Mar. 24. That race caught even trainer Darrin Miller a bit off guard. "I expected him to run well, but I thought his performance was surprising,"

the Missouri native said during a national teleconference Tuesday. He has a great deal of confidence in Dominican and has right from the start. "He shows up for work every morning and I've never had him disappoint me," he said. "He's very consistent, as long as we've got him feeling good." But Dominican hasn't always been in such fine fettle. After running as a ridgling for his two-year-old campaign, Miller, along with owners Tommy and Bonnie Hamilton, made the decision to geld Dominican. "It was a real tough decision," Miller admitted. "He was just always uncomfortable and it was necessary to do it." But he sees little attitudinal change year over year. "He's a very aggressive horse and that hasn't changed since he was gelded," Miller added. "I haven't seen anything different as a gelding. But it has allowed him to get fuller, bigger and stronger." The conditioner has another promising sophomore colt in the barn for Silverton Hill in the form of **Sedgefield** (Smart Strike). Despite his fourth in the GIII Central Bank Transylvania S. over the Keeneland turf Apr. 6, Sedgefield, the runner-up in the GII Lane's End S. Mar. 24, remains a candidate for the Derby. He is also possible to return to the turf for the GIII Crown Royal American Turf S. May 4.

Sightseeing to Skip Derby...

Sightseeing (Pulpit), runner-up in Saturday's GI Wood Memorial S., will skip the May 5 GI Kentucky Derby. "I just don't think he's ready for it," trainer Shug McGaughey told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's going to be a big price, and if I was wrong [to run], I'm going to really be out of it." McGaughey has not decided where the Phipps homebred will run next. "I'm going to piddle around and see what happens and have the Jim Dandy and that kind of program in mind for him," he said. He added that the only way Sightseeing would join the Triple Crown fray in time for the May 19 GI Preakness S. would be if "it looks like the Derby wasn't a good race and [the Preakness] is one of those six-horse or seven-horse fields."

'Kid' Skipping Ky Oaks...

Christmas Kid (Lemon Drop Kid), a game winner of last Saturday's GI Ashland S. at Keeneland, will bypass the GI Kentucky Oaks May 4 at Churchill Downs, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Trainer Jimmy Jerkens will point the Edward Evans homebred to Belmont's GI Acorn S. June 9. Jerkens indicated that both the timing and the nine-furlong distance of the 133rd Oaks weren't quite right for his charge. "It's a little soon," he told *DRF*, "and she's got the Grade I under her belt. It doesn't really seem to make sense to wheel her right back, ship her again, and go a sixteenth of a mile further. We might even try the turf again." After taking the Tropical Park Oaks on New Year's Day over the Calder turf, the bay captured the one-mile GII Davona Dale S. Feb. 10 at Gulfstream before finishing second at a mile and an eighth in the GII Bonnie Miss S. Mar. 10.

Florida's reputation as a cradle of future top stallions--Stormy Atlantic, Yes It's True and Songandaprayer all started out at stud there--is receiving another boost through the achievements of Exchange Rate.

Exchange Rate first made headlines as a yearling. He was knocked down to Satish Sanan's Padua Stables for \$1,400,000 at the 1997 Keeneland July sales, a price which made him the most expensive of the 18 Danzig yearlings sold that year.

Sent to D. Wayne Lukas, Exchange Rate kicked off his career with an impressive win in a five-furlong Hollywood maiden event. In his next two starts, the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship and GIII Best Pal S., he ran into Dixie Union, one of the best of his crop, and finished second both times, going down by 1 1/2 lengths on the first occasion and just a 1/2-length on the second.

After these two efforts, Exchange Rate wasn't seen under silks again until February of his three-year-old career, when he kicked off the campaign with a win in a 6 1/2-furlong turf allowance race at Santa Anita. He was back on dirt for the Risen Star S., and a win over Mighty there saw him set off on the Triple Crown trail. He could do no better than fourth in the GII Louisiana Derby, as Mighty took his revenge, then was beaten more than 16 lengths when ninth in the GII Wood Memorial S. Despite this, Exchange Rate still took his place in the GI Kentucky Derby, but wound up 12th, some 20 lengths behind the winner, Fusaichi Pegasus. Five weeks later, his lines cast in somewhat shallower waters, Exchange Rate returned to take the Northern Dancer H. at Keeneland.

Having started six times in the first six months of his three-year-old season, Exchange Rate promptly disappeared for the rest of the year. He started his four-year-old campaign in a way identical to the previous season, with a win in a six-furlong Santa Anita turf allowance, but this time he stayed on the lawn to contest the GII Frank E. Kilroe H. and the GII Makers Mark Mile, finishing third in the first event and fifth, although beaten only two lengths, in the second.

Switched back to the dirt, Exchange Rate finished third in the GII Churchill Downs H. and a well-beaten 10th in the GI Met Mile before ending his career with a lifetime best performance, outfighting New York perennial Say Florida Sandy to take the GII Tom Fool H. by a neck while running the seven furlongs in 1:21.1.

Along with his Grade II triumph, Exchange Rate took with him a rather fancy pedigree when he retired to begin his stud career at Padua Stables at a fee of \$7,500. In addition being a son of Danzig, he is out of the graded-stakes winning Seeking the Gold mare, Sterling Pound, subsequently also the dam of English group winner Sabre d'Argent (Kris S.). Exchange Rate's granddam, Spectacular Bev, was also a stakes winner, and she is out of a daughter of the well-known tap-root mare Native Partner, also the dam of English champion three-year-old Ajdal; and English Group 1 winner and successful sire Formidable. In addition, Native Partner is the third dam of GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile victor Arazi and English champion three-year-old Noverre.

Exchange Rate kicked off his freshman season in 2005 with 12 two-year-old winners, headed by Blazing Rate (out of a Mr. Prospector mare; inbred 4x2 to that horse). Blazing Rate established himself as one of Florida's best two-year-olds with wins in the Foolish Pleasure Breeders' Cup S. and In Reality S. Subsequent events were to show, however, that he was only the third-best member of Exchange Rate's second crop. The filly Swap Fliparoo didn't win a stakes at two, although she took second in the GIII Astarita S. and Miss Grillo S., but she made a name for herself at three by capturing the GI Test S., and this year she has added the GIII Sabin H.

A less precocious member of Exchange Rate's first crop was Ermine, who finished second in two maiden events in two starts at two. Ermine did, however, progress quickly enough to capture the Honeybee S. in March of her three-year-old career, and followed up that performance with a second in the GI Kentucky Oaks. Ermine ended her three-year-old season with her first graded triumph, gaining a

win in the GII Falls City H., and has continued in excellent form this term, taking seconds in the GI Santa Maria H. and GI Santa Margarita H. as a prelude to a win in Saturday's GI Apple Blossom H.

Exchange Rate's second crop, currently three-year-olds, is headlined by GIII Sapling S. winner Xchanger.

Ermine is the third foal and third winner produced by her dam, the Thirty Six Red mare Red Mischief. Red Mischief never gained black-type, but was hard-knocking runner, starting 38 times for 10 wins and earnings of \$187,804. A half-sister to the Comet S. runner-up Storm Street, Red Mischief is out of the Wajima mare, Wajima Street. Her third dam, Majestic Street, won twice at two and took second in the Palo Alto S., and subsequently produced English black-type winners Palace Street and Indian Trail, as well as Stramusc, winner of the G3 Criterium di Roma. Stramusc's sister Sham Street is the dam of three stakes winners, including English group winner Melrose Avenue, and another daughter of Majestic Street, Majestic Fire, is dam of the GII Swaps Breeders' Cup S. and GII Strub S. victor Arson Squad.

Incidentally, Arson Squad is by Brahms, like Exchange Rate a son of Danzig out of a Mr. Prospector-line mare, so Arson Squad and Ermine are bred on rather similar lines.


Majestic Street's dam, the imported My Babu mare, Beaver Street, produced four stakes winners, headed by the Kentucky Oaks heroine Native Street and her sister Street Dancer (both by Majestic Street's grandsire, Native Dancer) and she is the ancestress of additional major winners including Group 1/Grade I winners Stravinsky, Fire the Groom, Dowsing, Pearl of Love, Jam Alley, Royal and Regal and Fleetstreet Dancer.

Ermine is the product of the Danzig/Seattle Slew cross which has produced more than 30 other stakes winners, including sprint champion Agnes World. Two of the stakes winners on this cross--including graded-scorer Conserve--are out of mares by Slew o' Gold. In addition to Ermine, another is out of a mare by Slew o' Gold's son Thirty Six Red.

Thirty Six Red is a Bold Ruler-line stallion with a double of Tom Fool (Ermine's dam also has double of Bold Ruler); Tom Fool and Bold Ruler--frequent partners in crime--are also combined in the dam of Exchange Rate. In both cases, one of the Tom Fool strains comes in through his son Buckpasser, broodmare sire of Exchange Rate's own broodmare sire Seeking the Gold. It's worth noting that Fliparoo, the dam of Exchange Rate's other GISW, Swap Fliparoo, also has two crosses of Tom Fool and one of Bold Ruler. Contact Alan Porter at portrpedigree@msn.com. 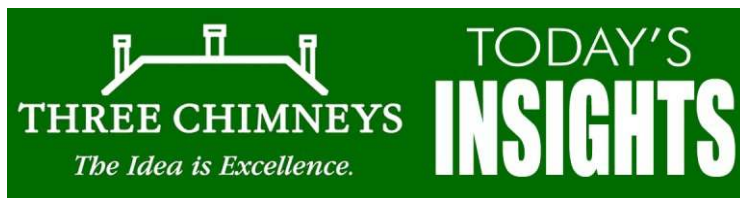

STEVE WYNN JOINS EXCELSIOR RACING Casino developer Steve Wynn, as well as real estate developers Richard Bronson and Steven Roth, have joined Excelsior Racing Associates, according to published reports. Excelsior is one of four groups bidding for the franchise currently held by the New York Racing Association. The four began presenting their proposals before a panel appointed by Gov. Eliot Spitzer in Albany yesterday, with Empire Racing leading off the proceedings, followed by NYRA. Capital Play and Excelsior will offer their presentations today. Wynn, Bronson and Roth fill the gap left when Kinsman Racing, owned by members of the George Steinbrenner family, dropped out of the group last week.

BELLO MAKES DONATION TO JOCKEYS FUND

California-based owner Michael Bello will donate \$58,000 to the Permanently Disabled Jockeys Fund and has pledged an additional \$250,000 to the Jockeys' Guild. Owner of MGISW Megahertz (GB), the building contractor is making the fund donation so former riders will each receive their scheduled \$1,000 relief payments for the month of April. "As a racehorse owner, I've developed friendships with many of the riders, and that's given me the opportunity to see racing from a different perspective," Bello said. "The jockeys are a group of hard-working, dedicated athletes who deserve more support. I'm grateful to [Guild National Manager] Dwight Manley for stepping forward into this difficult position, and I'm showing him my support." Earlier this month, Manley called on the industry for help when it was evident that the fund would not be able to send the planned \$1,000 payment in April to 58 disabled riders who currently receive monthly assistance. The saddle worn by Barbaro while winning last year's GI Kentucky Derby will be offered in a public auction held at the Mint Jubilee Gala May 4. All proceeds will go to the Disabled Jockeys Fund.

Dam of Monarchos Dead:

Regal Band (Dixieland Band--Regal Roberta, by Roberto), the dam of GI Kentucky Derby winner Monarchos, died Apr. 9 at Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington. The 20-year-old mare was being treated for liver failure at the time of her death. She was carrying a colt by Empire Maker, who was due in May. Regal Band won three of her 18 career starts, earning \$86,865. EHV CONCERN AT SHA TIN The Hong Kong Jockey Club confirmed Monday night that an outbreak of equine herpesvirus has been discovered in 132 horses--11 percent of the horse population--at Sha Tin Racecourse. According to a release from the HKJC, horses affected by the illness have exhibited mild fever and occasionally, mild blood abnormalities and mild swelling of the legs. The virus is now the official reason for the withdrawal of G1 Hong Kong Sprint winner Absolute Champion (Aus) from Monday's Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup. The release from the Jockey Club goes on to say that the horses have gone on to recover uneventfully. "Outbreaks of EHV are not uncommon overseas but rare among the Hong Kong horse population owing to the Club's system of twice daily monitoring of temperatures and biannual vaccinations against equine influenza, EHV and Japanese Encephalitis," said Dr. Brian Stewart, the Club's Head of Veterinary Regulation and International Liaison. "In this recent case in Hong Kong, the comprehensive surveillance systems and the aggressive and early application of disease control measures combined to contribute to the relatively minor impact of a potentially serious disease outbreak." The news is potentially damaging to the Jockey Club, as leading stables from around the world may reconsider accepting invitations to the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup Apr. 29. That day's meeting also includes the G1 Champions Mile.

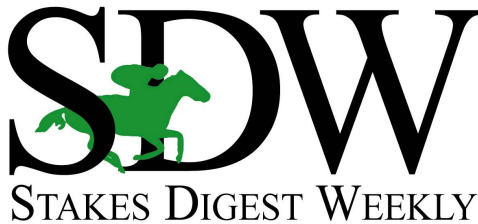
