MEANS TO AN END

In 1990, trainer Carl Nafzger saddled Unbridled to a third-place finish in the Blue Grass S., then a Grade II, before the strapping bay colt went on to wear the blanket of roses on the first Saturday in May. Nafzger, who is now semi-retired and maintains a string of just 13 horses, is using the Keeneland centerpiece again to prep for the Derby, this time with reigning two-year-old champion

Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}). And the \$64,000 question is how tight will he be for the nine-furlong event? The conditioner did a masterful job of managing the Jim Tafel runner in 2006, using each appearance at the races as an educational tool towards bigger and better goals. Following his third-place finish in the one-mile GIII Arlington-Washington Breeders' Cup Futurity, Street Sense made his first local appearance in Keeneland's GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity in October. Trapped wide for most of that journey, he made a bold, sweeping move to lead into the stretch, but flattened out a bit late to finish third to **Great Hunter** (Aptitude) and Circular Quay. The plan all came together in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Nov. 4, when Street Sense stormed home a 10-length winner, and it appears he's lost little at three. He outgunned Any Given Saturday to take the GIII Tampa Bay Derby Mar. 17, has since returned to his base at Churchill and has trained sensationally since. Nafzger knows his colt is one of a kind. "He's a patient horse," the conditioner told *Daily Racing Form*. "He does what I like. He doesn't make mistakes." To be sure, there is little room for error if Great Hunter improves even a little off his seasonal debut, a career-best performance in the Mar. 3 GII Robert B. Lewis S. (ex Santa Catalina S.) at Santa Anita. Third, beaten over 12 lengths in the Juvenile, the Pennsylvania-bred colt finished willingly to best Sam P. by 1 1/4 lengths in the Lewis. Given his obvious affinity for synthetic surfaces--he trains regularly over the Cushion Track at Hollywood Park--the dark bay will take some beating this afternoon. CURLIN FOR DOLLARS

The GII Arkansas Derby has been one of the most productive preps for the Kentucky Derby over recent years, with Smarty Jones completing the double in 2004 and Afleet Alex just missing in Louisville after

airing in Hot Springs in 2005. Stonestreet Stables, Padua Stables and George Bolton's **Curlin** (Smart Strike) has been nothing short of sensational in his two trips to the post thus far. The chestnut drifted out during the stretch run of his Feb. 3 debut over seven furlongs at

Gulfstream Park, but it didn't much matter, as he crossed the line a 12 3/4-length winner. Sold for a reported \$3.5 million off that victory, Curlin was turned over to trainer Steve Asmussen, who readied the colt for the GIII Rebel S. Mar. 17. Second choice that afternoon to **Flying First Class** (Perfect Mandate), he swept four wide into the stretch and rolled to a 5 1/4-length success over **Officer Rocket** (GB) (Officer). "Curlin has had a lot of obstacles to overcome," Asmussen said this morning at Wednesday's draw, "but talent isn't one of them. He is a very talented colt. Curlin answered a lot of questions in the Rebel. He surprises me at times." **Arkansas Derby cont. p3**

On the Fringes...

Although the top two seem to be in a different class, the rest of the field feature horses who could make some noise later in the year. Silverton Hill LLC's **Dominican** (El Corredor) was third to the sidelined Tiz Wonderful and Any Given Saturday in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. last November and returned from a five-month absence to post a resounding five-length success in the Mar. 24 Rushaway S. over the Turfway Polytrack. The chestnut was under consideration for today's GII Arkansas Derby, but, drawing on his strong performance at Turfway, trainer Darrin Miller opted to take on the big boys in Lexington.

Winchell Thoroughbred LLC's **Zanjero** (Cherokee Run) failed to make it into the field for the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but instead took in a Nov. 2 allowance at Churchill and won it by a length, with Dominican back in fourth. The \$700,000 Keeneland September yearling comes into this with thirds in the GIII Risen Star S. Feb. 10 and the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 10. **Teufflesberg** (Johannesburg), upset winner two back of the Southwest S. Feb. 19, looms the controlling speed this afternoon. **Time Squared** (Fusaichi Pegasus) topped last year's Keeneland April Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training at \$1.05 million and just last Friday broke his maiden over the local Polytrack.

favorite for the GIII Rebel S. But he dropped out of contention readily after six furlongs and "fell apart" according to *Daily Racing Form*, finishing eighth of nine, 13 lengths adrift of Curlin.

Deadly Dealer ships in for the always-dangerous Todd Pletcher barn. A maiden winner at the Fair Ground for

trainer Ronny Werner Dec. 24, the bay was purchased privately by Charles H. Wacker III of Oonagh Maccool (Ire) fame and took a 7 1/2-furlong allowance test at Gulfstream Park by seven lengths Mar. 3. **Officer Rocket** bested Street Sense in the Arlington-Washington BC Futurity last September and was second to Teuflesberg in the Feb. 19 Southwest S.

Harry Aleo became a household name in the racing world as his Lost of the Fog sprinted to championship honors in 2005. The 87-year-old is back on the sprint championship trail again this year with four-year-old Smokey Stover, who captured his fourth straight victory in last Saturday's GII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. Aleo, with the help of trainer Greg Gilchrist, bought both speedsters as two-year-olds.

Smokey Stover was purchased for \$140,000 at the 2005 FTMMAY auction, but Lost in the Fog was purchased privately after failing to meet his reserve at the 2004 OBSMAR sale.

"We bid on Lost in the Fog [at OBS], but he went much higher," Aleo explained. "We didn't realize it, but the consignor bought him back. They called us a few weeks later and asked if we were still interested."

"I buy yearlings every once in a while, I bought a couple at Ocala a few weeks ago," Aleo said. "But I like the two-year-olds in training sales. You can actually see the horses, how they move and how they run. You can't do that at the yearling sale, you can't see them actually running."

As for his strategy for picking out two-year-olds, Aleo said, "I leave that up to my trainer--he knows a lot more about that than me. I can tell if they're crooked and things like that, but I'm not the greatest at picking them out."

Aleo has "about a half-dozen" horses in training and estimates that 90 percent were bought as two-year-olds.

The California native has been a racing fan most of his life.

"I was interested in racing when I was 16 or 17," Aleo commented. "I would follow the races--it was the big thing then, before football and baseball. You'd always have crowds like we had at Santa Anita on Saturday. I saw Seabiscuit and Citation. I had no money to buy a horse of my own, but once I had a few dollars, I bought some horses."

Aleo found those "few dollars" in the real estate business. And he remains actively involved in the real estate business, with no plans for retirement.

"I'm a realtor," he said. "I own an office and take care of my property and my racing business. If you retire, you mildew and die."

Smokey Stover is currently enjoying a short vacation before beginning the second half of his 2007 campaign in Florida later this summer.

"Smokey Stover is getting some rest," Aleo said. "He's not on the farm, but he's just getting some time off. We plan on pointing him towards the [GII] Smile [Sprint H.] at Calder in July."

The good fortune of having two such racing stars is not lost on Aleo.

"Two out of three years to have two horses like these," he said appreciatively. "What are the odds?"

Trainer Todd Pletcher sent **Wait a While** to Santa Anita for the GI Yellow Ribbon S. last Sept. 30 specifically to get the firm underfoot conditions the attractive gray filly prefers. With abundant rain predicted for the Bluegrass, that seems somewhat unlikely and renders the odds-on morning-line favorite a bit vulnerable over a course notoriously quirky, wet or dry. Her form on the top of the ground makes her very tough to go past. Fourth to Ouija Board (GB) in the GI Breeders' Cup

Filly and Mare Turf following the Yellow Ribbon, Wait a While returned to action with a rock-solid success over **Precious Kitten** in the GIII Honey Fox H. Mar. 4. "She's clearly not as spectacular on soft ground as firm," Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "That doesn't mean she's not okay, but she's not as good." Named champion three-year-old filly, she won the GI American Oaks in addition to the Yellow Ribbon and was second in the GI Ashland S. and a promoted third in the GI Kentucky Oaks on the main track. One who might prefer some cut in the ground is Live Oak Plantation's **My Typhoon**. A close fourth in the GI Diana S. over a yielding Saratoga turf Sept. 29, the 1.8 million Tattersalls December weanling purchase closed the season with a respectable sixth in the Filly and Mare Turf. She might have a fitness advantage over Wait a While, as she made her 2007 debut in the Mar. 17 GIII Hillsborough H. at Tampa Bay Downs, finishing a good second over a course labeled 'good.' **Mauralakana** has upset claims off her performance in last year's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup, where she went down by just a half-length to Vacare. She was an overmatched seventh in the Filly and Mare Turf and lands in a difficult spot for her comebacker.

The four-year-old posted a career-

best 105 Beyer in a 2 3/4-length victory against \$40,000 optional claimers last out Mar. 16. **Ramsgate** should really take to this surface if his Hollywood Cushion form is any indication. The chestnut rattled off three straight over that course last term, including a \$100,000 optional claiming tally Dec. 17. He finished a good third behind Latent Heat and Proud Tower Too in the GII San Carlos H. last out Feb. 17. **Midnight Lute** notched this track's Oct. 13 GIII Perryville S. over **Lewis Michael** before placing third in the GI Malibu S. Dec. 26. The dark bay enters off a pair of routes--a second-place finish in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. Jan. 13 and a fourth-place finish in the GII Strub S. Feb. 3. He has bullets in the holster for his return.

Boca Grande debuted with a well-beaten third-place finish at Saratoga last September, but stepped up her game when stretched to one mile at Bemont Oct. 18, defeating subsequent UAE Oaks and UAE 1000 Guineas heroine Folk by 5 1/4 lengths. The Phipps homebred made the transition to stakes company without a problem, annexing this track's GII Demoiselle S. by 3 3/4 lengths Nov. 25, then was freshened for the winter. She resurfaced with a disappointing sixth-place finish in the seven-furlong GII Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream last time Mar. 10. "Seven furlongs is probably shorter than what she wants," said jockey Mike Smith, who is headed back to Southern California to ride first-call for owner Jerry Moss and trainer John Shirreffs. "She also lost a shoe going to the paddock. They had to re-shoe her in the paddock and she got really upset. She's usually a pretty cool horse; calm and collected. She lost it that day and basically ran that way." **Desire to Excel**, victress of last season's Astoria S. at Belmont July 2, returned from a runner-up effort in Saratoga's GIII Schuylerville S. July 26 with a fifth-place finish in Tampa's Florida Oaks Mar. 17. **Perfect Forest** enters riding a two-race winning streak for trainer Todd Pletcher, including a Gulfstream allowance last time Mar. 2.

GREAT HUNTER OWNER SEEKS CONTEMPT RULING AGAINST BANK

Attorneys representing the owner of Great Hunter are returning to court just one day before the colt is scheduled to run in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland, asking a California judge to hold in contempt a Kentucky bank that claims it has an interest in the colt. Owner J. Paul Reddam's legal team will argue in Orange County Superior Court April 13 that Fifth Third Bank violated a previous court-ordered agreement they claim temporarily prevents the financial institution from interfering with Great Hunter's run in the April 14 Blue Grass. Reddam's attorney, Dan Baren, said Keeneland was recently sent a letter by Fifth Third Bank that asks the track to refrain from distributing any purse winnings Great Hunter might earn in the race. Fifth Third Bank claims it has an interest in the horse because the colt purportedly was part of collateral used on since-defaulted loans extended to the horse's former owner, Ilona Whetstone, and her husband, L. Eric Whetstone. Reddam privately purchased Great Hunter for \$550,000 last June. "The order prevents them from doing anything that interferes with Reddam's ownership of the horse, and certainly one of the benefits of owning a horse is collecting the purse money," said Baren. "Here they (Fifth Third Bank) are sending a letter to the track, where they have ATMs, and where they sponsor a race, and are putting pressure on the track to do something that is clearly wrong. (The order) specifically bars (the bank) from taking any action that would interfere with Reddam's ownership of the horse," he continued. "I will let you decide whether claiming entitlement of purse winnings interferes with ownership of the horse. I think it is pretty clear." Keeneland spokesman Jim Williams confirmed that the track had received a letter from Fifth Third Bank, and that officials immediately contacted Reddam about it, but declined to comment further.

Lexington attorney William "Buddy" Bishop, who represents Keeneland in legal matters, also said he could not comment. Fifth Third Bank has been tight-lipped about the situation ever since news of its claimed interest in Great Hunter surfaced in early March. "We are not commenting on this because it is a matter of pending litigation," said Debra DeCourcy, director of corporate communications at Fifth Third Bank. **Click [here](#) to continue.**

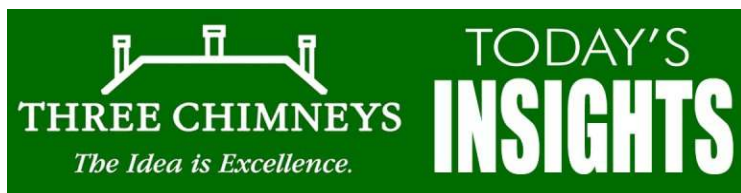

DANEHILL SON STRADA TO WIDDEN STUD

Dual listed winner **Strada (Aus)** (Danehill--Shindig {NZ}, by Straight Strike) has been retired to stand at Widden Stud in the NSW Hunter Valley in 2007 at a fee of A\$12,000, plus 10 percent GST. "Danehill is clearly the ultimate sire of sires, certainly in Australia, and we couldn't be happier to stand one of his most attractive stakes winners," Widden's Antony Thompson said in a statement. "He won two prestigious sprint races in fast time and there won't be many more opportunities, if any, to secure a Danehill son, particularly one with so many positive attributes as Strada demonstrates." A A\$750,000 purchase at the 2004 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, Strada was raced by Alan Bell, John Symonds and Nick Moraitis. He won four of nine starts for trainer Gai Waterhouse and retires with earnings of A\$190,075. Strada won the Listed Eskimo Prince S. and Listed Carrington S., both at 1100 meters, and was fourth, just over a length from Proprietor (Aus), in the G1 Galaxy S. Strada was off the board in his last outing, the Feb. 3 G1 Lightning S., a race won by Miss Andretti (Aus). Strada's dam Shindig won the 1998 G1 Coolmore Classic in course-record time. She has also produced Group 3 winner Shinzig (Aus) and stakes-placed Fiammarosa (Aus).

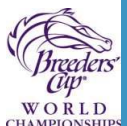
