It was 8-1 upsetter **Dominican** (El Corredor) who stole the show in a roughly run edition of yesterday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland. Southwest S. winner **Teufflesberg** (Johannesburg) was uncontested on the lead through :26.12 and :51.46 fractions, as Do-

minican sat in fifth. The pacesetter began to tire in midstretch, and drifted out into **Great Hunter** (Aptitude), who was forced to check. Juvenile champ **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) and Dominican rallied in tandem on the outside, and it was the Silver-

ton Hill colorbearer who got his nose on the line first over the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner. **Zanjero** (Cherokee Run) stayed on stubbornly in the stretch to place a close third. "My horse just gave me everything he had to win," winning jockey Rafael Bejarano said. **Cont. p2**

Deadly Dealer (Concerto) clicked off fractions of :23.56 and :47.89, Curlin inhaled the pacesetter on the turn for home and powered clear to a 10 1/2-length victory over **Storm in May** (Tiger Ridge). "I was impressed with

how much he had improved between this start and his last one," jockey Robby Albarado said. "He stayed straight through the stretch unlike his previous races."

Dominican finished fourth in the GIII Arlington-Washington Breeders' Cup Futurity Sept. 10, then graduated over this course

Oct. 12. He ran fourth to Zanjero in a Churchill allowance Nov. 2, and closed out his juvenile campaign with a third-place finish in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov. 25.

Gelded since that effort, the chestnut ran away to a five-length victory in the Rushaway S. over Turfway's Polytrack last time Mar. 24 and made it three-for-three over synthetic surfaces with a narrow victory here.

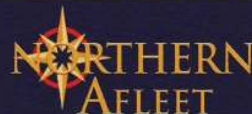

Great Hunter lost all chance after taking up in deep stretch and had to settle for fifth. "It's a bummer," trainer Doug O'Neill said from California. "I thought we'd have been right there if not for that incident in the stretch. From that standpoint, I think he ran a good race. But his lane completely got taken away from him. Hopefully, he came out of it okay. When you're going at that speed and get shut off you just hope you come out okay. If he looks okay, we're going on with our plans to go to the Derby."

Curlin debuted with a spectacular 12 3/4-length win going seven furlongs at Gulfstream Feb. 3 for trainer Helen Pitts and was subsequently purchased privately. He handled the jump to stakes company without a problem, taking this track's Mar. 17 GIII Rebel S. by 5 1/4 lengths and delivered once again as the heavy favorite here. "He is a very smart horse," trainer Steve Asmussen commented. "Curlin is brilliant in more ways than one. I know people are

saying he lacks experience. But I have had some real nice horses with experience that couldn't do the things this colt can do. I expect him to go off favorite in the Kentucky Derby. I was tight all day, just running a colt like this. He was more mature today, than in the Rebel."

He didn't tell us and the first we heard about it was when he said I've got Gallic back in the stable. This will be a very special win for dad and the whole team--he's the favourite."

BIRCH CLAIMS NATIONAL PRIZE After another pulsating finish to the Grand National Handicap Chase at Aintree, it was the 10-year-old **Silver Birch (Ire)** (Clearly Bust {Ire}) who emerged triumphant to provide another fairytale ending for his connections. Taking it up at the last fence under Robbie Power, the 33-1 shot fought off **Slim Pickings (Ire)** (Scribano {GB}) after a prolonged duel and galloped relentlessly to the line, where he had 3/4 of a length to spare over **McKelvey (Ire)** (Anshan {GB}), who had closed out wide. "I got a great run the whole way and he jumped and traveled great," explained Power, son of the famous Irish showjumper Con Power. "Gordon was worried he wouldn't be able to lay up early on, but it meant I was able to keep out of trouble. As soon as he got to the front, he did nothing." Elliott, who is a relative minion on the Irish jumps circuit, paid tribute to the winner, who was last seen finishing second in the Cross-Country Chase at the Cheltenham Festival. "We got him from the sales and we've tried to sweeten him up by hunting him," he said. "He's improved the whole time I've had him and I thought he was better here than he was going to Cheltenham. It's been a great team effort and everything has gone according to plan. He's an old gentleman."
