**A MATTER OF TRUST**

Though seven of the 10 three-year-olds entered in today's GII Coolmore Lexington S. are Triple Crown nominees, the only way any of them can make the starting gate for the GI Kentucky Derby in two weeks' time is to emerge as a winner here. One of the non-nominated colts is **Trust Your Luck** (Mr. Greeley), who graduated in his first try over Polytrack at Turfway Feb. 17. Following a narrow loss in a Mar. 3 allowance at the Florence, Kentucky, oval, the grey led at the stretch call of Turfway's Rushaway S. Mar. 24 before succumbing late to Dominican. Trust Your Luck was flattered when that rival came back to upset the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. last weekend, and a good performance here would offer some consolation to trainer Helen Pitts. Pitts saddled Curlin to his impressive maiden victory Feb. 3 at Gulfstream, but was left without a star when that chestnut was transferred to Steve Asmussen following a private sale. The Lexington will also feature the return of **Belgravia** (Mr. Greeley), who hasn't raced since December. The \$2-million FTFEB purchase, a debut winner over this surface Oct. 18, came back with a game victory in the GIII Hollywood Prevue S. on Cushion Track a month later. **O'Neill On Hand at Keeneland...**

Trainer Doug O'Neill flew to Keeneland from his California base to watch a pair of his GI Kentucky Derby contenders breeze yesterday morning. J. Paul Reddam's **Liquidity** (Tiznow) went six furlongs in 1:11.40 ([video](#)), while Merv Griffin's **Cobalt Blue** (Golden Missile) covered five-eighths in 1:01.80 ([video](#)). Exercise rider Tony Romero was aboard both colts. "The workouts were really just maintenance stuff," O'Neill said. "I wasn't looking for a whole lot as far as time goes. It's a couple of weeks out [before the Kentucky Derby May 5]. It's more of a leg-stretcher and just to see how they are physically prior to the work and after the work and go from there and see where we are." O'Neill caught a plane back to California yesterday afternoon, but plans to be back in Kentucky Apr. 27, when another Derby contender, Grade I winner Great Hunter, is slated to have his first drill since finishing a troubled fifth in the Blue Grass. **Triple Threats cont. p5**

**Solva** won a pair of handicaps in Britain during her tenure under Brian Meehan before closing out her career there with a fourth in the Listed John Musker S. at Yarmouth Sept. 13. She made her U.S. bow Feb. 1, rallying four wide to deny **Naughty Rafaela** in the La Zanzara H. over course and distance. The latter, a Group 1 winner in Brazil, broke through in this country on her fifth try, a local allowance at this trip Feb. 28. Another ex-British runner is **Mabadi**, who landed her stateside debut Feb. 14 before running second to **Sweet Belle** in a nine-furlong allowance Mar. 29. Trainer Sandy Shulman would like to see the four-year-old reserved in the early stages this time. "She was a little too close [to the pace] in that race," he explained. "She has to be taken hold of and make one run, but she's a nice filly. She can run."

Hall of Fame trainer Allen Jerkens may have been dubbed the Giant Killer back in the day, but he saddles the two most accomplished runners in this field, MGSW **Any Limit** and GISW **Swap Fliparoo**. Any Limit, who took the My Flag S. going a mile over this strip in October, broke through at Gulfstream this winter with victories in the GIII First Lady H. Jan. 20 and GIII Hurricane Bertie H. Feb. 17. She just failed to last in the GII Shirley Jones Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 17 and settled for second. The bay will have to avoid a speed duel with the tough **Magnolia Jackson**, but her stretch-running stablemate would appreciate that scenario. "I wasn't going to run Swap Fliparoo, but it was coming up a small field," Jerkens explained. "If they go fast up front, she'll have a good chance."

**Greenham S. preview cont.**

**Dutch Art** owes his place near the top of the market for the G1 2000 Guineas to his obvious class, but it is the unbeaten colt's stamina that remains the major question mark. Having shown brilliant speed over the five furlongs of Royal Ascot's G2 Norfolk S. in June and the six furlongs of

Deauville's G1 Prix Morny in August and G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket the next month, he faces his first acid test stretching out an extra panel in this traditional trial. Jockey Jimmy Fortune is hopeful he can last out. "I've seen him race and he looks pretty straightforward to me," he told *PA Sport*. "He is unbeaten in four starts and the only question he has to answer is if he will stay. We are hoping for a big run and we'll find out a lot more [today]." Peter Chapple-Hyam, who captured this with Turtle Island (Ire) in 1994 and with Victory Note four years later, also saddles **Tariq**, who has not been seen since finishing third in the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot in June. "Tariq has been working exceptionally well this spring and I'm looking forward to running him," the trainer commented. "Obviously, this is his first run since the Coventry and he is entitled to be a little ring rusty. He won't mind the ground, either." Like Chapple-Hyam, Richard Hannon is looking for a third renewal with **Major Cadeaux**, who also returns from an enforced absence after finishing a place in front of Tariq in the Coventry. "He had a couple of problems after Royal Ascot, but he's fine now and he's been working brilliantly," the conditioner's son and assistant Richard Hannon Jr. told *PA Sport*. "Last year he was just a little bit weak, but we've trained him like a Classic horse ever since and we will continue to do that until he proves to us he is otherwise. We just wanted to go over seven furlongs first time out, as the trip is a concern and, if the ground is firm, then he won't run."

Last year's G1 Cheveley Park S. heroine **Indian Ink** returns in contrasting conditions to those she encountered at Newmarket in September in a bid to treble Richard Hannon's tally in this 1000 Guineas prep. Having been collared in the closing stages of the G2 Lowther S. by **Silk Blossom** at York in August, the chestnut had made the most of the following month's rain to capture the Watership Down Stud Sales S. at Ascot and Cheveley Park in the space of a week. "She's a Group 1 winner and I don't think she's been give due respect really," Richard Hannon Jr. told *PA Sport*. "I don't think she needs it soft, it's just that when it is soft it stops the others. She's an extremely good filly with bundles of speed and a great attitude, and I think she'll go close [today]." Silk Blossom emerged from her Lowther success to garner another valuable sales race, the Goffs Fillies' Five Hundred at The Curragh in September. However, she needed the intervention of the stewards to do so, as **Wait Watcher** had got the better of her in the closing stages, despite drifting across her line. While Silk Blossom will be bidding to provide trainer Barry Hills with a second renewal, a win for Wait Watcher would be breaking new ground for Paul Blockley. "I was distraught after the Curragh, but there is no question of revenge over Silk Blossom as I think we will need the run, so we will just enjoy it," he told *PA Sport*. "The more rain the better for her, but it doesn't look like we are going to get any. She is definitely better with cut in the ground, but she has form on good ground."

Doug O'Neill had been concerned about **Great Hunter** (Aptitude), who was forced to take up several times when fifth in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland Apr. 14. "My initial fear was that I hoped he didn't get hurt," said the conditioner. "Whenever a horse has to take up so suddenly in the stretch run, you worry about injury. Fortunately, he came out of it in great shape, and the old cliché

is, 'There's no future in the past,' so we're going to press on. Great Hunter looked great [Friday].

**Still in the Hunt..**

**Teuflesberg** (Johannesburg), who settled for fourth after cutting out glacial fractions in the Blue Grass, galloped two miles yesterday at Keeneland and remains on course of the Kentucky Derby. The bay currently ranks 20th on graded-earnings list. "I think he's better than he's ever been," said co-owner and trainer Jamie Sanders. "He is so strong." CHRB Sets Penalty Guidelines:

The California Horse Racing Board (CHRB) established a strict set of penalty guidelines for medication violations and related drug classifications which apply to all CHRB licensees, including trainers, owners and veterinarians. The new guidelines call for a minimum one-year suspension to any trainer found guilty of a Category A violation, a violation which includes drugs with the highest potential to affect a horse's performance and have no medical use in the animal. Repeated offenses could lead to longer suspensions or permanent license revocation, along with a fine of up to \$50,000 to the owner and the trainer. A vet found guilty of administering a Category A drug will be referred to the California Veterinary Medical Board for consideration for further disciplinary action and would be disallowed from practicing at any California racetrack. The guidelines are slightly different from those proposed by the Racing Medication and Testing Consortium (RMTC) and offer licensees to offer mitigating circumstances for the Board's consideration. Owners of horses in the most serious cases would also face penalties. They would forfeit any purse money, as required by California Horse Racing Law, but could also have their horses ruled out of competition for a period of several months. The Board could also require further testing at the owner's expense. In the case of a third violation in Category A, owners can be fined as much as \$50,000. The Board has also set out to prevent suspended trainers from benefitting financially during their bans. New regulations prohibit the transfer of horses to family members and any trainer "suspended 60 days or more shall be banned from all inclosures under the jurisdiction of the CHRB." Trainers would also be forced to remove all stall space assigned them and remove all advertisements, trainer-related equipment, tack, office equipment and other property. The five drug classes (Classes 1-5) are based on the Racing Commissioners International drug classification system in use across the country; the four penalty categories (A, B, C and D) were set by the RMTC. The Board will continue to file complaints against trainers of horses that exceed the threshold of 37.0mmol/l for total carbon dioxide (TCO2). Additional deterrents are in place for readings in excess of 39mmol/l.

Jockey Fran Ferris, who is currently serving a two-year disqualification from racing, received a further three-year disqualification by the Horseracing Regulatory Authority yesterday. In completing the handing out of punishments to the five licensed individuals judged to have broken the rules of racing by providing information for reward, the disciplinary panel has created window for appeal. Ferris's disqualification is as a result of being found guilty on five counts of deliberately riding a horse to lose with the knowledge that it was being laid to lose on the exchange betfair. On Thursday, fellow jockeys Shane Kelly, David Nolan and Josh Byrne received bans for 12 months, nine months and four months, respectively, while trainer Phil McEntee had his licence suspended for a year. Unlike Ferris, the remaining four can still work in racing. All have the opportunity to appeal up to 5 p.m. next Friday, with the suspensions due to start Apr. 28.
