NAUGHTY BUT NICE

A Group 1 victress in her native Brazil, **Naughty Rafaela (Brz)** (Royal Academy) joined the ranks of U.S. graded winners with a rallying score in the GII Santa Barbara H. at Santa Anita yesterday. The five-year-old capped off her South American career with success at the highest level at Ciudad Jardim in December of 2005, but didn't make her U.S. bow until October of 2006. Third after a rough trip in that Oak Tree allowance test, she finished an even fifth in the Nov. 11 Hermosa Beach H. before taking a short break. The bay returned to finish a close-up second in an optional claimer Jan. 5 and was third in the Feb. 1 La Zanzara H. before earning her first stateside photo session after an allowance victory Feb. 28. The second choice in her first graded try this side of the equator, Naught Rafaela tracked **Sweet Belle** (Deputy Commander) from fourth. She angled outside for the stretch drive, fought her way past the pacesetter and edged clear, giving trainer Bobby Frankel his fourth win in this race in the last five years, and his sixth overall. **Marabadi** (Sahm) got up for second. "The race set up good for her," said Frankel's assistant, Humberto Ascanio. "It might have looked like she had a tough time getting to the front, but she's a one-paced mare. She doesn't have that kind of acceleration. I just told [jockey David Flores] to be patient and everything worked out." Added Flores, "It worked out great because I was able to lay close enough that I was able to put pressure on them at the right time." **Chart, p2**

Change of Pace at Keeneland...

Seventh in his first two starts, **Slew's Tizzy** broke through with a front-running score going 1 1/16 miles Jan. 13. An 82-1 outsider in the Risen Star, he clipped heels while racing in fourth early, losing his jockey and impeding half the field, including 6-5 favorite Circular Quay, who ended up fifth. Off at 52-1 in the Louisiana Derby, he pressed the pace from third early, but weakened down the lane to be seventh again, 11 1/2 lengths behind Circular Quay. It was no surprise that he was the longest shot in the Lexington field. The Joseph LaCombe homebred, who raced with blinkers in his last four starts, was without the hood yesterday, but found himself in front as they raced away from the gate. On the lead through a half in :48.17 and six panels in 1:12.41, he shook off **Soaring By** (Deputy Minister) as they came out of the turn and held **Starbase** at bay to pull off the shocker. "He had his ears up," jockey Robby Albarado remarked. "He was content being up there on the lead. I just tried to keep him as quiet as possible. He exploded when I called on him." Added Greg Fox, "I was concerned when the horse was on the lead, but I started to get excited when I saw Robby sitting there on a tremendous amount of horse. [Soaring By] was struggling and I knew if we could get loose, we had a shot." The colt will not wheel back in the May 5 GI Kentucky Derby. Bad Day for Belgravia...

Making his first start since finishing fourth in the Dec. 16 GI Hollywood Futurity, **Belgravia** (Mr. Greeley) was rated in fifth early, but tired after six furlongs and was not ridden out to the wire. "I had a good trip, but when I asked him at the three-eighths, he had nothing, no juice or anything," jockey Julien Leparoux said. "He stopped right there and I just rode him easy, no whip or anything. When he came back, we saw that he bled. I think that's the excuse for today."

The winner of an optional claimer at Belmont Park in September, Carmandia made it two in a row in the seven-furlong Nov. 4 GII First Flight H. at Aqueduct. The chestnut mare was outrun when stretched to a mile for the GII Top Flight H. 20 days later, finishing fifth, and took a short break. Fourth after enduring a wide trip in the Feb. 17 GII Barbara Fritchie BC H. at Laurel in her 2007 opener, she was second choice with the return to New York here. Fifth and last as they raced away from the gate, she still trailed as Magnolia Jackson and even-money Any Limit (Limit Out) duked it out through a half in :45.15. The favorite faded down the lane, leaving Magnolia Jackson in front, but Carmandia closed from the rail to take over inside the eighth pole and drew clear. "I think the key was that she was fresh, she likes the track and she likes seven-eighths," trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. said. "Those three things make her tough." Any Limit had an excuse for her fourth-place finish. "After the first furlong, the saddle started slipping," jockey Rafael Bejarano explained. Last of all early, Kettleoneup passed all of her rivals for her first stakes victory as even-money Mo Cuishle (Saint Ballado) ran fourth. Kettleoneup has made great strides since trouncing Mountaineer maidens by 11 lengths Sept. 25, following up with a 12-length tally in an allowance at the West Virginia oval Oct. 20 before finishing second to GISW Sugar Shake in a Churchill allowance Nov. 17. Wintering at Oaklawn, the chestnut came back with another daylight allowance win Jan. 28 before finishing second in both the Pippin S. Feb. 17 and the GIII Azeri Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 10. Though the third choice was content to caboose the short field early here as Mo Cuishle led, she began to draw closer entering the far turn. Jockey Calvin Borel angled his mount to the outside approaching the stretch and was forced to take up when My Chickadee came out a bit, but Kettleoneup regrouped, put her head in front and drove clear in the final sixteenth. The two were head and head after six panels in 1:10.50, with their two rivals far behind, but Master Command powered clear in the final drive to go three-for-three on the year. The chestnut picked up his first graded score in the GIII W.D. Schaefer H. at Pimlico last May and added the GII Meadowlands Breeders' Cup to his resume in October. Fourth in the Nov. 24 GI Clark H.,

Cal-bred Bonfante had to fight for it, but he earned his first graded score with a gallant decision over the ultra-game Battle Won. The bay gelding was off the board in three straight before turning it around to take the Oct. 7 Fort Mason S. on the grass at Golden Gate. Third in the Cal Cup Sprint on the Santa Anita main track three weeks later, he was then given a winter vacation. Bonfante opened the new year with a victory in the Mar. 31 California Sprint Championship S. on the Bay Meadows turf, but was the 6-1 outsider in this off-the-grass test. Battle Won, making his first appearance since a fourth in the GII Pat O'Brien BC H. at Del Mar last August, went right to the front and sailed through a half in :45.06. Waiting just off the pace early, Bonfante squeezed through an opening and went after the lead as they straightened for home. He appeared to have the race in hand, but Battle Won came back at him and it was two heads bobbing on the line. "This horse really earned this win," said jockey Aaron Gryder. She was required to pass a pair of barrier tests to prove that she had overcome her habit of sitting down in the gate, and did so successfully at Randwick Apr. 13. However, she reverted to her old habits this past week and the ban was extended. Connections were hoping to get clearance to run in next Sunday's G1 Champions Mile at Sha Tin, but Coolmore has instead decided to retire her to stud. "She was a top-class mare and a fun mare. She was a real trier and she never ran a bad race," Coolmore's Michael Kirwan told *Australian Associated Press*. "She's going to be missed. She was quite popular given her antics, but she's off to stud this season and she'll be served by Encosta de Lago (Aus)." Aqua d'Amore retires with a record of 34-9-4-7 and earnings of A\$1,926,850.

The second-highest price of the day was the €90,000 paid by John Hammond for Grove Stud's hip 131. The son of King's Best produced an eye-catching breeze during the morning session. He is a half-

brother to Feb. 24 Listed Prix Policeman winner Bold Girl (Ire) who sold for €120,000 at this sale last year. A notable international presence--which included representatives from Britain, Ireland, the Czech Republic, Germany, Greece, Italy, Scandinavia and Spain--witnessed a sale best aggregate of €3,031,000, albeit with a reduced clearance rate, and the record was boosted by a further €259,000 in private sales. Notwithstanding those private sales, the average soared over 23 percent to €32,946 while the median bettered that increase and was up 30 percent to €26,000. The Horses-In-Training catalog, which followed immediately after the Breeze Up sale, saw 19 of 27 lots sell for an aggregate €247,500.

More Losses Reported to Court by NYRA:

The New York Racing Association keeps bleeding funds, according to the racing group's latest disclosure to a federal bankruptcy judge overseeing its reorganization. After improvements following an especially sour financial month in December, NYRA reported losses of \$4.8 million in March, according to the filing. NYRA President Charles Hayward was not available for comment. NYRA lost \$7.1 million in December, blaming the flow of red ink chiefly on typical cash flow problems that occur during the slow racing month. By January, the monthly loss level had improved to \$3.9 million. The latest fiscal plight comes as NYRA is trying to hold onto the franchise to operate Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga racetracks--which it has run since 1955. NYRA is competing against three others--Excelsior Racing Associates, Empire Racing Associates and Capital Play--for the new franchise, which is scheduled to begin Jan. 1. Aides to Gov. Eliot Spitzer are currently reviewing proposals submitted by the four groups. A recommendation is expected to be delivered to Spitzer in about three weeks; from there, Spitzer and the Legislature must agree on a new franchise holder. NYRA, meanwhile, is trying to get approval of a video lottery terminal casino at Aqueduct. At the same time, the state of New York is seeking to have NYRA's entire bankruptcy case tossed out of court, arguing that it is a ward of the state and, therefore, ineligible for bankruptcy protection. During March, NYRA said it disbursed about \$14.3 million, but lost \$4.8 million.

Partners that own multiple Grade II-winner Lawyer Ron are fighting over the career of the four-year-old colt and are utilizing a Kentucky courthouse to wage their battles. The estate of breeder-owner James T. Hines Jr.--which on the eve of last year's GI Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands sold a headline-making 80 percent interest in Lawyer Ron to an affiliate company of Audrey Haisfield's Stonewall Farm Stallions--has the legal right to control the racing career of the \$1.8 million-earner, according to a November ruling by a Fayette County circuit court judge. But the judge has yet to rule on part of a counter-suit by Stonewall, which claims the estate's executor, attorney Ronald J. Bamberger (for whom Lawyer Ron is named), breached fiduciary duties owed to the partnership by continuing to race the colt in 2007. The partners are also fighting over the payment of racing and training expenses. Bamberger claims he is owed more than \$50,000 from Haisfield, who, along with other entities she manages, is contending with unrelated lawsuits and liens that level charges of about \$800,000 in unpaid bills to a variety of businesses, as well as about \$60,000 in ad valorem taxes due Woodford County, where Stonewall Farm Stallions is located. **For more, click [here](#).**
