### LONGSHOTS PUT ON A SHOW IN BEN ALI

With 6-5 favorite **Chatain** (Forest Wildcat) fading in the lane to finish eighth, it was 26-1 longshot **Jade's Revenge** (Quiet American) gamely prevailing by a nose over 14-1 **Minister's Joy** (Deputy Minister) in yesterday's GIII Ben Ali S. at Keeneland. Last seen annexing the Tejano Run S. in his Polytrack debut at Turfway Mar. 17, he stayed close to the leaders through :25.03 and :49.84 fractions here, gained a short lead in deep stretch and dug down deep to win it in a blanket photo. Jade's Revenge, who raced for a \$40,000 tag twice late last season, kicked off his four-year-old campaign with a Philly Park allowance win Jan. 7, then finished third in a \$32,000 optional claimer at Laurel Jan. 26 before winning the Tejano Run.

### DREAMING OF THE OAKS?

Reigning juvenile filly champion **Dreaming of Anna** (Rahy) may be headed to the May 4 GI Kentucky Oaks. Trainer Wayne Catalano and owner Frank Calabrese originally had planned on passing the Oaks, but may have a change of heart. "We're leaning toward [the Oaks]," said Catalano. "I'm supposed to wait and work her on the dirt at Churchill, and then make a decision." Last season's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies victress suffered her first career defeat when third in the GIII Old Hat S. at Gulfstream Feb. 10, then ran second in the grassy Gaily Gaily S. two weeks later. The chestnut has posted two listed works since, including a seven-furlong move at Keeneland 1:25.20 Apr. 21.

### BWANA BULL POSSIBLE FOR DERBY

**Bwana Bull** (Holy Bull), winner of the GIII El Camino Real Derby at Bay Meadows, may be scratched from Saturday's Derby Trial S. at Churchill and head to the GI Kentucky Derby, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer reported that his charge suffered "superficial scrapes" when shipped to Louisville from Northern California earlier this week. "We came there with the intention of running in the Derby Trial," Hollendorfer told *DRF*. "But he got a little skinned up flying out there, and we had to give him antibiotics. We could run in the Derby, I guess. It's a possibility. He does have enough money, and my owners might want to run. He's probably going to scratch from the Derby Trial. If he does, I would maybe breeze him there on Monday." The Apr. 7 GI Santa Anita Derby fifth-place finisher has \$125,000 in graded-stakes earnings.

Last season's GI Belmont S. hero **Jazil** makes his grass debut here. The Shadwell colorbearer completed the exacta in his two previous attempts this season, including a distant second behind Corinthian in a \$60,000 optional claimer at Gulfstream Feb. 8. "If they like the grass, you can run them every three weeks if you want," trainer Kieran McLaughlin told *Daily Racing Form*. "That's how many big grass races there are across the country between 1 1/4 miles and 1 1/2 miles. On the dirt, though, there really aren't that many longer races. Obviously it would be to our benefit for the colt to show he likes the grass, at least to give us that many more options with him."

Group 1 winners **Notnowcato** and **Red Rocks** forego the chance to add to their top-level tallies by sidestepping Sunday's G1 Prix Ganay and add luster to a strong renewal of this in an attempt to get back on song. Notnowcato lifted last term's G1 Juddmonte International in gritty fashion at York and comes back off an eighth in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket last October. Red Rocks emerged victorious from the GI Breeders' Cup Turf and was a last-out ninth in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. **Kandidate** had his limitations exposed when sixth in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba on the same card, but is trained by the master of surprise, Clive Brittain, and should not be discounted. **Art Deco** adds further strength to the contest and makes his long-awaited return since finishing fourth in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club and fifth in the G1 Juddmonte Grand Prix de Paris last summer.

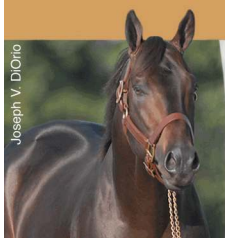

**A CASE FOR PROPONENT** Bjorn Nielsen's unbeaten G1 Epsom Derby prospect **Proponent (Ire)** (Peintre Celebre) remains on target to contest the May 17 G2 Dante S. at York, although trainer Roger Charlton had cause to resist the opportunity to tackle Epsom's Blue Riband Derby Trial at Epsom Wednesday. "Proponent is coming along nicely, but he's not quite ready for a race," Charlton told *Racing Post*. "We will prepare him for a trial, quite possibly the Dante, and we'll see then if he is good enough for the [June 2] Derby." Successful on debut at Newbury last September, the powerfully built bay impressed observers when surging to a six-length victory in a Newmarket conditions event the

following month.

**OPERA TRANSFERS TO GODOLPHIN** Last week's impressive Newbury maiden victress **Folk Opera (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) has been transferred from Michael Jarvis' Kremlin House barn and has joined Godolphin's band of G1 Epsom Oaks possibles. "We talked to Michael about her joining us and she came in yesterday," Godolphin's Simon Crisford told *Racing Post*. "She is fine after her race and will go for an Oaks Trial but we don't know which one yet."


