SIMPLY DIVINE

Stepping up to stakes company for the first time yesterday in the GIII Withers S., **Divine Park** (Chester House) led nearly every step to maintain his perfect record. "He stepped his game up a couple of notches," said Artie Magnuson, assistant to winning trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "We're definitely going in the right direction." The bay will continue his rise up the class ladder, but his next start isn't yet certain. "He's a special horse," Magnuson added. "There's the Peter Pan [GII, 9f, BEL, May 20] and the Preakness [GI, \$1 million, 1 3/16m, PIM, May 19]. [Owner] Jim [Barry] and Kiaran will sit down and talk it over." **Cont. p2**

GII Illinois Derby and GIII Gotham S. winner **Cowtown Cat** (Distorted Humor) posted the second-fastest time for yesterday's five-eighths breeze at Keeneland, covering the distance in :58.60 ([video](#)) while breezing in company with stablemate Magnificent Song. After a final quarter in :22 3/5, the chestnut galloped out in 1:11. "That's as good as a horse can work right there," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "He went very well and finished up strong." Pletcher's four other GI Kentucky Derby hopefuls--**Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor), **Circular Quay** (Thunder Gulch), **Sam P.** (Cat Thief) and **Scat Daddy** (Johannesburg)--are slated to work today.

'ANNA' FIRES BULLET

Champion juvenile filly **Dreaming of Anna** (Rahy) appears to be GI Kentucky Oaks bound following a best-of-47 five-furlong move in :58.60 at Churchill Downs yesterday. With jockey Shaun Bridgmohan aboard, the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine galloped out six furlongs in 1:11.60. Following the work, trainer Wayne Catalano said that he would recommend the Oaks for Dreaming of Anna's next start, but added that owner Frank Calabrese has the final say. "The jock's happy afterwards, that's the main thing," Catalano said. "I was curious about the track this morning. It was loose and deep. Obviously, she loved it." Regular rider Rene Douglas will be aboard for her next start, which will come in either the Oaks or the grassy Edgewood S., both at Churchill May 4.

Divine Park kicked off his career Feb. 10 over Aqueduct's inner track, battling for the lead before shaking loose late. He switched tactics for his next start--an allowance at Keeneland Apr. 7--when he broke slowly, but rallied to win going away. Breaking from the rail here, the second choice vied for the lead through splits of :22.93 and :45.46 before asserting himself on the turn. Jockey Alan Garcia shook the reins at him and Divine Park responded, opening up for his first stakes victory despite looking around a bit. "He was green a little bit, but he is very nice," said Garcia. Favored **C P West** (Came Home) came on to get second. "I had to wait a little bit," said rider Edgar Prado. "When I turned him loose, he started gaining. The winner had everything his way."

Chinese Dragon broke his maiden second time out for trainer Aidan O'Brien as a juvenile before being sold for 75,000gns at Tattersalls Autumn and found himself on a plane bound for California. The neatly made bay captured his first four starts for trainer Bob Hess Jr., capped by the Alcatraz Breeders' Cup S. over course and distance in May 2005, before being forced to the sidelines. He captured his second start off the six-month break, the Sir Beaufort S. at Santa Anita, and later ran third by a head in the GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile H. last March. Second to Silent Name (Jpn) in the GII Arcadia H. last April, he was benched once again due to ankle problems. The five-year-old, sent postward here as the third choice, was content to race at the back of the pack as even-money Becrux (Ity) (Glen Jordan {GB}) showed the way. When the favorite began to back up on the far turn, his stablemate Vega's Lord took the baton, only to have Chinese Dragon come up the inside and best him after a thrilling battle. Jeremy produced one of the memorable performances at last year's Royal Ascot meeting when powering away with the G3 Jersey S., but failed to build on that in subsequent efforts. Only sixth in the G2 Lennox S. at Goodwood, he revived his fortunes with a second in the G2 Hungerford S. at Newbury in August. Again below par when trailing in the G2 Challenge S. on Champions' Day at Newmarket in October, the blaze-faced bay returned with a display of promise ahead of a potentially fruitful four-year-old campaign. Reserved in rear by Frankie Dettori off the generous early pace, he was produced with a sustained run down the outer to gather in his rivals approaching the furlong marker and asserted himself on the uphill finish. "He's a nice horse," Dettori told *Racing Post*. "He was a good three-year-old last year and seems to have improved through the winter. He won that very easily."

After Market kicked off his career in the best possible way last year for previous trainer Bill Mott. The Wygod homebred sailed through his first four starts, including the GIII Lexington S. and GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S., before coming undone over the sticky Delaware turf in the GIII Kent Breeders' Cup S. last September. He faltered to be eighth in his return Jan. 31 at Gulfstream and was sent to John Shirreffs. Sixth, beaten 2 3/4 lengths in the GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile Mar. 3, the four-year-old missed by 1 1/2 lengths when fifth in a Santa Anita allowance Mar. 31. He looked a picture in the post parade here and lived up to billing. After settling several lengths from the lead in the early stages, the handsome dark bay ranged up four wide turning for home. He made the lead in the lane and was kept busy by Alex Solis for his third graded-stakes win. "He sort of lost his form last fall and, when Bill Mott couldn't get him back right, we took a shot and brought him out here," said co-owner/breeder Marty Wygod. Silent Pleasure was sent off as the second choice to odds-on Bob and John, but showed great fortitude to deny the favorite and, in the process, earned his fourth straight victory. He kicked off the year auspiciously with a 12 1/4-length score in a Delta Downs allowance Jan. 18 and ran second in his next condition at that track on Valentine's Day. The four-year-old rebounded with a seven-length triumph in the Delta Mile S. Mar. 2, added a success in the Gulf Coast Classic Mar. 31 and came into this contest on the strength of a win in the Fifth Season H. Apr. 12 at Oaklawn. Off to a good start, the dark bay headed a three-way dispute for the lead early before inching away through a half in :45.76. Last year's GI Wood Memorial S. hero Bob and John, making his first start since September, came rolling up on the far turn and looked to be comfortably on his way to the winner's circle, but Silent Pleasure proved dead game on the inside, digging in for his fifth victory in his last six outings. "I watched Pat Day and Jerry Bailey for years, and they always waited until the last possible moment to go to the left-handed whip," said winning rider Tracy Hebert. "I did that in the last 50 yards, and he gave me something more. I knew they'd have to fight to get by him; he was doing it so easy."

Longshot Jet Propulsion got brave on the lead and had more than enough in the tank to post his first graded victory. A four-length winner of a 7 1/2-furlong allowance over this course on New Year's Eve, the Florida-bred ran sixth in the GIII Canadian Turf H. at Gulfstream Feb. 3. He followed that with a runner-up effort in a crosstown optional claimer Feb. 19, then tried to make all the running before succumbing late to be fifth to MGSW Go Between in the Cherokee River Turf Classic at Tampa Bay Downs Apr. 7. The four-year-old bounced out of the gate to show the way while skimming the hedge. After a half in :48.08, Jet Propulsion shifted gears turning for home and held sway late over a slew of challengers. "We claimed this horse two years ago for \$25,000," said Donna Green, assistant to winning trainer Dan Hurtak. "It's great to have him back home at Calder. He's not a very good shipper and didn't run his best race last time in Tampa."

Masseuse made three trips to post as a sophomore, posting a pair of tallies at Belmont before finishing second in the Virginia Oaks behind My Typhoon (Ire) in July 2005. Missing in action for nearly 12 months, the dark bay finally resurfaced with a Belmont allowance victory July 9, but was back on the sidelines after getting eased in the GIII Matchmaker S. at Monmouth Aug. 6. Masseuse didn't spend quite as much time on the sidelines following that effort, returning at Tampa Mar. 17 with a third-place finish in the GIII Hillsborough S. last time out. Just Rushing's victory in a \$50,000 claimer last June at Woodbine kicked off a seven-race winning streak.

That skein was capped by a pair of stakes victories at Woodbine, the Mt. Sassafras S. Oct. 8 and an eight-length triumph in the Labeeb S.

Nov. 2. Stepped up to graded company for the GIII Woodbine Slots Cup Nov. 18, the dark bay tired to finish fifth and went on vacation for the winter. Sent off as the third choice in his return, the Ontario-bred went straight to the lead, but was engaged by Are You Serious from his inside on the turn, and the fight was on. That rival put his head in front in midstretch, but Just Rushing battled back gamely for his first graded victory.

With just a Beverley maiden score to his name, Regime entered the melting pot for the inaugural Goffs Million in September as a lively outsider and emerged as arguably the best horse, having finished clear of the pack in second. Post-race analysis strongly suggests the winner Miss Beatrix (Ire) was heavily favored by racing on the far side and among those trailing in Regime's wake against the stands' rail was the subsequent G1 Prix Marcel Boussac and G2 Rockfel S. winner Finsceal Beo (Ire). Regime disappointed on his final juvenile start the next month when seventh in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Newbury, but put that behind him here to book his ticket to the Classics. Settled in last early by a confident Frankie Dettori, the bay arrived up the inner in the stretch and despite drifting left, as he had at The Curragh, wore down Striving Storm and Asperity approaching the eighth pole. Straightened up there, he asserted up the rising ground for a convincing success. "He ran extremely well in the Goffs Million and he looks a very nice horse," trainer Michael Bell said. "He always looked pretty classy and came to hand early, but we backed off him and were right to do so. He won't run before a Derby and Frankie says a mile and a half will be well within his range, so Epsom is very much on the agenda. I think he'll handle Epsom well, but he is also in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club [at Chantilly June 3], so we're not committing yet as the ground will be a factor. He's a high-class middle-distance horse in the making."

Dylan Thomas is sent in pursuit of more Group 1 glory here, and the Ballydoyle colossus should be able to deal with a largely moderate home defence. Third in the G1 Epsom Derby last June, he put that firmly behind him with a highly impressive success in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh the next month before finishing fourth after a break in York's G1 Juddmonte International S. in August. Rebounding with a defeat of Ouija Board (GB) in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown in September, he failed to handle dirt in Belmont's G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup in October before returning with a cozy reintroduction score in the Apr. 15 Listed Alleged S. at The Curragh. Among his opponents is last year's G2 Grand Prix de Deauville winner **Irish Wells**, who was sixth before being promoted to fifth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at this track in October. Third behind **Boris de Deauville** and the G3 Prix Exbury winner **Pearl Sky** under a penalty in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt back here last time Apr. 1, he may prove the chief threat.

Bullish on Derby...

As expected, GIII El Camino Real Derby winner **Bwana Bull** (Holy Bull) was scratched from yesterday's Derby Trial S. at Churchill in favor of the main event May 5. The California-based grey, fifth to Tiago in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 7, shipped to Kentucky last Wednesday. "He'll work at Churchill Downs on Monday," said trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. "He'll go either three-quarters or seven-eighths, I haven't decided yet." Javier Castellano has the mount for owners Mark Dedomenico, Dan Jelladian and George Todaro.

Outside Looking In...

The relatively recent announcement that **Bwana Bull** [see above] was pointing for the GI Kentucky Derby means that **Teuflesberg** (Johannesburg) will be forced to miss the Run for the Roses. The handsome bay is currently 21st on the graded-stakes earnings list; the Derby field is limited to 20. "It is very frustrating," said trainer Jamie Sanders, who scratched the colt from yesterday's Derby Trial S. "It is hard to train your horse when everybody is so indecisive." Teuflesberg has started nine times in graded-stakes company, earning \$122,942. Should no defections occur before entries for the 133rd Kentucky Derby, Sanders will target the GI Preakness S. May 19 and is showing some creativity about tuning up her colt. "I am hoping for the best...I think I have a pretty good shot at getting in the race," Sanders added. "He is doing so well right now, but if for some reason he does not get in, I would look at the [GI] Woodford Reserve [May 5] or supplement for the [GIII] Crown Royal American Turf [May 4] to get a race in him before the Preakness."

Making Sense...

Champion **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) galloped a mile and a half yesterday morning. "I thought he went very well, just like I expected," said trainer Carl Nafzger. Nafzger reflected on the quality of his colt's championship performance in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Nov. 4 at Churchill. "I like to look back at that race and see how the other horses that ran in there are doing, and it looks like the first five from that race are going to be in the Derby," he said. Following Street Sense home were, in order, Circular Quay, Great Hunter, Scat Daddy and Stormello. "All of those horses have held their form," Nafzger added. The record number of Breeders' Cup Juvenile starters to run in the following year's Kentucky Derby is five, established in the 1987 Derby won by Alysheba, who finished third in the 1986 BC Juvenile.

Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out GI Kentucky Oaks hopefuls **Cotton Blossom** (Broken Vow) and **Octave** (Unbridled's Song) for five-furlong moves over the Keeneland Polytrack yesterday. The Mar. 17 Florida Oaks heroine stopped the clock at 1:00, working in company with stablemate Twilight Meteor ([video](#)). "She worked really well," Pletcher said of Cotton Blossom's move. "Her workmate didn't help her much. She did it all on her own." Cotton Blossom heads to the Oaks following a runner-up effort as the 1-2 chalk in the GII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Apr. 6. Octave, the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up covered the same distance in :59.20. She

worked in company with stablemate Mini Sermon, an Apr. 14 maiden winner at Keeneland. "I thought it was a good work for her," Pletcher said of Octave, who most recently finished second in the GI Ashland S. Apr. 7. Likely Oaks favorite **Rags to Riches** (A.P. Indy) is scheduled for a Keeneland workout today.

Fantasy Winner For Real...

High Heels (E Dubai), a sharp 6 3/4-length winner of the Fantasy last time, tuned up for the Oaks with a five-furlong drill in 1:00.40 at Churchill Saturday. "She did it pretty easy; looks like 12s all the way," trainer Gary Hartlage said. "I had her galloping out six furlongs in 1:13 3/5 and seven-eighths in 1:27. As long as she comes out of this work good, we are ready to go."

Autobahn Girl Breezes for Oaks...

Autobahn Girl (A.P. Indy), heroine of Tampa's Suncoast S. Feb. 17, worked five furlongs at Churchill yesterday in 1:01.60 in preparation for Friday's Kentucky Oaks. "It was a good work," trainer Nick Zito commented. "She's a good filly. She always acted like she was one of the better three-year-olds. She's very steady. She fits with these fillies." The Live Oak colorbearer was last seen finishing fourth behind Cotton Blossom in the Florida Oaks. Zito added that **Silver Knockers** (Silver Deputy) is likely to skip the Oaks. "Unless something happens and the field gets small, it looks like we'll pass on the Oaks with her," Zito said. "She didn't have any experience as a two-year-old, so it's probably the best thing for her." Silver Knockers finished seventh in the Ashland last time.

Cash Included Works with Blinkers...



Last season's GI Oak Leaf Breeders' Cup S. victress **Cash Included** (Include) will race with blinkers for the first time in the Kentucky Oaks. The dark bay was equipped with blinkers yesterday for a six-furlong move at Churchill, which she covered in 1:14.40. Jockey Corey Nakatani was in the saddle. 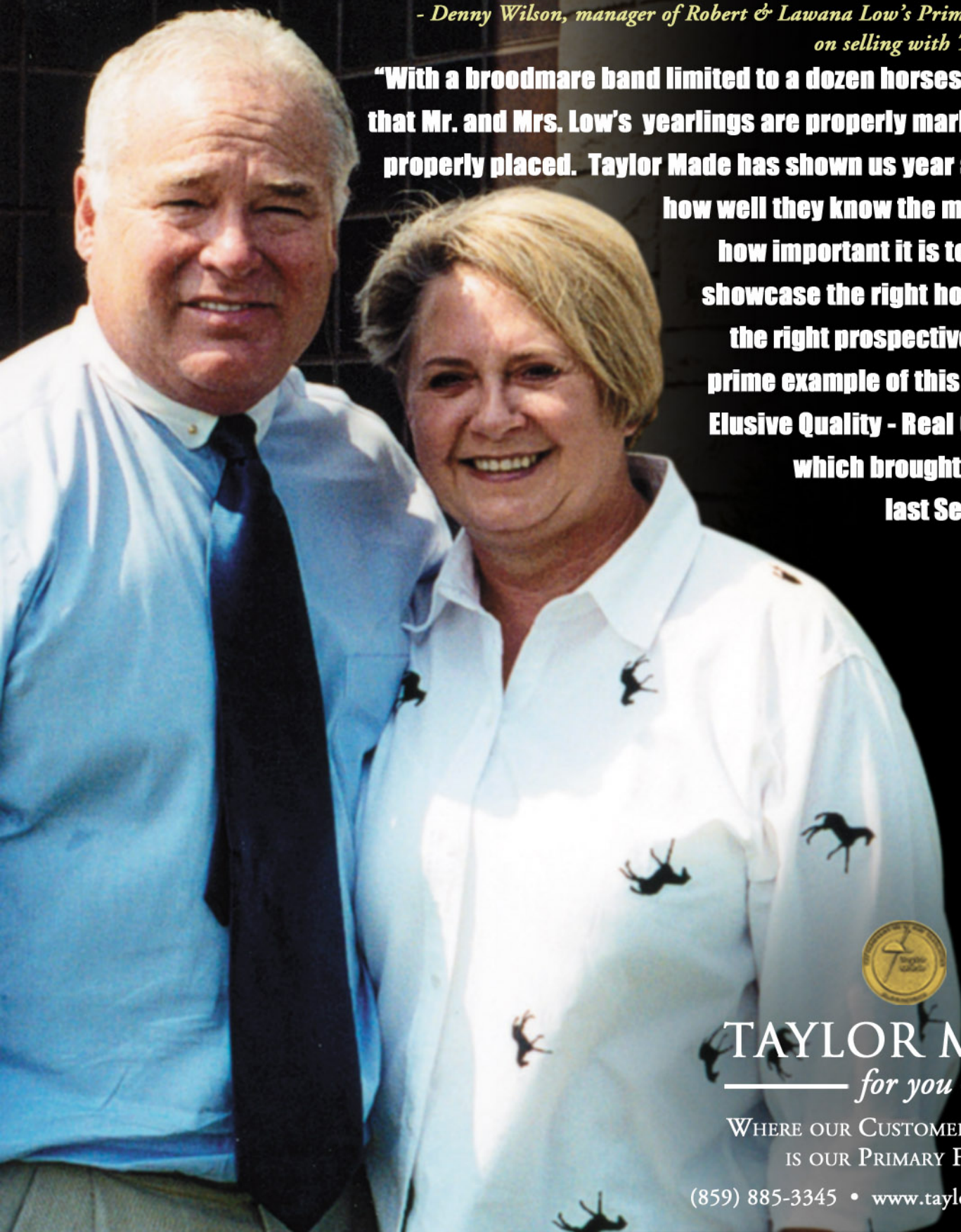
Camillo Back in Guineas Picture...

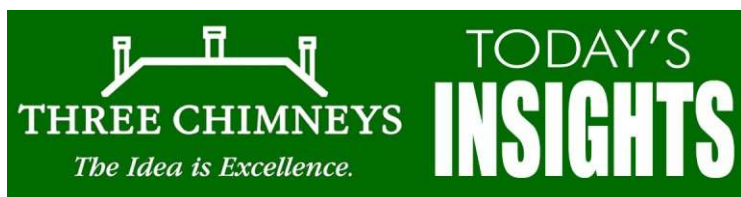
