PLETCHER POSSE GET FINAL DERBY WORKS

Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out four of his GI Kentucky Derby hopefuls yesterday, as well as the likely favorite for the GI Kentucky Oaks, Rags to Riches. At Keeneland, the trio of Any Given Saturday, Circular Quay and Scat Daddy were given their final Derby drills in advance of Saturday's Run for the Roses. First up was **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor), who, with Angel Cordero Jr. in the irons, breezed an easy five panels in 1:01 1/5 ([video](#)). The GI Wood Memorial third clocked splits of :24 3/5 and :49 before galloping out in 1:14. "[Cordero] nailed it," Pletcher said afterwards. "I wanted 1:01 today with this horse and he got it--just what I was after following that stiff

work [:58 4/5] he had last week." A bit later, Pletcher sent out **Circular Quay** (Thunder Gulch) and **Rags to Riches** (A.P. Indy) together. Circular Quay, eager early, soon fell in line with his stablemate, and the pair moved in tandem through five furlongs in 1:00 1/5, while galloping out six furlongs in 1:12 ([video](#)). "That's the best work he's had since he's been here," said Pletcher. "Each work he's done has been progressively better. He works well with [Rags to Riches]." Around 8:00 a.m., it was **Scat Daddy** (Johannesburg)'s turn. Under Cordero, the GI Florida Derby winner breezed through :23 2/5 and :47 splits and stopped the clock in :59 2/5 for five furlongs, with an out time of 1:12 ([video](#)). "He covers a lot of ground, doesn't he," asked Pletcher. "That just shows how talented he is. He gets a time like that and he does it so effortlessly. Right now he's a happy horse." Meanwhile, some 75 miles down Interstate 64, Pletcher's fifth Derby horse, the improving **Sam P.** (Cat Thief), put forth his final Derby breeze. With Pletcher assistant Mike McCarthy looking on, the chestnut worked in company with the filly Awesome Ashley right after the morning renovation break. Sam P. covered five furlongs in 1:00 1/5, the third-fastest of 32 works at the distance, capping a busy day for Pletcher. "Now it's just the details," Pletcher said of his horses' Derby preparations. "Getting them shipped over there, settled in, some paddock schooling. The little things that make it all right." Pletcher's fifth Derby horse, **Cowtown Cat** (Distorted Humor), worked Saturday.

FREEWHEELIN'

There was hardly an anxious moment at Longchamp yesterday as Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill) outclassed the opposition in the G1 Prix Ganay. Last year's G1 Irish Derby and G1 Irish Champion S. winner met some light traffic in the home stretch, but when daylight appeared for Christophe Soumillon it was over in a matter of strides. Scorching clear of **Irish Wells (Fr)** (Poliglote {GB}) in the final eighth, the imposing bay recorded a facile two-length success without serious exertion. "He quickened in really good style and won easily," commented Robert Nataf, representing Coolmore. "He did everything expected of him and it was a good opportunity to come to Longchamp today ahead of his target of the [Oct. 7] G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe." 'Nobiz' Sharp in Final Derby Work...

Nobiz Like Shobiz (Albert the Great), last seen winning the GI Wood Memorial Apr. 7, satisfied trainer Barclay Tagg yesterday with a five-furlong move in :59 4/5 over Belmont Park's 'fast' main track. "He worked very nicely," said Tagg, who saddled his 2003 GI Kentucky Derby winner Funny Cide to a third-place finish in the King's Point H. at Aqueduct later in the afternoon. The work, which came with regular jockey Cornelio Velasquez in the irons, was the second-fastest of 28 at the distance. 'Nobiz' once again wore blinkers, which he wore for the first time in a race in the Wood. "I think they help him concentrate," said Tagg. "At least, he won with them." Tagg added that his charge is scheduled to be shipped to Churchill Downs on Wednesday.

Stormello, Tiago Breeze at Hollywood...

Kentucky Derby contenders **Stormello** (Stormy Atlantic) and **Tiago** (Pleasant Tap) both worked over Hollywood's Cushion Track yesterday. Stormello thrilled his connections with a five-furlong breeze in 1:00 4/5. Trainer Bill Currin, who co-owns Stormello, called it, "the most perfect work he's ever had." Jockey Kent Desormeaux flew out to California for the move. "Kent got off the horse all bubbling over--really pumped up," said Currin. "There were some media people watching the work and Kent told them, 'He will win the Kentucky Derby.' They asked me how I felt, and I said, 'My jockey said it all for me.'" Tiago, the GI Santa Anita Derby upsetter, covered six furlongs in 1:11 2/5, earning Giacomo's little brother the bullet (1/27). "I'm very pleased with it,"

said trainer John Shirreffs. "I wanted a good work coming into this race and he gave it to me. Mike [Smith, who will ride the colt in the Derby] was very pleased, also." Tiago is slated to ship today.

Miller Happy With Dominican's Work...

Minutes after GI Blue Grass S. winner **Dominican** (El Corredor) breezed a bullet five furlongs in :59 2/5 at Churchill Downs yesterday, his trainer Darrin Miller enthused, "Just fantastic! It was exactly what we wanted." Miller got a first-hand perspective of the move: he was aboard Dominican's workmate Avenstoke. "He was strong throughout," said Miller. "We got a good, deep work into him before we run in the Derby." While all three of Dominican's career wins have come over Polytrack, Miller said he was happy with the way his charge moves over Churchill's surface. "This work showed he's hitting the ground here just as good as he did on Polytrack," Miller said.

Dylan Thomas was keen on the front end for most of the journey when third best in the blanket finish to the G1 Epsom Derby in June, but showed what he was capable of when restraint was applied the next month in the Curragh version. After a resounding 3½-length victory there, the freshness was back and he threw away his chance by pulling when a disappointing fourth on testing ground in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York in August. Back on a sound surface, he got the better of Ouija Board (GB) in a grand finale to the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown in September before his well-documented failed mission in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup in October. Making the most of the dry spring at home, Aidan O'Brien sent him to The Curragh for an ideal prep in the Apr. 15 Listed Alleged S. and this assignment proved hardly more taxing. Always traveling strongly in behind Irish Wells and his rabbit, he was pinned against the fence in the home straight only for as long as Soumillon chose to curb his acceleration. Let loose approaching the furlong marker, he met no resistance in the run to the line. Robert Nataf revealed that he will run next in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 27.

turn of foot to secure the win. The victory came at the expense of two top horses, Hong Kong's own Vengeance of Rain, the recent G1 Dubai Sheema Classic hero, and Japan's Admire Moon, who took the G1 Dubai Duty Free on the same card.

"It might have been a good thing

that the horse had missed Dubai," admitted Moore afterwards. "We came here a fresher horse than Vengeance of Rain, but the way we've sprinted home here to beat two Group 1 horses makes him something pretty special." Viva Pataca--whose long-term goal is the G1 Cox Plate in Australia--and Vengeance of Rain are likely to clash next in the G1 Champions & Chater Cup at Sha Tin June 3. **For video, click [dial-up](#) or [broadband](#).**

The winner of the Champions Mile, the first installment of the Breeders' Cup Challenge 'Win and You're In' series, would be guaranteed a spot in the starting gate for October's GI Breeders' Cup Mile, and in the end it was 33-1 longshot Able One who earned a trip to Monmouth Park if his connections so choose. With jockey Mick Kinane in the irons, Able One went right to the front and never looked back, setting lackadaisical fractions en route to the upset for conditioner John Moore, who also saddled runner-up Joyful Winner. "I couldn't believe how they let Able One dictate the race from the front," said Moore, who has had a relatively slow season in part due to a stable affected by an outbreak of equine herpes. "Mick said he had plenty of horse under him and, once he kicked, he got to the line very strongly. To run one-two is a dream." Moore added, "I guess we have the invitation to run in the Breeders' Cup now and we'll have to think about it. Maybe racing the other way around [left-handed] would cure Able One's tendency to hang." Most of the pre-race focus was on the local horse Good Ba Ba (Elle Meme) and the G1 Dubai Duty Free runner-up Linngari (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}), who could do no better than fifth and sixth, respectively. Italy's champion juvenile Golden Titus maintained his position at the top of the tree in this Classic, but he had to work hard to earn his stripes. Out early last term, he captured the Listed Premio Alberto Giubilo here in May and G3 Premio Primi Passi at the San Siro the following month before running second in the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte in July.
