**CURLIN FAVORED IN CAVALRY CHARGE**

Unbeaten **Curlin** (Smart Strike), who will break from post two, was made the slight 7-2 favorite for Saturday's \$2-million GI Kentucky Derby when post positions were drawn last night before a live audience on espn2. Trainer Steve Asmussen didn't have too many options for the big chestnut, who was 16th in the selection

order, but went for the inside rather than the three outside posts. He had previously opted for the three hole with stablemate **Zanjero** (Cherokee Run). "They're both extremely manageable horses," Asmussen said. When asked what he thought Curlin's biggest asset was, the conditioner responded, "how fast he is." He'll need to be, with 18 three-year-olds to his right. Asmussen added, "A

horse of his size can take his position, but we would have preferred to be further outside." The second choice at 4-1 is champion **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}), who will break from post seven in an attempt to give trainer Carl Nafzger his second Derby victory. Nafzger is pleased with the colt's progress since his successful juvenile campaign. "He's matured and become more

balanced," said the former rodeo rider. "He's gained a bit of weight. He's more mentally focused and a lot better." Nafzger added, "We have the option to settle in any position we want. I'm looking forward to a great, great Derby." Trainer John Shirreffs, successful in his first Derby try in 2005 with Giacomo, was all smiles as he picked post 15 for that grey's younger brother **Tiago** (Pleasant Tap). The GI Santa Anita Derby hero is 15-1 on the morning line. "They're very similar, so we've stuck to the same training program," he said. "I'm feeling really good about our chances."

**Spin City...**

Conditioner Larry Jones chose post eight for **Hard Spun** (Danzig), who had the backstretch buzzing after flying through five-eighths in :57.60 Monday morning at Churchill. It was the fastest Derby week work since General Assembly went the same distance in :57.40 before finishing second to Spectacular Bid in the 1979 Classic. "I think it means he likes the racetrack," Jones quipped. "He's got a very high cruising speed." Coming off a six-week break since taking the GII Lane's End S. Mar. 24, the Danzig colt is listed at 15-1.

**Teuflesberg Interest Sold...**

**Murtagh Deserts Magic...**

Johnny Murtagh has opted to ride Derrick Smith, Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's **Simply Perfect (GB)** (Danehill) instead of Tony Ryan's **Magic America** (High Yield) in Sunday's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Having partnered the latter to success in the Listed Prix Imprudence at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 11, the Irishman had committed to resuming the partnership with the Criquelette Head-Maarek-trained filly in the mile Classic. However, in a late u-turn, Murtagh will now team up with last year's G1 Fillies' Mile heroine for trainer Jeremy Noseda. Christophe-Patrice Lemaire will take over on Magic America and Murtagh's agent Eddie Byrne told *PA Sport*, "It was a very difficult decision, as both are good fillies with chances, but Johnny has had a successful association with Simply Perfect's owners over the years and will ride her on Sunday."

**Pleasing Art...**

Susan Roy and Cheveley Park Stud's **Dutch Art (GB)** (Medicean {GB}) pleased trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam on Tuesday ahead of his tilt at Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. Last year's G1 Prix Morny and G1 Middle Park S. winner was second on his return in Newbury's G3 Greenham S. Apr. 21, and his conditioner expects him to have improved since that outing. "I am very happy with Dutch Art," Chapple-Hyam said Tuesday. "He went well in his routine work this morning and everything is going according to plan. He is very much on course for taking his place in the Guineas."

**Rahiyah Pouliches Bound...**

Sheikh Rashid bin Mohammed's **Rahiyah** (Rahy) will be aimed at the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, trainer Jeremy Noseda announced yesterday. Runner-up to Finsceal Beo (Ire) in the G2 Rockfel S. at Newmarket in October, the filly will be stepping up to a mile for the first time in the May 13 Classic. "We have been satisfied with her progress through the spring and feel that her two-year-old form warrants her taking a chance in France," Noseda commented. "If there is a slight query, it is the trip as she is a filly with a lot of speed. But hopefully, the easier mile at Longchamp and the more sedate tempo of French racing should suit her."

**Stalls in Centre for Classics...**

Newmarket's Director of Racing and Clerk of the Course Michael Prosser yesterday announced that the stalls will be placed in the middle of the track for both Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas and the fillies' equivalent the following afternoon. "With a bigger than usual field in prospect for the 2000 Guineas on Saturday, we did consider positioning the stalls on the stands' side rail," Prosser explained. "However, it has worked so well for the last three years that we see no reason to change it. Of course there is the possibility of the field splitting, but realistically that might have well have happened even if we had positioned them on the stands' rail. Our aim is to try to ensure that the best horse wins the race and, by positioning the stalls in the centre of the track, the potential for scrimmaging is minimised."

**O'Brien Confirms Riding Plans...**

Aidan O'Brien finalised jockey arrangements for his 2000 Guineas trio yesterday after Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Mount Nelson (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) ruled out of Saturday's mile Classic. Mick Kinane will partner **Duke of Marmalade (Ire)** (Danehill), while Christophe Soumillon has been booked for the ride on **Eagle Mountain (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) and Johnny Murtagh will ride the triumvirate's **Yellowstone (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}). "Mount Nelson won't be running, as we've decided to give him more time," O'Brien told *Racing Post*. "We've made our riding plans on the basis of who we think will suit each horse best. The three colts we are running are in good form, and we are just hoping they run well."

**'Swing in for Action...**

Pat Garvey's **Arch Swing** (Arch) will start in Sunday's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, connections announced yesterday. Trainer John Oxx confirmed that the G3 Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial winner had fully recovered from the infection she suffered after that Apr. 7 trial. "She is an intended runner, as everything seems well with her at the moment and things have gone well in recent days," Oxx said. "If it remains that way up until Friday, then she will be declared to run and we intend to go there."

Utopia, winner of Japan's G1 Nanbu Hai Mile Championship in 2005, travelled to Dubai to annex the 2006 G2 Godolphin Mile by four lengths for trainer Kojiro Hashiguchi. Subsequently purchased by Godolphin, the chestnut was making his first start in the royal blue colors here. The co-second choice broke alertly under Mike Luzzi and went up to press the pace of :23.20 and :46.26 set by Happy Hunting (Seeking the Gold). When that rival began to tire, Sun King and Political Force came up to challenge, but the seven-year-old battled back stoutly along the inside, despite being bumped, for his first victory in 13 months. "When you come back to win and get by a horse like Sun King, you have to feel pretty good about the effort--especially off a 13-month layoff," said Rick Mettee, assistant to winning trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "We'll see how he comes out of this. If we brought him back in the Met Mile [GI, May 28] he would be eligible to react after such a big race after such a long layoff. On the other hand, he's seven, and you are only going to get so many chances to run in a Grade I like the Met Mile. If you wait for the Suburban [GI, June 30], you're going to hook Invasor (Arg) in there, and I don't know if he can get a mile and a quarter against that type of horse. We'll play it by ear." Political Force, who wound up crossing the line second, bumped Sun King twice and was disqualified to third.

Transferred to France after a six-race sophomore campaign in Germany, Macleya eventually came good in the 15-furlong Listed Prix Scaramouche here last October. Back this term to run fourth in the Apr. 9 Listed Prix Right Royal at Saint-Cloud, she claimed a career high with a gritty display in this group race debut. Stalking the leader in second after the opening exchanges, the eventual winner was pushed to the front with 350 meters remaining and kept on well under a sympathetic drive to hold the all-too-late rush of Satwa Queen. "This is a tough racemare who is improving all the time," said the owner's representative Eric Puerari. "She really stays well, and her target this summer is the Aug. 5 G2 Prix de Pomone at Deauville. She will probably run again before then, maybe the G2 Prix Corrida [Saint-Cloud May 30] could be next."

## NYRA ORDERED TO DROP CONNECTICUT INTERNET CUSTOMERS

State regulators have ordered the New York Racing Association to stop taking any Internet wagers from Connecticut residents, an embarrassing blow to NYRA on the first day of its new Internet wagering program. The demand to halt the wagers came after Connecticut's attorney general threatened to take NYRA to court because Internet gambling is illegal in the state. NYRA last week received approval from the New York State Racing and Wagering Board to begin accepting wagers over the Internet, which officials predict will attract tens of thousands of gamblers. Because of a contract provision with TVG, though, NYRA said it would only take bets from residents from New York, New Jersey and Connecticut. NYRA began its Internet operation Wednesday with the start of its Belmont meet. But Connecticut Attorney General Richard Blumenthal said letting NYRA offer Internet wagering to residents in the state "would be extraordinarily dangerous." The Associated Press said Blumenthal vowed court action, if necessary, to halt it. Hours later, though, racing regulators in New York told NYRA to stop letting Connecticut residents bet on its new platform. "The approval given to NYRA by the board to allow Internet wagering is limited to only those jurisdictions where the activity is legal," said Dan Toomey, a spokesman for the New York State Racing and Wagering Board. "Accordingly, NYRA has been ordered by the board to cease and desist from taking orders that exist from the state of Connecticut." Toomey said regulators in New York have notified the Connecticut attorney general of the conditions by which NYRA won approval for Internet wagering. "NYRA is expected to fully comply with this order," Toomey said. NYRA officials could not be reached for comment. **For complete story, click [here](#).**

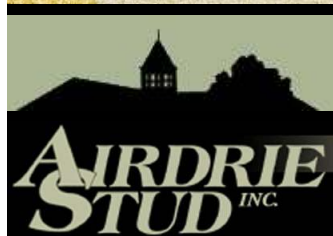

### ICON GROUND FEARS

Jeremy Nosedá has warned that Susan Roy's **Sixties Icon (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) could miss Sunday's G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket if conditions are too quick. Last year's G1 St Leger winner has been off the track since trailing in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp in October and his trainer is hoping that the current watering is sufficient to allow the four-year-old to return. "Sixties Icon is definitely ready to run; however, the ground would currently be faster than is ideal for him," Nosedá said. "I shall look at the ground on Sunday morning and we will then make a final decision as to whether he definitely takes his place in the race."

### CHEVELEY PAIR HAVE LOCKINGE DATE

Cheveley Park Stud's distaffers **Nannina (GB)** (Medicean {GB}) and **Peeress (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) are being aimed at the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury May 19. Last year's winner Peeress will be saddled by Sir Michael Stoute as long as the ground is not too fast. Fast conditions will favor the John Gosden-trained G1 Coronation S. winner Nannina. "We're quite likely to start both there, but I think it will be ground-dependent for Peeress, who looks really well," commented the Stud's Managing Director Chris Richardson. "I think she has developed physically again and will be competing at the top level this year. If it were very dry then Nannina would have the advantage and she'll then go on to something like the G2 Windsor Forest S. [at Royal Ascot June 20]." Richardson also had news of last year's G1 Prix de Diane winner **Confidential Lady (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}), who has the June 20 G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot as an early-season target. "She hasn't come in her coat and has taken a bit of time, but I would think the Prince of Wales's will be an option," he said.

## NTRA REPORT FROM *Capitol Hill*

### Equine Equity Act Re-Introduced

On April 30, Senator Mitch McConnell (R-KY) re-introduced the Equine Equity Act (EEA), S. 1251. The bill amends the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide for the tax treatment of horses. If passed, the EEA would:

1. Reduce the capital gains holding period for horses from two years to one, beginning with taxable years after Dec. 31, 2007.
2. Standardize depreciation schedules for all racehorses. Current law states that racehorses that begin training when older than 24 months of age are depreciated over 3 years, while those horses that begin training before reaching 24 months of age are depreciated over 7 years. The EEA would reduce the depreciation period for racehorses to 3 years and more accurately reflect the racing life of horses.

The bill, co-sponsored by Senators Jim Bunning (R-KY) and Blanche Lincoln (D-AR), has been referred to the Senate Finance Committee.
