**LEGEND IN THE MAKING**

Trainer Jim Bolger had a timely reminder of the downs of racing when Teofilo (Ire) was recently forced onto the sidelines, but yesterday saw a serious upturn in fortunes as **Finsceal Beo (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley) produced a scintillating performance in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Michael Ryan's chestnut translates as "living legend" and she was all that here, outclassing her peers under Kevin Manning to reward the countless backers who hammered her into 5-4. Stretching clear of **Arch Swing** (Arch) in the final quarter, she made history by becoming the first Guineas winner of either sex to dip under one minute 35 seconds. "With a filly like her, who is utterly dependable, she is always going to give her best and as long as she doesn't have any bad luck she'll get the result she is capable of," Bolger commented. "She has a marvellous turn of foot and if we get everything right with her, she will deliver the goods." *Cont.p2*

**POST DERBY JOG FOR STREET SENSE**

Trainer Carl Nafzger wasted no time sending **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) back to the track after his Kentucky Derby win Saturday. The newly crowned Derby champ jogged one mile at Churchill yesterday under exercise rider Mark Cutler. Despite the quick return to the track, Nafzger was not ready to commit to the May 19 G1 Preakness S. "I would imagine he will [go to the Preakness]," Nafzger said yesterday. "They asked me that yesterday and I realized then that I had focused so hard on the Derby, that I hadn't gone one day past the Derby. But, basically, that doesn't really matter here, because the horse is going to train me anyway. He's going to take me to the Preakness or not. This morning, he looks like we're on the way." As for Street Sense's training schedule, Nafzger said, "He'll walk two days for sure now, then he'll probably gallop a day or two and then he'll walk some more. He'll tell me what he wants to do." Derby runner-up **Hard Spun** (Danzig) and third-place finisher **Curlin** (Smart Strike) are also listed as possible Preakness contenders. Trainer Larry Jones thinks racing in Maryland might provide Hard Spun and jockey Mario Pino with an advantage over Street Sense and jockey Calvin Borel. "It'll be Mario's home track," Jones said of Pimlico. "[Churchill] is Calvin's home track, but we're going to Pino country." Other Derby runners possible for the Preakness are fifth-place finisher **Sedgefield** (Smart Strike) and 17th-place finisher **Teuflesberg** (Johannesburg).

**'Beo' In Charge...**

Finsceal Beo came from nowhere when recording an emphatic five-length score in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp on Arc day, but connections had long held her in the highest esteem and felt that she was better than her previous sixth in The Curragh's Goffs Million. To ensure she received the champion juvenile filly accolade, she was sent to Newmarket just 13 days later to stamp her authority in the G2 Rockfel S. on Champions' Day and made light of a penalty to do so. Unlike her heralded stable companion, she had endured no troubles this spring and arrived here with maximum confidence behind her. That proved justified, as she stalked the pace on the stands' side traveling with purpose before being allowed a breather by her confident jockey. Asked to quicken approaching the quarter pole, she struck the front instantly and was in no danger thereafter, despite the game effort of Arch Swing and Mick Kinane stuck out in the centre of the track. "I always thought she was a very special filly and she's improved a deal since last year," Manning commented. "Today, she was a little bit fresh with me and I was closer than I would have liked, but she was carrying me there. I would have won over any distance today and she won very easily. She has got all the boxes ticked--she's very straightforward and the best filly I've ever ridden." Bolger has the winner's program mapped out and it involves an eventual step up in trip. "She'll go to the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas [at The Curragh May 27], the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 22] and then we'll probably move her up to 10 furlongs for the G1 Pretty Polly S. [at The Curragh June 30]. She's laid-back and nothing bothers her, so I've been thinking about 10 furlongs in recent days--she settles and is an economical mover in her races." Trainer John Oxx said of the runner-up, "She got a little isolated on her own out there, but the winner was always going very well and we were never going to get to her. We are delighted and we will aim for the Irish Guineas."

Progressing from a third in last term's G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot, Sixties Icon took out the G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood in August before claiming Classic glory in the G1 St Leger at Doncaster the following month. Closing that sophomore campaign with a disappointing sixth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, he lifted spirits in the Jeremy Nosedá barn with a rousing win on seasonal return here. Settled third behind Mighty's sedate pace until improving into second at halfway, the eventual winner was given the office at the quarter-mile marker. One flick of Frankie Dettori's whip was all that was required thereafter and he scooted clear to score as he pleased. "He's some horse and has improved physically," claimed Dettori. "It was a good performance with a penalty and he's a proper middle-distance horse." Trainer Jeremy Nosedá was equally delighted and added, "It was a good performance, it was very smooth and a nice return to the racetrack. He'll improve a lot from the race as he's at least seven pounds away from peak fitness and he'd much prefer good ground where he can get his toe in a little bit. I needed to get a run into him as the plan has always been to go for the [June 1] G1 Coronation Cup. He's done the job well, he'll go to Epsom and we'll keep our fingers crossed." Aviso's winning debut, when making all to wire the field in a course-and-distance maiden Apr. 1, was all the more notable for being a first representative of Gestut Schlenderhan's new racing operation based at nearby Bergheim. Utilizing similar tactics to lift a hot conditions event at Chantilly last time Apr. 24, he maintained his unbeaten record despite veering across the track in the closing stages of this Classic. Chasing the leaders in sixth, the homebred made progress once into the stretch run and hung left under a drive from the 400-meters pole. Exhibiting enough class where it mattered to wrest victory on the line from Molly Max on the other side of the track, Aviso became the first group winner for both trainer Jens Hirschberger and third-crop sire Tertullian. Successful at Bremen in her only juvenile start last September, Scatina met with the phenomenon that is Mi Emma (Ger) in the Apr. 8 Listed Henkel Trial at Dusseldorf on seasonal return and finished second to the subsequent G2 German 1000 Guineas winner. Stepping up in class for this pattern race debut, she resisted a determined stretch challenge to secure a career high in brave fashion. Sent to the front passing the judge first time, she maintained a steady pace down the backstraight and came under pressure soon after turning for home. Tackled by the crowd's choice Scoubidou approaching the final furlong, Scatina found plenty to repel that rival in the drive for the line. Scatina traces back to the outstanding Schlenderhan foundation mare Schwarzgold (Ger), in whose honour this race is run. River Savage began the year with a front-running victory in the Jan. 12 Paseana H. before competing in a string of three straight Grade I races. She was sixth in the Feb. 10 GI Santa Maria H., third in the Mar. 10 GI Santa Margarita H. and sixth in the Apr. 7 GI Apple Blossom H. Always within striking distance, the dark bay mare bid three wide turning for home, took a slim lead in upper stretch and forged clear to the wire. The victory gave jockey Omar Berrio and trainer A.C. Avila their first Hollywood stakes win. "It's nice, I feel good...like a million dollars," Berrio admitted after the win. "She's a good filly. I was a little scared about the Cushion Track, but today she ran beautiful." Of future plans for River Savage, Avila said, "I think I am going to give her a short break now and regroup." 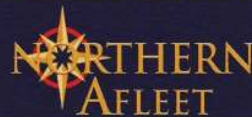

**TEOFILO UNLIKELY TO MAKE EPSOM**

Jim Bolger yesterday described **Teofilo (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) as “doubtful” for the June 2 G1 Epsom Derby following the unbeaten colt’s setback which ruled him out of Saturday’s G1 2000 Guineas. Last year’s G1 National S. and G1 Dewhurst S. winner was scratched from the mile Classic after being found to be sore at the back of his off-fore knee after exercise on Thursday and will be given weeks on the easy list. “He is more or less the same as he was, except the heat has abated somewhat,” Bolger explained. “He is only marginally sore at this stage, but because of the horse he is we have to make sure that everything is right before we start back. We are going to give him whatever number of weeks is required on the easy list and are not going to worry about which race we go for further down the line. We will just try and get him right and produce him right on the day when the time comes. Epsom would look doubtful now, but hopefully we’ll get him back and we will be going the safe route with him--we won’t be taking any chances.”

**CAMILLO MISSES GUINEAS**

Sir Robert Ogden’s **Sander Camillo** (Dixie Union) was taken out of yesterday’s G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket and will wait for the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 22. Second favorite at the time of her withdrawal, last year’s G2 Cherry Hinton S. winner had produced mixed workouts ahead of the mile Classic, having “tied up” when runner-up in the Apr. 18 G3 Nell Gwyn S. “I look forward to the Coronation at Royal Ascot,” was trainer Jeremy Nosedo’s comment.


**REBEL OK**

Geoff Huffer yesterday declared his G1 2000 Guineas hero **Cockney Rebel (Ire)** (Val Royal {Fr}) to be fine after his 1½-length defeat of Vital Equine (Ire) in the Newmarket Classic. Confirming the G1 St James’s Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 19 as the Phil Cunningham-owned colt’s next target, Huffer ruled out the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas in under three weeks’ time. “He is absolutely 100 percent fine,” Huffer said. “He has eaten up and is in top-class form. He only lost five kilos and you would not know that he has been in a race. We haven’t got anything to prove in a Guineas anymore. I rate the English 2000 Guineas as the best and we’ve beaten them in that.”

**HANCOCK HAILS BIG WEEKEND**

Newmarket’s Managing Director Lisa Hancock yesterday reflected on the “exceptionally good two days” that made up the 2007 Guineas Festival. After yesterday’s crowd bested last year’s figure, she said, “The Stan James Guineas Festival has lived up to all our expectations and the 32,000 racegoers who have been here have enjoyed a feast of top-class racing. The weekend was crowned today by an exceptional big race winner in a new record time for a Guineas and Finsceal Beo was very special. We have been thrilled with an exceptionally good two days with two great winners of the Guineas, whose stories couldn’t have been better scripted. We had the best crowd since 2000 on Saturday and no hard-luck stories on the track. The team worked hard and nobody was complaining about the ground.”

**DERBY HANDLE MATCHES RECORDS, TV RATINGS UP**

A crowd of 156,635--third largest in Kentucky Derby history--wagered enough to equal records set last year for total on-track and all-sources wagering. Total wagering from all sources on the Kentucky Derby was \$118,317,714. On-track wagering for the race totaled \$12,076,490. Off-track wagering on the race was \$106,241,224. Total wagering from all sources on the 12-race Kentucky Derby card was \$168,018,982--a decline of 4.1 percent from last year. On-track wagering on the card was \$24,065,098, down 1.6 percent from 2006, while off-track wagering was down 4.5 percent to \$143,953,884. NBC Sports' coverage of the Derby recorded an 8.3 overnight rating and an 18 share, a 12-percent increase from last year and the race's highest overnight rating since 1992. Hollywood Park also benefitted from the Classic card, handling a record \$27.7-million on Churchill's Derby program. That surpassed the mark of \$26.7 million which was the largest single-day handle in California set in 2006.

**BOREL TO DINE AT WHITE HOUSE** Jockey Calvin Borel, who won Saturday's Kentucky Derby aboard Street Sense, will attend a White House state dinner today in honor of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II of England. A total of 134 guests will attend the dinner hosted by President George W. Bush and First Lady Laura Bush in the State Dining Room on the State Floor of the White House, which follows a reception in the East Room of the State Floor. The queen, who attended her first Kentucky Derby Saturday, is scheduled to end her six-day visit to the U.S. and return home.
