Blood-Horse

INTO BATTLE

Joseph Allen and Cheveley Park Stud's **Battle Paint** (Tale of the Cat) will go to post for tomorrow's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) at Longchamp with a score to settle for trainer Jean-Claude Rouget. Still without a domestic Classic winner, the Pau-based conditioner will go to war with a strong team of sophomores this term. Battle Paint, who found only Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) too strong in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere over this track and trip in October, returned to finish second in the Apr. 15 G3 Prix de Fontainebleau and has the right credentials to break the dam. **Cont. p2**

BEO IDEAL

Saturday's G1 1000 Guineas heroine **Finsceal Beo (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley) will face 12 rivals as she bids to complete a unique double in tomorrow's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp. Michael Ryan's sensation has proven track form, having lit up the Bois de Boulogne with a five-length route in the G1 Prix Marcel Bousac in October. Last Sunday's record-setting display when victorious in the G1 English 1000 Guineas offers little encouragement for her rivals, who will try to stop her from emulating Ravinella and Miesque, both of whom triumphed at Newmarket and Longchamp in recent times. Heading the home defense is Princess Zahra Aga Khan's G3 Prix de la Grotte scorer **Darjina (Fr)** (Zamindar), who bids to provide Alain de Royer-Dupre with his third renewal. De Royer-Dupre also saddles William Preston's Listed Prix Isonomy winner **Anabaa's Creation (Fr)** (Anabaa), and he is hopeful that the duo can hold their own. "Darjina has done very well since her victory in the Prix de la Grotte, but I don't want any rain for her and the weather forecast is very bizarre," he told the *Racing Post*. "I would prefer some cut for Anabaa's Creation, who has made a lot of progress, but we were hesitating between this race and the longer G1 Prix Saint-Alary."

ALL YOU NEED IS ONE

All five of trainer Todd Pletcher's GI Kentucky Derby entries failed to hit the board last Saturday, but the reigning Eclipse Award winning conditioner has a fresh face for the GI Preakness S. in **King of the Roxy** (Littleexpectations). The Team Valor colorbearer annexed the Mar. 3 GII Hutcheson S. in his sophomore debut, then finished a close second in the GI Santa Anita Derby last time Apr. 7. "We started focusing on the Preakness immediately after the Santa Anita Derby," said Pletcher, who saddled Impeachment to a third-place finish in the 2000 Preakness. "He has only been long a couple times, and in the one start at Churchill [GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile], it wasn't his best effort. He lost some training time when we first got to Florida over the winter, so we felt we didn't want to rush him and pointed to the Preakness."

Hard Spun (Danzig), a game runner-up in the Kentucky Derby, galloped a mile and a half and jogged a quarter mile at Delaware Park yesterday. "It was vintage Hard Spun," trainer Larry Jones said. "He is as normal as normal can be. We have total confidence in him. We do not have any plans to breeze him. As well as he's doing, we'll just have to play it by ear. If he acts like he needs to, we'll let him blow off a little steam, but we do not plan to schedule a work for him. We'll do as we've done all spring, we'll let him tell us what we need to do and hopefully we'll be able to understand what he's saying and do right."

David Wachman, who went within a head of winning this two years ago with Indesatchel (Ire), relies on Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's **Followmyfootsteps** (Giant's Causeway). He faces a jump up from a Tipperary maiden success Apr. 12, but his conditioner thinks he can prove up to the task. "He won his maiden about a month ago and he has shown me enough at home since to suggest that he is worth his place in the line-up," Aidan O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "He won his maiden over 7 1/2 furlongs and he's by Giant's Causeway, so the trip shouldn't be a problem." Peter Chapple-Hyam collected the 1998 renewal courtesy of Victory Note. He saddles Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's G2 Coventry S. third-place finisher **Tariq (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}), who was fifth on his sophomore bow in Newbury's G3 Greenham S. Apr. 21. "Tariq is on course to run in the French 2000 Guineas," his trainer said. "He wasn't at his best at Newbury in the Greenham, but his work has improved since then. The ground is currently soft at Longchamp and if stays like that, it would be in his favour. He won his maiden in the soft at Newmarket last May."

Mythical Kid is put to the test over Lingfield's undulating course in a bid to provide Godolphin with a serious contender for the June 2 G1 Epsom Derby. He did all his racing in the space of 11 days at Newbury in October, stepping up from a smooth maiden score to finish runner-up to Dijeerr in the G3 Horris Hill S. "Mythical Kid had a nice winter in Dubai, he is improving all the time and has been working well," commented trainer Saeed bin Suuroo. "It is a case of so far, so good with him. This will be a sound test for him before he can hopefully run in better races." He meets **Kid Mambo**, who found only the subsequent Listed Cheshire Oaks winner Light Shift too strong in a 10-furlong conditions race at Newbury last time Apr. 20. "He ran very well against the filly and has been as good as gold since," trainer Terry Mills commented. "All the form is stacking up around us and I don't think too much will worry this fellow, as he's a real tough old nut. I think he'll handle the track and any ground."

CHRB FUNDING PULLED BY SENATE COMMITTEE *By Jack Shinar, courtesy www.bloodhorse.com*

The California Horse Racing Board drew more political heat May 9 when a state Senate budget sub-committee pulled the regulatory agency's \$10.8 million funding for the 2007-08 fiscal year. The action seems mostly related to the CHRB's refusal of Bay Meadows' request to waive a commission mandate requiring installation of an all-weather racing surface by the end of the year. Sen. Leland Yee, whose district includes Bay Meadows, made the request formally to Sen. Michael J. Machado, chairman of the Budget and Fiscal Review Sub-Committee. During the one-minute hearing, Machado told Ingrid Fermin, executive director of the the CHRB: "The Senate and the Senate leadership is very concerned about the actions and attitudes of the horse racing board. Today, I'm recommending eliminating the complete budget for the board. And with that, I hope this action will motivate people on the board to open up the communication lines with the Senate to resolve outstanding issues." With the 73-year-old Bay Meadows set to close in November following the Mar. 22 decision, Yee has been harshly critical of the CHRB, citing the loss of more than 500 jobs and tax revenue it would cause. A week after the Bay Meadows vote, Yee called for the resignation of Richard Shapiro, chairman of the seven-member board, for engineering the vote against the waiver. The board has repeatedly cited the need to improve the safety for horses and jockeys for the synthetic track requirement. During the recently concluded Bay Meadows meet, 25 horses were euthanized as a result of training or racing injuries, according to a CHRB report. **Click for the [complete story](#).**

HEARING SHEDS LIGHT ON TRPB INVESTIGATION, JOCKEY BANS

The transcript from a recent hearing before a judge appointed by the Illinois Racing Board brought new details to light concerning the Thoroughbred Racing and Protective Bureau's investigation of 10 jockeys banned last December from Florida and Pennsylvania tracks for alleged race-fixing. Jockey Terry Houghton, appealing his recent exclusion from Arlington Park, is one of seven riders banned from Tampa Bay Downs Dec. 19 when track management was contacted by the TRPB regarding an ongoing independent investigation that parallels one into suspicious wagering patterns organized by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Houghton, with other jockeys, was questioned by the FBI regarding his involvement in several races run in 2006. The TRPB investigation focuses in particular on three of those races; the sixth at Tampa Bay on Apr. 10, the third at Great Lakes Downs on Aug. 24, and the fourth at Great Lakes on Sept. 5. In each race, the horse ridden by Houghton was left out of suspicious wagers placed off-site from Michigan and Delaware. "There was a systematic exclusion throughout the betting pattern of a particular betting interest," said TRPB wagering analyst Jerry Curtis Linnell, who completed the analysis of the three races in question. "The analysis had produced...substantial and compelling evidence that these jockeys were involved in the fixing of races," attorney Shawn Wood said on behalf of Churchill Downs Inc. and Arlington Park. According to the transcript, the TRPB met with representatives of CDI Mar. 29 to present information on the investigation. At that time, said CDI vice president Steve Sexton, a review of data linked to the wagering patterns led officials to believe Houghton improperly influenced the outcome of the races in question. "We take the integrity of racing very seriously and [don't want] any chance that there would be someone racing at our tracks [who] may call into question the integrity of the honesty of racing at our operations," Sexton said. "I made an independent conclusion based on the review of the data that was presented to us and subsequent discussions after the TRPB meeting between myself and [Churchill General Manager] Jim Gates." "We looked at Polytrack and also looked at the training centers that have Tapeta, and we believe Michael will give us the best service," Williams said. "Also, Polytrack couldn't meet our installation schedule." Dickinson's Tapeta surface primarily consists of sand, with the addition of rubber and fibers coated with hot wax. Preparation for the installation of the new track is currently under way at Presque Isle Downs, which opened earlier this year with slot-machine gaming. Golden Gate Fields also is scheduled to replace its dirt track with Tapeta this year.
