It seems Aidan O'Brien can do little wrong. The Ballydoyle bonanza continued apace at Longchamp yesterday when Derrick Smith's **Astronomer Royal**

(Danzig) led home a first, third and fourth for O'Brien in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains. Beaten less than four lengths when sixth in the course-and-distance G3 Prix de Fontainebleau Apr. 15, the bay was coupled with his barnmates at

34-10. He came running wide and late under Colm O'Donoghue to inhale **Creachadoir (Ire)** (King's Best) and was in command in the final yards for a half-length score. "This horse ran very well in his trial and all of our horses are improving from their first run," explained O'Brien, who was winning this Classic for the third time. "The horses are running consistently well and this is a big thing for Colm, who was very confident after riding him here last time." *Cont. p2*

DARJINA FLOORS FINSCEAL

She was second best in the betting at 4-1, but it was Princess Zahra Aga Khan's **Darjina (Fr)** (Zamindar) who

came out on top in yesterday's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp. The filly's late rattle denied G1 1000 Guineas heroine **Finsceal Beo (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley) her Classic double in the final stride. Taking her record to a perfect three-for-three, G3 Prix de la Grotte winner Darjina had to play catch-up in the straight as the 5-6

crowd's choice shook loose, but answered Christophe Soumillon's every call to reel her in and earn a head success. "She's a really lovely filly with a lot of class," trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre commented after greeting his third Pouliches winner. "I was slightly worried when the rain came before the second race, as she is definitely much better on fast ground, but she quickened brilliantly." *Cont. p2*

Astronomer Royal had an inconspicuous start to his career when second in a Naas maiden in July and when taken to Newbury to break his maiden the following month. Shipped in for his trial in the Fontainebleau here, he failed to strike a serious blow despite running with credit, as last year's Poulains winner Aussie Rules had done in the same race 12 months ago. Held up in rear early off the moderate tempo set by **Battle Paint** (Tale of the Cat), he had the majority of his rivals still ahead at the top of the false straight before being unleashed widest of all approaching the quarter pole. Driving into Creachadoir and Kevin Manning's advantage with every stride, he rolled by that rival in the final 75 yards and was beyond recall as Jamie Spencer struggled for room on the race's hard-luck story **Excellent Art** (GB) (Pivotal {GB}). "We have lots of options with our colts, as most are showing Group 1 form," O'Brien added. "This colt is certainly one for the G1 St James's Palace S. Darjina arrived at the Apr. 15 G3 Prix de la Grotte with just a Saint-Cloud conditions success to her name, but the homebred carried a substantial reputation into the race and emerged with it enhanced. Settled in rear off the strong early fractions, the bay traveled smoothly to the top of the home straight before quickening out wide. Finsceal Beo had been committed by Kevin Manning at the quarter pole and had an apparently safe cushion approaching the eighth pole, but despite her game effort she could not match the momentum of Darjina in the final drive. "I am certain she will stay further, so we have options," her trainer added. "She is in the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 22], or she could go for the G1 Prix de Diane [French Oaks] at Chantilly June 10." Finsceal Beo's trainer Jim Bolger was not downcast after seeing his star filly run out of a unique achievement. "She has run a good race, but Kevin [Manning] said the ground affected her speed," he told *PA Sport*. "It all went well, but the shower before racing didn't help at all. She was very well coming here and was two kilos heavier then before Newmarket, so that race can't have taken anything out of her. It's on to the Curragh now [for the May 27 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas], where hopefully she will get faster ground." While it was unsurprising that Ballydoyle enjoyed a one-two-three here after saddling four of the five starters, the shock came in the order of finish as Macarthur was upstaged by stable companion Archipenko. He had burst onto the scene on his final start at two when registering a six-length defeat of the subsequent G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains third Honoured Guest (Ire) over seven furlongs of this track at the end of October. That was a marked improvement on a no-show in a Curragh maiden on debut in August and second at the same track a week previously. Confidently ridden on his return by Mick Kinane in a stalking third as Macarthur dictated up front under Seamus Heffernan, he quickened on demand to pass that rival at the furlong pole and was always holding Yellowstone in the run to the line. "Mick [Kinane] was very happy--that puts him right in the mix," John Magnier told *PA Sport*. "He might get a mile and a half. We will have to run a few of them and see what comes out best." Alexander Tango made a winning debut over seven furlongs at The Curragh last July, but was not allowed to rest on her laurels for long. Third in the G2 Debutante S. later that month and a close-up fifth in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. in August, the chestnut may have been unsuited by the good-to-soft conditions when off the board in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot the following month. 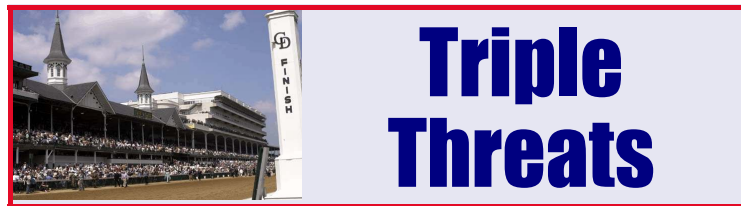
