**Street Sense Tunes Up for Preakness...**

Kentucky Derby winner **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}), accompanied by regular pilot Calvin Borel, turned in a strong five-furlong work at Churchill Downs yesterday in preparation for Saturday's GI Preakness S. Caught in 1:00, the seventh fastest of 22 at the distance, the colt recorded internal splits of :12.60, :25, :37 and :48.60 and galloped out in 1:12.60.

"He wanted to go faster than he did, but he just listened to Calvin," explained trainer Carl Nafzger. "They

asked me before the work why we went five-eighths, and that's because I didn't think the horse would get into stride enough going a half mile it might frustrate him because he just likes to stride along," said Nafzger, explaining the move. "Actually, he worked a lot faster than we thought [he would], but that's what he had to do. He did it the right way and it didn't hurt him."

Owned by James Tafel, the bay is scheduled to fly to Baltimore on the second of two Sutton Forwarding Co. equine transport flights departing from Louisville today. Nafzger and his wife Wanda were scheduled to arrive in Baltimore yesterday, while Borel, who is scheduled to ride at Pimlico Friday, is expected in Baltimore tomorrow.

**Lukas Sets Sights on Baltimore...**

**Flying First Class** (Perfect Mandate), ridden by Stacy Prior, breezed four furlongs in :49.80 in his final major prep for Saturday's Preakness. The winner of the Apr. 28 Derby Trial posted the 19<sup>th</sup> fastest of 30 at the distance Tuesday. "He went very well," said D. Wayne Lukas. "We didn't want to do a lot, but we got it right on the money. We didn't want to break :49, and we're pretty close to the race. We're tight and fit, so it was good--very good. I was very pleased." No stranger to Pimlico's winner's circle, Lukas

is confident that he has another major player in this year's edition of the Classic. "We're not going down for the crab cakes," he said. "We're going over there with high expectations. I think we're going to raise hell. I really do." Jockey Mark Guidry, who was aboard for the Derby Trial, will ride the colt in the Classic.

**Circular Quay Confirmed for Preakness...**

**Circular Quay** (Thunder Gulch) will join stablemate King of the Roxy in Saturday's lineup in the GI Preakness S., it was revealed yesterday. Winner of the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 10, the chestnut finished sixth in his latest start in the GI Kentucky Derby May 5. Jockey John Velazquez will get the call on the chestnut in the middle jewel of the Triple Crown. Both Circular Quay and King of the Roxy are expected to arrive in Baltimore Thursday.

**Any Given Saturday Exits Derby with Bruise...**

**Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor), 8th in the Kentucky Derby, came out of the race with a bruised foot, reports the *Daily Racing Form* yesterday. According to trainer Todd Pletcher, the injury was discovered May 8. "We had to pull the show off of him," Pletcher told *DRF*. "It's improving but he has not gone back to the track since then." As for the remainder of Pletcher's Derby team, **Scat Daddy** (Johannesburg) is being aimed at the GII Dwyer S. July 4, while **Cowtown Cat** (Distorted Humor) may contest Thistledown's GII Ohio Derby June 2.

**Les Arcs** makes his seasonal debut under a penalty for his winning exploits in last year's G1 Golden Jubilee S. and G1 July Cup and bids to emulate Pipalong (Ire), who achieved the feat in 2002. Last year's winner **Steenberg** is in his element when the ground is easy here and his half-length defeat of **Quito** 12 months ago was due reward for runner-up finishes in 2004 and 2005. Peter Chapple-Hyam saddles the improver **Al Qasi**, who handed the smart Greek Renaissance (Ire) a four-length beating in a Ripon handicap in August before adding a competitive Ascot handicap to his tally when last seen in September. His trainer is hopeful he can become the latest in a long line of sprinters to bridge the narrow gap between that company and stakes level. "I am very pleased with the way things have gone with him this spring," he said.

"The Duke of York was always going to be his first run of the year and everything has gone as well as expected in the build up. His draw of three isn't brilliant, but the ground won't matter to him. In fact, he quite likes it when he can get his toe in." Jeremy Noseda brings **Soldier's Tale** back to the track after a lengthy lay-off, but if he can reproduce his latest fourth in the 2005 G1 July Cup he can play a role. "Soldier's Tale appears to have retained all of his ability," his trainer commented. "The ground will be ideal for him and and I am delighted to have him back on the track." **Amadeus Wolf** knocked on the door last term following a two-year-old campaign which saw him capture the G1 Middle Park S. and he bids to follow in the steps of the 1997 winner Royal Applause (GB), who failed to build on his Middle Park success at three before returning to center stage the next season. "He's in great shape," trainer Kevin Ryan told *PA Sport*. "He's done marvelous over the winter, he's been working very well and we are very hopeful."

After a brief spell out of the big time, Henry Cecil can prepare for a return if **Passage of Time** comes through this Epsom Oaks trial in expected fashion. She handled soft ground when opening her maiden at Newmarket in August and when returning to that venue to best **Sues Surprise** by five lengths in the Listed Montrose S. in October. She had the subsequent dual group scorer Soldier of Fortune (Ire) back in second in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud the following month and, despite the recent finding of an abscess in her throat, connections are hopeful she will book her ticket to the June 1 Classic. "She has taken a little bit of time to come in her coat, so we have gone along gently with her, as she is not a very heavy filly," said Cecil, who has won seven times with the likes of Indian Skimmer, Diminuendo, Snow Bride, All at Sea and Reams of Verse. "She's coming along nicely, but was very late coming in her coat, so we've taken her very gently. I've had to wait and go with her, as you can't move them when they are not thriving. She seems in good fettle and is deceiving, because she travels very well in her work, but when she gets upsides, she decides to sit and talk to the filly next to her. I'm happy with her and the proof of the pudding will be in the eating." Sir Michael Stoute has also collected seven renewals and saddles **Shorthand**, a sister to last year's winner Short Skirt (GB) who was fourth in the G2 Rockfel S. on her last start in October.

**Curragh Option for Rahiyah...**

Sheikh Rashid bin Mohammed Al Maktoum's **Rahiyah** (Rahy) could be supplemented for next Sunday's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas. The filly was beaten less than two lengths by Darjina (Fr) and Finsceal Beo (Ire) when third in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp Sunday. "We're going to see how she is in the next week and, although she isn't entered in the Irish 1000 Guineas, it would be a consideration," trainer Jeremy Nosedo said. "I'll talk to Sheikh Rashid regarding supplementing her. [But] it's more likely that she might go straight to the G1 Coronation S. [Royal Ascot June 22]."

**Camillo Could Drop Back in Trip...**

Sir Robert Ogden's **Sander Camillo** (Dixie Union) could revert to sprinting after disappointing in Sunday's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas). Her unplaced effort in the Longchamp feature followed a second when 4-7 for the Apr. 18 G3 Nell Gwyn S. at Newmarket, and connections will investigate the reasons for her flops. "She seems fine, but we're going to go over her with a fine-tooth comb," trainer Jeremy Nosedo commented. "We feel she is the best in the yard, yet she has performed below what we expected on both starts this year. Her seasons have been very tough on her and the ground couldn't be fast enough for her, but the other thing on my mind is I'm just beginning to wonder whether she might just be a sprinter. We'll wait and see and start back at the beginning, to work things out where we go from there."

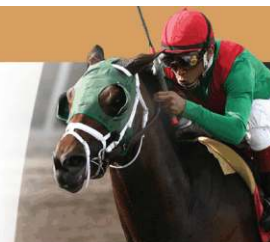

Starting at odds of 17-1, Ashley's Kitty surprised not only the bettors, but also her connections with her performance in the GIII Railbird S. The lightly raced filly debuted with a win in a \$100,000 maiden claimer at Santa Anita in early February. She followed up with an allowance win over the same course, but ran off the board when tried on turf in the GIII Providencia S. On Sunday, making only her fourth start and back on the main track, Ashley's Kitty rated off a fast pace, took over in the stretch and held off favorite Silver Swallow to score by a nose.

Ashley's Kitty is a member of the first crop of sired by Tale of the Cat out of the mares he attracted following his excellent freshman season in 2002. That crop was finally topped by My Trusty Cat, winner of the GI Humana Distaff S., and included five other stakes winners. Tale of the Cat's second crop, which saw him take honors as leading sire of two-year-olds, produced no less than 16 stakes winners, among them GI Hollywood Futurity and GI Haskell Invit. victor Lion Heart as well as graded scorers Be Gentle, Spellbinder, Feline Story, Whoopi Cat, Catboat and Artemus Sunrise.

Tale of the Cat didn't get a stakes winner from his third crop, but juvenile graded scorer and Grade I-performer Catcominatch was in his fourth. As we mentioned, Ashley's Kitty is from the first crop sired by Tale of the Cat followed by the bright effort put forth by his freshman crop as juveniles, and that crop now also includes 2007 stakes winners Taletobetold (winner of the Open Mind S. Saturday at Churchill Downs), Native Legend and Dinner Break.

Ashley's Kitty is the second foal of her dam, Pretty 'n Smart, who earned graded black-type with a third in the GII Railbird S., the race her daughter won. This is a family which has been pretty light in recent generations. The only other black-type in the first three dams is that gained by Pretty 'n Smart's half sister, Hostess, who took third in last year's GIII Sands Point S., and has been black-type placed again this year. The family does get a little stronger under the fourth dam, Mlle. Liebe. A half-sister to Au Printemps (a stakes winner who produced GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Success Express, Canadian champion Charlie Barley, and Grade I winner Greenwood Lake), Mlle. Liebe bred two stakes winners. She is also granddam or third dam of several more, including her graded-stakes winning grandson, Artemus Sunrise, who is by Ashley's Kitty's sire, Tale of the Cat.

Pretty 'n Smart--the dam of Ashley's Kitty--was the first black-type performer to emerge in the direct female line for some time, and it is likely that the upgrade in ability was the result of a clever mating plan. She is a daughter of Beau Genius, a horse who was out of a mare by Viceregal. Her dam is by Viceregal's brother, Vice Regent, so she has the siblings 3x2.

Complex and clever inbreeding would also appear to be the key to Ashley's Kitty's pedigree. Tale of the Cat's sire, Storm Cat, is a reverse Northern Dancer/Bold Ruler cross to Beau Genius. His sire, Storm Bird has a particularly close relationship with Beau Genius's dam, Royal Colleen: she is by a son of Storm Bird's sire, Northern Dancer, out of Own Colleen, a half-sister to Storm Bird's broodmare sire, New Providence. There is also a strong relationship between Storm Cat and Ashley's Kitty's granddam, Charge d'Affaires: both are by sons of Northern Dancer, and both dams are by Secretariat out of a mares by grandsons of the stallion Balladier. **Alan Porter may be contacted at [portrpedigree@msn.com](mailto:portrpedigree@msn.com). **DANZIG AVENUE**

As several of my colleagues, including Andrew Caulfield in these pages yesterday, have noted, Danzig's next-to-last crop, sired when he was 26, includes 30 named foals. Eighteen of them were colts. Since five of them contested Classics over the last two weekends, that makes the odds 13-5 (call it 5-2) that a colt sired by the then-26-year-old stallion would be a live Classic contender, and 8-1 that they would finish first or second in a Classic. Those two, of course, are G1 French 2000 Guineas winner Astronomer Royal, and G1 Kentucky Derby second Hard Spun. The three Guineas also-rans include a Group 3 winner (Dijeerr), listed winner (U.S. Ranger), and last year's G1 Dew-hurst fourth, Haatef. Danzig has always been the best sire of A Runner colts that system has ever discovered: historically, the odds of any named colt by Danzig becoming an A Runner are only 4-1, while the odds of one achieving the highest standard I measure, a Grade I/Grade II winner, are 10-1. In both cases he is comfortably the best sire of the last 20 years. It is significant for historians and researchers to discover that it is possible for sires to sustain their numbers even at the age of 26.

Danzig is not only the very best of the great sons of the peerless Northern Dancer, he is arguably also the most influential. His best sire son, of course, is Danehill. Though he himself does not yet qualify as a significant sire of sires, Danehill of course dominates the Australasian lists, especially as his son Redoute's Choice has taken over where he left off.

His only really top sire son yet in the Northern Hemisphere is Danehill Dancer, who came from such humble beginnings as a sire himself that we still don't know how good he is. The great racehorse Rock of Gibraltar is looking plenty useful now--as we'll see below, he ranks second to Invincible Spirit on the accompanying European second-crop sire list (see p10)--but whether he does or doesn't prove as good a sire as he was a racehorse, the sheer volume of Danehill sons at stud guarantees his will be the number one Danzig branch.

Invincible Spirit is the fly in the ointment as far as Rock of Gibraltar is concerned. Interestingly, he is by another top sire son of Danzig, Green Desert. Though himself a very successful sire (60 A Runners in 17 crops, for example), Green Desert's only really successful sire son on the international stage so far has been Cape Cross. So Invincible Spirit was no lock, on paper, to make a sire, even though the Judges really liked his first foals and yearlings.

Invincible Spirit had not won a Group 1 until he was a five-year-old, so there wasn't an obvious pointer that he was going to be Europe's leading freshman sire of 2006, and with 35 first-crop two-year-old winners, breaking End Sweep's previous world-record 32.

From almost exactly the same number of runners (83 to 84--where do they get them?), Invincible Spirit has sired 43 winners to Rock of Gibraltar's 29, and seven stakes winners to three for 'The Rock.' Rock of Gibraltar has another seven stakes-placed, so Invincible Spirit's lead in combined stakes horses is less marked, 12 to 10. Aidan O'Brien trains at least three by Rock of Gibraltar (see p9) who look like they'll go considerably further than a mile. Invincible Spirit looked like he might be more of a sprint sire (that would not exactly seem out of a character for a sprinting son of Green Desert), so followers of his longer-term prospects couldn't help but be impressed when Lawman (an Invincible Spirit half-brother to Lattice, winner of the G1 French Oaks over 10 1/2 furlongs, but herself by the sprint sire, Inchinor) won the GIII Prix de Guiche over nine furlongs in a style that suggested he might be a GI French Derby (now 10 1/2 furlongs) horse. That would really rocket Invincible Spirit into orbit, though the French had better hope their three-year-old middle-distance horses are better than their three-year-old milers, who were beaten out of sight in the G1 Poules d'Essai de Poulains. In any case, after early 2007 returns, Invincible Spirit is sustaining his lead over Rock of Gibraltar, and the two remain well clear among this term's European second-crop sires. Incidentally, Invincible Spirit's sire, Green Desert, has a chance to have a third son qualify as a big-time sire in 2007 freshman sire Oasis Dream, himself a champion sprinter and a dead ringer for his old man.

The horse who has come from the clouds to make a big impact among European sires whose first crops are three-year-olds this year ('second-crop sires') is Val Royal, the 2001 GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner when trained by Julio Canani for Hollywood producer David Milch. By the perennially underrated (I've been saying that for so long I think it's part of his name) Royal Academy--he's also the damsire of Finsceal Beo, remember--Val Royal hails from a good Lagardere family, and won up to 10 furlongs in France. Being by the relatively unfashionable sire of sires Royal Academy and without much of a following, Val Royal toiled in relative obscurity in Ireland for his first few seasons, but arrived at England's National Stud in Newmarket in time to make the top 10 among Europe's 2006 freshman sires, thanks to the American Grade III winning filly, Valbenny, and the then Group 2-placed colt, Cockney Rebel. Valbenny added a second Hollywood Park one-mile (turf) Grade III, the Senorita, last weekend. We all know now that Cockney Rebel scored a decisive Classic win in the G1 English 2000, propelling Val Royal past Noverre into the third spot, ranked by cumulative lifetime progeny earnings (as qualified on p10) among 2007 European second-crop sires.

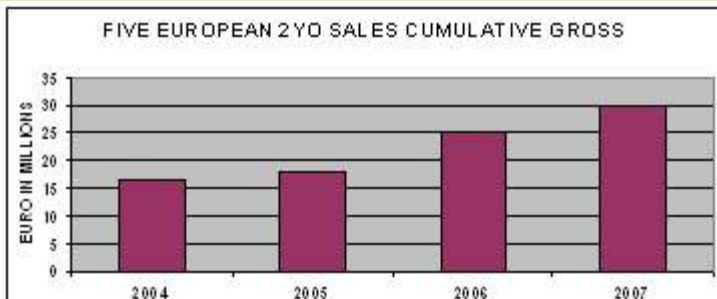

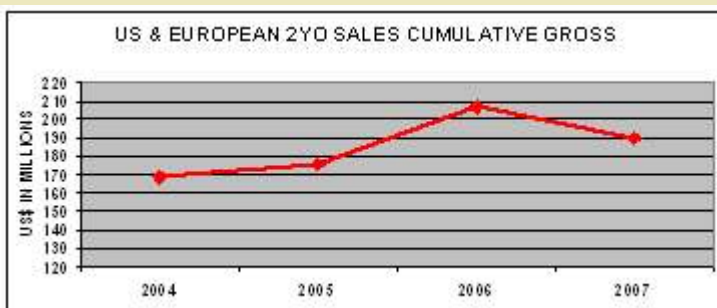

Noverre won the G1 Sussex S. over one mile as a three-year-old and placed in 10 other Group 1's at distances from six to 10 furlongs. He's sired plenty of winners so far, and has only narrowly lost third spot to Val Royal, though he needs more stakes winners. His stablemate, Tobougg, has been a real surprise package. Still standing this year for only £5,000, the 2000 G1 Dewhurst winner never won another race after his two-year-old campaign (sound familiar?), in his case from nine more starts (three Group 1 placings including the Epsom Derby, though). He's sired 28 winners (oddly, four of the top six on this list have each had 83 or 84 runners to date), seven stakes horses, including runners in both English Guineas races (albeit the colt, Tobosa, finished 14th, and the filly, Sweet Lilly, was 12th. She runs back in today's Group 3 Musidora). Tobougg is by Sadler's Wells's son, Baratheia, while by Sadler's Wells himself is Juddmonte's Beat Hollow, only 18th in earnings, with just nine winners from a smaller crop (28 runners), but five of them are stakes horses. That ties him for fourth, with Val Royal, in number of stakes horses thus far, behind Invincible Spirit (12), Rock of Gibraltar (10), and Tobougg (seven).

There are quite a few interesting horses on this list, not least current number 15, the nearly unpronounceable Chichicastenango, who was a good horse himself by the equally obscure Smadoun (by Kaldoun). He has two Group 3 winners among his five winners. And two horses lurking outside the top 20 could yet be heard from, if they're going to sire more of a later developing, middle-distance type: runaway 2001 Group 1 Arc winner Sakhee; and dual Group 1 winner Act One. Finally, there is the odd case of Zamindar, who is back for his second stint as a second-season sire. He sired 2002 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches winner Zenda in his first crop; then, after a stint in Florida, just sired the 2007 French 1000 Guineas winner Darjina, in his first crop back. So he's an honorary 'leading second crop' sire.

**Aidan's XI...**

If I were more knowledgeable about the strategy of those two world-renowned ball games featuring 11 players, (American) football and 'football' (a/k/a soccer), I would be better placed to advise Aidan whether to run one in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and two in the G1 French Derby, or two and one. It's a matter of the correct formation, the strategists tell you. Anyway, writing in yesterday's *Racing Post*, Tony O'Hehir enumerated predicted targets for Ballydoyle's top three year olds. These currently number 11. There may be as many as 15 in the 'first eleven,' but probably the best sprinter-miler of them, Holy Roman Emperor (Danehill), was traded by Ballydoyle to Coolmore for George Washington (Danehill). Mount Nelson (Rock of Gibraltar), a Group 1 winner at two who earlier this year was thought to be the stable's main Derby hope, still appears to be on the bench. Macarthur (Montjeu) and Acapulco (Galileo) look to be out of consideration for the starting XI. So, depending on whether Eagle Mountain (Rock of Gibraltar) runs in the Irish 2000 or the French Derby, the lineup could be 1-5-2-3 or 2-5-1-3: Duke of Marmalade (Danehill) and maybe Eagle Mountain for the Irish 2000; five for the G1 Epsom Derby; Anton Chekhov (Montjeu) and maybe Eagle Mountain for the French Derby; and then last Sunday's G1 French 2000 Guineas one-three-four Astronomer Royal, Honoured Guest (Danehill), and Excellent Art (Pivotal) for 'Ascot,' presumably for the G1 St. James's Palace S. Myself, I don't see what he's waiting for; surely one or two of the Ascot prospects could top up the numbers for the Irish 2000.

But seriously, folks, what an arsenal (no football pun intended). The attached table lists (p9) them in sire-line order, and it's an awesome picture. The table includes the two Group 1 winners not currently in the first XI; so, of the 13 listed, eight hail from the Danzig line, including four (three 'live' for future Classics) by Danehill, and three by Rock of Gibraltar--which could definitely impact Invincible Spirit's current lead over him among European second-crop sires.

“The weekend's classics at Newmarket provided a wonderful demonstration of why ROYAL ACADEMY should be held in higher regard. Three are by Sadler's Wells's two young guns: Soldier of Fortune and Mahler are by Galileo, while Anton Chekhov is by Montjeu (as is current Derby favorite, Authorized, due to run in tomorrow's G2 Dante). Then there are the two 'outliers': G2 Derrinstown Derby Trial winner Archipenko (by Kingmambo out of Bound, therefore inbred 4x2 to the great broodmare Special, dam of Nureyev and granddam of Sadler's Wells); and French 2000 fourth Excellent Art (by Pivotal). That's not even to mention other colts owned by Tabor and/or Smith which aren't at Ballydoyle--intended Dante runner Adagio (Grand Lodge) and US Ranger, for example. By the way, when we hear who Mick Kinane is riding at Epsom--he rode Soldier of Fortune and Admiralofthefleet to win at Chester, and Archipenko at Leopardstown--we'll have a pretty good idea of the O'Brien first string. Then again, maybe that 2-1 at Ladbroke's for Aidan to train the Epsom Derby winner is the way to go.

And the Opposition, the 'Boys in Blue'? Their older horses are getting going now: two of their first three four-year-olds to run in Britain have won. Their three year olds are one-for-eight: their sole three year old winner in Britain so far this year is Calabash Cove, who broke his maiden at Lingfield last weekend. As far as the Classics are concerned: Gone missing.

**LITE LIGHT DIES** Millionaire **Lite Light** (Majestic Light--Printing Press, by In Reality) was euthanized May 5 after rupturing her uterine artery while foaling a Mineshaft filly, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The 19-year-old mare resided at owner Edward Evans' Spring Hill Farm near Casanova, Virginia. The filly has been placed on a nurse mare. Purchased as a yearling for \$35,000 by Jack Finley, the bay captured three of nine starts at two, including the GII Oak Leaf S. and GIII Sorrento S., and was the runner-up in both the GI Hollywood Starlet S. and GII Del Mar Debutante S. She opened her sophomore season with a victory in the GI Las Virgenes S. before being purchased by Oaktown Stables, the nom de course of rap star M.C. Hammer (of "Can't Touch This" fame) and his family. The Jerry Hollendorfer trainee landed the GI Santa Anita Oaks in her initial outing for Oaktown, then took the GII Fantasy S. and triumphed by 10 lengths in the GI Kentucky Oaks. After an epic battle with champion Meadow Star in the GI Mother Goose S., Lite Light came up a nose short, but turned the tables on that rival with convincing seven-length score in the GI CCA Oaks. That turned out to be her final career victory, though she did take third in the GII Chula Vista H. during the summer of 1991 and mirrored that effort in the 1993 GII San Gorgonio H. Lite Light retired with a record of 26-8-4-4 and earnings of \$1,231,596. Her second foal, the Storm Cat filly Gaily Egret, became a millionaire stakes winner in Japan. In reality, Fernando is an extraordinarily conscientious, independent thoroughbred horse agent who is trying to make a living one transaction at a time. Fernando is always intensely loyal and vigilant as to the best interests of his clients. Well-earned trust and respect from those to whom Fernando provides bloodstock services is his first and foremost priority. For the last year and a half, he has been powerless to protect his reputation against allegations that he participated in a scheme to steal millions, cheat, defraud, fleece and conspire against Jess Jackson. Such allegations were always untrue as to Fernando Diaz-Valdes.

Upon investigation, it was clear that Jess Jackson never hired Fernando to perform any services, that Fernando never acted as his bloodstock agent, that Fernando never gave him advice on any thoroughbred horse transaction and that Fernando never billed Jess Jackson for anything at any time. It has been a difficult time for Fernando, a proverbial "little guy" within the thoroughbred horse industry, to be forced to defend his good name and reputation against someone of the resources and resolve of Jess Jackson. This lawsuit has plagued Fernando with an ever-present cloud of suspicion. Long-time acquaintances stopped calling, casual acquaintances would turn and look the other way and the allegations had made him a pariah in the thoroughbred horse community. Happily, the chagrin, professional embarrassment and burden of those accusations come to a permanent end today.

Fernando did not participate in any fraudulent activity, scheme or engage in any activity that was deceitful. Fernando has always conducted himself with integrity and deserves the fitting reward of an unblemished reputation. The dismissal, with prejudice, of all charges against Fernando shall appropriately restore him to a position of credibility throughout the thoroughbred industry.

It is our hope that the dismissal of all claims against Fernando Diaz-Valdes will receive even a fraction of the media attention that his inclusion as a defendant did. The thoroughbred horse industry is a close-knit community and a person's reputation means everything.

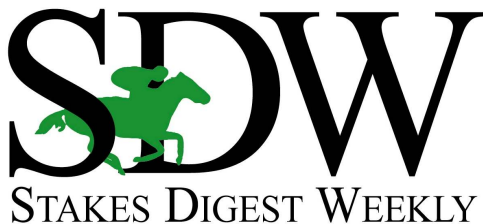
