**LIKE FATHER, LIKE DAUGHTER?**

Six years and six days ago, Include notched the biggest win of his career with a narrow victory against Albert the Great in the GI Pimlico Special H. Today, his daughter **Panty Raid** (Include) tries to notch the biggest win of her young career over the same strip. Panty Raid will be one of the favorites in this afternoon's nine-furlong GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico, and rates a good chance of getting her first stakes win against a field of eight other three-year-old fillies, seven of whom are also looking for their initial black-type victory. The Todd Pletcher-trained Panty Raid is coming off two strong efforts over the Polytrack. She fell a head short when runner-up in the GIII Bourbonette BC S. at Turfway Mar. 24, then won a first-level allowance at Keeneland Apr. 13. Edgar Prado was aboard for those, and will be reunited with Panty Raid for this test.

**NAFZGER STAYS PHILOSOPHICAL**

Carl Nafzger is maintaining an even keel as he prepares GI Kentucky Derby winner **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) for Saturday's GI Preakness S. "It's really very simple," Nafzger said. "When you get a good horse, don't mess him up. If he can really run, I can really train." The Derby winner is also taking everything in stride, according to Nafzger, who 17 years ago trained Derby champ Unbridled to a runner-up finish in the Preakness. Describing Street Sense's attitude upon arriving at Pimlico, Nafzger said, "He takes a couple looks around

like Unbridled, then he says: 'Ok, this is where we're at. I wonder what's going to happen now.'" Comparing his two Derby winners, Nafzger said, "Mentally, yes; soundness, yes; immune system, yes; ability, yes; the way he performs, they're different horses. Unbridled was a big horse and he'd get his machine rolling and he could really, really cover the ground. But if he got in traffic...This horse can check--hit it, cruise; hit it, cruise, hit it, cruise, hit." Street Sense will have his first gallop over the Pimlico strip this morning.

Peter Chapple-Hyam selected Newbury's prestigious Haynes, Hanson & Clark S. for Authorized's debut in September, a conditions race which boasts the likes of Shergar (GB), Shahrastani, Rainbow Quest, Unfuwain, King's Theatre (Ire) and Nayef on its honor roll. Despite finishing third there, he was far from disgraced behind the useful Teslin (Ire) and subsequent G3 Lingfield Derby Trial winner Aqaleem (GB). Still, he made giant strides forward next time, breaking his maiden in the G1 Racing Post Trophy back at that track in October. Reported to have thrived during winter quarters, he was enthusiastic under Dettori's restraint yesterday, tracking the moderate pace and full of run against rivals in the stretch as the heat was turned up. His rider was still motionless on the approach to the quarter pole, but when let loose there, he quickened to settle the result without being asked a serious question. "I'm relieved and happy," commented Chapple-Hyam, who will be chasing a second Epsom trophy on the first Saturday in June. "He's very good and he'll improve from this." Topatoo has an affection for the Knavesmire, having clocked up all three previous successes at this venue before this career-best. Formerly a smart handicapper, the chestnut was off the board at her first try in stakes company in the Listed Severals S. at Newmarket in October. Vastly improved when second to Echelon (GB) (Danehill) in the G3 Dahlia S. back at that track May 5, she was left without that rival to contend with here after the late scratching of the Cheveley Park distaffer. Held up in rear early, she was asked to close at the top of the straight and, although it took until the final 50 yards to get to Anna Pavlova, she was in no mood to lose out at her beloved York. "The loose ground blunted her speed, but I was always going to get there," jockey Michael Hills said. "She keeps going and is a good filly." As the lone stakes winner in the field, **Baroness Thatcher** is deserving of her morning-line favoritism, and is the only filly to finish within four lengths of Rags to Riches this year. The Zayat colorbearer, winner of the GIII Santa Ysabel S. in January, was just 3/4 lengths back of the subsequent GI Kentucky Oaks heroine in the Feb. 10 GI Las Virgenes S. She didn't fare as well against that foe next out, however, running fourth in the Mar. 11 GI Santa Anita Oaks, and most recently came out of a fifth-place effort in the Apr. 12 GII Beaumont S. at Keeneland with a cut to her right hind that was severe enough to require stitches. Baroness Thatcher has trained well since and looks like a strong gate-to-wire threat if left alone up front. **Winning Point** won her first three efforts against much softer competition, but, in her first stiff test, acquitted herself admirably by overcoming a troubled start to fill the exacta under Boca Grande in the Apr. 14 GII Comely S. at Aqueduct.

**Fiery Pursuit** took the field wire-to-wire in a sloppy renewal of the GII Louisville Breeders' Cup S. on the Kentucky Oaks undercard May 4, and, with the expected scratch of Sugar Shake, could well have things her own way up front once again. Trained by D. Wayne Lukas, the Overbrook homebred has won three of her last five. Notably, though, the jockey that was aboard for Fiery Pursuit's Louisville win, Calvin Borel, stays faithful to the filly to her outside, **Kettleoneup**. That one ran India to a head in the GIII Azeri BC S. at Oaklawn Mar. 10 with Borel in the irons, then teamed with the Cajun rider once again in her first stakes win, the GIII Sixty Sails H. at Hawthorne Apr. 21. **Amandatude** returns to routing after a closing second-place effort in a minor stakes at Delaware Apr. 28. Sugar Shake is expected to start in Saturday's GII Shuvee H. at Belmont; Grade I winner Swap Fliparoo is also cross-entered in the Shuvee.

### YORKSHIRE CUP-G2 preview cont.

**Sergeant Cecil** returns to the scene of his successes in the G2 Lonsdale Cup and G2 Doncaster Cup in 2006 burdened with a five-pound penalty. While the former performance in August represented a breakthrough at stakes level for the popular gelding, who had pulled off the remarkable treble of Northumberland Plate, Ebor H. and Cesarewitch H. the previous year, he went from strength to strength in the fall. Delivering his potent turn of acceleration to eclipse Shamdala (Ire) in Longchamp's G1 Prix du Cadran on Arc day, he was far from disgraced when third to Montare (Ire) in the G1 Prix Royal-Oak back there later in October. Warming up with a staying-on fourth in Newbury's G3 John Porter S. on his seasonal bow Apr. 21, he bids to go one better than 12 months ago, when **Percussionist** ground him into submission. That win was due reward for Percussionist's second in the 2005 renewal and he reverts to the flat at his favorite venue following a spell over fences during the winter. Another with a penalty is the filly **Allegretto**, by virtue of her success in the G2 Lancashire Oaks in July. She held her own against her elders on her two subsequent outings here when third in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks the following month and to **Rising Cross** in the G2 Park Hill S. in September.

G1 Dubai Sheema Classic runner-up **Oracle West**, who should go favored to give trainer Mike de Kock his first Cup winner from four starters, drew towards the inside for Sunday's \$1.7-million feature, much to the delight of connections. "The draw is fine as he can be as close to the pace as he needs to be," commented assistant trainer Steven Jell. "He did well in Dubai and he was probably at his peak then, so if we can get him there like that on Sunday, we'll be right in it." The striking dark bay was most recently sixth in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup in Hong Kong, a race in which he was never able to get in on the track. One of the likely pacemakers in the race, **Kandidate**, pulled the inside gate, earning a fist pump from Desmond Reape, the five-year-old's head lad. "We've never had a draw so good!" Reape explained. "He normally jumps well, so we're hoping he does the same on Sunday and that he comes out running."

The striking dark bay was most recently sixth in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup in Hong Kong, a race in which he was never able to get in on the track. One of the likely pacemakers in the race, **Kandidate**, pulled the inside gate, earning a fist pump from Desmond Reape, the five-year-old's head lad. "We've never had a draw so good!" Reape explained. "He normally jumps well, so we're hoping he does the same on Sunday and that he comes out running."

## NEW YORK OFFICIALS CONSIDERING OVERHAUL OF RACETRACK INDUSTRY

New York officials are considering a major overhaul of the state's Thoroughbred racetrack industry, with an eye to possibly shutting down Aqueduct racetrack, having a new operator run Belmont and giving the New York Racing Association rights to operate Saratoga. The plan being examined by officials with Gov. Eliot Spitzer comes as the administration continues to review bids from four entities who want to control the franchise now held by NYRA to run the three tracks. Two officials close to the matter, who spoke on condition of anonymity, said the Spitzer administration in the past week or so began eyeing a plan that would end the current bidding process for Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga. Unclear is whether the state, though, would necessarily re-start the entire bidding process for the new idea under consideration. Driving part of the new route under consideration, officials say, was the recent withdrawal by MGM Mirage from a deal in which it was to develop a video lottery terminal casino at Aqueduct; MGM several years ago signed the casino agreement with NYRA. The withdrawal made officials examine whether it makes sense to continue operating the two downstate tracks run by NYRA. Officials said the new idea under consideration involves three main components. First, the state would shut down and sell Aqueduct, which sits on 192 acres in Queens that could be ripe for a variety of real estate development plans. One source theorized that some of the sale of the assets could help to retire some of NYRA many financial obligations. Second, the plan envisions winterizing Belmont, officials said, so racing could be offered at times during the year now handled by Aqueduct. Other features of a re-developed Belmont would include a casino and possibly other entertainment space. Unclear is which, if any, of the entities now in the bidding process would take over Belmont--or even if any of them would be interested in just the one track. Besides NYRA, the bidders include Empire Racing Associates, Excelsior Racing Associates and Capital Play.\

## SIDELINED SANTOS SEEKS RETURN TO RIDING

More than four months after an Aqueduct racing accident left Jose Santos with five fractured vertebrae and a fractured sternum, the Eclipse Award-winning jockey remains on the sidelines--but an innovative new therapy may facilitate his eventual return to the saddle. Santos, 46, fractured his sternum and received compression fractures to the T-5, T-6, T-7, T-8, and T-9 vertebrae in a three-horse spill Feb. 1 of this year. The injury occurred when his mount, the three-year-old filly For a Prayer, went down and suffered a fatal neck injury. The other horses and riders involved in the spill were not severely injured, although jockey Ramon Dominguez was briefly sidelined with bruising to the bone of his right knee. Following treatment at New York's Jamaica and North Shore University Hospitals, Santos was fitted with a removable body cast and was released to the home of a family friend, where he remained before he was cleared to travel to Florida. Although doctors initially considered surgery to be a viable option, Santos declined in the hopes of riding again. Speaking from Miami May 17, Santos said he will begin a post-injury rehab regimen next week with his New York physician in order to build up the muscles around the area that was injured and return his body to the condition it was in before the accident. The rehab process will take approximately six-to-eight weeks. Santos will also undergo regular treatments from a new therapy program called Nuromed, which is a pain-management method that the rider hopes will facilitate his return to the racetrack. "I tried this method today and I wish I'd known about it two months ago," Santos said of the Nuromed machine, which delivers electric impulses to the body in varying degrees during treatment sessions. "I walked into the clinic in pain this morning and walked out pain-free." [Click for complete story.](#)
