He looked the winner on paper, but few would have foreseen how easy it would be for **Manduro (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) to garner his first win at the top level in

yesterday's G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp. Arguably unlucky not to have made the grade earlier in his career, the bay turned in a performance of panache on the Bois de Boulogne without breaking sweat. He was settled in third while tracking a moderate pace, took over at the quarter pole and duly stretched clear to win unchallenged. "He is much better on good ground, like

most by his sire," commented owner Baron Georg von Ullmann. "However, he is one of the few who can handle some cut and it was not a problem today. He quickened really nicely and deserves a Group 1." Campaigned by Peter Schiergen at two, Manduro collected his native country's most prestigious prize, Cologne's G3 Preis der Winterfavoriten, before being sidelined for the majority of his sophomore season. **cont. p2**

PREAKNESS WINNER HEADS HOME

The top three finishers of Saturday's GI Preakness S. headed back to their respective bases Sunday, including winner **Curlin (Smart Strike)**. The Steve Asmussen-trained colt left the Pimlico stakes barn at 6:00 a.m. and was returned to Churchill Downs. "He looked good as he was loaded on the trailer, but he definitely knows he ran," said Asmussen. The conditioner did not commit to the GI Belmont S. June 9 or the GI Travers S., but indicated that those events are possibilities. "Those are the caliber of races he is intended for," said Asmussen. "It will be all up to him physically, but that is the stage he deserves to be on. Our job is to make sure he is prepared for it." **cont. p9**

Coquerelle lacked stakes experience, but made light of that potential drawback with an impressive front-running display. Facing smart rivals in every prior start, she emerged from a debut score over Nuqoosh (GB) at Deauville in August to best eventual listed scorer Cinnamon Bay (GB) the next month at Saint-Cloud. The imposing bay had West Wind (GB) back in second on her return here Apr. 15, and that filly franked the form with a subsequent win at Chantilly. Sent straight to the front by Christophe-Patrice Lemaire here, Coquerelle was set alight with three furlongs remaining, a move which saw Anabaas Creation instantly struggling. It was left to the diminutive Believe Me to strike late, but the damage had been done and Coquerelle was beyond reach. "She has a lot of talent and, with the one draw, we decided not to take any chances and lead, rather than wait at the back off a slow gallop," trainer Jean-Claude Rouget said. "It worked out very nicely--she is a very handy filly who you can do anything you want with. She now has a date at Chantilly on June 10 for the G1 Prix de Diane." Switched to Andre Fabre's stable last season, **Manduro** got off to a bright start, winning the G2 Prix d'Harcourt here in April before a string of frustrating placings that included seconds in this event and in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville in August, and thirds in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot in June and G1 Prix du Moulin here in September. Sent to Newmarket for his 2007 bow, he registered a four-length success in the Apr. 19 G3 Earl of Sefton S., and handled Group 1 company with equal ease yesterday. As for what's next, Baron von Ullmann stated, "We will look at the [June 19] G1 Queen Anne S. and [June 20] G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot and decide later which one he will go for."

Italy's main event went to the home team again as Awelmarduk provided Alduino and Giuseppe Botti with the Classic their domestic dominance demanded. Off the mark at the San Siro in November, the bay followed up with a victory in his sophomore bow at that track Apr. 21 before running third in the Listed Premio Emanuele Filiberto there May 1. It was a case of anchor down early here, as Edmondo Botti kept Awelmarduk at the back of the pack off the searching gallop set by the English raider Zar Solitario (Singspiel {Ire}). Taken wide for his challenge at the top of the straight, he rolled by rivals to lead with 100 yards remaining before containing the threat of Shrek in the run to the line.

Lord du Sud capped a run of four straight stakes scores which a victory in the Listed Prix Right Royal at Saint-Cloud last April. Bettering a second in the G3 Prix de Barbeville over course and distance later that month, he confirmed his position as one of France's leading stayers with a win in the G2 Prix Kergorlay at Deauville in August before closing last term with a fourth in the G1 Prix Royal-Oak, again over course and distance, in October. The grey was fourth when trying to defend his title the Listed Grand Prix du Conseil General des Alpes Maritimes on his seasonal return at Cagnes-sur-Mer last time Feb. 22, but wired the field here and required minimal encouragement inside the closing panel to record a comfortable success. "With this horse, the key is the ground, and when he has these conditions he is tough to beat," trainer Jean-Claude Rouget commented. "After a moderate race last time, I wondered whether he was going to come back to his best, but I should not have worried. Street Sense (Street Cry {Ire}), runner-up to Curlin in Saturday's GI Preakness S., was flown back to trainer Carl Nafzger's Churchill Downs base early Sunday morning. "He's good and he's already home," said

Nafzger, who, accompanied by his wife Wanda, began his long trip back to Kentucky Sunday morning. Nafzger pointed out that although a start in the June 9 GI Belmont S. has not been ruled out, it is unlikely that Jim Tafel's homebred colt will start in the 1 1/2-mile Classic. "There won't

be a decision on the Belmont until Mr. Tafel and I have a meeting," explained Nafzger. "That will probably take place in two or three days, or maybe a week. Right now, I don't think we probably will. There's not really any good reason to go there right now. These horses ran their guts out the last two races." Conversely, third-place finisher **Hard Spun** (Danzig) is likely for the Belmont after coming out of Saturday's Classic in good order. "Everything looks good," said trainer Larry Jones, who shipped the colt back to his Delaware base Sunday. "He ate well, his legs are cold. He's tired, but he came out of the race OK." Jones indicated that a start in the Belmont depends on how the colt exits Saturday's exertions, and a decision will probably be made in the upcoming week. **C P West** (Came Home), fourth in the Preakness, is expected to miss the Belmont in favor of the GI Travers S. at Saratoga Aug. 25, while **Flying First Class** (Perfect Mandate) will return to the sprinting ranks and may point toward the GI King's Bishop S. on the Travers undercard.
