COCK OF THE WALK

Cockney Rebel (Ire) (Val Royal {Fr}) may have come from left field when winning Newmarket's G1 2000 Guineas, but Phil Cunningham's colt made certain he is

firmly established in the elite after completing a double in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas yesterday at The Curragh. He was brilliant when rushing from almost last to first in the May 5 Newmarket Classic, and, while the 6-4 pick was less dazzling this time, he answered every call from Olivier Peslier throughout the final quarter to best **Creachadoir (Ire)** (King's Best) by a length. "He's just

a good horse, a proper horse and that's it," trainer Geoff Huffer said. "He's shown that emphatically, and he could win at six furlongs, a mile and a mile and a quarter." Cockney Rebel is the first colt to complete the Newmarket/Curragh double since Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) did so in 2002. **Irish 2000 Guineas cont. p2**

A SWING AROUND?

While **Arch Swing** (Arch) has 2 1/2 lengths to find with **Finsceal Beo (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley) on their Newmarket encounter, she has the potential to turn that around in today's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh. Like Kooyonga (Ire), Marling (Ire) and Matiya (Ire) before her, Pat Garvey's charge will bid to go one better than her finish in the May 6 G1 1000 Guineas, where she met with defeat for the first time. "She has been fine at home; she came out of the Newmarket race very well," trainer John Oxx told *PA Sport*. "There have been no problems since, we have been happy with her work and she looks well. We've got a bit to find [with Finsceal Beo]. She won very well at Newmarket and, if she is back to that form and fully recovered from her trip to France, obviously she'll be hard to beat. If Cockney Rebel was under the radar at two, it was due to his trainer's keenness not to overface the bay, but he showed marked ability when runner-up in the St Leger Yearling S. at York in August and third behind **Vital Equine (Ire)** (Danetime {Ire}) back there the following month in the G2 Champagne S. His spring work with established sprint handicapper Banjo Patterson (GB) had his connections jumping and he showed the same exciting acceleration in what appears at this stage to have been a strong renewal of the Newmarket feature. Racing more freely here closer to the pace, he eventually settled into a rhythm and was full of run as he loomed upsides his old foe Vital Equine with a quarter mile remaining. In front soon after, he forged a safe margin and maintained his advantage despite drifting left to hold Creachadoir and Kevin Manning in the run to the line. "He had to travel over here and this was a totally different race to Newmarket," Huffer added. "He hit the front too soon, but he'll dig and fight for you. The plan is the G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 19], and then we'll give him a rest before the G1 Juddmonte International S. [at York Aug. 21] and G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Ascot Sept. 29], then maybe the Breeders' Cup." As for the runner-up, trainer Jim Bolger was not too despondent after watching Creachadoir finish second in another Classic. The bay just missed in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp 13 days earlier, and the colt may find himself heading back to France eventually. "He has run a good race," Bolger said. "We will take a pull with him now and give him a break. He won't go to Royal Ascot, and we might save him for the G1 Prix du Moulin [at Longchamp Sept. 9]."

Kayah to Join Oaks Mix...

Julian Richmond-Watson's **Kayah (GB)** (Kahyasi {Ire}) has been supplemented for Friday's G1 Epsom Oaks, for which 15 were declared yesterday. Trainer Ralph Beckett, who paid the £20,000 fee to add the Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial winner to the mile-and-a-half Classic, told *PA Sport*, "Kayah's work has been very satisfactory since her Lingfield win and we are going to supplement her for the Oaks. Everything has gone well and we are hopeful of a good run." Khalid Abdullah's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud and G3 Musidora S. heroine **Passage of Time (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) is the likely favorite for the contest, which also saw His Highness the Aga Khan's G3 Blue Wind S. winner **Four Sins (Ger)** (Sinndar {Ire}) confirmed by trainer John Oxx. Only four fillies were withdrawn at yesterday's five-day stage, with other notable confirmations including St Albans Bloodstock's Listed Pretty Polly S. winner **Dalvina (GB)** (Grand Lodge), Godolphin's Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' S. scorer **Measured Tempo (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) and Derrick Smith, Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's **Simply Perfect (GB)** (Danehill). Epsom's Clerk of the Course Andrew Cooper described the going as currently good, with a wet forecast. "We are expecting rain to-night or tomorrow, with more to come on Monday and Tuesday, so we will see what happens," he said. "The weather is forecast to improve after that."

Set for a Treat...**

British-trained challengers have made four successful raids across the Irish Sea since 1999, and Highclere's **Treat (GB)** (Barathea {Ire}) is the sole flyer of the Union Jack this time. Runner-up in Ascot's G1 Fillies' Mile in September, she handled herself with credit when fourth in the Newmarket Classic last time, and connections believe that she can be a major factor here. "We are very excited about Treat; I think she ran one hell of a race in the 1000 Guineas without a prep run," the syndicate's Harry Herbert told *PA Sport*. "She's a tough, gritty filly that doesn't give up. The ground at Newmarket that day was quick and that wouldn't have been in her favour. If we get the rain that they are forecasting at the Curragh, then I think it will improve the filly quite significantly."

Don't Count Them Out...

Aidan O'Brien has won this three times with Classic Park (GB) in 1997, Imagine (Ire) in 2001 and Yesterday (Ire) two years later. He saddles Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's maiden **Diamond Necklace** (Unbridled's Song), ninth in the G3 Blue Wind S. at Naas 11 days ago; and **Peeping Fawn** (Danehill), who got off the mark at that track the same evening. Kevin Prendergast has won this contest with Pidget (GB) in 1972 and Arctique Royale (Ire) in 1981, and it is up to Lady O'Reilly's **Dimenticata (Ire)** (Danetime {Ire}) to carry the famed black-and-white colors here. She has looked exposed and needs to show major improvement on her latest second in the May 6 Listed Victor McCalmont Memorial S. at Gowran Park.

In addition to winning this race last year, Honey Ryder captured the GI Flower Bowl Invitational and the GIII Orchid H. before concluding her season with a third in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf Nov. 4. She returned to run second by a neck to the boys in the GI Gulfstream BC Turf S. Feb. 24, but didn't fare as well at Nad al Sheba, finishing 11th in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic Mar. 31. Shedding blinkers for her return, the old grey mare was content to race near the back of the pack during the early stages before being taken to the outside by Garrett Gomez on the far turn. She still had a ways to go turning for home, but reeled in barnmate Safari Queen for a popular victory. Winning trainer Todd Pletcher dismissed any post-Dubai concerns. "I've always thought the shipping back from Dubai thing has always been overrated," he said. "The horses that we've brought back have always come back in good form."

Dismissed at 81-1 after a disappointing year to date, Spotsgone relished the Arlington Polytrack and wired his ballyhooed rivals for his first graded victory. Takeover Target, who cost trainer Joe Janiak a mere A\$1,350, is now a five-time Group 1 winner after taking down the colors of star filly Gold Edition in scintillating fashion. The three-year-old, in receipt of 10 pounds from her older rival, assumed control early as Takeover Target was content to track her to the home turn. He drew on even terms at the 200-meter marker and asserted late for the victory, which Janiak labelled the best of his 26-race career. "I'm so excited I can't explain how I feel," the former taxicab driver told *Australian Associated Press*. "This is as good as it comes and it's a great rush." The winner departs Wednesday for England's Royal Ascot meeting, where he will try to defend his title in the G2 King's Stand S. and improve on his third in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. "I think he's in better condition now than when I took him to England last year," Janiak told *AAP*. "Provided he travels well, he's right on target to win both races this time." [RP chart.](#)

He was a half-length down on Rail Link (GB) when second in the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp early the following month before making the most of a quick return to the races when capturing Cologne's G1 Preis von Europa two weeks later. Third behind Vengeance of Rain (NZ) in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba, he has to demonstrate his versatility over this shorter trip. "Dylan Thomas looks the one to beat, but on his day Youmzain is certainly capable of winning a race like this," Jaber Abdullah's Racing Manager Bruce Raymond said. "His preparations have gone fine, although he is not an exuberant worker at home." **Danak** impressed when finishing strongly to win the G3 Amethyst S. over a mile at Leopardstown last time May 13, prompting connections to take the plunge. "We don't know how good he is, but he made significant improvement from his first to second run and based on his work since the Amethyst, we feel he has improved again," His Highness the Aga Khan's Racing Manager Pat Downes commented. "He deserves to take on Group 1 horses at this stage."

Hopefully, he'll get a chance as a stallion somewhere."

NEW YORK JOCKEY CRITICAL BUT STABLE

Jockey Andrew Lakeman, injured in a spill in the fourth race at Belmont Park Friday afternoon, was in critical but stable condition at North Shore University Hospital on Long Island Saturday. The 32-year-old injured his spinal cord in the incident, but his condition showed some improvement when Charles Hayward, the president and CEO of the New York Racing Association, visited yesterday. "When Andrew was admitted...he was extremely unstable and had precipitously low blood pressure," Hayward said. "He did not suffer any head trauma, but he did have severe spine trauma, the implications of which they're not making any prognosis or projections." He added, "We did see him briefly. He's still critical, but he is stable and certainly much improved from his situation when he was admitted. I talked to two nurses and two doctors and I have never seen such good physicians. North Shore has a very good reputation, but I was thrilled to see the level of care." The spill occurred when Lakeman's mount, Our Montana Dream, clipped heels with Irish Senorita on the far turn. Norberto Arroyo Jr. and his mount, Lady Alice, fell over Our Montana Dream. Arroyo fractured his collarbone and was in stable condition at North Shore University Hospital yesterday. Neither horse was seriously injured. Lakeman, a native of England, was winless in 51 starts over the last two years. He was six-for-57 in 2005, taking the Huntington S. at Aqueduct with the Allen Jerkens-trained Saint Daimon.
