LEGEND OF THE SPRING

Finsceal Beo (Ire) (Mr. Greeley) wins hands down in the naming game. The "living legend" produced another chapter for the fable with a hard-fought success in yesterday's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh to go with her English epic. Michael Ryan's colorbearer had done enough to ensure a place in the history books in creating a new all-Guineas record at Newmarket May 6 before connections attempted a daring Classic double in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches a week later. While the chestnut was narrowly denied that achievement, the Curragh faithful stayed true and hammered her down to 9-10 here, but had to sweat before she earned a

neck success from the outsider **Dimenticata (Ire)** (Danetime {Ire}). "It was a great performance," trainer Jim Bolger said. "She's not quite as good on that softer ground, and so she's had to be at her best to win today." Finsceal Beo becomes just the second filly to complete the English/Irish Guineas double after Attraction (GB) in 2004. **Cont. p2**

HEAT OF BATTLE

Belmont's traditional Memorial Day feature, the \$600,000 G1 Metropolitan H., has drawn a very competitive 10-horse field. Trainer Bobby Frankel, looking for his fourth Met Mile crown, will saddle **Latent Heat** (Maria's Mon), a 6-1 shot perfect in two starts around this oval. The Juddmonte homebred, who concluded 2006 with a victory in the G1 Malibu S., kicked off this season by winning the GII San Carlos H. Feb. 17. After getting caught up in a speed duel last out in the GI Carter H. Apr. 7 at Aqueduct, he wound up fourth to **Silver Wagon** (Wagon Limit), and will need to avoid a similar scenario this time. **Cont. p6-7**

Finsceal Beo was named Europe's champion two-year-old filly after winning the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp on Arc day and Newmarket's G2 Rockfel S. under a subsequent penalty 13 days later. Despite the high level of those feats, they were merely a precursor to a sensational performance in the G1 1000 Guineas, where she became the first to dip under 1:35 in either of the mile Classics. Jim Bolger surprised many when shipping the chestnut to Longchamp for the French equivalent just seven days after such a major effort, but she justified that boldness with a game display to finish a head second to Darjina (Fr). Settled behind the early leaders by Kevin Manning here, she was pulled wide for her challenge and rolled to the front approaching the eighth pole. Strongly pressed late on by Dimenticata and Chris Hayes, Finsceal Beo drew on her reserves to hold on to the prize. Her next challenge is not yet certain. "She's in the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 22], but I'm not sure if we will go there, and she may step up to 10 furlongs for the G1 Pretty Polly S. [June 30 at The Curragh]," Bolger said. He called on the Pattern Committee to look into re-scheduling the principal filly mile races. "It shouldn't be beyond the capabilities of those concerned to create a two-week break between the English and French 1000 Guineas," Bolger said, reflecting on her narrow failure to record a historic treble. Trainer Kevin Prendergast said of the runner-up, "They didn't go quick enough, and she would have won with a quicker pace." Aidan O'Brien, who conditions third-place finisher **Peeping Fawn** (Danehill), has not ruled out a tilt at Friday's G1 Epsom Oaks. "The Oaks might come a bit too quick, but she does like a dig in the ground," he said.

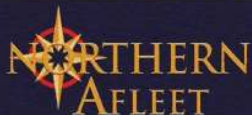

Notnowcato scaled the heights quickly last spring and summer, following a brace of successes in the G3 Earl of Sefton S. at Newmarket in April and Sandown's G3 Brigadier Gerard S. the following month with a fifth in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot in June. Second to David Junior in the G1 Eclipse S. back at Sandown in July, he battled to a short-head success over Maraahel (Ire) in York's G1 Juddmonte International S. the next month before disappointing when last of eight in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket in October. He returned to finish fourth under a penalty in the G3 Gordon Richards S. at Sandown last time Apr. 27, and built on that comeback to upset the red-hot favorite Dylan Thomas here. Settled in second off the steady early gallop, he was committed before the quarter pole, where he was joined by the Ballydoyle giant. After a prolonged duel, it was Notnowcato who had the edge where it mattered. Evelyn de Rothschild, representing his two owner sons, said, "He enjoys a real battle and that was as good as it gets. He did beat Dylan Thomas [in the International] at York last year, and he's run a wonderful race today. He's in the G1 Prince of Wales's [at Royal Ascot June 20], in which he ran a hell of a race last year, and the G1 Eclipse S. [at Sandown July 7]." As for the beaten favorite, trainer Aidan O'Brien offered no excuses. Hero of this race in 2005, Ecclesiastic won just once in five 2006 outings and had yet to have his picture taken this year, his best effort being a third to Lawyer Ron in a main-track mile at Gulfstream Feb. 11. The Joe Allen homebred came into this contest off a seventh in the GIII Fort Marcy H. over the Aqueduct lawn Apr. 29 and wasn't given much love at the windows here. Urged along by Javier Castellano to race in fifth as favored Weigelia smoked through a half in :44.27, the six-year-old rallied three wide, set his sights on the chalk and drove clear late for his second Jaipur success. "Now that he's older, it doesn't seem that he wants to go long any more," said winning trainer Allen Jerkens. "He might go a mile, but he's got a lot of natural speed. I thought if he could stay in striking distance today, he would have a chance. I think his game is going short on the grass. We'll see what races are out there for him."

Eccentric, third in last year's G3 Maktoum Challenge - Round I at Nad al Sheba, rallied to take Keeneland's GIII Fayette S. on Polytrack Oct. 28 in his second North American outing and closed out 2006 with a third over Woodbine's all-weather surface in the GIII Woodbine Slots Cup Nov. 18.

The chestnut resumed his career Apr. 26 at Keeneland in the GIII Ben Ali S., but faded to ninth after vying for the lead and went back to grass this time. Allowed to settle into stride in sixth, the six-year-old switched out for running room four wide, collared pacesetter As Expected in the final sixteenth and surged clear late. A mid-afternoon downpour didn't concern trainer Roger Attfield, who was confident in Eccentric's ability on all surfaces. "This is a very versatile horse," said Attfield. 

The 114th renewal of this historic contest brings together an intriguing group of runners, but the presence of several top-class speed horses suggests that a stretch-runner will get the glory. To ensure that scenario, trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. brings in rabbit **Mr. Umphrey** to play up the chances of **Silver Wagon**. The Florida-bred grey, hero of the GI Hopeful S. at two in 2003, has hit his best stride this year at age six, rallying for victories in the GII General George H. Feb. 19 at Laurel and the GI Carter H. Apr. 7 at Aqueduct, both at seven furlongs. Trainer Todd Pletcher will saddle a pair of four-year-olds, the \$1.8-million earner **Lawyer Ron** and the once-beaten **Half Ours**. This is one of those races we haven't been able to win," Pletcher said. "We'll take another crack at it and hope to get lucky." Lawyer Ron, a somewhat headstrong winner of three graded stakes last year, has proven more amenable to rating in 2007. The handsome chestnut started off with a win at a one-turn mile at Gulfstream Feb. 11, then drew off to take the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 7 last out. He will need to have learned his lessons well in breaking from the rail here, and Pletcher was particularly impressed with his seasonal opener. "Obviously, this is a tougher group of horses, but the way he ran that day, it looks like he can do just about anything," Pletcher explained. "There should be plenty of pace that he can sit off." Five-year-old **Sun King** has banked over \$2 million despite coming up the tiniest bit short in the big races. Second by a head in last year's Met Mile, the dark bay ran Invasor (Arg) to a nose in the 2006 GI Whitney H. and most recently crossed the line third in the GIII Westchester H. May 2 over track and trip. He was put up to second via the disqualification of **Political Force**. The wild card in the race is **Silent Name**, an accomplished grass runner who put up a tour-de-force over Keeneland's Polytrack in the GI Commonwealth BC S. Apr. 14. He tries conventional dirt for the first time here.

He can get pretty aggressive, but he settles well for me." **Chinese Dragon**, beaten only a head when third in the 2006 edition of the Kilroe Mile, disappeared after finishing second to Silent Name (Jpn) in the GII Arcadia H. that spring. He returned after a 385-day layoff to take the Apr. 28 GII San Francisco Mile by a nose over **Vega's Lord**.

A victim of the stewards' booth in the 2006 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, Price Tag was demoted from first to third, and came back three starts later to take the Sept. 7 G3 Prix du Pin. She was eased in her French finale, the Sept. 30 G1 Prix de la Foret, but the Juddmonte homebred has been unbeatable since shipping to California. He got her behind horses, and she didn't like it." After her QE II score, Vacare was sold to Jon and Sarah Kelly for \$2.8 million at Fasig-Tipton November and given the winter off. She made her first start under new management in the Apr. 1 Magna Distaff S. at Gulfstream, winning by a length as the odds-on choice, and looks to run her record to a perfect six-for-six here. Three Degrees has been knocking on the door, but is winless since taking the 2005 GII Honeymoon BC H. over this track and trip.

The chestnut, who covered five furlongs in 1:00.64, is being considered for a start in either the GI Belmont S. June 9 or GI Mother Goose S. June 30. **Octave** (Unbridled's Song), runner-up to Rags to Riches in the Oaks, breezed a half mile in :48.22. The gray is being pointed toward the GI Acorn S. on the Belmont S. undercard. Posting a bullet for five panels, **Cowtown Cat** (Distorted Humor) completed the task in :59.47, the co-fastest of 28 moves at the distance Sunday. **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor), who exited the May 5 GI Kentucky Derby with a foot bruise, was back in action with a half-mile work in :49.88. "That foot bruise absolved itself in about four days," said Pletcher. "It was a nice easy breeze. We haven't really decided where we're going with him." Pletcher indicated that the July 4 GII Dwyer S. at Belmont is a possibility. Looking toward a change in strategy, Pletcher will cut **Deadly Dealer** (Concerto) back to the sprinting ranks for the colt's next start. A well-beaten third behind Curlin in the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 14, the bay will be aimed at the GII Woody Stephens June 9. "He's got sprint form and he's doing well," said Pletcher, explaining the switch. According to Pletcher, a decision has not been made whether **Circular Quay** (Thunder Gulch), fifth in the GI Preakness S. May 19, will contest Belmont's 1 1/2-mile Classic.

"I spoke to [trainer] Geoff [Huffer] this morning and the horse is on his way back," Cunningham told *PA Sport*. "He's fine and eaten up well, so it's all systems go to Ascot [for the June 19 G1 St James's Palace S.], he'll have an easy week now. The plan was always to be up with the pace yesterday, and to be honest, it was only unfortunate circumstances that meant he was so far behind at Newmarket. Watching it again, I think he won a little bit more comfortably than the winning distance. Geoff said he would do one more thing for me, and that is to give me a Royal Ascot winner. That would be absolutely amazing."

He was transferred to Cassidy late in his four-year-old season and blossomed in the California sun, finishing second to The Tin Man in the GII San Marcos H. before taking the GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile H. last March. Third in both the GII Arcadia H. and last year's Woodford Reserve Turf Classic, he ran sixth in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile last Memorial Day, but emerged with a fracture and went to the sidelines. Milk It Mick retires with a record of 28-6-4-6 and earnings of \$671,602.

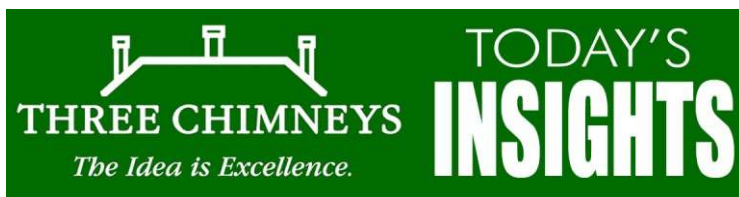
