second. After a strong week of training, Jimmy Jerkens was confident going into the Met Mile. "I thought if he didn't run good today, he just wasn't good enough," Jerkens said. **Cont. p2**

**HE'S ALL HEART**

Most of his contemporaries don't even remember the racetrack, but don't tell **The Tin Man** (Affirmed) he's over the hill. The nine-year-old gelding returned from an eight-month layoff to win his third straight Grade I event in yesterday's GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile at Hollywood Park. The veteran rated a stalking third before reeling in the pacesetters down the stretch and finished with determination to best **Get Funky** (Straight Man) by 3/4 lengths. "Age doesn't seem to matter to him," said winning rider Victor Espinoza. "He runs like a young horse. He's unbelievable." During an abbreviated 2006 campaign, The Tin Man was second in the Mar. 25 G1 Dubai Duty Free H. After wins in the July 2 GII American Invitational H. and Aug. 12 GI Arlington Million, he capped his stellar season with a front-running victory in the Sept. 30 GI Clement L Hirsch. "We might try the Arlington Million again, but we're also thinking of trying him on synthetic surface because he has trained very well on it, every work has been good," said winning trainer Richard Mandella. **Corinthian Wins Met Mile** (cont. from p1)

Centennial Farm's Corinthian burst onto the Kentucky Derby trail last year when finishing first in the GII Fountain of Youth S. (before being disqualified and placed third), but Triple Crown dreams were dashed by a minor fracture to his left hind ankle, and he was sidelined for much of 2006. The handsome chestnut's resurgent 2007 began with a 9 1/2-length victory over last year's GI Belmont S. winner Jazil in a Feb. 8 Gulfstream allowance. He won the Mar. 3 GII Gulfstream Park H., but was fifth after a troubled start in the Apr. 7 GIII Excelsior Breeders' Cup H. at Aqueduct. He showed he was ready to roll with a bullet five-furlong move

in :58 last Monday. "The work a week ago was beyond anything I ever saw," Jerkens said. "He was just strong all the way. He was terrific all week." Corinthian broke cleanly yesterday and was ridden up to shadow the early leaders through moderate fractions. Asked for run in upper stretch, the colt forged to the lead and gamely held off Lawyer Ron (Langfuhr) and Political Force (Unbridled's Song). "When I saw him break and laying that close, I knew we were in business," Jerkens said. "He ran to his workout the other day." Winning rider Kent Desormeaux enjoyed a perfect trip. "You couldn't have planted me at the half-mile pole and asked for a better position," Desormeaux said. "More than the position was the way he was carrying me. When a good horse is traveling well, :45 feels like :48. I didn't have to ask him for much, even when it was time to go. In the stretch, I thought he was just doing enough, quite frankly. All I could hope for at that stage of the race was that nothing came swinging wide and he couldn't see it. He was really determined."

The favorite was quickly to the front end and set fractions of :23.95, :47.97, 1:11.16 and 1:34.23. She kicked clear in upper stretch, opening up by 1 1/2 lengths before holding off stablemate Price Tag. "She just kept giving me another gear every time," said winning rider David Flores. "In the middle of the turn, she really picked it up. I hit her a couple of times and I didn't want to let up because I could see Price Tag coming." The race was marred when Three Degrees (Ire) (Singspiel {Ire}) broke down at the wire and had to be euthanized. The gray gelding sat off the pace in fifth. Asked for run at the quarter pole, Dry Martini surged to the lead with a furlong to run and held off Rehoboth for the first stakes win of his career. Miss Macy Sue, fifth in the GIII Safely Kept Breeders' Cup last October in her only previous try in graded stakes company, was unbeaten in two starts this term, taking the Mar. 31 Carousel S. at Oaklawn and the Apr. 28 Prairie Rose S. at Prairie Meadows. A slight second choice in the eight-horse field, the dark bay filly settled off the pace after bobbling at the break. She moved to the lead in upper stretch and pulled clear to the wire. "Going in, we felt we would be very competitive with a good shot to win," said winning trainer Kelly Von Hemel. "When we got the post position we wanted, I envisioned how it would go and the race unfolded pretty much the way we thought it would. You always worry until the end, but turning for home, it looked like we had a good shot and by the sixteenth pole there was nobody else coming at us. By then, we knew we had it." "Him being comfortable, relaxed and traveling the way that he is is what we're concerning ourselves with right now, and I can't tell you how fortunate we feel. For everything that he's done over a short period of time and for him to be carrying the weight that he is, and acting the way that he is, is the testament to his quality." **Hard Spun** (Danzig), second in the Derby and third in the Preakness, will contest the Belmont as well, while a decision on Street Sense's participation will be made by Wednesday, according to trainer Carl Nafzger.

**R&R For Dominican...**

GI Toyota Blue Grass S. winner **Dominican** (El Corredor) has been turned out for some rest and relaxation. "He's on the farm, getting some sunshine," trainer Darrin Miller said. "Right now, the plan is to get him in July and get rolling again. The Derby was a little tough on him." Dominican was 11th in the Derby.

**Sedgefield Under Belmont Consideration...**

Silverton Hill Farm's **Sedgefield** (Smart Strike), fifth in the Kentucky Derby in his first start on dirt, breezed a half-mile in :48.20 under jockey Julien Leparoux at Churchill yesterday morning. His connections, who had previously wanted to run in the June 2 GI Ohio Derby as his next outing, are now considering a tilt at the Belmont. "I guess you've got to figure out who's going to go," said trainer Darrin Miller. "We're looking at the Ohio Derby, and we need to be the most productive we can be with him right now. So we'll see how he comes out of this work." Sedgefield is a full brother to MGISW English Channel.

**Excuse for Missed 'Swing'?**

Trainer John Oxx yesterday offered a valid reason for the flop of Pat Garvey's **Arch Swing** (Arch) in Sunday's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas. Sent off the 10-3 second favorite for the Curragh Classic, the G1 1000 Guineas runner-up was eased in the closing stages and trailed in last. "She's a bit stiff and sore behind," Oxx told *PA Sport*. "She seemed to hurt herself, probably jumping out of the stalls. She jumped out very awkwardly and twisted herself. She wasn't moving well at any stage. It wasn't like her at all. She's not lame or anything like that, so hopefully it's something that can be put right. We are leaving her in the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 19] and we will see if we can get her ready for that."

**Authorized Heads 19 for Derby...**

Saleh Al Homaizi & Imad Al Sagar's **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) will face a maximum of 18 rivals when he heads to post for Saturday's G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom. Last year's G1 Racing Post Trophy winner, who returned to collect York's G2 Dante S. by four lengths May 17, will be bidding to provide Frankie Dettori with a first Epsom Derby on his 15th attempt. "To win the Derby would fulfil all my dreams," he said. "I am 36 now, and the years are running away from me. I have 10 more years definitely to achieve my aim." The Peter Chapple-Hyam-trained colt who looks likely to start odds-on for the £1.25-million Classic, could be the shortest-priced favorite since Entrepreneur (GB) was hammered into 4-6 10 years ago. He is also certain to meet an army of Ballydoyle contenders. *Cont. p8*

The Ballydoyle contingent includes the G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial winner **Archipenko** (Kingmambo), G3 Chester Vase hero **Soldier of Fortune (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), G3 Dee S. victor **Admiralofthefleet** (Danehill), G2 Prix Hocquart winner **Anton Chekhov (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and G1 2000 Guineas fifth **Eagle Mountain (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}). After scratching the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club hopeful **Chinese Whisper (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) yesterday, O'Brien is not ruling anything else out at this stage. "We'll definitely run more than one at Epsom, but a lot of it will depend on the way the ground is going to go," he said. "Of the other eight, Eagle Mountain is definitely in the picture. While he handles fast ground, he also handles an ease." Marcus Tregoning is hoping that G3 Lingfield Derby Trial winner **Aqaleem (GB)** (Sinndar {Ire}) will be able to handle the rain-softened conditions. "Aqaleem is out of a Sadler's Wells mare and he has got form on soft ground anyway, so softish ground will not bother him," he commented. "He ran a very solid race when winning at Lingfield and won very easily. He seems in very good form, and we are hopeful of a huge run from him. The one thing about Aqaleem and Authorized is that it looks like both are going to stay very well. The Derby, on softish ground, is going to be about horses who have class and stamina." Godolphin provided the only other withdrawals yesterday, ruling out **Mythical Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid) and **Jalil** (Storm Cat), but left in Friday's Listed Cockeyed Hat S. runner-up **Eastern Anthem (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}), while David Elsworth has confirmed A J Thompson's Listed Newmarket S. scorer **Salford Mill (Ire)** (Peintre Celebre). John Gosden has left in George Strawbridge's **Lucarno** (Dynaformer), who was impressive when winning Saturday's Listed Fairway S. at Newmarket. Despite speculation earlier in the week, Gosden did not supplement Khalid Abdullah's Dante runner-up **Raincoat (GB)** (Barathea {Ire}), who will head to Sunday's Chantilly Classic instead. Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*, "He could now go to the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club; in fact, he is likely to go for that." Epsom's Clerk of the Course and Director of Racing Andrew Cooper was yesterday counting the cost of heavy rainfall at the Surrey venue and ruled out the possibility of firm being in the description for the two-day meeting, which gets underway on Friday. "We have had plenty of rain, with 20 millimetres coming last night," he said yesterday. "But we are hopeful that we have seen the worst of the rain. The forecast is for unsettled weather for the rest of the week, though with showers rather than a lot of rain. It looks like it is going to be on the slow side for the start of the Vodafone Derby Meeting on Friday, but the course dries well given the appropriate conditions." Managing Director Stephen Wallis was looking forward to the main event yesterday. "This year's Vodafone Derby is generating plenty of Frankie fever and that is going to be overwhelming by Saturday," he commented.

It is always great to see Classic form endorsed, and last weekend saw both winners of Newmarket's Guineas races go on to further success in the equivalents at the Curragh. This was the first time this has happened, as Val Royal's son Cockney Rebel is only the sixth to complete the colts' double, and the first since Rock of Gibraltar in 2002, while Mr. Greeley's magnificent daughter Finsceal Beo is only the second to complete the fillies' double, following Attraction in 2004.

Selfishly, I rather hoped that one or other of them would fail in the double attempt, simply to give me something new to write about the Classic generation. Fortunately, plenty has recently happened in Europe's older horse division at around 1 1/4 miles, with France staging the G1 Prix d'Ispahan and Ireland the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup. Manduro turned in what was probably a career-best performance to take the d'Ispahan by five lengths, chased home by the last two winners of the G1 Prix Jean Prat. Then, a week later, Notnowcato staked a rival claim to being the leader of the older 10-furlong division by withstanding the challenge of the odds-on Dylan Thomas.

This was the second time that Notnowcato has defeated the triple Group 1 winner Dylan Thomas at the top level, as they finished first and fourth in last year's Juddmonte International at York. Notnowcato had only a short head to spare when successful at York and a head at the Curragh, but no one should have been too surprised that he came out on top, as he is a son of the ultra-determined Inchinor.

At 15.1 1/2 hands, Inchinor qualified for the PC description of vertically challenged, but he more than compensated for his lack of inches by possessing a steely will to win. His competitive nature earned him a neck win in the G3 Greenham S., a half-length triumph in the G3 Criterion S. and a short-head victory in the G3 Hungerford S., to establish that seven furlongs was his ideal distance. Inchinor also came out on top in a three-way photo for second place behind Zafonic in the G1 Dewhurst S.

Inchinor started his stallion career at £3,000 at Woodland Stud at Newmarket in 1994. Although this was a comparatively modest sum, he almost certainly benefited from being seen as an attractive substitute for Indian Ridge, another Ahonoora stallion. Indian Ridge had recently decamped to Ireland following an eye-catching start with his first runners in 1993.

That assessment proved pretty accurate, as Inchinor also succeeded in working his way up the ladder, with his fee reaching five figures by 2002. Unfortunately, he suffered a fatal paddock accident at the age of 13 in 2003, in much the same way that his remarkable sire had done at the age of 14 in 1979. In both instances it was fair to say that their premature deaths represented a blow to the European industry. Inchinor's demise has been followed by group/graded success for no fewer than 13 of his progeny--Notnowcato, Latice (G1 Prix de Diane), Cape of Good Hope (G1 Golden Jubilee S.), Silca's Sister (G1 Prix Morny), On the Acorn, Satchem, Felicity, Secret Melody, Orientor, In Clover, Royal Copenhagen, Sesmen and Yasoodd. This represents a remarkable total for a horse who averaged 48 named foals per crop. With several other group winners in his earlier crops, including the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. winner Summoner, Inchinor achieved not far short of 4 per cent group winners to foals, which underlines how big a loss he was.

In the circumstances, Notnowcato should have plenty of appeal to admirers of the Ahonoora male line, whose future hitherto has rested heavily on the sons of Indian Ridge. The one hurdle he will have to overcome is the fact that--together with many horses trained by Sir Michael Stoute--Notnowcato has been improving with age. After being placed in both his juvenile starts, he developed into an excellent handicapper at three before finally making the transition to stakes company at four.

As all three of his group victories have come over nine or 10 furlongs, Notnowcato stays well for a horse whose grandsires are the top sprinters Ahonoora and Cadeaux Genereux. The explanation is that his dam Rambling Rose was a far from typical daughter of

Cadeaux Genereux. She won the Galtres S. over 1 1/2 miles and was also group-placed over 1 11/16 miles.

The next dam, the Blushing Groom mare Blush Rambler, was also a mile-and-a-half winner, while Notnowcato's third dam, the Nijinsky filly Nikitina, scored over 1 1/4 miles. His fourth dam, the G1 Criterium des Pouliches winner Vela, was a stoutly bred daughter of the Ascot Gold Cup hero Sheshoon, and there is clearly a fair amount of stamina ingrained in this family, despite injections of speed from Inchinor, Cadeaux Genereux and Blushing Groom. It could also be relevant that Notnowcato is inbred 5x4 to Nijinsky, a prolific source of stamina, through two of his daughters, the other being African Dancer, a group winner at up to 1 3/4 miles.

Manduro should also hold plenty of interest for breeders, as he is a son of the outstanding German stallion Monsun. With his fee now €120,000, Monsun ranks among the highest-priced stallions in Europe. He has clearly done extremely well since he began his career in 1996 at Gestut Schlenderhan at a fee equivalent to around \$10,000. Manduro's d'Ispahan victory made him the 10th Group 1 winner by Monsun, following such as Shirocco (Breeders' Cup Turf and Coronation Cup), Gentlewave (Derby Italiano), Amarette (German Oaks) and Guadalupe (Oaks d'Italia), and he has had four winners of the Deutsches Derby in Shirocco, Samum, Salve Regina and Schiaparelli.

As a son of Konigsstuhl and a Surumu mare, Monsun has a valuable outcross pedigree, and the striking aspect of his success story is that nine of his 10 Group 1 winners are out of Northern Dancer-line mares. Manduro is one of them, as his dam is by Be My Guest.

Manduro has won both his 2007 starts in tremendous style, after winning just one of his eight starts last year, so it is tempting to jump to the conclusion that he is another late developer. However, he earned the title of champion two-year-old colt in Germany with an official ranking of 112 in 2004, and this will surely stand him in good stead when the time comes for him to retire.

"Demand at the better end of the market is strong, but it also seems quite healthy at the other levels, too," he told *Racing Post*. "We have tried to upgrade the quality of the sale this year, and I think that this has been reflected in the prices that we have seen here today."
