EIGHT HEADED TO HALL

Jockey Jose Santos, trainer John Veitch and Kentucky Derby hero Silver Charm were among the eight equines and humans elected to the National Museum of Racing's Hall of Fame as the Class of 2007, which was announced yesterday. The other inductees included jockey John Sellers, trainers Henry Forrest and Frank McCabe, and the horses Mom's Command and Swoon's Son. The 52nd Hall of Fame class will be inducted on Aug. 6 at a ceremony in Saratoga Springs, New York. Santos, Veitch, Mom's Command and Silver Charm were elected in the contemporary categories. Sellers, Forrest, McCabe and Swoon's Son were

elected by the Historic Review Committee, which considers candidates who have not been active for at least 25 years. Forrest, who saddled two Kentucky Derby winners, and McCabe, whose resume includes developing three Hall of Fame horses, tied in the voting for trainer. It's the largest class since nine were inducted in 1978. The induction ceremony will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Monday, Aug. 6 at the Fasig-Tipton Sales Pavilion. MANY HAPPY RETURNS

Last year's Cartier Award winner as the champion three-year-old filly in Europe, **Mandesha (Fr)** (Desert

Style {Ire}) makes her eagerly awaited comeback in today's G2 Prix Corrida at Saint-Cloud. The bay filly's sensational sophomore campaign advertised her class, toughness and versatility. Having registered her first success at a mile over Deauville's testing ground in the G1 Prix d'Astarte

in July, the homebred proved the step up to a mile and a half held no fears when taking the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp in September. Bouncing off the quicker surface at that track the next month, she set a new stakes record in the 10-furlong G1 Prix de l'Opera before being put away for the winter. She encounters a heavy surface here, but her connections are hoping that she can set up a trip to Royal Ascot for the June 20 G1 Prince of Wales's S. "The surface won't be ideal, but there is nothing we can do about it," conditioner Alain de Royer-Dupre, who saddled Pride (Fr) to win this contest last year, told *Racing Post*. Andre Fabre saddles **Macleya**, who beat Satwa Queen (Fr) in the G3 Prix Allez France at this track May 2, when **Nickelle** was back in third.

John Veitch (Trainer)...

During his career, Veitch, 61, trained four champions, but his best-known horse is Hall of Fame member Alydar, who was part of the great rivalry with Affirmed in 1977 and 1978. Retired from training since 2003, Veitch is the Chief State Steward in Kentucky. He joins his father in the Hall of Fame. The late Sylvester Veitch, who trained from 1946 until 1984, was inducted in 1977. "It's actually the dream of a lifetime," Veitch said. "When my father was inducted and I saw how important it was to him, it made me realize what an achievement it was." Veitch's champions were Davona Dale, Our Mims, Before Dawn and Sunshine Forever.

Jose Santos (Jockey)...


The Chilean-born Santos, 46, the rider of the 2003 GI Kentucky Derby Funny Cide, arrived in the U.S. on Jan. 3, 1984 and quickly established himself as a prominent rider. He was the nation's leading jockey in earnings for four consecutive years, from 1986 to 1989, and was the Eclipse Award-winning jockey in 1988 when he set a record for purse earnings of \$14,856,214. Through Dec. 31, 2006, *Equibase* statistics show Santos had 4,076 victories in North America, with purse earnings of \$186,936,820. Santos has been the regular or frequent rider of champions Manila, Meadow Star, Criminal Type, Chief Bearhart, Fleet Indian, Fly So Free and Rubiano.

Silver Charm...

Racing from 1996 through 1999 for trainer Bob Baffert, Silver Charm won 12 of 24 starts and earned \$6,944,369 in purse money, good for seventh on the career earnings list. Silver Charm rose to prominence in 1997 when he edged Captain Bodgit by a head in the GI Kentucky Derby and prevailed by a head over Free House in the GI Preakness S. The Florida-bred son of Silver Buck had the lead in the stretch of the GI Belmont S. and appeared poised to complete the sweep of the Triple Crown, but was passed by Touch Gold late. He was the champion three-year-old. "I'm thrilled to pieces," said Beverly Lewis. "He's the horse that people just love. I'm just so happy that he's there where he belongs."

Mom's Command...

Mom's Command, bred and owned by Peter Fuller and primarily ridden by his daughter, Abby, was the champion three-year-old filly of 1985. Trained by Edward T. "Ned" Allard, the front-running filly won seven of nine starts that year, including the New York filly Triple Crown--the one-mile GI Acorn S., the nine-furlong GI Mother Goose S. and the 1 1/2-mile GI Coaching Club American Oaks. After finishing second to Hall of Famer Lady's Secret in the Test, she defeated Fran's Valentine in the historic GI Alabama S. in what turned out to be her final start. Mom's Command was euthanized on Feb. 3 at the age of 25 at Fuller's farm.

John Sellers (Jockey)...

Sellers, 69, rode from 1955 through 1977. The peak of his career was the decade of the 1960s, when five times in the span of six years he finished in the top 10 nationally in purse money won. He led the nation in victories, 328, and was second in purses in 1961, the year he rode Hall of Fame Carry Back to victories in the Kentucky Derby and the Preakness.

Henry Forrest (Trainer)...

Forrest was a native of Covington, Kentucky, and trained from 1937 until his death in 1975 at the age of 69. He saw every Kentucky Derby from 1921 until his death and trained the Derby and Preakness winners Kauai King in 1966 and Forward Pass in 1968.

Frank McCabe (Trainer)...

McCabe was a distinguished trainer in a career that spanned the later part of the 19th century and the early decades of the 20th century. Born in Patterson, New Jersey, he trained Hall of Famer Hanover, part of McCabe's run of three consecutive Belmont S. winners: Inspector B. 1886; Hanover, 1887; Sir Dixon, 1888.

Swoon's Son...

Swoon's Son was a top stakes horse during a four-season career in the 1950s. Bred and owned by Kentuckian E. Gay Drake, Swoon's Son won 30 of 51 starts.

Allegretto was a quick learner last term, winning the G2 Lancashire Oaks in just her fourth start at Haydock in July before finishing third to Alexandrova (Ire) in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York in August. She returned to that venue the following month to contest the G2 Park Hill S. and filled the same berth, but had offered enough evidence to suggest she could figure in the better staying events this year. Only fifth on her return in the G2 Yorkshire Cup May 18, she returned here just 11 days later with a visor applied and rewarded that move with a game success. Settled in mid-division early, the chestnut ground her way to the front approaching the final quarter and rallied when briefly headed by Balkan Knight soon after to win the war in the last 100 yards. "Whatever Mr. Tafel's decision is, we can come off of [this] work and go either way."

Tempo Meets with Setback...

Godolphin have announced that **Measured Tempo (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) has a foot abscess and may miss Friday's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom. Sheikh Mohamed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's operation are still hoping that the Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial S. winner will make the 12-furlong Classic. "She has popped an abscess in her foot and we will be monitoring it over the next few days," Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented. "Hopefully, she will be okay to take her chance on Friday."

George Strawbridge's **Lucarno** (Dynaformer) has been confirmed for the Derby. Rain Dampens 'Prince' Hopes...

Sultan Ahmad Shah's **Strategic Prince (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) may miss Saturday's G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom due to unfavorable ground conditions, trainer Paul Cole warned yesterday. Last year's G2 July S. and G2 Vintage S. winner will be at a disadvantage following recent rain and connections are keeping a close eye on the weather ahead of the £1.25-million Classic. "We feel that he isn't at his best on soft ground," the conditioner told *sportinglife.com*. "When he has worked at home on it, he works very ordinarily. We feel he actually needs firm in the going description to be at his very best. At this stage, he isn't certain to run at Epsom if they continue to get more rain." Cole, not downhearted by Strategic Prince's eighth in Newmarket's G1 2000 Guineas May 5, hopes the colt can improve over the extra half mile if he makes it to the Epsom starting stall. "I thought it was a tremendous run," Cole said about the Guineas. "He was only beaten about four lengths and there were some seriously good, fast horses, in the race. If he gets a mile and a half, the Newmarket run was excellent, but he showed so much speed at two that we are not certain he will get the trip. His temperament and the gradients at Epsom won't be a problem for him."

Ballydoyle Duo for Oaks

Aidan O'Brien is set to be double-handed in the Oaks. Despite virtually ruling Sunday's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas third **Peeping Fawn** (Danehill) out of the £1.25-million Classic, the Ballydoyle conditioner confirmed Roisin Henry and Susan Magnier's Listed Cheshire Oaks runner-up **All My Loving (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and Susan Magnier's G3 Derrinstown Stud 1000 Guineas Trial second **Nell Gwyn (Ire)** (Danehill). "All My Loving is likely to run, as we think she will handle plenty of ease in the ground well," O'Brien told *Racing Post*. "Nell Gwyn is also a likely runner, but Peeping Fawn, who was third in the Irish 1000 Guineas on Sunday and handles cut in the ground, might not as the Oaks looks like coming a bit soon for her."

The auction will conclude with three yearling sessions, the first two of which are select. Selling will begin each day at 10 a.m. The auction company is expecting a global group of buyers. "Buyers around the world are quickly realizing how important our National Sale is on the international Thoroughbred calendar," said David Chester, Magic Millions managing director. "There isn't another sale like it in the Southern Hemisphere. With the record-sized catalogue on offer, there's plenty of great prospects for buyers on any budget." 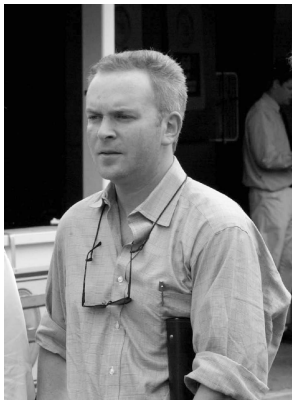

WITH THE BREEDERS' CUP BOARD CANDIDATES

TODAY'S CANDIDATE: THOMAS GAINES

Last December, Breeders' Cup stallion and foal nominators voted to select 13 candidates to stand for election to the Breeders' Cup Limited Board of Members and Trustees. Those candidates are joined by 12 existing trustees who have chosen to stand for re-election. Thirteen will ultimately be chosen. The voting opened on May 1 and will conclude June 18. While bios of the 25 candidates are contained in documents circulated to nominators, the *TDN* is responding to reader suggestions that we provide more information on the candidates' viewpoints. To that end, we posed the following question to each of the 25 candidates and have given them 300 words or

fewer in which to respond. Their responses will be published over the next few days, beginning with Thomas Gaines.

Q: What do you think is the biggest issue facing the Breeders' Cup today and, if voted to the Breeders' Cup board, how would you propose this issue be solved?

A: I think the biggest problem facing the Breeders' Cup is the biggest problem facing the sport of Thoroughbred racing: creating a larger fan base. When my father created the Breeders' Cup, he envisioned a day of championship races as a means to market the sport in new, protracted, exciting ways.

Had it not been for a hairline fracture in his hind leg, Corinthian may well have been one of the favorites for last year's GI Kentucky Derby. The enigmatic colt had captured his second start at two, and, after an allowance win over subsequent G1 Belmont S. winner Jazil, finished a length in front of First Samurai in the GII Fountain of Youth S., only to be demoted to third for causing interference in the stretch. The chestnut emerged from that effort with a minor fracture.

He returned to take third in an allowance race at Saratoga in July, an effort which convinced his connections to give him further time off.

The benefit of the extra rest was clear on his four-year-old debut, when he took a nine-furlong allowance at Gulfstream Park by 9 1/2 lengths from Jazil. Next time out, Corinthian took the GII Gulfstream Park H., but in the GIII Excelsior Breeders' Cup S., for which he started odds-on, he forfeited all chance with a horrible break from the gate. Happily, Corinthian was on his best behaviour Monday, and he finally gained the major win which he had always threatened to achieve, capturing the GI Metropolitan H. With a Grade I win at a mile under his belt, and a pedigree to match, Corinthian now looks sure to be a hot stallion prospect when the time comes for him to retire to stud.

Corinthian's sire, Pulpit, also suffered an injury on the Triple Crown trail. In his case, the injury--which proved to be career-ending--occurred in the GI Kentucky Derby itself, a race Pulpit entered with a record of four wins in five starts, including a win in the GII Fountain of Youth S. and GII Blue Grass S. on his most recent starts. In a time when stallions who consistently sire top-class runners are hard to find, Pulpit has distinguished himself by siring at least one high-quality individual in each of his first six crops. His first crop, foaled in 1999, produced four stakes winners, including the \$2 million earner Essence of Dubai. From his second crop came six stakes winners, headed by the GI Hopeful S. victor Sky Mesa and GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic captor Stroll. The 2001 crop yielded another six stakes winners, of which the most notable were GI Cigar Mile winner Purge; and Tapit, who took the GI Wood Memorial S. The 2002 crop featured Oratory, who took the GII Peter Pan S. in a style which suggested that he might be a coming star, but who then suffered a career-ending injury. Corinthian is the leading member of Pulpit's 2004 crop, which also includes graded winner Devil's Preacher.

Corinthian's dam, Multiply, a daughter of Easy Goer, never ran, but she made a name for herself as broodmare with her first foal, the Sea Hero colt, Desert Hero, who won the GII San Rafael Stakes, took second in the GIII Affirmed Handicap, and third in the GI Santa Anita Derby. A half-sister to minor stakes winner Inflate, Multiple is out of Add, a half-sister to the Mr. Prospector sired trio of Jade Robbery (G1 Grand Criterium), Numer-

ous (GIII Derby Trial Stakes) and Chequer (GIII William P. Kyne Handicap). Add's dam, Number won the GII Hempstead Handicap, GII Firenze Handicap and GIII First Flight Handicap. More significantly, from the standpoint of Corinthian's potential as a stallion, the daughter of Nijinsky II was out of Special, which makes her a three-parts-sister to Nureyev (by Nijinsky II's sire, Northern Dancer out of Special), and to Sadler's Wells – the dominant European sire of his era – and his brother Champion Sire Fairy King (both by Northern Dancer out of Special's daughter, Fairy Bridge). With this in mind it's obviously going to be inviting to breed Corinthian to mares carrying Nureyev, Sadler's Wells, Fairy King and other descendents of Special and her dam, Thong.

Corinthian is the first stakes winner for Pulpit out of an Alydar line mare, but his sire, A.P. Indy has four stakes winners on the cross, grade one winners Secret Status and A P Valentine among them. One would expect Pulpit to enjoy meeting mares with Alydar, as his broodmare sire, Mr. Prospector, is bred on very similar lines to Alydar – both are sons of Raise a Native out of mares by sons of Nasrullah, and have further commonalities in the distaff sides of their pedigrees. The strike-rate of the Mr. Prospector/Alydar has exploded in recent years, and there are now more than 100 stakes winners who have the pair combined in the first four generations of their pedigrees. Fifteen of these are grade one winners, and in addition to Corinthian, they also include Point Given, Anees, Circular Quay, Dubai Escapade, Brother Derek and Pine Island.

RIBOT DAYS

Only one other time have I seen an American stallion have the kind of day Mr. Greeley had in Europe last Sunday. It was at the Curragh, on September 25, 1971, the first time I had ever been racing outside the

United States. I knew just enough about pedigrees then to know who Ribot was, and that day at the Curragh he had four runners, for three winners and a second in a maiden race in which he ran one-two. History will relate that the one-two finishers were Arkadina and Ribot's Fantasy, in a race for unraced two-year-old

fillies (Arkadina went on to place in three Classics and produce Classic winner Dark Lomond; Ribot's Fantasy placed in the Pretty Polly S. at three, and later produced Classic-placed Bold Fantasy, an important early mare for Juddmonte). The then-two-year-old colt Boucher won the Beresford S.; he went on to win the following year's St. Leger, and became a passable sire in Australia. Finally, a four-year-old handicapper called Cumbernauld won a race which I think was over 14 furlongs. I know it was, at that time, the longest race I'd ever seen in my life. Cumbernauld ended up racing until he was 11, and won 10 of 78 career starts.

That's the kind of day Mr. Greeley had last Sunday.

As a racehorse himself, the son of Gone West won three graded races, all at Grade III level at six and seven furlongs, and ran second to Desert Stormer in the 1995 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Not quite the same profile as Ribot took to stud, but that was 35 years ago.

Here's how it went for Mr. Greeley on Sunday. First, in the 2:30 p.m. race at the Curragh, the filly Saoirse Abu (evidently pronounced 'share-say' abu), emphatically won a six-furlong two-year-old maiden in her second start. She had been bought by the BBA Ireland's Eamonn Reilly at Keeneland for \$260,000 and is trained by Jim Bolger for Ennistown Stud. Then, over at Newmarket for the 2:45, two Mr. Greeley colts vied for favoritism in the five-furlong sprint for two-year-olds. Lordship Stud's Swiss Franc, out of the speedball Swiss Lake and making his second start, went off favorite and prevailed over Wolgan Valley, a \$1.45 million buy for Godolphin from Fasig-Tipton's Calder two-year-old sale this March.

And finally, Europe's top three-year-old filly, Finsceal Beo, trained by Mr. Greeley's favorite European, Jim Bolger, completed the G1 English-Irish 1000 Guineas double, with the little blip of that second in France in between.

And that, class, is why the Europeans are all over Mr. Greeley.

Finsceal Beo wasn't the only English Guineas winner to repeat the dose in Ireland: the GI English 2000 winner Cockney Rebel (as noted thereafter, from Royal Academy's son Val Royal's first crop) stayed on strongly to win Saturday's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas by a length from the Bolger-trained Creachadoir, previously second to Astronomer Royal (Danzig) in the G1 French 2000 Guineas. Not to take anything away from the winner, who heads to Royal Ascot's G1 St. James's Palace S. with every chance of completing a memorable Group 1 treble, but it does rather pay another compliment to last year's G1 Dewhurst one-two, Teofilo and Holy Roman Emperor. Trainer Bolger has always seemed very clear that Teofilo is better than Creachadoir--who's becoming a pretty good yardstick, by the way. It's not surprising that Bolger would have that view, since Teofilo was an undefeated dual Group 1 winner who went five-for-five as a two-year-old. For the record, longshot He's A Decoy (In the Wings) appeared to outstay Duke of Marmalade (Danehill) for third in the Irish 2000. **Oppenheim cont. p10**

That canny veteran Irish jockey, Johnny Murtagh. Just last weekend we saw him upset 1-2 shot Dylan Thomas (Danehill) with Notnowcato (Inchinor). It's not

the first time we've seen him win on horses that weren't supposed to be quite good enough: remember him winning the 2002 G1 English 2000 Guineas on Rock of Gibraltar, upsetting stablemate Hawk Wing? Here's another one: he took the 25-1 Australian sprinter Choisir (Danehill Dancer) straight to the

front in the 2003 G2 King's Stand S., five furlongs on the opening day of Royal Ascot, and forgot to stop. The four-year-old colt Acclamation (Royal Applause) came late to get second, with the previous season's G1 Middle Park winner Oasis Dream (Green Desert), finishing third in his three-year-old debut.

In typical Australian fashion, Choisir, then a four-year-old on Northern time but still six weeks short of his official four-year-old birthday, came right back five days later to win the G1 Golden Jubilee over Airwave, the previous year's GI Cheveley Park winner. Europeans habitually complain that their sprinters are below par, but 2003 must qualify as an exception. Oasis Dream came back to beat Choisir (second), Airwave (third), and Acclamation (only eleventh) in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket, then won the G1 Nunthorpe, over five furlongs at York, with Acclamation third. At the end of the season, Timeform rated Oasis Dream, Europe's champion sprinter, at 129; Choisir was 126, Airwave 120, and Acclamation, who didn't win a Group 1 but gained consolation in the G2 Diadem at Ascot, was rated 118.

It is only the end of May, so let's not be hopping to any conclusions, but at this moment, anyway, Acclamation has turned the tables on his two contemporaries (Airwave is now part of the Coolmore broodmare band).

Through Sunday's racing, Acclamation has no fewer than 12 two-year-old winners of 15 races already; he's had six winners in the last 10 days, including last Saturday's upset

Curragh stakes winner Pencil Point. Right now, Acclamation is £20,000 in front of Choisir, who has seven winners of nine races (now eight winners of 10 races, after a winner Tuesday, just his second in the last 10 days), including stakes-placed The Loan Express and dual winner Group Therapy. Oasis Dream has just one winner so far, though a couple of others have shown good promise, including the colt Captain Gerrard, who narrowly missed in a conditions event at Beverly, in the north of England, last Saturday. **Cont. p11**

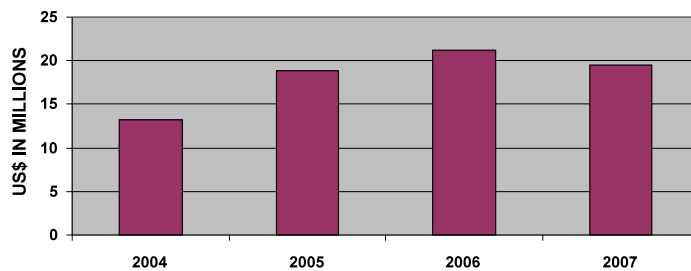

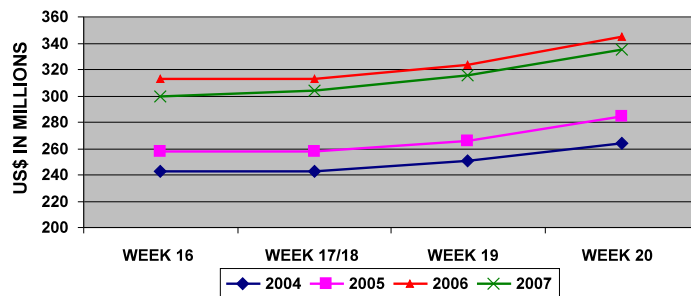

Air Force Three...

Keeping in mind that it is only the end of May, we can really only say for definite that Acclamation and Choisir have made very good starts, but we can mention a few others who are showing promise. Europe's third-ranked freshman sire right now is Blu Air Force, with seven winners already in Italy. A Group 3 winner in France (in fact, he won the Prix du Palais-Royal over seven furlongs, of which the 2007 edition was run Monday at Longchamp) and a Listed stakes winner at Hollywood Park for the Wildensteins, he is by Sri Pekan, who I believe was champion sire in Italy one year. He is just ahead of Statue of Liberty, a half-brother to Lemon Drop Kid, but evidently a whole different kettle of fish. Lemon Drop Kid is by Kingmambo, but might have thrown to his damsire, Seattle Slew, having won the GI Belmont. Statue of Liberty, who is by Storm Cat, won the coveted G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot in the second of his two starts at two, but (here we go again) failed to win in five starts at three. His five winners so far include two five-furlong conditions race winners: the filly Magnetic Storm, at Longchamp, running a very respectable RPR (Racing Post Rating, equivalent to Timeform) 90; and the colt New Jersey, at York, running a 91. Another filly by him, Liberty Belle, ran fifth in a stakes first time out, and came back last Sunday to win a hot-looking six-furlong maiden at Newmarket, running an RPR 86.

Catcher in the Rye, a son of Danehill who ran a close second to Clodovil in the 2003 GI French 2000 Guineas but never ran again and never won a stakes, has four winners, including Eileen's Violet, who won another

hot-looking conditions race, this one at Windsor, in which she defeated a highly-touted Acclamation and a highly-touted Choisir. He ranks fifth, just ahead of Captain Rio (three winners from 23 starters) and Oasis Dream. Dubai Destination (Kingmambo) has three winners, including the filly Dubai

Princess, who ran fourth in a Listed stakes last week at York (RPR 89); and a promising colt called Yem Kenn, racing for Sheikh Ahmed, and bred by none other than L. Dettori. Yem Kenn won a five-furlong maiden at Ascot in which the third was Swiss Franc, the Mr. Greeley colt who came back to win at Newmarket last Saturday. A few by Dubai Destination are showing promise. Ditto Hawk Wing, though he, too, has just one winner, and from 16 starters. For him to have had 16 starters at this point in time could be a good sign, though.
