**STREET SENSE WORKS**

Kentucky Derby winner **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}), partnered by regular rider Calvin Borel, worked a half mile in :49.00 at Churchill Downs Wednesday.

Owned by Jim Tafel, the bay carved out internal fractions of :12.80, :24.60 and :36.60 before galloping out five panels in 1:01.80. The work was the 19<sup>th</sup> fastest of 39 at the distance yesterday. "He's doing good," Borel said. "[Trainer] Carl's [Nafzger] got him on the right track. It's up to Carl now. He told me what to do with him this morning,

and I did what he wanted. We're just going to go from here. He's as good as before, or better." Connections, who are still pondering a start in the June 9 GI Belmont S., will hold a press conference today at 10:30 a.m. to announce whether the colt will contest the third jewel in the Triple Crown. "There's something about this horse--he's a fast work horse," Nafzger said. "I don't necessarily say that's an asset or not, but he worked :49 this morning and never did drop his head." According to Nafzger, should the colt bypass next Saturday's Belmont S., he is likely to prep for the Aug. 25 GI Travers S. with either the GI Haskell Inv. Aug. 5 at Monmouth or the July 29 GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga.

**'PERFECT' POISED FOR OAKS**

Despite the ominous presence of Khalid Abdullah's **Passage of Time** (GB) (Dansili {GB}), a quality field of 14 will assemble for tomorrow's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom, including Derrick Smith, Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's **Simply Perfect** (GB) (Danehill). Third in the G1 1000 Guineas on her sophomore bow May 6, the grey bids to emulate Polygamy (GB), Fair Salinia (Ire), Time Charter (Ire), Balanchine and Shahtoush (Ire) in using the Newmarket Classic as a springboard to Oaks success. "I am delighted with the filly," trainer Jeremy Nosedo said. "She is in great order. The likely soft ground will not be an issue to her. However, it will turn the race into a severe test of stamina, and the question mark with Simply Perfect is her ability to stay a mile and a half." cont. p2

**REDOUTE'S CHOICE COLT SETS RECORD**

A new Australasian record of A\$1.15 million for a weanling at auction was set yesterday when a colt by Redoute's Choice (Aus) was purchased by Coolmore Australia at the Magic Millions National Sale. The previous record was A\$660,000. The youngster, produced

by Gypsy Dancer (NZ) (Dance Floor), is a half-brother to 2004 champion juvenile Dance Hero (Aus) (Danzero {Aus}), who is also a grandson of Danehill. Bidding opened at A\$800,000 and continued apace through the seven-figure barrier before Coolmore finally secured the colt. Coolmore Australia's General Manager Michael Kirwan felt

that lot 807, consigned by Vinery Stud as agent, was outstanding. "He's the standout in the catalogue," said Kirwan. "He's a quality individual and he's a...brother to a former top two-year-old who's still a top racehorse. I don't think I've seen a better two-year-old in Australia in the past 30 years than Dance Hero. He won the Golden Slipper and Alinghi was third, Fastnet Rock fourth and Charge Forward was second--they all turned out to be champions." Kirwan added, "Rarely does the opportunity come up to buy a weanling like him. You have to pay the big dollars to get them." The colt was offered as part of the supplementary catalogue and was offered by Vinery on behalf of breeder Tony Akkari. "I must thank each and every person at Vinery for their hard work in preparing him for the sale," Akkari said. "As well I must thank David Chester and the team at Magic Millions for giving me the opportunity to sell my colt at the sale." Akkari was understandably delighted with the record bid. "He's a lovely colt, but the final price did exceed my expectations," he said. The colt's dam, in foal to Redoute's Choice once again, will sell next week during the National Broodmare Sale. Dance Hero, a gelding who has bankrolled over A\$3.9 million, captured the G1 Salinger S. earlier this year. **Magic Millions** cont. p5

**Top Operations Present and Accounted For...**

Epsom's many colors during tomorrow's fayre will include the varied silks of the Coolmore operation, His Highness the Aga Khan, the Niarchos Family and also Godolphin, whose **Measured Tempo** has won the race against time to make the gig. Now fully recovered from a foot abscess discovered earlier in the week, the May 18 Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial S. heroine bids to follow in the steps of Eswarah (GB), who used that Newbury prep as a stepping stone to success here in 2005. "She is in good form following her foot problem and any further rain would help her chances," said Racing Manager Simon Crisford. The Aga Khan's **Four Sins** will bid to provide John Oxx with a first renewal. She finished second to subsequent G1 1000 Guineas runner-up Arch Swing in the G3 1000 Guineas Trial S. at Leopardstown Apr. 7 before besting Susan Magnier's **Cherry Hinton** in the G3 Blue Wind S. at Naas May 16. "She handled the good-to-yielding ground better than we expected at Naas, so good to soft would be okay," Oxx told *Racing Post*. "But if it looks like being really soft, then we'll have to have a rethink. We also have some concerns about how she might handle the track." Supplemented for Saturday's Classic, unbeaten **Kayah** will hope to fulfill Julian Richmond-Watson's dream. She who proved her stamina with a last-gasp win in the Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial on only her second start May 12. Trainer Ralph Beckett is hopeful she can emulate User Friendly (GB), Lady Carla (GB) and Ramruma in winning this Classic after handling the similar undulations of Lingfield. "The owner took the view that this might be his only ever chance at it and she's in good nick," Beckett said. "Having gone round Lingfield, we're hopeful she will handle the track and she'll stay. I see no reason why she shouldn't get better with experience." Conditions at the Surrey track eased yesterday after a further four millimetres of rain fell. "There was enough to lose the good to soft element and just call it soft," Clerk of the Course Andrew Cooper told *PA Sport*. "The forecast is for the risk of showers Thursday, a diminishing risk of showers on Friday and dry on Saturday."

"We've been very pleased with [Dandy Man's] preparation, he's very well, but we're apprehensive about the ground," Collins told *PA Sport*. "We're waiting to see. He's not due to travel over until Thursday morning, so we'll make a decision then. I'll have to discuss it with the owners. He's a high-profile horse and a lot of people have been interested in him. Princess Haya has taken him over and, hopefully, he'll be very lucky for her." **Red Clubs**, who garnered the G2 Diadem S. at Ascot last September, was not disgraced when ninth in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp in his campaign closer the following month. He returned with another commendable effort to chase home Amadeus Wolf (GB) in the May 16 G2 Duke of York S. and leads the home defence. **The Trader**, making his seasonal bow here, has proved an admirable stick throughout an eight-season career and bids to improve on last year's runner-up finish when making a belated first attempt at this prize. **Wi Dud** was a sharp juvenile and bagged the G2 Flying Childers S. at York in September before succumbing to subsequent G1 2000 Guineas placegetter Dutch Art (GB) when runner-up in the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket the same month. He also makes his first start of the campaign here and bids to become the first sophomore to lift this since Airwave (GB) in 2003.

Mandesha swept through last season with a swathe of Group 1 victories, but she was forced to overcome a blooper moment when left in the stalls to claim this seasonal return in determined style. Stepping up from a course-and-distance maiden victory at this meet last year, Princess Zahra's homebred recorded a first stakes score in the Listed Prix Urban Sea at Lion d'Angers in June, though she was disqualified from first place in the G3 Prix Chloe at Maisons-Laffitte the following month. The bay gained compensation in the G1 Prix d'Astarte at Deauville in late July and claimed another top-level success in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp in September. She returned to the Bois de Boulogne track on Arc day to lift a classy renewal of the G1 Prix de l'Opera in her sophomore finale. Mandesha was the main attraction on this card, but gave connections and supporters alike a heartstopping moment when remaining in situ as her four rivals broke from the gate. Recovering to stalk the sedate fractions, she took control with 300 meters remaining and asserted under a sympathetic drive to secure a fifth stakes rosette. "Some were worried as she acted up a little in the paddock beforehand, but she was scared by something," explained winning owner-breeder Princess Zahra Aga Khan. "It was more worrying to see her break slowly, but once she got back into the race and into the straight it was most satisfying to see her stretch out as she did. For her next race, we will be in search of good ground and she will go for either the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot [June 20] or the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud [June 24]. 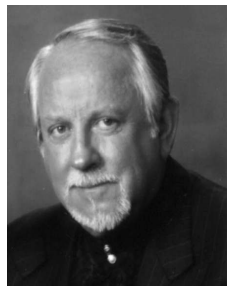

**BREEDERS CUP Q & A WITH CHRIS YOUNG**

**Q:** What do you think is the biggest issue facing the Breeders' Cup today and, if voted to the Breeders' Cup board, how would you propose this issue be solved?

**A:** For more than 20 years, the Breeders' Cup Limited has created the premier day (now two days) of racing, featuring the world's best horses across racing divisions, sex and age groups. In the weeks surrounding Breeders' Cup day, the fan interest and excitement generated about our sport is tremendous. The challenge, as I see it, is building upon this short-lived exposure and extending it throughout the year. The newly instituted "Breeders' Cup Challenge" races are a good start, and need to be constantly evaluated for efficacy with regard to building fan interest. Additionally, I propose that even greater effort be made with technology to better connect our sport with the fans. This can be accomplished through greater community involvement on the Breeders' Cup website and could include blogs, chats and forums. In addition to allowing fans to communicate with one another, I think this could be used to create better communication with trainers, jockeys, and owners. The industry should be constantly striving to keep our fans informed and involved, and using technology to do that is essential in this day and age. We can never forget that horse racing is nothing without the support of the fans.

## EQUINE INJURY REPORTING SYSTEM BEGINS

**FRIDAY** A standardized equine-injury reporting system will begin Friday at 30 tracks around the country, representatives of the Welfare and Safety of the Racehorse Summit announced yesterday. Organizers hope the project will help identify frequency, type and outcome of racing injuries in a standardized format that can be used to generate more accurate statistics. The program will also be used to identify horses most at risk of injury and provide ideas to prevent injuries. The reporting system was developed by Dr. Mary Scollay, association veterinarian at Calder Race Course and Gulfstream Park. "Most tracks have been keeping much, if not all, of this information already," Scollay said. "The difference with this program is that by using standardized terminology, definitions, and reporting criteria we can all be on the same page. And that will permit constructive interactions. There is no such thing as 'an acceptable rate of injury,' but until we are able to document injury rates, trends, and outcomes--and figure out where we are--it is hard to figure out how to get to where we want to be." The Welfare and Safety of the Racehorse Summit was conceived by the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation board of directors in 2005 and held in October 2006. Six committees are conducting research and making recommendations on the action plans that evolved from the summit's strategic planning session:

- Injury Reporting, Dr. Mary Scollay
- Stallions' Progeny Racing Durability, Ed Bowen
- Racing Surfaces, Dr. Wayne McIlwraith
- Race Condition and Race Office, Eual Wyatt
- Shoeing and Hoofcare, Bill Casner
- Education and Licensing, Paul Bowlinger

Among the racetracks participating in the on-track injury reporting system are: Arlington Park, Belmont Park, Calder Race Course, Churchill Downs, Delaware Park, Ellis Park, Gulfstream Park, Hollywood Park, Keeneland, Monmouth Park, Philadelphia Park and Saratoga.

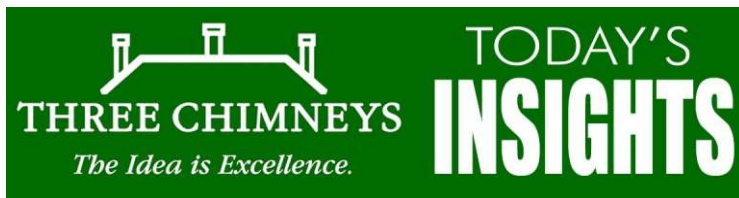
