LAYING DOWN THE LAW

Not content with his personal landmark win in Epsom's G1 Derby a day earlier, jockey Frankie Dettori jetted into Chantilly to guide **Lawman (Fr)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) to an all-the-way success in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club yesterday. Unperturbed by a false start, Claudio Marzocco and Enrico Ciampi's G3 Prix du Guiche winner went right to the front the second time the gates opened and could not be

passed, duly rewarding the faithful who sent him off the 7-2 favorite with a 1½-length success over **Literato (Fr)** (Kendor {Fr}). "What an amazing 24 hours," Dettori commented. "It's just unbelievable--he gave me a lovely ride and it is another day to remember." For co-owner Ciampi, it was the completion of a Chantilly Classic double; Lawman's sister Lattice (Ire) took the G1 Prix de Diane three years ago. "I already enjoyed such pleasure with Lattice, but to have the same experience with her brother is out of this world," he said. **Cont. p2**

DARLEY TO STAND DERBY 1-2 FINISHERS

Darley has acquired the breeding rights to **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}--Bedazzle, by Dixieland Band) and **Hard Spun** (Danzig--Turkish Tryst, by Turkoman), the 1-2 finishers in the G1 Kentucky Derby. The two will stand at Darley's Jonabell Farm in Lexington at the conclusion of their racing careers. Street Sense, named champion two-year-old after his 10-length romp in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, became the very first Juvenile hero to wear the blanket of roses. He came back to be second by a head in the G1 Preakness S., and has earned \$3,158,200. Hard Spun, who set the pace in the Derby before holding on for second, was third in the Preakness and now heads to the June 9 G1 Belmont S. A perfect three-for-three last season, he captured the GII Lane's End S. in March, and boasts a bankroll of \$983,470. "Street Sense and Hard Spun are the two most thrilling horses of their generation, each blessed with remarkable, exceptional gifts," Darley's Chief Operating Officer Dan Pride said. "They've achieved so much, and impressed so much, in victory and also in defeat. It will be an enormous privilege to take charge of their stud careers. They are both so deeply talented that it's easy to see how they could each leave a lasting impression on the breed."

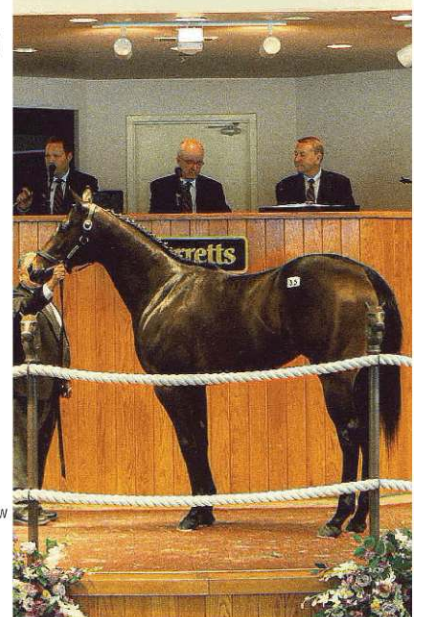

Beaten in his first two starts this season, Lawman looked a different proposition when wiring the Prix de Guiche over nine furlongs here May 9. But his stamina was an issue yesterday, and Frankie Dettori had the bay in hand as he secured the rail and the early lead. Keeping enough in reserve, the rider gave the squeeze in the final quarter and his mount responded with a kick that proved potent as Literato and Shamdinan closed in. Co-owner Enrico Ciampi was pleased to be able to share the Classic glory this time. "Racing is also about sharing, and when I bought him I offered shares to my friends in Monaco," he remarked. "It is a dream come true for all of us, and to enjoy success in such a prestigious race is hard to describe." Trainer Jean-Marie Beguigne, enjoying his first win in the Classic, said, "Ever since he won first time as a two-year-old, I knew he was a good horse and he proved it in the Prix de Guiche." He added, "Olivier Peslier, who rode him there, rang Frankie and advised him...and I told him to feel free to do what was suitable. It was not necessarily the plan to go from the front and he would have done the same if he had come from behind. I'll probably give him a break now and think about where to go, but he most definitely won't be going for the G1 Grand Prix de Paris over a mile and a half." Mystic Lips gave the G2 German 1000 Guineas winner Mi Emma (Ger) a boost here with an impressive success to break her maiden. Beaten over 10 lengths by that phenomenon in the Listed Henkel Trial here Apr. 8, she fared little better when nine-lengths second in the Apr. 29 Classic. Opting for the lead, the bay set a strong pace this time. She quickened in the straight to extend her advantage and forged clear of the fast-finishing Dominante, who had suffered from traffic problems early on. Mystic Lips is the fifth foal bred from Majorata, herself a daughter of Majoritat, winner of both filly Classics in 1987. She is from the immediate family of Monsun (Ger). She was making her first start outside of Cal-bred company, but Nashoba's Key proved she could handle the jump with a game effort. The bay broke her maiden on the Santa Anita turf in January and posted a six-length allowance score over fellow state-breds Feb. 7. Freshened after that effort, she returned to make it three-for-three in the Apr. 29 Fran's Valentine S. on the Hollywood lawn, but was giving Cushion Track a go here. Jockey Joe Talamo rated the filly in fourth as odds-on Hystericalady cut out moderate splits. The rider had some trouble keeping Nashoba's Key on a straight course as they went after the pacesetter, but she put her head down in the waning yards and just got up to post the upset. "All I had to do was guide her in the right direction," Talamo said. "She was 100 percent--no 110 percent--for this race. She's just an incredible filly. Saddex and Torsten Mundry struck for Germany in a competitive renewal of this prestigious affair; they will be back in France for the fall showpiece, the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 7. Fourth in the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg last July, the bay was third behind Prince Flori (Ger) in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden in September. He ending his campaign with a second in the G3 Preis der Deutschen Einheit at Hoppegarten the following month, then made the ideal start to 2007 with a win in Cologne's G2 Gerling-Preis Apr. 22. Held up towards the rear throughout the early stages off a moderate tempo here, he was traveling best of all at the quarter pole as Kerrin McEvoy had Mountain High in full stretch. That rival veered steadily left soon after, leaving Saddex to hit the front with 150 yards remaining, and he was comfortably on top as Vison Celebre built up steam out wide. Said trainer Peter Rau, "He will go for the G1 Deutschland-Preis [at Dusseldorf July 22] and the [Sept. 2] G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, with the ultimate target being the Arc." Kept in the provinces at two, All is Vanity had a brace of wins at Divonne and Vichy last summer and was third in the Listed Prix Delahante at Marseille-Borely in November. She remained out of the spotlight in three trips to the track this term, winning conditions races at Lyon-Parilly Mar. 18 and Marseille-Borely Apr. 11 before returning to the latter venue to best the colts in the Listed Prix Georges Trabaud last time May 4. Left alone on the front end here, the chestnut was angled wide of the rail at the top of the stretch and looked set to be swamped as rivals descended on both sides, but she responded to strong driving, finding another gear inside the final eighth to settle the issue. "I thought she was capable of winning a Group 3, so it's great for her to win so nicely," said trainer William Cargeeg, who has trained in Marseille for 12 years, but was celebrating his first group score. Bruce Raymond, racing manager to runner-up Majestic Roi's owner Jaber Abdullah, told *PA Sport*, "She ran a bit keen and tugged for most of the race. She's in the G1 Coronation S. "I would love to win a Group 1 in Australia before I retire, and I think this horse has the potential to do just that," said Moore.

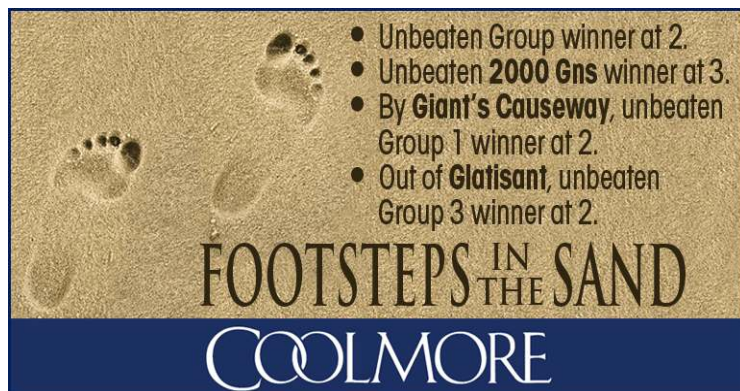

Donoma lost her unbeaten tag when finishing second in the G3 Premio Dormello over course and distance last October, but regained the winning thread when victorious on seasonal return at Rome Apr. 1. Returning off a ninth in the May 13 G3 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) back at the Capanelle, she was handily placed until taking over in early stretch and would not relinquish her advantage thereafter to bravely hold the persistent effort of Nolas Lolly.
