**AUTHORIZED ACQUIRED BY DARLEY**

Chalk up another Derby winner for Darley. Darley announced yesterday that **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}--Funsie {Fr}, by Saumarez {GB}), an impressive winner of last Saturday's G1 Vodafone Derby, has been purchased as a future stallion. The three-year-old has been leased back to owners Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar, whose colors he flew at Epsom. Peter Chapple-Hyam will continue to train the bay, a 95,000gns TATDEC weanling and a 400,000gns TATOCT yearling. Winner of the G1 Racing Post Trophy S. last season and of the G2 Dante S. in his 2007 opener, Authorized is expected to take on his elders next out in the G1 Coral Eclipse S. July 7 at Sandown. The announcement follows last week's news that both the G1 Kentucky Derby winner and runner-up, Street Sense and Hard Spun, will both retire to Darley in Kentucky.

**VISINDAR RETIRED**

The Aga Khan's **Visindar (GB)** (Sinndar {Ire}--Visor, by Mr. Prospector), fifth as the favorite in last year's G1 Epsom Derby, has been retired with a tendon problem, according to *Racing Post*. "It's very disappointing, tragic, as he was such a high-class horse," trainer Andre Fabre told the *Post*. Bred by Jean-Luc Lagardere and campaigned by the Aga Khan, the chestnut sailed through his first three starts, including the G2 Prix Greffulhe, before crossing the Channel with his sights on Epsom. Beaten 2 1/2 lengths by Sir Percy (GB), Visindar sustained an injured tendon and missed the rest of 2006. He had just one subsequent outing, finishing second to Numide (Fr) over very soft ground in a Lonchamp conditions race May 31. The Aga Khan's racing manager, Pat Downes, said, "We don't know yet where he will stand as a stallion, but it will be discussed in the near future." Visindar, who hails from the family of 1984 G1 Kentucky Derby winner Swale, is a half-brother to Visionary (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), SW & G1SP-Fr; Visorama (Ire) (Linamix {Fr}), GSW & G1SP-Fr; and Visionnaire (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), MG1SP-Fr.

**HILL PRINCE A BELMONT APPETIZER**

While the attention of the racing world is focused on tomorrow's final leg of the Triple Crown, a half-dozen sophomore colts with a preference for turf will face the starter in today's GIII Hill Prince S. But the race should prove kind to chalk bettors, as Zayat Stables LLC's

**Marcavelly** (Johannesburg) and Centaur Farms' **Distorted Reality** (Distorted Humor) look to be the obvious class of the field. The two rivals faced off last time in the GIII Crown Royal American Turf S. at Churchill Downs May 4, finishing noses apart in fourth and fifth, respectively. Marcavelly is the

more accomplished runner, having finished second-to Dreaming of Anna--in last year's GIII Summer S. at Woodbine and to the Todd Pletcher-trained Twilight Meteor in the Oct. 27 Bourbon S. at Keeneland. The bay returned to take the GIII Transylvania S. back at Keeneland Apr. 6, but may have struggled with the underfoot conditions in Louisville last time. "I believe that affected us," trainer Bill Mott told *Daily Racing Form*. "I think it had something to do with the outcome. He didn't seem to like it as well as firm ground." Distorted Reality, a half-brother to the good turf sprinter Atticus Kristy, was perfect in two turf tries prior to the Crown Royal, winning his maiden at Gulfstream Mar. 8 and a Keeneland allowance from close range Apr. 12.

**Curlin** (Smart Strike), who has gone from maiden winner to Classic hero in the span of four months, schooled yesterday at the gate and "there weren't any problems," said Toby Sheets, New York-based assistant to trainer Steve

Asmussen. Jockey Robby Albarado hopes for a trouble-free journey tomorrow afternoon and is of the opinion that Curlin will take well to "Big Sandy." Says the rider, "I'm not sure if it was the smaller track or the short turns, but I believe he'll

like Belmont Park a lot more than the others he's raced over. He's going to like those sweeping turns." Despite being based in the Midwest, Albarado has had his fair share of experience in big spots at Belmont, having guided eventual Horse of the Year Mineshaft to victory in the GI Suburban H., the GI Woodward S. and the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup in 2003.

## Tiago Sitting on Go...

Trainer John Shirreffs learned a lot from his 2005 visit with Giacomo and hopes to make use of that experience when he tightens the girth around his half-brother, **Tiago** (Pleasant Tap) in tomorrow's mile-and-a-half feature. For starters, Shirreffs elected to ship the colt into New York over a week ago. "It was very important to get him here early," said Shirreffs of Tiago, who was seventh in the GI Kentucky Derby, but galloped out past Street Sense entering the clubhouse turn.

He continued, "The first few days he was looking around a lot, but now he's much more focused." Tiago has even breezed over the track, covering six furlongs in 1:14 4/5 June 3, and Shirreffs would like to see

him more forwardly placed than he was in the Derby. "I think with a slower pace, he probably should be where we want him," the conditioner commented. "You always want your horse to creep up into a good position to make a strong final run." The GI Santa Anita Derby winner will have Mike Smith in the irons for the Belmont.

Rags to Riches, the half-sister to last year's Belmont winner Jazil, comes into the race off her powerful victory in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 4. Her 104 Beyer Speed Figure from that effort is the second best in the field.

**WOODMAN MARE TOPS MM THURSDAY**

**Rhianna Louise (Aus)** (Woodman), selling as [lot 1698](#) from the Gaden Park dispersal, topped Thursday's general session of the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale at A\$100,000. Randwick Bloodstock purchased the eight-year-old mare, a daughter of Thunder Cat (Aus) (Marscaj {Aus}) from the family of G1SWs Sydney's Dream (Aus) and Charge Forward (Aus), in foal to Jet Spur (Aus) (Flying Spur {Aus}). The mare's first two offspring, both by Easy Rocking (Aus), are winners, including the two-year-old colt Pepperwood (Aus). The sale's two general sessions have easily outpaced the 2006 figures, with an aggregate of A\$5,728,750 this year compared to A\$919,250 a year ago. "We're delighted with the strong clearance rate again over the past two days, following on from the record breaking sale for sessions one and two," Magic Millions managing director David Chester said. *Wind Added to Diane Field...*

Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **West Wind (GB)** (Machiavellian) has been supplemented for Sunday's G1 Prix de Diane Hermes at Chantilly. Trainer Henri-Alex Pantall paid the €48,000 fee to add the May 9 course conditions winner to the Classic, which featured 16 fillies at yesterday's stage. "Her form is excellent and she is a progressive sort who has been improving with each race," Pantall told *Racing Post*. Frankie Dettori has the mount aboard the chestnut filly. Khalid Abdullah still has two entries in the Andre Fabre-trained duo **Cinnamon Bay (GB)** (Zamindar), who took the Listed Prix d'Angerville over a mile at the venue May 19; and the Longchamp conditions winner **Concentric (GB)** (Sadler's Wells). "Our most likely runner is Cinnamon Bay, and Stephane Pasquier will be in the saddle," the owner's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told the *Post*. "When it comes to Concentric, we will be keeping an eye on Friday's weather and if there is rain, we could also run Concentric."

**REBEL PROGRAM ANNOUNCED** Phil Cunningham's dual Classic winner **Cockney Rebel (Ire)** (Val Royal {Fr}) had his 2007 campaign mapped out by connections yesterday, which won't have him resting on his laurels. The Geoff Huffer-trained colt, successful in Newmarket's G1 2000 Guineas May 5 and the Irish equivalent at The Curragh three weeks later, will tackle Royal Ascot's G1 St James's Palace S. in 11 days' time before tackling two of France's premier mile events. "Touch wood, hopefully he will win at Ascot, and the race I have set my heart on after that is the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot, which isn't until Sept. 29," Cunningham told *PA Sport*. "We've not entered him in the G1 Eclipse S. or the G1 Sussex S. We've looked at the calendar and picked out a race for him a month. A tentative plan could be the G1 Prix Jean Prat [at Chantilly July 8], then the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois [at Deauville Aug. 12] and in September his main target, the QEII. In October, it could be the G1 Champion S. [at Newmarket Oct. 20] or the Breeders' Cup [Mile]. Wouldn't the Champion be a race if Authorized turned up? I would love to have a crack at him."

### BREEDERS' CUP Q AND A

Last December, Breeders' Cup stallion and foal nominators voted to select 13 candidates to stand for election to the Breeders' Cup Limited Board of Members and Trustees. Those candidates

are joined by 12 existing trustees who have chosen to stand for re-election. Thirteen will ultimately be chosen. The voting opened on May 1 and will conclude June 18. While bios of the 25 candidates are contained in documents circulated to nominators, the *TDN* is responding to reader suggestions that we provide more information on the candidates' viewpoints. To that end, we posed the following question to each of the 25 candidates and have given them 300 words or fewer in which to respond. Their responses continue here.

#### RICK PORTER

**Q:** What do you think is the biggest issue facing the Breeders' Cup today and, if voted to the Breeders' Cup board, how would you propose this issue be solved?

**A:** Thank you for giving me an opportunity to respond to your question. Since I do not currently sit on the board of the Breeders' Cup, it is difficult to answer the question as to their biggest issue. I can only address



what I feel needs to be accomplished, in my opinion, by the Breeders' Cup board. The Breeders' Cup is in a unique position to positively influence Thoroughbred horse racing in North America. Championship Day was a brilliant idea and it has been carried out with much success since its inception. Having achieved that success, the Breeders' Cup should now ask what more they can do to serve the betterment of racing. Can the Breeders' Cup implement a series of races, particularly in

the older division, that leads to the Classic? There should be a way of giving additional exposure and excitement to racing. This idea has been talked about for some time and I feel that the Breeders' Cup has the means and wherewithal to "make it happen." The Breeders' Cup has the rare opportunity to make a very real difference in our sport. It can, if the board so desires, lift the sport up and increase its popularity. Horse racing is my passion and if elected to the board, I hope that I'm able, through the Breeders' Cup, to further this great sport.

### NAIFY, LIEBAU, MARZELLI JOIN NTRA BOARD

The National Thoroughbred Racing Association (NTRA) announced yesterday that Marsha Naify, F. Jack Liebau, Sr., and Alan Marzelli have joined the NTRA Board of Directors. All three were in attendance at yesterday's regularly scheduled, second-quarter NTRA Board meeting in Garden City, New York. Naify is the first woman to serve on the NTRA Board of Directors and is the first female chair of the board of directors of the Thoroughbred Owners of California (TOC). Liebau, who oversees the operations of Bay Meadows and Hollywood Park, replaces former NTRA chairman Craig Fravel, whose term expired as the western region, independently-owned-racetrack Board representative. Liebau has served as the president of Bay Meadows Racing Association since July 2004 and the president of Hollywood Park since September 2005. Marzelli, president and chief operating officer of The Jockey Club, replaces Ogden Mills Phipps, who has served on the NTRA Board since its inception. In addition to his duties at The Jockey Club, Marzelli was a driving force behind the formation and establishment of Equibase Company, of which he has served as chairman since 1997. At the meeting, the NTRA unanimously passed a resolution thanking Phipps for his years of service in support of the organization. "The NTRA will forever be indebted to Dinny Phipps for his instrumental and tireless service to our organization," said Alex Waldrop, President and CEO of the NTRA. "We also thank Craig Fravel for the many important contributions he made as the first chairman of the NTRA," Waldrop added. "We welcome Marsha Naify, Jack Liebau and Alan Marzelli to the Board, and we feel extremely fortunate to have three people with such a rich breadth of experience to help guide us in the years ahead."

### NTRA Charities to Disburse \$150K on Belmont Day:

The National Thoroughbred Racing Association announced yesterday that it will disburse a total of \$150,000 through its Barbaro Memorial Fund following Saturday's seventh race at Belmont Park. A disbursement of \$100,000 will be made to the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation, while an additional \$50,000 will be disbursed to the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine's Fund for Laminitis Research. "Thanks to the generosity of fans across North America and of member organizations like the New York Racing Association, we are proud to make these initial two disbursements from the NTRA Charities--Barbaro Memorial Fund to the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation and to the University of Pennsylvania's Fund for Laminitis Research," said Alex Waldrop, President and CEO of the NTRA. "The importance of equine health and safety does not end with the Triple Crown season, however, and the work of the Barbaro Memorial Fund will continue so that we can make many more disbursements to the various leaders in the care of Thoroughbreds." Also part of the ceremony will be a check presentation to the Fund in the amount of \$15,000 from the New York Racing Association.
