FAIRY TALE ENDING TO BELMONT STAKES

How could you root against her? She had to overcome a century of history and one of the toughest competitors on the track today, but **Rags to Riches** (A.P. Indy) fought off an unrelenting **Curlin** (Smart Strike) to take yesterday's GI Belmont S. by a head. Just the 22nd filly to attempt the feat, she became only the third of her sex to take the "Test of the Champion," following Ruthless in 1867 and Tanya in 1905. In the process, she gave trainer Todd Pletcher his first Triple Crown race victory after a frustrating 0-for-28 streak, and broke an 0-for-20 run for jockey John Velazquez. "It's a special feeling no matter when you do it, but when it hasn't been done in 102 years, it makes it really special," Pletcher said. "It's a real credit to how good this filly is." Owner Michael Tabor, who won the 1995 Belmont with Thunder Gulch, added, "I just have so much confidence in this filly--I always thought she could do it. Take nothing away from Curlin, who is a very special animal, but I always felt that she was just that much better than anything." **Belmont S. cont. p2**

Bred to be a champion, **Rags to Riches** was a \$1.9-million KEESEP purchase, but she was never expected to excel at two. She made just one start last season, finishing fourth at Churchill Downs in June, bucked her shins in the race and was done for the year. The chestnut returned to break her maiden by six lengths at Santa Anita Jan. 7, and was tossed right into

Grade I company. She captured the Feb. 10 GI Las Virgenes by 3/4 of a length, the Mar. 11 GI Santa Anita Oaks by 5 1/2 lengths and, despite catching a muddy track, took the May 4 GI Kentucky Oaks by 4 1/4 lengths. Todd Pletcher and owners Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith waited 'til Tuesday to decide to tackle the boys in the Belmont, adding not only cachet but a worthy opponent to the final jewel in the Triple Crown. The filly was sent off the 4-1 second choice in the race, with GI Preakness winner **Curlin** the crowd's choice at even-money.

Passing the Test...

Rags to Riches stumbled badly at the break, but John Velazquez took her in hand and kept her on the outside as **C P West** (Came Home) and **Slew's Tizzy** (Tiznow) led them into the first turn. The leaders were crawling on the front end, churning out fractions of :50.14 and 1:15.32. The pace picked up as they raced to the quarter pole, and the filly, wide throughout, had grabbed the lead through 10 panels in 2:04.91. **Curlin**, just off the leaders while saving ground early, drove between horses at the top of the lane and the battle was joined. What's Next?

Todd Pletcher has not yet mapped out a summer campaign for Rags to Riches, but he did not rule out another tilt at mixed company. "She might show up in the Coaching Club [American Oaks] and Alabama, or maybe the Haskell and Travers, but the filly is going to make those decisions," he said. "My job is to read how the filly is doing and when she's ready to run."

Shining in Defeat...

Trainer Steve Asmussen was full of praise for runner-up **Curlin**. "He is definitely a throwback," he said. "The races that he's run since March, with the pressure that's been on him, I can't say enough about him. We're very proud of him." He added, "At the eighth-pole, the filly put a good neck on him and he never gave up. The one thing we've learned with **Curlin** is that...he's got a lot of fight in him. To the last jump, I thought he'd win-- I thought he'd come back." **Hard Spun** (Danzig) pressed the slow pace, but tired down the lane to be fourth. "Maybe the fatigue factor starts taking its toll a little more here," trainer Larry Jones said. "It looked like he came back okay and will live to fight another day."

Better Than???

Broodmare **Better Than Honour** (Deputy Minister), a \$750,000 KEESEP yearling, won the GI Demoiselle S. and was runner-up in the GI Acorn S. and third in the GI Mother Goose S. The 12-year-old mare sold in foal to Mineshaft for \$2 million at the 2004 Keeneland November sale, when 2006 GI Belmont S. winner **Jazil** was just a yearling. She was consigned by Lane's End, agent, and purchased by BBA Ireland Ltd. Her first foal, a filly by Storm Cat named **Teeming**, was a \$1.5-million KEENOV weanling, and her second, a filly by A.P. Indy named **Magnificent Honor**, brought \$925,000 as a KEESEP yearling. **Jazil** sold for \$725,000 at the 2004 Keeneland September sale, Rags to Riches went through the ring at that venue the following year and Casino Drive, the colt sold in utero in 2004, brought \$950,000 last year. **Better Than Honour** has a yearling colt by Giant's Causeway, foaled a colt by Giant's Causeway this year and was bred back to A.P. Indy.

Better Talk Now, hero of the 2004 GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Lone Star Park, was looking for his first Grade I win since taking the 2005 Man o'War S. at Belmont, but he proved he could still get the job done in top company. Seventh in his attempt to make it two in a row in the '05 BC Turf, the dark bay gelding was two-for-five last year, taking the GII Dixie S. at Pimlico in May and the GII Sky Classic S. at Woodbine in September. He just missed on Breeders' Cup day 2006, finishing second by a half-length at Churchill Downs in November, and took a six-month vacation. The Bushwood Stable colorbearer had a world of trouble in his return in the May 5 GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill Downs. Sent off at 5-2, the veteran was last early, then had to steady sharply as he was making his move in deep stretch and still finished fourth, just 1 3/4 lengths behind winner Sky Conqueror. But he encountered no such trouble yesterday.

Not a Straw in His Path...

Sent off the 3-1 second choice in the Manhattan, Better Talk Now took up his customary position at the back of the pack as 25-1 Red Zipper (City Zip) cut out easy early fractions of :50.58 and 1:14.95. He gained ground from the inside on the turn and was in full flight as the rail remained open down the lane, getting up in the final jump to take the three-way photo. "I was not worried at all," jockey Ramon Dominguez said. "Early in the race, he became so much more settled. It was great to see him off the bridle. As we got to the backside, I had the feeling they were going a bit slow. From there, the horse just galloped beautifully. I was able to save ground. At the sixteenth pole, he was able to come up the rail. It was amazing to come through after the slow fractions." Added trainer Graham Motion, "He really shouldn't have been able to close like that into those fractions. He is an unbelievable horse. Ramon rode him beautifully today; he has so much confidence in him." The winner could be pointed for the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth Park July 7. A Tough Beat for the Favorite...

English Channel, sent off the 3-2 chalk, was making his first start since finishing 12th in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai Duty Free H. A three-time Grade I winner last year, he was 2 1/4 lengths adrift of Better Talk Now when third in the BC Turf, and opened 2007 with an allowance win at Gulfstream Park Feb. 22. The five-year-old pressed the pace and made a run at the lead in deep stretch, but was outfinished by the winner.

Late Scratch...

GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic hero **Sky Conqueror** (Sky Classic) was a late scratch from the Manhattan. "He unfortunately tied up when we trained him [Friday] morning," trainer Darwin Banach told *Daily Racing Form*. "His muscle enzymes looked pretty high. It's very disappointing obviously, but it's the best thing for him."

Dream Rush looked like she had it won at the eighth pole, but the final furlong proved just a bit too much, and Cotton Blossom came on to post the mild upset. The winner of the GIII Schuylerville S. and third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies last season, Cotton Blossom opened her sophomore campaign with a win in the Mar. 17 Florida Oaks. She finished a well-beaten second in the Apr. 6 GII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn and, after an eventful stretch run, finished ninth behind stablemate Rags to Riches in the May 4 GI Kentucky Oaks. "She had a nightmarish trip [in the Oaks]," Todd Pletcher said. "She wasn't going to win, but she was going to hit the board. She was a deserving Grade I winner today."

A Well-Timed Ride...

John Velazquez rated Cotton Blossom in the middle of the pack as 3-5 Dream Rush dashed off a half in :45.10. The crowd's choice still had a length and a half on the field at midstretch, but Cotton Blossom finished full of run, taking over in the waning strides and edging clear. "It set up for her today," Velazquez said. "The speed went and she had a really good trip." As for the runner-up, trainer Rick Violette Jr. said, "She ran hard. This was the first time she had to run hard to the wire and she came up a little bit short. Still, it was a huge race." Dream Rush could be pointed for the Aug. 4 GI Darley Test S. at Saratoga. After Market opened his career with four consecutive victories, taking the GIII Lexington S. last July and the GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame BC S. at Saratoga in August. The streak came to an end when the dark bay was 10th in the Sept. 9 GIII Kent BC S. at Delaware Park, and afterwards he disappeared for nearly five months. Eighth in an optional claimer at Gulfstream Jan. 31, he then shipped to trainer John Shirreffs barn at Hollywood Park, but opened his West Coast account with off-the-board efforts in the GI Frank Kilroe H. Mar. 3 and an allowance test Mar. 31. The four-year-old turned it around in the Apr. 28 GIII Inglewood H. at Hollywood, closing to win by two lengths, and was the second choice to put them back-to-back. The 9-10 chalk was Lava Man, making his first appearance since a last-place finish in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai Duty Free H. Lava Man settled in third early and took over at the quarter pole, but After Market came after the favorite in the final furlong, sweeping to the front in the final strides and drawing clear. Valbenny ran her U.S. record to four-for-five with this rallying score. A maiden winner at Ayr last July, the bay shipped to the States after that victory. She opened her American account with a narrow tally in the Nov. 25 GIII Miesque S. at Hollywood and came back to take the Dec. 31 Blue Norther S. at Santa Anita. The Irish-bred was freshened off that effort and came up short in her return, running sixth in the Apr. 7 GIII Providencia S., but she was back on top of her game to beat Super Freaky and Passified (Compton Place {GB}) in the May 12 GIII Senorita S. Favored to add to her impressive resume here, Valbenny saved ground while patiently ridden early, swung wide for the drive and caught Super Freaky inside the eighth pole to post a handy score.
