SHE'S LIKE THE WIND

A late addition to the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes, Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **West Wind (GB)** (Machiavellian) swooped to capture yesterday's Chantilly Classic and continue the Classic run for Frankie Dettori. Buoyed by Derby successes on Authorized (Ire) and Lawman (Fr) last weekend, the Italian made it a historical treble on the decisive 7-1 winner. The homebred quickened with an irresistible rush in the final 300 yards, and her 1 1/2-length margin of victory flattered runner-up **Mrs. Lindsay** (Theatrical {Ire}). "Last Sunday, I stood here talking about an amazing 24 hours, but now I'm talking about an amazing week," Dettori said. "She's a really nice filly who quickened very well and gave me a great feel." For conditioner Henri-Alex Pantall, the triumph represented a notable first. "I've been chasing a Group 1 win for so many years, so you can imagine how proud and thrilled I am," Pantall commented. **Prix de Diane cont. p2**

A day after her historic victory in the G1 Belmont S., Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's super filly **Rags to Riches** (A.P. Indy) was reported to be no worse for the wear. "She came back well," said trainer Todd Pletcher, the three-time Eclipse Award winner who was capturing his first Triple Crown event. Pletcher, too, was in fine fettle Sunday morning. "This feels good," he said. "I don't know if it's all sunk in yet--the historical significance of it and all. It's a pretty special win. It was a great day and I think a popular victory. It was great for the sport, great for the Belmont and it made for good TV." The valiant runner-up **Curlin** (Smart Strike), meanwhile, left Belmont at approximately 6 a.m. yesterday and was due to arrive in Kentucky later in the afternoon. **Cont. p2**

Go West...

West Wind started out over a mile at Saint-Cloud Mar. 23, but showed little in that third-place effort to suggest she held Classic pretensions. The chestnut turned a corner when upped in trip next time, however, running second to **Coquerelle (Ire)** (Zamindar) at Longchamp Apr. 15. She graduated going 10 furlongs at this track last time May 9, and her 2 1/2-length defeat of

the highly regarded Andre Fabre runner Concentric (GB) was a sign of how much progress she had made in her short career. She made her stakes debut in Classic company. Held up in mid-division against the rail, West Wind needed the gaps to appear at the top of the stretch; when daylight came, she was angled wide for her run. When the question was asked approaching the eighth pole, she responded to settle the result in a matter of strides. "I would like to thank Sheikh Mohamed, who has been a long-time supporter and who was fully behind me wanting to supplement her," Henri-Alex Pantall said. "At one point, I thought she might never make it to the races, but she suddenly changed around and has improved so much from the start of the year and between her races." Looking ahead, he added, "Having done so much so far this year, I would imagine she needs a break now before coming back probably for the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 16], with a race beforehand. Without a doubt, she is the best I have trained so far." Francois Rohaut was delighted with the performance of Mrs. Lindsay, who gamely attempted to make all. "With the number one draw, I knew we had to be close up with the pace and Johnny Murtagh did well to go on after no one wanted to make it," he said. "We could have done with a pacemaker and, if we had had one, we might have made more of a fight with the winner, but she has run a great race and I'm very proud." "He ate well last night and his legs are good and cold," trainer Larry Jones said. "We're not going to plan on anything right away. We'll let him recharge his batteries. He won't run again until August."

Belmont Handle Down With Smaller Field...

With a considerably smaller field and no Triple Crown on the line, the overall handle for Saturday's Belmont S. was down from 2006 numbers. Total all-sources handle for Belmont S. day was \$75,587,892, compared to \$81,465,277 in 2006. Track officials attributed the dip in overall handle of \$5,877,385--and the Belmont Stakes-only handle reduction of \$7,319,263--to the five fewer betting interests in 2007 as compared with 2006. Total all-sources handle for the 2007 Belmont only, with a seven-horse field, was \$37,786,382, compared to \$45,105,645 for the 2006 Belmont with a 12-horse field. At Belmont Park, on-track wagering totaled \$8,843,720 for the 13-race presentation, compared to \$8,958,323 in 2006. An additional \$712,406 was wagered by the on-track crowd on incoming simulcasts, elevating the total on-track handle to \$9,556,126, a record Belmont Day handle when there was no Triple Crown opportunity.

Tough Tiz's Sis has blossomed under the tutelage of trainer Bob Baffert and yesterday earned the first graded stakes victory of her career. The daughter of Tiznow broke her maiden in her route debut at Hawthorne last December, then was moved from Tom Dorris's barn in Illinois to Baffert's California operation. After taking a Santa Anita allowance in her second start for the silver-haired conditioner, she was given a shot in the \$200,000 WinStar Oaks at Sunland Mar. 18 and came away with a popular 3 3/4-length victory. Taking another big step up in company when tried in the May 4 GI Kentucky Oaks, Tough Tiz's Sis found either the company or the off-going too much to overcome and trailed home a well-beaten seventh to Rags to Riches. Shipped back to the West Coast, she'd been given a work over Hollywood's Cushion Track in the interim and came into this off a sharp 1:11 2/5 drill at Santa Anita June 5.

Given a perfect ride by Aaron Gryder, Tough Tiz's Sis was put on the lead and dueled outside of Follow the Clues (Hold For Gold) through sensible :23 4/5 and :47 1/5 splits. Given her head on the turn, she opened a clear lead and leveled out nicely as the favorite gave game but futile chase. "I'm really upset; I wanted to run her in the Belmont [Saturday],"

Baffert quipped to TVG after the race. He added, "After the Kentucky Oaks, I brought her back here and gave her a good stiff workout over the track. We liked this filly a lot. It doesn't seem that distance is a problem and I liked the way she was in a good spot today. I'm not sure what's in store for this filly, I just wanted to see what she did here and how she comes out of it. Hopefully, we'll ship her somewhere, but right now it's up in the air."

Kieren Fallon predicted trainer Jean-Marie Beguigne would win a Derby with Lawman (Fr) after riding that colt last year. Fallon wasn't in the saddle for that victory, but he was handed a measure of reward for his prophecy with this milestone on his comeback trail. Spirito del Vento had not looked back since finishing seventh in this contest 12 months ago, and took his tally to two wins from three subsequent starts in a conditions event at Longchamp Apr. 1. Third behind Multiplex in the Listed Prix de Montretout at that track last time Apr. 26, the gelding benefitted from the Fallon magic to reverse that form. Outpaced early in a detached fourth as Passager forced the early pace, he was coaxed into contention and, after one crack with the whip, quickened impressively down the outer to swamp that rival and Multiplex in the final 100 yards. "He is a nice horse who is improving all the time, and today had the fast pace he needs," conditioner Jean-Marie Beguigne commented. BEO TO ASCOT Trainer Jim Bolger has ended speculation as to the next start of dual Classic heroine **Finsceal Beo (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley), committing the filly to the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot. Michael Ryan's G1 1000 Guineas and G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner will stay at a mile for the June 22 contest. "Finsceal Beo is very well since The Curragh," he told the *Racing Post*. Bolger also announced that his G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas runner-up **Creachadoir (Ire)** (King's Best) will target either the June 20 G3 Jersey S. or G1 St James's Palace S. the previous day. "Creachadoir's work has been very good and we think that he has improved again from the Irish 2000 Guineas," he added. "We have him in the Jersey as well as the St James's Palace, but we just thought, the way he's going at home now, he could be in there with a good chance in the St James's Palace."

EVIE FOR ANNE Terry Neill's G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. scorer **Red Evie (Ire)** (Intikhab) is on course for the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot. Trainer Michael Bell reported that the four-year-old, who added that Newbury contest to a record that already included last year's G1 Matron S., to be firing ahead of her June 19 test. If we decide to keep her to the fillies' races, there is always the likes of the G1 Falmouth S. [at Newmarket July 11] and the G1 Matron S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 8]-there are plenty of options."

Table Games Referendum Defeated at Charles Town:

A referendum in Jefferson County, West Virginia, concerning the issue of whether to allow table games at Charles Town Races & Slots, went down to a 'no' vote on Saturday, June 9. According to the *The Journal*, a local newspaper, voters rejected casino-style gambling by a margin of 56 percent to 44 percent. "We're very disappointed, there's no question," John Finamore, senior vice president of regional operations at Penn National Gaming Inc., which owns Charles Town Races & Slots, told to the newspaper. "We think the big losers...are all the schools, the horsemen, the breeders, the state and a lot of residents in Jefferson County." Increased traffic and social problems, such as gambling addiction, were cited as reasons for the 'no' vote. Residents of Ohio County thought differently, however, approving a similar referendum for the Wheeling Island Racetrack & Gaming Center, which conducts Greyhound racing. Proponents of table games must wait two years before putting the referendum before Jefferson County voters again.

June 11, 1921...**Grey Lag**, under jockey Earl Sande, won the first Belmont S. ever to be run counter-clockwise. Previous Belmonts were run clockwise over a fish-hook course which included part of the training track and the main dirt oval.
