COCKNEY REBEL OFFER ON HOLD

According to trainer Geoff Huffer, owner Phil Cunningham has received a bid of £10 million for **Cockney Rebel (Ire)** (Val Royal {Fr}), but he will not consider any offers for the dual Classic winner until after the June 19 G1 St James's Palace S. "We've had lots of offers, including a firm bid of £10 million for him, and that's not a bad return on the 30,000 guineas he cost as a yearling," Huffer commented. "Nobody's bought him at the moment and Phil

Cunningham doesn't want to do anything until after Royal Ascot. Cockney Rebel is worth that now and if he wins the St James's Palace he'll be worth more--he won't devalue. He's a dual Classic winner so he can stand for £15,000 to £20,000 at stud whatever happens. His owner is a sporting man and money is not the main factor." Looking ahead to the Royal meeting, Huffer is hopeful his stable star can once again prevail in a rematch with G1 2000 Guineas third **Dutch Art (GB)** (Medicean {GB}). "He's improving all the time and you haven't seen the best of him yet," he said. "You can never be totally confident and he's got to run his race, but Dutch Art has to catch us up. If he gets beat then he gets beat, but I find it hard to think he will. He quickens off a good gallop and then quickens again--very few horses do that." Looking ahead, Huffer revealed Cockney Rebel will target the Aug. 12 G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville and the Sept. 29 G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. back at Ascot.

EINSTEIN TO MISS STEPHEN FOSTER

GISW Einsten (Brz) (Spend a Buck), who was expected to try his luck on the dirt in Saturday's GI Stephen Foster H., will be forced to miss the race after suffering a minor injury. The five-year-old worked five-eighths in :59.40 on the main track at Churchill June 3, but exited the move with a bruised splint bone in his right front leg. "He worked awesome last week, but he just wasn't right afterwards," said trainer Helen Pitts. "We're probably going to give him about three weeks off and then we'll bring him back and see what happens." Pitts speculated that the injury might have occurred when Einstein lost his rider while trying to avoid a fallen horse in the May 19 GII Dixie S. at Pimlico. "I hadn't done enough with him in the mornings until we worked him for a deep bone bruise to come out," she explained. Einstein capped a three-race winning streak last year with a neck score in the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. on the grass. He was sidelined after finishing fourth in the May 6 GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill, but returned to be take the Mar. 10 GII Mervin H. Muniz Jr.

Memorial H. at Fair Grounds in his third start off the 8 1/2-month layoff. The dark bay was seventh, but beaten just three lengths, in the Woodford Reserve prior to his troubled appearance in the Dixie. Overall, he has five wins from 13 career starts and earnings of \$519,082. The starting highweight in the Foster will be **Master Command** (A.P. Indy), who is perfect in three starts this term. The five-year-old comes off a 3 3/4-length victory in the Apr. 21 GIII National Jockey Club H. at Hawthorne. He has been assigned 123 pounds.

From the first crop of European champion Blushing Groom (Fr), the grey didn't race at two, but won third time out at Keeneland as a three-year-old. Runner-up in the Queen's Plate, the Ontario-bred annexed the Prince of Wales S.

before upsetting the apple cart in the GI Travers S., where his victims included subsequent Horse of the Year Conquistador Cielo and GI Preakness winner Aloma's Ruler. He later won the Breeders' S. on the turf at Woodbine and was named Canada's Champion Three-Year-Old Colt. After an anti-climactic four-year-old season, Runaway Groom was retired to El Rancho Murrieta in California. He moved to Double Diamond Farm the following year, standing in Florida from 1985 through 1990, then was relocated to Vinery, where he finished out his stud career. He started off quietly, but Runaway Groom established himself as a versatile sire of racehorses, getting champion sprinter Cherokee Run as well as Grade I-winning millionaire routers Down the Aisle and Wekiva Springs. He has also sired GI Champagne S. winner The Groom Is Red and record-setting miler Najran. Pensioned in February, he has sired 72 stakes winners to date. His progeny have earned more than \$55 million.

When people talk about Danzig as a sire of sires, Danehill takes pride of place, but Shadwell's Green Desert usually comes in a very honourable second. Interestingly, there were some distinct similarities between the two, as both reached the first three in the 2000 Guineas before dropping down the distance scale to win two important six-furlong contests, including the Sprint Cup at Haydock.

Speed was clearly their main asset, even though both colts had elements of stamina in the bottom half of their pedigree. Whereas Danehill's first two dams were daughters of His Majesty and Buckpasser, Green Desert's were by the Derby-winning Sir Ivor and the Kentucky Derby second Never Bend. Despite their similar profiles, Green Desert has proved the stronger influence for speed, with his mature progeny in Britain and Ireland having an average winning distance of 7.7 furlongs, compared to Danehill's figure of around nine furlongs. He's best known in the States as the sire of Grade I winners Sheikh Albadou, Heat Haze and White Heart.

There was probably no better example of Green Desert's propensity for speed than his son Invincible Spirit. Theoretically, if ever there was going to be a son of Green Desert suited to a mile and a quarter, it was going to be Invincible Spirit. He comes from a stamina-packed female line, starting with his dam Rafha, who followed up her victory in the Lingfield Oaks Trial over 1 7/16 miles with a game victory in the French Oaks. The next dam, Eljazzi, was a daughter of the versatile Artaius and the long-winded Border Bounty. Border Bounty excelled with the top miler Petingo, notably producing the champion sire Pitcairn, whose son Ela-Mana-Mou made a big impact as a sire on Britain's long-distance races. Pitcairn's sister Dingle Bay became the dam of the top-class stayer Assessor, whose stamina stretched to 2 1/2 miles.

With a background like this, it was no surprise to see Rafha produce 1 1/2-mile group winners to Shirley Heights and Bahri and a very useful two-mile horse to Royal Academy. However, it was a different story when Rafha was mated to Danehill and Green Desert. Her Danehill foals were the accomplished sprinters Kodiak and Massarra, but the fastest of her foals was undoubtedly Invincible Spirit.

Three stabs at seven furlongs established that even that short distance was beyond Invincible Spirit's best, and all seven of his victories came over six. Appropriately, his best effort came when he sprang a 25-1 surprise to emulate his sire Green Desert in the 2002 Haydock Sprint Cup.

The signs are that Invincible Spirit is going to prove a worthy alternative to Green Desert, who is now 24. Even though he began his stallion career at a fee no higher than €10,000, he got off to a flying start last year and maintained his momentum so well that his fee for 2007 rose to €35,000. With 35 first-crop juvenile winners to his credit, Invincible Spirit is clearly very adept at passing on the speed and precocity associated with his male line.

Green Desert has only once sired a Grade I winner over as long a distance as 1 1/4 miles--the American-raced White Heart--but Invincible Spirit, with his stamina-packed bottom line, has already matched that feat. His dashing son Lawman carried his speed beyond a mile and a quarter nine days ago, when he landed the Prix du Jockey-Club.

Whether Invincible Spirit will make a habit of siring top middle-distance performers remains to be seen, and I expect he'll ultimately make his name principally as a sire of smart sprinter-milers, just as Green Desert has done.

Needless to say, there is plenty of stamina in the bottom half of Lawman's pedigree, even though his broodmare sire is Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Gulch. His second dam Light the Lights proved herself one of the best staying fillies in France in 1988 when she won the G2 Prix de Pomone over 1 11/16 miles and ran a very respectable ninth in the Arc. Lawman's third dam, the accomplished broodmare Lighted Glory, was also a Group 1 performer in France, as well as being a half-sister to the high-class stayers King Luthier and Torus.

This excellent female line traces to the 1000 Guineas winner Picture Light, whose descendants have won all five of Britain's Classics. Another member of the Picture Play family is the Classic-winning miler Desert Prince, a Green Desert colt who was the highest-rated three-year-old of 1998.

Incidentally, Desert Prince is inbred 4x4 to Never Bend through Courtly Dee and Mill Reef, and so is Green Desert's outstanding son Oasis Dream. This inbreeding appears one generation further back in Lawman's pedigree and also in the pedigree of another of Invincible Spirit's first crop group winners, Captain Marvelous. The second dams of Lawman and Captain Marvelous are both by Shirley Heights, a stallion who appears as the broodmare sire of five of Green Desert's stakes winners.

I am feeling guilty that I have got this far into Lawman's story without mentioning the tremendous record of his dam, Laramie. This daughter of Gulch finished fourth of 12 on the second of her two starts in minor company in Ireland, without showing much ability, but she must now be a contender for any Broodmare of the Year awards. As a non-winner, Laramie was sent by Petra Bloodstock to comparatively inexpensive stallions but that hasn't stopped three of her first five foals from becoming group winners. Her mating with the £6,000 Inchinor resulted in Lattice, who became Laramie's first Classic winner over Chantilly's 2,100-metre course when she took the 2004 Prix de Diane. It was Laramie's rendezvous with the Ir10,000gns Mujadil which produced Satri, who graduated from handicap company to win a Group 3 and finish second in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest. It should pay to keep an eye on Laramie's next foal, a yearling colt by Cape Cross, another accomplished son of Green Desert.

Mention of Cape Cross reminds me that, despite leaving a sizeable legacy for speed, Green Desert has several stallion sons with top middle-distance performers to their credit. Cape Cross, of course, is best known as the sire of Ouija Board, while Desert Style gave us Mandesha, France's champion three-year-old filly last year. Desert Sun's daughter Sunline, the extraordinary New Zealand-bred, twice won the prestigious W.S. Cox Plate at around 1 1/4 miles, so Lawman joined some illustrious company when he won at Chantilly.

BELMONT OVERNIGHT TV RATINGS SLUMP

Overnight television ratings for ABC's coverage of the June 9 Belmont Stakes from New York slumped 14 percent from the modest levels of a year ago. The two-hour telecast from 5-7 p.m. EDT registered a 3.1 rating and a 7 share, down from a 3.6 in 2006. In overnight ratings, each ratings point equals 770,000 viewers, and the share refers to the percentage of TVs in use that were tuned to the program. The program, which featured a thrilling victory by the filly Rags to Riches, showed a continued decline from 2005, the last year NBC televised all three Triple Crown races. NBC registered a 5.0 for the 2005 Belmont. This year's telecast drew a 1.8 rating in the pre-race segment from 5-5:30, and a 3.5 for the 5:30-7 p.m. race segment. The Belmont still drew more viewers than most other sporting events shown over the weekend. Regional baseball telecasts on FOX June 9 measured a 2.2 rating. PGA golf on CBS registered a 1.4, and French Open tennis on NBC returned a 1.8. ABC's coverage of the NBA Finals the following evening drew a 6.9. The leading markets for the Belmont were: 1) Louisville, 8.0/17; 2) West Palm Beach 6.0/13; 3) Cleveland 5.8/14; 4) Baltimore 5.2/12; and 5) Pittsburgh 5.2/12. ABC's contract to televise the Belmont Stakes has now run its two-year course, the maximum length of time the New York Racing Association could negotiate given its license to run racing in New York expires at the end of 2007. In related ratings news, ABC's telecast of its Ruffian television movie drew a 2.9 rating and 5 share June 9 from 9-11 p.m. EDT. The movie, which documented the story of the brilliant race filly from the 1970s, finished third in its time slot behind "American's Most Wanted" on FOX (3.7) and "Die Another Day," a film on CBS that drew a 4.1. NBC showed "Scary Movie," which registered a 1.9.
