Blood-Horse

GRABBING THE FOSTER BY ITS HORNS

Flashy Bull (Holy Bull) made an impact in a handfull of graded stakes at two and three, but has really come into his own as an older horse and landed a career high in yesterday's GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs. Sent off as the fifth choice in the wagering here, the gray settled in fourth as **Mr. Umphrey** (Jules) clicked off fractions of :23.39 and :46.45. The West Point flagbearer began to put in his rally on the turn for home and opened up daylight in the stretch, but became leg weary in deep stretch and just held off **Magna Graduate** (Honor Grades) to win it by a head. **Master Command** (A.P. Indy), favored at 8-5, ran into some trouble on the clubhouse turn and never threatened. "This horse is just a different horse this year," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said. "It's just amazing what a different horse he is from last year, from three to four years old." McLaughlin added that the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga July 28 may be next for Flashy Bull. **Cont p2**

Take D'Tour (Tour d' Or) has made a name for herself winning one-turn routes at Belmont Park, and made it two straight victories in the GI Ogden Phipps H. with a gutsy performance yesterday. Favored at even-money, she hooked up with **Teammate** (A.P. Indy) through :23.07 and :44.97 fractions, opened a clear lead in the stretch and had just enough left in the tank to hold off a fast-closing **Ginger Punch** (Awesome Again) by a neck. **Cont p3**

CHELOKEE DIGS DOWN DEEP FOR 'DANCER'

Chelokee (Cherokee Run) looked beaten in the stretch after **Zanjero** (Cherokee Run) gained command in yesterday's Gill Northern Dancer Breeders' Cup S. at Churchill Downs, but the Centennial Farms colorbearer gamely battled back to post a neck victory as the even-money favorite. "I didn't know what to think when [Zanjero] went by me," jockey Ramon Dominguez said. "I knew for sure that I had a little more horse left, because at that point I had not used mine, but at the same time, that other horse made such a bold move, it kind of left me wondering whether I could keep up in contention with that kind of a kick and, if that was the case, then nobody was going to be a match for him. After that horse made the lead, my horse had the opportunity to come back and challenge him, and I knew that I had a chance because my horse kept on battling." **Cont p5**

"This horse has improved with every start," jockey Robby Albarado said. "Kiaran told me that I might want to give him the first jump as he's a little racy, but with the amount of speed in the race it was pretty easy getting him back. I saw a little traffic trouble in the first turn, but I was on the outside of it so I got a clear trip the whole way. I squeezed on him turning for home, and he went right on. He kind of opened up turning for home and he held them off at the end."

Four Straight for Flashy Bull...

Flashy Bull had only a maiden win under his belt, but posted a second-place finish behind Bluegrass Cat in the GII Remsen S. as a juvenile, and third-place finishes in the GII Fountain of Youth S.-- he was moved up to second following the DQ of Corinthian from first--and the GII Ohio Derby. Given the rest of the season off following a well-beaten seventh in the GI Haskell Invitational H. in August, Flashy Bull resurfaced with a second-place finish in a Gulfstream allowance Jan. 26.

He cleared his first-level allowance in his next attempt at Gulfstream Mar. 4, then added a \$50,000 optional claimer at Aqueduct Apr. 18. Backed at 3-1 odds in the GIII William Donald Schaefer H. on the GI Preakness S. undercard, he outgamed Hesanoltsalt to the wire to win by a head.

Take D' Tour rattled off four straight victories last term, including the GII Shuvee H. May 21 and the Ogden Phipps June 17. Following a fourth-place finish in Saratoga's GI Go For Wand H. July 30, she returned to Belmont with a second-place finish in the GI Ruffian H. Sept. 10, but could only manage a sixth in the GI Beldame S. Oct. 7. The chestnut closed out the year with a year with a pair of stakes victories at Calder--the Elmer Heubeck Distaff H. Nov. 11 and the GIII Stage Door Betty H. Dec. 30. Take D' Tour began her six-year-old campaign with a runner-up effort in the Sunshine Millions Distaff S. at Santa Anita Jan. 27 and was given a breather before completing the exacta in the GI Apple Blossom H. last out Apr. 7. Take D' Tour became only the third mare to win back-to-back runnings of the Phipps. "I think we are probably going to wait for the [GII] Molly Pitcher [Breeders' Cup at Monmouth Park Aug. 25], trainer David Fawkes said. "That would give her a race over the track for the Breeders' Cup."

Indian Vale closed out her sophomore campaign with back-to-back wins in the GIII Turnback the Alarm H. at the Big A and the GII Falls City H. at Churchill in November. She only made one start last season--a well-beaten fifth in the GII Shuvee H. at Belmont in May--but returned from the sidelines with a 5 1/2-length tally in the GIII Next Move H. at Aqueduct Mar. 31. Favored at 6-5 over a sloppy Churchill surface in the GII Louisville Breeders' Cup S. May 4, the Melnyk homebred finished a close fourth behind Fiery Pursuit (Carson City), Asi Siempre and Baghdaria (Royal Academy). Sent off as the third choice in the wagering here, she pressed Fiery Pursuit through :23.81 and :47.32 fractions.

With John Velazquez aboard, Indian Vale gained a short lead at the six-furlong marker and held the late rallying tandem of Asi Siempre and Kettleoneup at bay.

Inca King made his first start for these connections a winning one under a heady ride by jockey Shaun Bridgmohan. Previously trained by Eduardo Caramori, the dark bay graduated in his seventh career start when making his grass debut at Gulfstream Mar. 8. He made it two straight with an allowance tally over Lattice (Arch) in a Keeneland allowance Apr. 27 and was making his stakes debut in this spot. Allowed to set an uncontested lead through fractions of :24.80 and :49.95, Inca King had plenty left for the stretch, drawing away to post an easy victory. Favored Duveen raced in tight quarters throughout after stumbling at the start, but failed to quicken once clear in stretch. "The pace scenario definitely favored him," trainer Steve Asmussen offered. "He's coming off a very good race at Keeneland where he beat a quality field. We were fortunate that the owners moved him into our barn."

He may be named Summer Doldrums, but this colt has put in thrilling runs in each of his two turf tries. While a big win in the Whirlaway S. over Aqueduct's inner track put him on the Triple Crown trail, he finished third in the Gill Gotham S. Mar. 10 and fourth in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 7, and trainer Rick Violette Jr. opted to regroup. The seal brown made his turf debut in Belmont's one-mile Straight Deal S. May 23 and, after a battle with Strike a Deal, lost the bob at the wire. Both colts returned in this rich affair and made it their own. Summer Doldrums skimmed the rail under Jose Lezcano, several lengths off fractions of :24.31, :48.84 and 1:13.75. Angled six wide turning for home, the Klaravich colorbearer hit the front in midstretch--an instant before Strike a Deal--and hung on tenaciously for his first graded win.

Chelokee stamped himself as one to watch last October with a 13 1/4-length maiden win at Delaware Park. The dark bay hit the board in his first two allowance attempts at Churchill and Gulfstream, then posted a 3/4-length allowance tally over For You Reppo and Sightseeing at the Hallandale oval Mar. 3. Sent off at 8-1 in the GI Florida Derby Mar. 3, Chelokee ran a very creditable third after running into some traffic trouble in the stretch. Freshened following that strong effort, he resurfaced on the GI Preakness S. undercard with a dominating performance against an overmatched field in the Barbaro S. Favored against a solid group here, he sat in third behind the dueling leaders and took over entering the turn for home. Zanjero rallied past Chelokee to lead by one length in the stretch, but couldn't sustain Chelokee's second wind and lost a tight one.

Park, Quite a Bride capped off the campaign with a third in the Nov. 26 Gill Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill Downs. The chestnut filly opened her 2007 season with a victory in the Turf Distaff S. at Tampa Bay Apr. 7 and missed by just a nose in her latest, the May 5 Gill Distaff Turf Mile over a yielding Churchill lawn. The second choice to go one better here, she broke sharply under jockey Robby Albarado, cruised through an easy opening half and let it out down the lane to win handily. The final time was a new course record. "She did it within herself; she had her ears up," jockey Robby Albarado said. "She felt some pressure from the outside and kind of stretched herself out and finished up well."

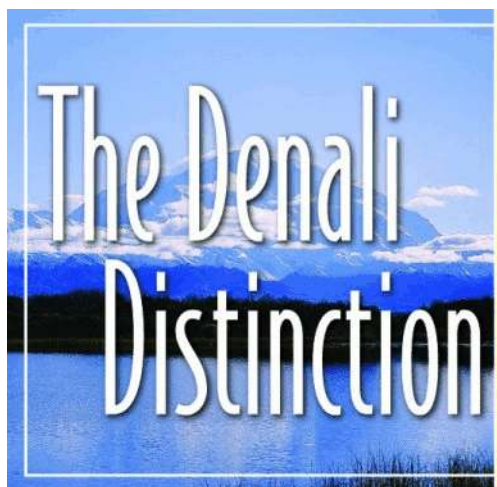

The Jim Bolger-trained filly will try to turn the tables on Princess Zahra Aga Khan's **Darjina (Fr)** (Zamindar), who beat her a head in the May 13 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp. Trainer Andreas Wohler has confirmed the entry of Rennstall Darboven's G2 German 1000 Guineas winner **Mi Emma (Ger)** (Silvano {Ger}), while further international interest is provided by J. C. Gour's G3 Prix de la Grotte runner-up **Missvinski** (Stravinsky) from the Jean-Claude Rouget stable, and Pat Garvey's 1000 Guineas runner-up **Arch Swing** (Arch). Of the British entries, Sheikh Rashid bin Mohammed Al Maktoum's Poule d'Essai des Pouliches third **Rahiyah** (Rahy) and Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Yaqeen (GB)** (Green Desert) stood their ground in what is shaping up to be a championship decider. Yaqeen's trainer Michael Jarvis believes she can improve off her sixth in Newmarket's May 6 Classic. "We were delighted with her run in the Guineas, and she would have almost certainly been fourth and maybe third if she hadn't been hampered there," he said. 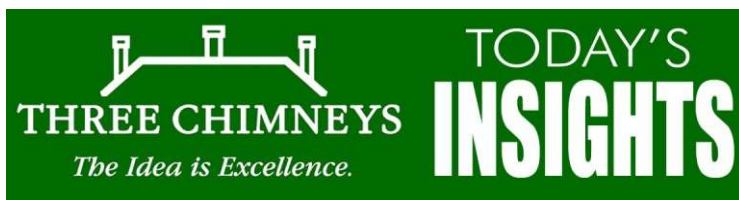

The "Tattersalls Millions" is comprised of the Tattersalls Million, Tattersalls Fillies' 800 and the Tattersalls £400,000 3YO Trophy. The series is restricted to horses purchased from Book 1 of the 2007 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale and will be held on the Rowley Mile in 2008. Commenting on the increase, Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony said, "We already guarantee the £2.2 million prize money, and our increased financial contribution reflects not only our commitment to the 'Tattersalls Millions,' which is the most valuable sales race series in the world, but also the importance we attach to the concerns of racehorse owners. The 'Tattersalls Millions' provides owners with unprecedented opportunities to win massive prize money and, while other similar races rely entirely on owners contributions for funding, we took heed of the views expressed by the ROA Council and made the decision to increase our contribution to the £2,200,000 by £55,000." Mahony also revealed that the sales company will make a change to the conditions of the £250,000 Tattersalls October Auction S., allowing an increase in the reimbursement to owners of horses eliminated at the declaration stage from the current 36 percent of the entry fees to 50 percent. THIS DATE IN HISTORY...

June 20, 1996...Emerald Downs in Auburn, Washington opened for its inaugural Thoroughbred meeting.

June 22, 1935...Seabiscuit, competing at Rhode Island's Narragansett Park, won his first race.

June 23, 1985...With his victory aboard Greinton in the Hollywood Gold Cup, **Laffit Pincay Jr.** became the second jockey in history to surpass \$100 million in career earnings.

June 24, 1893...The field for the American Derby at Washington Park was held at the post for 1 hour and 40 minutes, the **longest pre-race delay in history.** Boundless, with "Snapper" Garrison aboard, won the \$49,500 race, which was witnessed by a crowd of 48,000. Garrison and three other riders were each fined \$250 for bad conduct at the start.

June 24, 1952...Jockey **Eddie Arcaro** rode his 3000th career winner at Arlington Park, becoming the first American-born rider to reach the mark.
