She is the real Andretti. At the end of the most talked about G2 King's Stand S. ever run, Australian raiders occupied three of the first four positions, with the mare **Miss Andretti (Aus)** (Ihtiram {Ire}) leading the contingent home while laying waste to the track record. Putting the seal on a plan hatched after her G1 Newmarket H. success at Caulfield Mar. 10, the heavily supported 3-1 pick delivered her deadly kick off the furious

pace in the final eighth as Europe's best **Dandy Man (Ire)** (Mozart {Ire}) closed to within 1 3/4 lengths. "A few Melbourne Cups are pretty good, but I've lived all my life to do this and it's extremely exciting," trainer Lee Freedman commented. **King's Stand S. cont. p4**

RAMONTI SPOILS GEORGE'S RETURN

Godolphin ended a near two-year drought of Group 1 success in Britain courtesy of **Ramonti (Fr)** (Martino Alonso {Ire}) after a rousing four-horse blanket finish to yesterday's G1 Queen Anne S. The victory came at the expense of the returning **George Washington (Ire)** (Danehill), who had to settle for the bottom of the superfecta after failing to relax early. For Godolphin's Sheikh Mohammed, it was a case of patience being its own reward as he celebrated an outstanding seventh renewal for his operation since 1996. "Some years you have good horses and some years you have alright horses," he said. "That's the way the game goes, but Godolphin will always be here." **Queen Anne S. cont. p3**

A PRINCELY AFFAIR

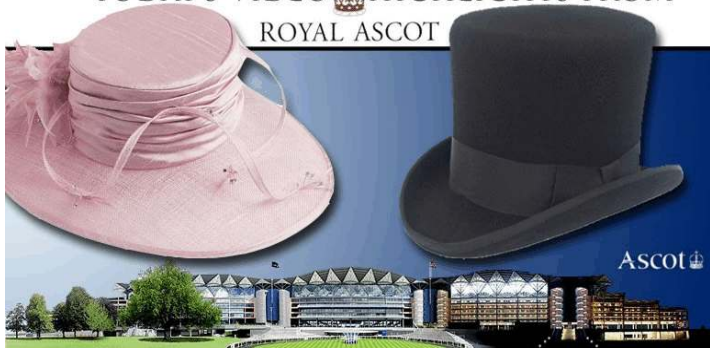

An Excellent Adventure...

Excellent Art was campaigned for Green by Neville Callaghan in 2006 and plied his trade over five and six furlongs, recording a first stakes success over the former trip by nine lengths in Sandown's Listed National S. in May. Third in the G2 Railway S. at The Curragh in July and G1 Prix Morny at Deauville the following month, he got the better of Doctor Brown (GB), now known as Helene Brilliant, in Newbury's G2 Mill Reef S. in September. Transferred to Ballydoyle for his sophomore season, the bay did not get the chance to reach top gear after running into a pocket during his debut for new connections in the French Guineas. Settled in rear by a confident Spencer early, he was threaded up the inner in the stretch to reel in the long-time leader Duke of Marmalade in the final 75 yards and was always holding his barnmate's game rally. "I did what I thought was best for the horse on the day in France, but felt that he would have won and won easily if he'd got the gaps," jockey Jamie Spencer said. "Today he's proved it and I always feel that this is the race that matters for the three-year-old milers, as all the Guineas winners come here and the best wins. Once I got the split a furlong down, I was always going to win and he did it snugly in the end." Commenting on the historic trifecta, Aidan O'Brien told *PA Sport*, "We were delighted with the race and they are three very good colts. We always thought they were very good, but it is hard to know what is between them, especially when they don't work together. There are plenty of races for them and the winner has the G1 Sussex S. [at Goodwood July 7] and all those other races open to him."

Rebel Without a Placing...

Phil Cunningham's G1 English and Irish 2000 Guineas scorer Cockney Rebel (Ire) (Val Royal {Fr}), sent off the even-money crowd's choice, came from rear with his customary rattle late on, but threw away his chance by veering left in the closing stages. "The horse is fine, but he's run three group ones in the space of six weeks," his owner said. "I think he hung a little bit left and that is there for everyone to see. I'm absolutely gutted, but congratulations to the winner. Coming into the straight he looked the winner, but he hung across the track." Nurtured by Alduino and Giuseppe Botti, Ramonti took the G2 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas) before going within a head of completing a Classic double in the G1 Derby Italiano at the Capannelle two years ago. At four, he emerged as Italy's champion miler with wins in San Siro's main events, the G2 Premio Emilio Turati in June and G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua in October, before adding the G2 Premio Ribot to his tally back in Rome the following month. Purchased by his new connections following a fine third in the G1 Hong Kong Mile at Sha Tin in December, he proved he retained his ability when a head runner-up to Red Evie (Ire) (Intikhab) in the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury May 19.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a ▲ will denote a first-time Grade/Group 1 winner, a + will indicate first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

Taken straight onto the lead by Frankie Dettori, the bay was swamped by Jeremy before the eighth pole, but rallied gamely to win a four-horse war with that rival, Turtle Bowl and George Washington (Ire) (Danehill). "It's very hard to make the running here at Group-1 level, so this was a gutsy performance," his rider commented. "They all went by me, but I knew he

stayed a little further and he would come back. I had to get really serious at the end, but he really dug for me and got his head down on the line. I didn't really know the horse last time, but I spoke to Endo Botti, who rode him last year, and he told me he brave as he stays

well. It's been a while since we won a Group 1 in England and I am so thrilled for my boss. We're back where we belong." Racing Manager Simon Crisford added, "He's really tough and seasoned, but when we bought him we didn't really see him winning a Queen Anne, so all credit to him. He might need a little bit of time now, but he could step up in trip or maybe run in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois [at Deauville Aug. 12]." George Washington raced keenly in the front rank early and, after settling for Mick Kinane, the 10-11 favorite was briefly outpaced before finishing strongly. "We were delighted with his run," Aidan O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "It was a good run back and he showed his early pace. He looked out of it for a while, but came home well. We always thought he would get 10 furlongs and that could be an option, but we will get him home and see how he is first." Miss Andretti has made giant strides since finishing 11th to Takeover Target (Aus) (Celtic Swing {GB}) in last year's Newmarket H. at Caulfield, winning seven of her next nine starts. Among those, Moonee Valley's G1 Manikato S. in September, Feb. 3 G1 Lightning S. and Feb. 17 G1 Australia S. On the former occasion, she broke the 1200-metre track record before claiming the 1000-metre equivalent in the Lightning. Confirming her metamorphosis in

this year's renewal of the Newmarket, the bay was rated the number one by the Ascot crowds and rewarded that faith with a memorable display of speed. Racing out wide towards the far rail, she was in the right place positioned near the murderous early fractions by Craig Newitt. Asked for more inside the final quarter, she drew alongside her compatriot Magnus before surging beyond the reach of Dandy Man, who had been forced to race virtually alone on the stands' side.

"I think it's a marvelous thing that we can come here and compete," Freedman added. "We'll continue to do that, hopefully with some horses over a bit more ground next time. After the Newmarket, we waited three months and gave her a break. There was the work, the admin, inoculations and the hope that she traveled well and settled in well, so it was a massive gamble. Craig knows her and has a great record on her -he said she was near the top all the way chasing as they went so hard, but she kept picking up and is more of a 1200-metre mare anyway." Freedman is looking at emulating the double of Choisir (Aus) in Saturday's G1 Golden Jubilee S., but only if the six-year-old gives the right signals. "She'll stay in the paddock for two days and if she's eating up and she's well, she'll tell us that she wants to run." Last year's winner Takeover Target will be in Saturday's line-up, while Dandy Man is likely to miss that six-furlong contest and head to Newmarket for the July 13 G1 July Cup. Cometh the hour, cometh the man and Aidan O'Brien instantly stamped his presence on the Royal meeting by unleashing a potential Classic contender in Henrythenavigator in this opener. While the bay had already established his class over seven furlongs when making most of the running and recording a seven-length success in a Gowran Park maiden May 6, he faced a different challenge dropped back a panel here. Breaking well from his wide draw, the Kentucky-bred stalked the early pace before being asked to stretch passing halfway. Responding to Mick Kinane's urgings, he rolled by Pencil Hill (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) at the eighth pole before asserting to provide his jockey with his 39th Royal win. "We were very worried coming here drawn out wide with only one run in a maiden behind him," commented O'Brien, who was winning this prize for the fifth time since 1997. "He jumped sharp and Mick just took him back to teach him--it's a big thing running out there and being produced in the middle of the track, with the stand and crowds--so we're delighted with him. We always thought he was a horse who would get further than six and he looked today like he would, but he is naturally very quick like his dam. She was a Sadler's Wells who won the Moyglare Stud S. over seven, but I remember even then she had to be dropped in and relaxed because she had a lot of natural speed. The 2000 Guineas is a long way away, but we've always hoped that's the kind of horse he would be." Jockey Ted Durcan said of the staying-on runner-up Swiss Franc, "The ground may have been a little on the fast side." Putting that firmly behind him with a convincing success under a penalty in Sandown's G3

Gordon Richards S. Apr. 27, he is primed for a major effort. "It's a very tough race; I would be surprised if you met as tough a field in the Breeders' Cup," Reddam's Racing Manager Jamie McCalmont told *PA Sport*. "They all have claims. Although we beat Notnowcato at Sandown, that was his first start of the season, so there are excuses there. You have got a Derby winner in Sir Percy and he would go close if he was at his best, while Dylan Thomas is obviously a high-class horse. When Andre Fabre sends one over from France for Royal Ascot I always think you have to take note. Manduro wasn't beaten far behind Ouija Board last season and he seems to be even better this year."

Cheveley Park Stud's recent fortunes have ensured that their runners often clash, and that is again the case here as **Nannina** and **Echelon** go head-to-head for David and Patricia Thompson's operation. While the former was highly impressive when annexing the G1 Coronation S. at this meeting last year, she failed to add further success throughout her sophomore campaign. She was reported to have needed her return when third behind Echelon in Epsom's G3 Princess Elizabeth S. June 1 and should be sharper today. Sir Michael Stoute has saddled two of the three winners of this race since it was introduced in 2004 and Echelon looks a progressive type who can build on her second to Soviet Song (Ire) in this race 12 months ago. Her Princess Elizabeth success was preceded by a win in Newmarket's G3 Dahlia S. May 5 and she enters this on an upward curve. "[Nannina] ran very well at Epsom. We got the buzz and the fizz out of her," the stud's Managing Director Chris Richardson told *PA Sport*. "I probably think the trip may be a little short as I think she's better over 10 furlongs, but there wasn't really a suitable option. We hope it stays relatively dry for her--she's in good form. Echelon will be better suited by the trip." Last year's G2 Prix Jean Romanet winner **Satwa Queen** split the top-class Mandesha (Fr) and Alexandrova (Ire) when second in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp in October before finishing fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf at Churchill the following month. Sixth in the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin in December, she was a respectable length runner-up to Macleya (Ger) attempting to give that smart mare nine pounds in the G3 Prix Allez France at Chantilly May 2.

Richard Hannon first enjoyed success in this contest back in 1981 and when Gilded (Ire) scored 12 months ago, she was registering a fourth renewal for the Marlborough maestro. **Sweepstake** looks the pick of his duo, having shown impressive acceleration and courage when opening her stakes account and beating **Lady Avenger** in the Listed National S. at Sandown last time May 31. Peter Chapple-Hyam sent out Shining Hour to win this for the Sangster family in 1999 and saddles another of their homebreds here in **Polar Circle**. She managed to overcome racing too freely in the early stages when taking a Newbury maiden on debut May 18. "I've been very happy with her progress since her one run," her trainer commented. "We will find out where we stand with her on Wednesday. I believe she will run a decent race but she would not want too much rain." **Regal Step** created such an impression when registering a first-time-out score at Nottingham June 6 that Highclere Thoroughbred Racing were prompted to open their cheque book. "She could well be the best filly I've trained and gives every indication of being a very high class horse," trainer Robert Cowell told *PA Sport*. "Looking at the speed figures compared to other potential candidates for the Queen Mary, you'd think she'll have a serious chance. I certainly wouldn't swap her for anything else." **Starlit Sands** is a rare runner for Kirsten Rausing and trainer Sir Mark Prescott in a race marked by precocity, but she looked sharp and professional when going two-for-two in a Thirsk maiden May 19 and conditions event at Catterick June 1. "She's not been led yet and I think she's fully entitled to be there," her conditioner said. "I'd prefer the ground to be on top."

He had previously extended his perfect run to four in the Apr. 11 Listed Prix Djebel over seven furlongs of Maisons-Laffitte's straight track and has those conditions again here. Trainer Jean-Claude Rouget is hopeful he can provide his Pau base with a notable first. "We decided to be wise and not go for the St James's Palace Stakes, as we have time to win a Group 1 later in the season," he told *Racing Post*. "This is the perfect distance for US Ranger." **Major Cadeaux** and **Sonny Red**, who were sixth and 15th respectively in the 2000 Guineas, form a two-pronged challenge from the Richard Hannon stable successful with Sergeev (Ire) in 1995 and Lots of Magic (GB) four years later. Major Cadeaux picks up a penalty for his impressive success in the G3 Greenham S. at Newbury Apr. 21 and had excuses for his Guineas defeat. "Major Cadeaux may be better over seven furlongs, although I don't see any reason why he shouldn't stay a mile," his trainer told the *Post*. "He's a very fast horse, but so is Sonny Red. He had a problem with a leg, but that has cleared up and he's going great. We go there with hope rather than confidence." **Strategic Prince** was also amongst the also-rans in the Newmarket Classic and was down the field in the June 2 G1 Epsom Derby when last seen. He represents the Paul Cole stable, whose River Deep dead-heated in 1994.

THE NEWER THAN NEW ASCOT

Overall, the newer-than-new Ascot gets pretty high marks. There are some design flaws that just can't be changed--escalators in the middle of the concourse definitely belong in airports, not in racetracks--but the good news was a lot more people were able to see a lot more racing yesterday. The Royal Enclosure was much more like a series of Clubhouse sections in America, or Members' Enclosures in the rest of Britain, except that to get in this Clubhouse, you still have to dress up like something out of My Fair Lady. I dunno, maybe it's okay the first couple of times you do it, but this is the best week of racing in the world. It's really more important, for the thousands of racing professionals who make the pilgrimage, to see the horses and the racing. Maybe I'm just being American, but I can't help feeling that morning suits belong to another era. But that's a different discussion: the really important thing for the professionals was that you had a lot better shot this year to actually see the races.

The first four races on day one, yesterday, were two Group 2 races, followed by two Group 1's. True to form, Coolmore won the two-year-old race (the G2 Coventry) and ran 1-2-3 in the one-mile G1 St. James's Palace for three-year-olds. Also true to form, Godolphin won a race for older horses (the G1 Queen Anne); and, true both to form and to the new world order, Australia ran one-three-four in the sprint (the G2 King's Stand). Let's review.

Royal Ascot's opening race was the G2 Coventry (attheraces.com video), run over six furlongs for two-year-olds. This is traditionally an especially hot race, probably the best of Royal Ascot's two-year-old races. Coolmore's homebred Henrythenavigator, bred on the highly successful Kingmambo/Sadler's Wells

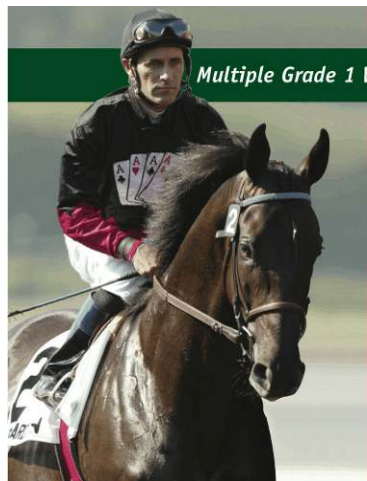

cross, had won his debut by seven lengths over seven furlongs in Ireland at the beginning of May. The late Indian Ridge did himself proud with the next two. Swiss Franc, by Mr. Greeley (what a record he has in Europe), is out of the very fast Indian Ridge mare Swiss Lake; and the third, impressive

maiden winner Luck Money, is by Indian Ridge himself. Pencil Hill, an impressive stakes winner in Ireland from Acclamation's first crop, was always prominent and battled on well to be fourth.

Next came the G2 King's Stand S. (attheraces.com video), run over five furlongs. Choisir (2003) and Takeover Target (2006) had already won this race for Australia, and this year they sent a whole squadron, including three of the first four favorites. Takeover Target was back, but he was only third favorite of the Australians. He battled on bravely to finish fourth, but the number one Aussie sprinter, the Northern Hemisphere six-year-old Miss Andretti (by Royal Academy's son, Ihtiram), was an impressive winner in :57.44, a new course record. Four-year-old Dandy Man, from Mozart's one and only crop, ran a great race to finish second for his new owner, Sheikh Mohammed's wife, Princess Haya. The outsider of the Australians, Magnus (Flying Spur), finished third; both the second and third are by sons of Danehill. Ihtiram, Miss Andretti's sire, was a 10-furlong stakes winner by Royal Academy. She's not exactly bred to be a rocket, but a rocket she is.

The G1 St. James's Palace S. (attheraces.com video) ideally brings the winners of the G1 English, French, and Irish Guineas together for what can be a decisive clash, effectively a "European 2000 Guineas," and a three-year-old mile early-season championship. Cockney Rebel, from the first crop by another son of Royal Academy, G1 Breeders' Cup Mile winner Val Royal, was made the hot favorite following wins in the English and Irish Guineas. He hung left in the straight, though, and could only finish a close-up fifth, just behind the G1 English 2000 third Dutch Art (Medicean), who maybe didn't quite stay this stiff mile. Aidan O'Brien ran three, and they ran one-two-three. Unlucky G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) fourth Excellent Art (Pivotal) got up to win, with long-time leader Duke of Marmalade (Danehill), previously fourth in both the G1 English and Irish Guineas, hanging on grimly for second; and French 2000 winner Astronomer Royal (Danzig) in third. Best two-year-old race of the day: Coolmore. Best three-year-old race of the day: Coolmore.

The best four-year-old race of the day--the G1 one-mile Queen Anne--went to Godolphin (attheraces.com video). The even-money favorite was actually Coolmore's George Washington, returned from stud, but even Mick Kinane couldn't anchor him. Everybody makes a big deal about his temperament, but to me he just looked like a horse who had been off for 7 1/2 months, and simply ran too keen. He still got going late and finished a close-up fourth, and I would bet on him redeeming the losses next time out--whether that is at a mile or 10 furlongs. Frankie Dettori, who proves over and over again he is the best front-running jockey since Steve Cauthen, had just enough up his sleeve to win with the ex-Italian five-year-old Ramonti, who is by a virtually unknown but very successful sire in Italy, Martino Alonso (by Marju). Brushwood Stable's Betty Moran's Jeremy (Danahill Dancer) ran a bang-up second, with French-trained Turtle Bowl (by an obscure son of Night Shift, Dyhim Diamond) in third.

Next Up...

Today's feature is the G1 Prince of Wales's S. for 'olders' over 10 furlongs. This looks like the best race of the meet: there are only seven runners, but such is the strength of the field that last year's G1 Epsom Derby winner, Sir Percy (Mark of Esteem), is only fifth favorite. The race features last month's G1 Tattersalls' Gold Cup one-two, Notnowcato (Inchiner) and Dylan Thomas (Danahill); last year's G1 Breeders' Cup Turf winner, Red Rocks (Galileo); and the ultra-progressive recent French G1 winner, Manduro (Monsun). And the hits just keep on coming.

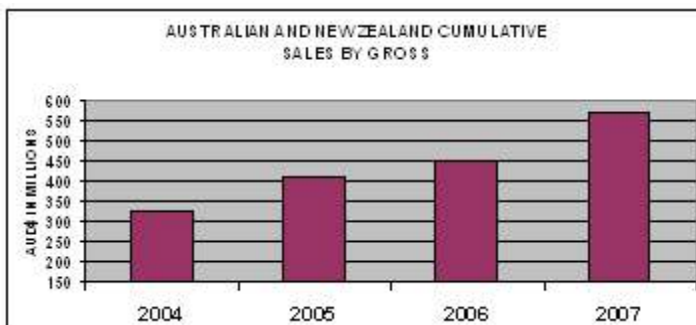

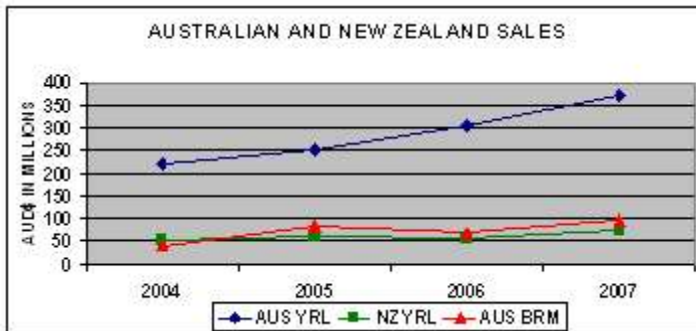

Going into last winter, Flashy Bull was considered a fairly serious GI Kentucky Derby hopeful. He had ended his juvenile season with a good second to the then undefeated Bluegrass Cat in the GII Remsen S., and

first time out at three finished fourth, beaten only 3 3/4 lengths by eventual Derby winner Barbaro in the GIII Holy Bull S. The GII Fountain of Youth S. saw another creditable performance as Flashy Bull crossed the line third, a neck behind First Samurai, who subsequently received the win when the first home, Corinthian, was disqualified for bothering Flashy Bull in the stretch. Although beaten 10

lengths in the GI Florida Derby, Flashy Bull did take his place in the first Classic, but, after breaking awkwardly, was towards the rear throughout. He made three more starts that season, taking third in the GII Ohio Derby, but was again found wanting against the best, ending the campaign being beaten 27 lengths in the GI Haskell Invitational H. Away from the races for nearly four months, Flashy Bull has returned at four a much better horse. Second on his seasonal debut, Flashy Bull took allowance events at Gulfstream and Aqueduct before a hard-fought victory over Hesanoltsalt in the GIII William Donald Schaefer H. credited him with his first stakes win. On Saturday, Flashy Bull extended his winning streak to four, when holding off the hard-charging Magna Graduate to take the GI Stephen Foster H.

Flashy Bull's sire, Holy Bull, has to rank as one of the best U.S. dirt horses of the last 30 years. An undefeated Grade I winner at two, he was both Horse of the Year and champion three-year-old the following year.

Despite Holy Bull's brilliance as a runner, expectations for his stud career were tempered by his less than fashionable pedigree. The Florida-bred was the only top-class horse to be sired by tough Grade III-winning sprinter, Great Above, a relative to the mighty Dr. Fager (he was by Minnesota Mac, a son of Dr. Fager's son, Rough'n Tumble, out of two-time champion sprinter Ta

Wee, a half-sister to Dr. Fager). Holy Bull's dam, Sharon Brown, did produce another stakes winner in the Crafty Prospector filly, Winnie D., but overall the female line is distinctly lacking in black-type. In general, brilliant runners with modest pedigrees have tended to throw more to their bloodlines than their race record, but Holy Bull has done far better than most of this kind.

Holy Bull has sired 31 stakes winners in his first nine crops, including champion two-year-old Macho Uno, GI Kentucky Derby winner Giacomo, as well as other Grade I winners Confessional, Bishop Court Hill and Pohave, and graded scorers Woke Up Dreamin, Turnofthecentury, Estimraar, Thunder Blitz, Crash Course, Hollywood Picture and Holy Bubbette.

Flashy Bull's dam, the Mt. Livermore mare Iridescence, is off to a good start to her stud career. Flashy Bull is her second foal, and her third is this year's Count Fleet S. winner Pink Viper. The granddam, Orient Pearl, is a half-sister to the dam of Shadwell GI Turf Mile winner and champion Canadian older horse Perfect Soul, and the third dam, A Status Symbol, is a stakes-winning daughter of Exclusive Native and champion Canadian two-year-old filly Queen Louie.

Flashy Bull and Macho Uno are both by Holy Bull out of Blushing Groom-line mares. We can also note that Flashy Bull's broodmare sire, Mt. Livermore, has sired six stakes winners, including two-time champion sprinter Housebuster, out of mares by Holy Bull's sire, Great Above; and that the GII Mazarine S. winner, Higher World, the only graded stakes winner to date out of a Holy Bull mare--is by Mt. Livermore's son Peaks and Valleys.

The tie-in between the pedigrees of Great Above and Mt. Livermore would seem to be that Great Above's grandsire, Rough'n Tumble, is by a son of Questionnaire out of a mare by Bull Dog, the same formula which produced Mt. Livermore's third dam, Questar (Holy Bull also has a stakes winner out of a mare by Distinctive Pro, whose own broodmare sire, Distinctive, is out of a sister to Questar). Interestingly enough, Mt. Livermore has two other stakes winners out of mares carrying Dr. Fager (the close relative to Great Above) and three more out of mares carrying In Reality (who is out of a mare by Rough'n Tumble). Looking down the road, it should obviously pay dividends to breed Holy Bull and his sons to mares by Mt. Livermore and his sons (particularly Peaks and Valleys), and it could well be that Mt. Livermore's champion sprinter son, Orientate, will prove suited by Holy Bull mares.

Ed Friendly is survived by his second wife, Paula Reddish Zinnemann, daughter Brooke and son Edwin III, and three grandchildren. Services will be private. 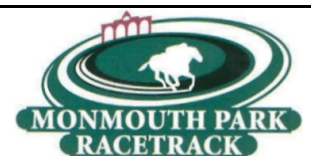
