**Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill) in a thrilling finale to yesterday's G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot. He shaded that foe in the betting at 15-8 and lived up to those hopes. Manduro got first run under Stephane Pasquier at the top of the straight and was always keeping the Ballydoyle giant at bay to record a 1 1/4-

length success. In so doing, he made amends for his third-place finish in this contest 12 months ago. "Last year he got boxed in and he's a horse who needs some space," trainer Andre Fabre commented. "It was an interesting lesson, and today Stephane had different conditions, with a clear run, a good pace and not many runners." Cont. p2

**YEATS OUT TO JOIN THE GREATS**

Now in its bicentennial year, the G1 Ascot Gold Cup is the Royal meeting's most treasured jewel, and **Yeats (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) will attempt to stake his claim as one of the race's most esteemed characters. Highly impressive when recording a four-length success 12 months ago, Susan Magnier and Diane Nagle's imposing bay is now firmly established as Europe's head of state amongst the stayers. Last year, he came into this marathon on his seasonal bow, but the six-year-old has two facile wins under his belt this time including in May 30 Listed Saval Beg S. at Leopardstown. Trainer Aidan O'Brien believes there is better to come. "We've been very happy with his two runs this year and, for some reason, he has gone really classy and pacey in his work," O'Brien commented. "Maybe that is maturity or maybe it's because he's had a clear run this time. He's a bigger, stronger and heavier horse than ever before, so obviously this will be the next test for him." **'REBEL SUFFERS FRACTURE**

Phil Cunningham's **Cockney Rebel (Ire)** (Val Royal {Fr}) has reportedly emerged from his fifth-place effort in Tuesday's G1 St James's Palace S. with a fracture of his pelvis. The G1 English and Irish 2000 Guineas winner was sent off the even-money favorite for the one-mile contest at Royal Ascot, but failed to hit the board after drifting left in the closing stages. After the initial prognosis of a pulled muscle yesterday morning, a later scan revealed that Cockney Rebel had suffered a more serious injury. "We got him to the surgery this morning and gave him a scan which showed the fracture," trainer Geoff Huffer told *PA Sport*. "It's not life-threatening, but that's racing, I'm afraid. It's too early to say, but he could be out for a month or two. He will have the best treatment any horse can have and will be brought back as good as ever--if not better."

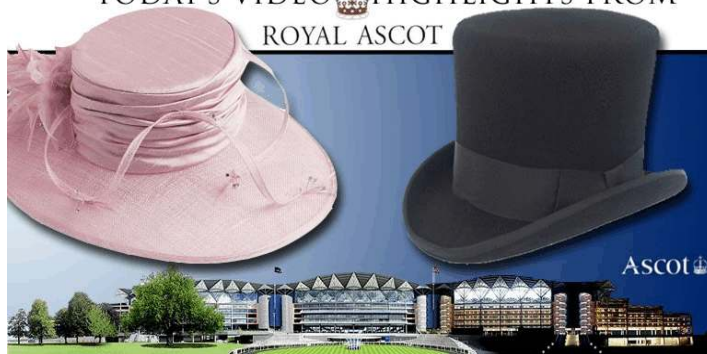

ambitions, but, under the care of Andre Fabre he emerged as a top-class international runner at four in 2006. Third in this race last year, he made the frame in both the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville in August and G1 Prix du Moulin back at

Longchamp in September. Making his five-year-old bow in Newmarket's G3 Earl of Sefton S. Apr. 19, he bounded away to win by daylight before breaking through at the top level in this year's renewal of the Prix d'Ispehan May 21. Manduro settled in third while traveling comfortably off the ever-increasing pace set by Sir Percy (GB) (Mark of Esteem {Ire}), was asked to stretch before the quarter pole and seized the lead there. Despite the instant threat of Dylan Thomas and Christophe Soumillon, he was not to be denied and was firmly on top at the line. "He's a top-class miler as well and I had a little worry with the distance last season, but now I'm convinced he'll get even further," his trainer added. "He's entered in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. [at this track July 28], and the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 7] is an obvious target." Owner Baron Georg von Ullmann expressed his delight with the latest son of Monsun to hit the heights. "To win such a race is amazing," he said. "We came here very optimistic and we knew we had a good horse, but he had to produce, and he produced. He was very unlucky last year, and Pasquier fits the horse very well." Aidan O'Brien said of Dylan Thomas, "We are delighted--he's run really well. **TRACK RECORDS EXPLORED** Ascot's Clerk of the Course Chris Stickels yesterday reacted to the swathe of track records set on the opening day of the Royal Ascot meeting. Four of the six races beat the times of 2006, which was the first time the new re-laid track had been used after the redevelopment program. They included the sensational winning time of Miss Andretti (Aus) in the G2 King's Stand S., which took over two seconds off that of Takeover Target (Aus) 12 months ago. "Because the new track was completed in 2005, records go back only as far as last year, so it's early days yet," he explained. "They were really exceptional horses running yesterday, but, obviously, the track has to have time to settle down. There was a quite a tailwind yesterday and the ground was certainly fast and probably getting faster as the afternoon went on, as it was a good, drying day."

Cheveley Park Stud's Nannina is becoming an Ascot specialist, recording her second Royal success in impressive style in yesterday's G2 Windsor Forest S. David and Patricia Thompson's homebred had produced a scintillating turn of acceleration to annex the G1 Coronation S. 12 months ago, and that was in evidence again yesterday as the 3-1 joint-favorite registered a commanding three-length success. "She's back to her best, but I still think a mile and a quarter will be her trip," trainer John Gosden commented. Nannina's success in the Coronation was her second at the highest level, having beaten subsequent G1 Epsom Oaks winner Alexandrova (Ire) in a thrilling renewal of the 2005 G1 Fillies' Mile at Newmarket. Runner-up in the G1 Falmouth S. on Newmarket's July Course in July, she was third best behind Ouija Board (GB) and Alexander Goldrun (Ire) in the epic G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood in August. The bay was fourth in the G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown in September and fifth in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp the following month to conclude her sophomore campaign.

Nannina eased back into action with a third to Echelon (Danehill) in Epsom's G3 Princess Elizabeth S. June 1. Settled just off the moderate early pace here, it was plain sailing as she was asked to move to the front with a quarter mile remaining by Jimmy Fortune. Quickening clear despite rolling to the right and onto the far side rail, she was in splendid isolation as Satwa Queen (Fr) stayed on into an unthreatening second. "Jimmy got a bump before the two and he thought I'd better go now, as if you wait off not a strong pace, you're going to get caught and she opened up," Gosden added. "At Epsom last time the ground was too soft, but she got a run in and she just likes good, or good to firm--that suits her action. The G1 Nassau S. [at Goodwood Aug. 4] is a huge target for us, as I think that was the best race of her life last year. We are also in the G1 Falmouth S. [at Newmarket July 11], which was a Mickey Mouse race last year where they trotted and then sprinted; and the G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh, which might come a bit soon as it's in 10 days' time."

Elletelle finished third behind subsequent Listed Isabel Morris S. winner and G2 Coventry S. fourth Pencil Hill (GB) in a six-furlong conditions event on debut at Naas May 16. She showed battling qualities when breaking her maiden over that trip at Leopardstown last time June 6 and proved the drop back a panel held no fears with another tenacious success here. Missing a beat at the break, the bay soon recovered to race behind the fast early pace and needed luck to make her way through the crowds passing halfway. Getting the splits inside the final furlong, she reeled in the enterprisingly ridden Starlit Sands in the final yards to earn the spoils. "She traveled very well at Leopardstown and it's a very stiff five here," jockey Johnny Murtagh said. "I said to the owners not to worry if they saw us getting outpaced a bit early on, as the last furlong takes a bit of getting and they usually go fast. She missed the kick a bit, but I was traveling very well through the race and she came home well. Everything worked out really well for her--the gaps came just in time for me and I got a lovely run. She's tough, hardy and genuine and got to the line well. I think five or six furlongs is no problem to her."

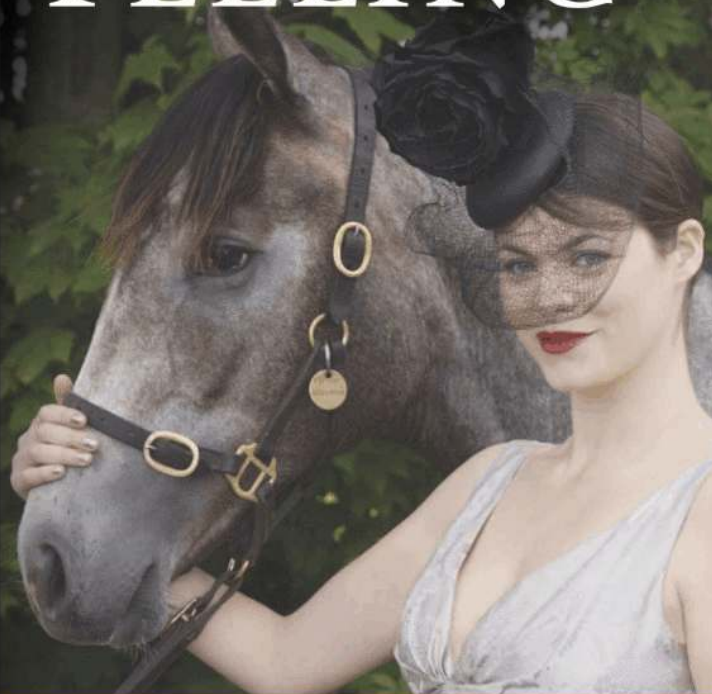

Tariq struck for the Authorized (Ire) combination of Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar and Peter Chapple-Hyam when recording an impressive success in this competitive affair. Sidelined after finishing third away from the stands-rail bias in the G2 Coventry S. here 12 months ago, the chestnut was slow to come to hand this spring and was off the board in both the Apr. 21 G3 Greenham S. at Newbury and G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp May 13. Rebounding to take the Listed King Charles II S. at Newmarket last time May 26, he was on the right side of the track this time around to make amends for last year's reversal. Settled towards the rear off the generous early tempo, he was unleashed on the far side passing the quarter pole, inhaled favored US Ranger with 150 yards remaining and drew away for a comfortable score. "He ran very well here in the Coventry last year and I still believe if he had been drawn low he would have won," Chapple-Hyam explained. "He injured himself in that race, so the owners were very patient, and we gave him time off and he spent six months in a field. I rushed him back trying to get him to the French Guineas, which he wasn't ready for, but it made a man of him, and after that he started to improve and his coat was better. His work had been good, and [jockey] Jimmy [Fortune] did it perfectly and got it spot-on. He'll probably get a mile now, so he might go for the G1 Sussex S. [at Goodwood Aug. 1]."

Barshiba beat the subsequent four-time winner Zaham on Lingfield's Polytrack on her sophomore bow Feb. 10 before tackling more prestigious company in Newmarket's Apr. 18 G3 Nell Gwyn S. Beaten two lengths when fifth there, she trailed in 15th in the G1 1000 Guineas at that track when last seen May 6. Rank throughout the early stages of this contest, the chestnut was still urging to go faster as she ran into a wall of rivals inside the final quarter. 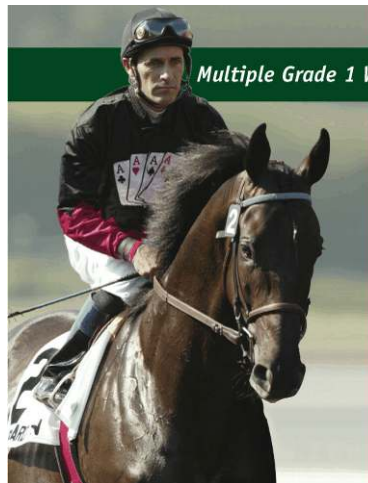

While **Yeats** bids to become the eighth multiple winner of this contest in the last four decades, Terry Cooper's **Sergeant Cecil (GB)** is looking to spoil the party. After a string of consistent efforts in this division, the popular eight-year-old defied a penalty for his win in last year's G1 Prix du Cadran to best **Geordieland (Fr)** in the G2 Yorkshire Cup at York May 18. Trainer Rod Millman is hoping he can improve on last year's fifth in this event. "He does seem to be improving," he told *PA Sport*. "The horse is very, very well and everything has been planned for this Gold Cup. It was great to win the French Gold Cup [Cadran], but there's nothing like the Ascot Gold Cup. In hindsight, he didn't come right last year until the backend. This year he ran a great race in the Yorkshire Cup and he couldn't have run a better trial. It's wonderful to have a horse good enough to have a go at it and he's got a live chance, even though we're up against Yeats, who was probably the best Gold Cup winner for several years." France was successful two years back with **Westerner (GB)**, and the great **Sagaro (GB)** flew the tricolore when achieving the feat of winning three renewals from 1975 to 1977. George Strawbridge's **Montare (Ire)** and Beatrice Hermelin's **Lord du Sud (Fr)** form a strong challenge this time, and the former suggested she was a high-class stayer in the making when beating **Bellamy Cay (GB)**, **Sergeant Cecil** and **Lord du Sud** in the G1 Prix Royal-Oak at Longchamp in October. She warmed up with a third behind that rival on very soft ground in the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier at that track May 20, but may reverse that form on this livelier surface. "She has never done the distance, but I think she will stay as she has always finished well in her races," trainer Jonathan Pease told *Racing Post*. Godolphin have won this race four times since 1996 and rely on **Cherry Mix (Fr)** a three-times winner at the highest level and an intriguing contender upped markedly in trip. He was fourth in the G1 Presidente della Repubblica at the Capannelle last time May 13 and trainer Saeed bin Suroor is hopeful he can last the trip. "Cherry Mix is in good form," he said. "He came back well from his last race, which he needed. He seems happier in himself now. The 2 1/2-mile distance is new for him, but if he settles and relaxes, it could suit him." Sir Michael Stoute is seeking a second renewal and Cheveley Park Stud's **Allegretto (Ire)** showed that stamina is her forte when grinding out success in the G2 Henry II S. at Sandown on her latest outing May 29.

**All My Loving** bids to emulate recent winners **Punctilious (GB)**, **Yashmak** and **Bahr (GB)**, who had previously placed in the G1 Epsom Oaks. Her third behind **Light Shift** in that June 1 Classic is strong form, as was her runner-up effort in the May 9 Listed **Cheshire Oaks**, where she split the subsequent Oaks heroine and G2 Oaks d'Italia winner **Fashion Statement (GB)**. **Dalvina** also took part at Epsom, but was a disappointing 11th, having looked a prime contender with an easy success in Newmarket's Listed **Pretty Polly S.** May 6. "Epsom was extremely disappointing, but I had huge doubts about the soft ground and her ability to handle the track," trainer Ed Dunlop commented. "Unfortunately, I was proved correct on both accounts but she has come out of the race extremely well." Luca Cumani has yet to add this prize to his major-race record, but his unbeaten homebred **Cosmodrome** looked to have a bright future when taking the Listed **Height of Fashion S.** at Goodwood last time May 24. That followed a debut score on Wolverhampton's polytrack Apr. 28 and she holds strong claims. "She ran on the all-weather because I didn't want to run her on firm ground and although her listed race wasn't very strong, she couldn't have done it better," her conditioner said. "She deserves to be there." Michael Jarvis saddles an intriguing contender in **Silkwood**, who steps up off a Sandown handicap score Apr. 27. "We dearly wanted to run her in the Oaks, but she's very much a fast-ground animal and it was on the soft side at Epsom," her trainer explained. "She's a lovely filly from a family of milers, but we're hoping that **Singspiel** has put the necessary stamina into her."

**BAY MEADOWS TO RACE IN '08**

The California Horse Racing Board agreed in principle June 19 to a one-year waiver in 2008 from the state's synthetic track mandate for Bay Meadows, partially reversing a decision made in March. But the board can't make it official until its next meeting. A majority of the

CHRB's members said they would support a limited waiver for the historic San Mateo venue from its requirement that all major Thoroughbred tracks install safer, engineered racing surfaces by Jan. 1. But wording of the agenda item--presented simply as "status of Bay Meadows"--prevented definitive action because it did not specifically mention the waiver or synthetic surfaces. At the suggestion of deputy attorney general Derry Knight, the board postponed its vote at least a month on the issue, but polled its five members present. They unanimously supported the waiver with an asterisk--adding the clause "in light of the circumstances." Commissioners Marie Moretti and John Amerman did not attend the meeting at Hollywood Park.
