### FALLON RETURNS TO TOP WITH HIGH

Less than three weeks after his comeback, Kieren Fallon made his inevitable return to the big time yesterday when guiding **Mountain High (Ire)** (Danehill) to success in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's improver hung left and threw away a winning chance when third in the June 3 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly and that may have explained his huge starting price yesterday of 13-1. Making a mockery of those odds going his favored way round,

he was straight and true and rewarded a positive ride to best the 5-6 pick **Mandesha (Fr)** (Desert Style {Ire}) by 1½ lengths. "He's improved so much--he was light last year and Sir Michael [Stoute] has brought him on so well," Fallon commented. "It went super--the pace was nice, but I just had to force it a little. The way he ran today, I'd say now that he's reached this level he'll stay here. I didn't have my confidence back beforehand, but I do now." *Cont. p2*

### WILSON SCORES HISTORIC FIRST IN PLATE

Emma-Jayne Wilson, Eclipse Champion as leading apprentice rider of 2005, became the first woman to ride the winner of the Queen's Plate when she guided **Mike Fox** (Giant's Causeway) to a perfectly timed victory in the 148th renewal of the Canadian Classic at Woodbine yesterday. Despite the historic achievement, Wilson was in no mood to rest on her laurels. "Been there, bought the t-shirt, said and done," the charismatic jockey commented. Wilson settled Mike Fox, a 15-1 shot, in third, while 16-1 outsider **Alezzandro** (High Yield) set the pace through fractions of :23.66, :47.74 and 1:12.51. Favored **Jiggs Coz** (Cozzene) made a move on the leader at midstretch, but Alezzandro kicked clear and looked home free. Wilson got Mike Fox in gear late and the bay split the two leaders and powered clear in the final yards. "As we were going down the backside, Jiggs Coz made a big move and ran by me," Wilson said. "I wasn't too concerned until the three-eighths pole, when Alezzandro and Jiggs Coz started to make a move away from me. I started to get a little worried and started to get after my horse. Mike was taking a little while to get going and I thought after the eighth pole, I will get third and I might get second. I just buried my head and kept on driving and out of nowhere, I knew we were flying. It was unbelievable."

Mountain High had long promised to shape up in this league, but two trips to Royal Ascot in the past two seasons appeared to set him back. On the first occasion, he was fourth on only his third start in the G2 King Edward VII S. when the meeting was staged at York, and his sophomore campaign subsequently fell by the wayside. Nurtured back at four, his return to the Royal meeting was more impressive and the bay put in a career best when going down by a head when second to Maraahel (Ire) in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Ascot last June. Upset when second at 4-7 in Newmarket's G2 Princess of Wales's S. the next month, he was put on the shelf and came back to be fifth in Sandown's G3 Gordon Richards S. Apr. 27. After enjoying a confidence-boosting win in Ascot's Listed Buckhounds S. May 12, he looked to have a first group success in the bag at Chantilly until wandering late and surrendering to Saddex (GB). Kept close to the even early pace set by Irish Wells (Fr) (Poliglote {GB}) yesterday, he was committed at the top of the straight and gained first run on Mandesha, who had missed the break before racing freely under Christophe Soumillon. Despite that rival's efforts, Mountain High was always holding her safely at bay. "Last week, Kieren had ridden him and said how much he had improved since the spring, but we were hopeful rather than confident," commented Coral Pritchard-Gordon, speaking on behalf of Stoute, who saddled Gamut (Ire) to win this three years ago. "After Chantilly, we were confident he would be helped by going left-handed and with the addition of a crossed noseband. Sir Michael is absolutely thrilled, but needs to talk to the owners to discuss future plans." Mandesha was joining Bago (Fr) and Hurricane Run (Ire) in becoming the third consecutive odds-on favorite to suffer a reversal in this race, but her trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre was not too downhearted. "She has not sparkled at home like she did last year, when she showed her best form from August onwards," he said. "[We] will consider the G1 Nassau S. [at Goodwood Aug. 4], before a break and a prep race for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [Oct. 7]." concerned there [around the far turn], but I knew he would run all the way, so if anybody stopped in front of him, he would keep running," Black said. "It is a wonderful feeling, I'm honored to be part of Emma's great day and for [owner/breeder] Morgan Firestone, to have a horse like this, to get a Plate win with a homebred. Legerete was pitched in at the deep end by Andre Fabre in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp in October, but acquitted herself with credit to fill third spot behind the authoritative winner Finsceal Beo (Ire). She was tried in the Apr. 15 G3 Prix de la Grotte back there with a view to contesting the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 1000 Guineas), but after a fourth-placing was rested until the G3 Prix de Royaumont.

Showing the benefit of the step up to a mile and a half when getting the better of La Hernanda (Ire) (Hernando {Fr}) by a short head in that June 2 Chantilly event, the homebred took another step forward with an easy success here to provide her trainer with a sixth renewal. Reserved in fourth off the tepid early fractions set by Kaloura, the bay was asked to stretch by Olivier Peslier on the home turn and, while her response was not immediate, when she got to the front approaching the eighth pole she required only hand riding. "We'll now consider the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 16] and see if she has a race in between," the Wertheimer brothers' Stud and Racing Manager Pierre-Yves Bureau commented.

Due to a rescheduling of the German program around the soccer World Cup last term, Schiaparelli was asked to take on his elders before the G1 Deutsches Derby. Second to Donaldson (Ger) in the G1 Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf in June, the chestnut went on to claim glory in the Hamburg Classic the following month before disappointing when sixth in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden in September. Up to lead early, he was soon passed by Arcadio (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) and Andrasch Starke did not panic as that rival was sent several lengths clear. Steadily reeling him in on the final turn, he was back in front at the top of the straight and maintained the gallop to comfortably hold the wide challenge of Poseidon Adventure. In his first race since returning from overseas, a trip that included a win in the G1 Dubai Duty Free in March and a third-place finish in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup in Hong Kong at the end of April, Admire Moon was sent off the third wagering choice in a field that including seven Group 1 winners. Settled toward the rear of affairs, the four-year-old son of End Sweep pulled out wide for the stretch drive, hooked up with Meisho Sampson and gamely asserted in the final furlong to earn his seventh group win and second Group 1. Favorite Vodka (Jpn) (Tanino Gimlet {Jpn}), who last month became the first female Japanese Derby winner in 64 years, traveled in mid-pack and loomed a threat, but failed to muster the needed kick and finished eighth.

Jockey Calvin Borel was in the irons for the work, 14th fastest of 40 at the distance, over a muddy Churchill oval. "He went good," trainer Carl Nafzger said of the work. "He was relaxed. He went really good and we're back on schedule. Let's see if we can make the [July 29 GI] Jim Dandy or the [Aug. 5] GI Haskell and go from there." Despite his absence from the work tab since a runner-up effort in the May 19 GI Preakness S., Street Sense was kept busy during his mini-vacation. "He'd been galloping the whole time, and we just thought it was time for him to get back," Nafzger explained. "If we're going to make the Jim Dandy or the Haskell, we've got to start cranking up. And he did it exactly the way we wanted him to."

**VACARE SCRATCHED FROM NEW YORK** Jon Kelly's **Vacare** (Lear Fan), who would have been one of the favorites in Saturday's GI New York S. at Belmont Park, was scratched from the race and is scheduled to undergo throat surgery for an entrapped epiglottis tomorrow. "It's very frustrating because I thought this

\$2.8 million at the Fasig-Tipton November Sale. She won the Magna Distaff S. in her seasonal return Apr. 1, but was handed the first defeat of her career when finishing third to Citronnade in the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup S. at Hollywood Park May 28.

**SOLDIER'S OPTIONS OPEN** Underfoot conditions will determine where Budget Stable's **Soldier's Tale** (Stravinsky) runs following his win in Saturday's G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot. Trainer Jeremy Nosedo announced that the six-year-old, who denied Takeover Target (Aus) in the final stride to win the Royal meeting's feature sprint by a head, would be aimed at the main Group 1 sprints. "Ground will dictate his programme, but we will consider all the obvious targets--the G1 July Cup [at Newmarket July 13], the [Sept. 8] G1 Haydock Sprint Cup and G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 6]. But Saturday proved that if he is to be competitive at this level, he needs soft ground and the downpour before his race helped."

Like West Point's Terry Finley said, "They don't just hand out Grade 1 wins!" We finally made it to the condo we own in South Padre Island, Texas.

**Funniest movie?** Office Space by far, and So I Married an Axe Murderer--best comedy with the worst name.

**Favorite music/musicians?** UB40. I love reggae or any tropical/vacation music.

**Last Purchase?** An Indian Charlie colt called Kohana trained by Rick Violette. We are really high on him.

**NIGHTIME RETIRED** Last year's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner **Nightime (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}--Caumshinaun {Ire}, by Indian Ridge {Ire}), who is currently in foal to Holy Roman Emperor (Ire), has been retired. Bred and owned by trainer Dermot Weld's mother Gita, the impressive six-length victress of the Curragh Classic had run off the board in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh on her sole four-year-old start May 27 and connections have decided to call time. "When we ran her in the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot] after [the Irish 1000 Guineas] last year, she pulled a muscle quite badly and I never really got her quite right," Dermot Weld explained yesterday. "We decided to breed her to Holy Roman Emperor and I'm delighted to say she's safely in foal. She was an extremely talented filly and it was just unfortunate that she had a recurrent muscle problem. I think we did the right thing in breeding her and retiring her." Nightime retires as the winner of two of her five starts and €224,500 in earnings.

**WIND TO BE ADDED TO PRETTY POLLY** Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **West Wind (GB)** (Machiavellian) will be supplemented for Saturday's G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh at tomorrow's five-day stage. Connections are keen for the G1 Prix de Diane (French Oaks) winner and Thursday's G2 Ribblesdale S. scorer **Silkwood (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) to go separate ways and the latter is to be aimed at the July 15 G1 Darley Irish Oaks at the same venue. The owner-breeder's racing advisor John Ferguson stated that West Wind would be ridden by Johnny Murtagh, as Frankie Dettori is currently serving a suspension. "We're looking forward to the race," he told the *Racing Post*. "It is not ideal for two Darley-owned fillies such as West Wind and Silkwood to clash at this stage of their careers."

**ASCOT PLAYS DOWN CROWD DROP** Reduced attendances during Royal Ascot week were not greeted with despair by the racecourse's new Chief Executive Charles Barnett as he reflected on the latest meeting yesterday. Despite a decrease of over 37,000 over the five days compared to last year, Barnett was accentuating the positive. "We are still going to have the best part of 275,000 people over five days, which is an enormous crowd and most people would have gone away very satisfied," he told the *Racing Post*. "The fall was down to two reasons, one was that some people did not have a great time last year and the second is I suspect there is probably more of a movement towards Saturday and weekend racing from the early part of the week. There are a mass of little things we will change, but there is not one big rain cloud above my head. We will sit down and have a debrief with the whole team, speak to the trustees and get feedback from the customers before we decide what to change."

**FORTUNE CROWNED TOP JOCKEY** Jimmy Fortune received the London Clubs International trophy for being the leading rider at Royal Ascot after partnering five winners. Reflecting on the achievement, which included a treble on Wednesday highlighted by victory on Nannina (GB) in the G2 Windsor Forest S., he told the *Racing Post*, "You come to these big meetings hoping to ride one winner. To go away with five is spectacular. [Nannina] won a Group 1 as a two-year-old and a three-year-old, and now she's come to Royal Ascot and won as a four-year-old. She's been a special filly for me."
