Blood-Horse

SCAT DADDY RETIRED

MGISW **Scat Daddy** (Johannesburg--Love Style, by Mr. Prospector) has been retired, it was announced yesterday. The three-year-old suffered a slight tendon injury in his right front leg when off the board in the May 5 GI Kentucky Derby. "Our vets told us he would need 90 days rest, so we would have run out of time to get him back for the major races this year, and the decision was made to retire him to stud," trainer Todd Pletcher said. Purchased by James Scatuorchio for \$250,000 as a KEESOP yearling, Scat Daddy broke his maiden at Belmont in his first start and came back to take Saratoga's

GII Sanford S. Scatuorchio gave both Pletcher and his father, Jake, a 25-percent share, and the colt ran for that partnership when second in the GI Hopeful S. After that race, the Pletchers sold their interest to Michael Tabor; Derrick Smith bought into the Kentucky-bred this year. The winner of the GI Champagne S. and fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile to end 2006, Scat Daddy opened '07 with a third in the GIII Holy Bull S. He captured the GII Fountain of Youth S. and GI Florida Derby, and retires with a record of 9-5-1-1 and earnings of \$1,334,300. "From his very first works, Scat Daddy showed us he was a horse of the highest class," Pletcher said. "He had great tactical speed and a marvelous will to win." Stud plans have not been announced.

ANDRETTI CUP BID UNLIKELY

Tuesday's G2 King's Stand S. winner **Miss Andretti (Aus)** (Ihtiram {Ire}) looks set to ship back to Australia rather than stay in England for a tilt at the G1 July Cup. The six-year-old was a disappointing 15th in Saturday's G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot, and connections are now looking at a campaign geared towards the Dec. 9 G1 Hong Kong Sprint. "I'll have to discuss it with [part-owner] Sean [Buckley], but my advice would be to go into quarantine, go back to Australia, spell her and concentrate on Hong Kong at the end of the year," trainer Lee Freedman told www.racenet.au. While Miss Andretti and Joe Janiak's **Takeover Target (Aus)** (Celtic Swing {GB}) are likely to ship out, conditioner Peter Moody confirmed that King's Stand third **Magnus (Aus)** (Flying Spur {Aus}) would remain for the July 13 showpiece of Newmarket's July Festival.

MOYGLARE TO DOWNSIZE

Walter Haefner's Moyglare Stud Farm is poised to cut back its County Kildare-based operation over the next 18 months. Manager Stan Cosgrove revealed the news to the *Racing Post*, and stressed that the move reflected a change in emphasis towards "improving the stock." While Dermot Weld's draft will remain at the same level, Moyglare will be more prominent in the States, where Christophe Clement is the organization's trainer. "Our main concern is we want to get more quality and less quantity," Cosgrove told the *Post*. "We have 160-odd horses here and we intend to gradually get that figure down to somewhere near 100 by 2009, but it doesn't mean job cuts or anything like that. Racing is more competitive in Ireland these days than the likes of Britain or France, so we are hoping to raise the bar by hopefully improving the stock. We only have one horse at the moment with Christophe Clement, but we intend sending out more horses to him at the end of the year. Dermot Weld has about 50 this year and that number will stay around the same for next year."

After winning a conditions event at Chantilly May 9, Loup Breton was tossed in Classic competition in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club. He was beaten about five lengths when eighth in that June 3 Classic, and made the most of this class drop to open his stakes haul. Settled towards the rear by Christophe-Patrice Lemaire early, the bay swooped to lead with a furlong remaining and responded to driving to hold the late charge of Bleu Intense and Kieren Fallon. "He ran a very good race in the Jockey-Club and is still tender, but he learned a lot and is an improving horse," trainer Elie Lellouche said. "He might go onto better things now, and the intention is to give him a short break before running in the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano [at Deauville Aug. 18]."

Since capturing the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville last August, Marchand d'Or had failed to reach the frame in three starts, but put an end to that sequence in style to record back-to-back successes in this contest. Seventh in the G1 Prix de la Foret over course and distance in September, the gelding was taken to Dubai for an ambitious tilt at the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen on Nad Al Sheba's dirt Mar. 31 and was not disgraced in eighth. He filled that position again when returned to France for the May 1 G2 Prix du Muguet over a mile at Saint-Cloud. Settled in rear while traveling easily here, the grey was delivered with a sustained run down the outer to inhale Ridaar passing the eighth pole before being geared down near the line. "It's a relief to see the horse returning to his best after two poor runs, but in fairness to him he has had problems with a quarter crack and I might have made a mistake sending him to Dubai," trainer Freddie Head said. "Saint-Cloud was a nightmare, as he was half-crazy to post, but now his foot isn't hurting him anymore and he is more relaxed. When an inexpensive commercial stallion makes a sensational start, there is always a slight worry that he won't maintain the same level of success when his fee soars and he starts to cover supposedly superior mares. Theoretically, the fortunes of the stallion should continue to rise, but these "superior" mares often represent a significant change in direction, perhaps from cheap speed to a more Classic type, and the anticipated improvement isn't always forthcoming.

Consequently, it was always going to be fascinating to see whether Cheveley Park Stud's remarkable stallion Pivotal would build on his eye-popping start after his fee had been raised from £10,000 in 2002 to £25,000 in 2003 (and subsequently to £85,000 in 2007, through steps of £40,000 and £65,000). His current fee--the highest for a stallion in England--is 17 times the amount he stood at in his third, fourth and fifth seasons.

The good news is that Pivotal's £25,000 crop--now three-year-olds--is maintaining his high profile. It was represented by its first Group 1 winner last week when Excellent Art defeated a strong field in the St James's Palace S., to make amends for his very unlucky run in the French 2000 Guineas.

Excellent Art is one of five group winners (and six stakes winners) to have emerged from the 116 foals in Pivotal's 2004 crop and there is every chance, given the way some of Pivotal's progeny improve with age, that these figures will rise still higher.

Incidentally, the considerable increase in the size of Pivotal's more recent crops will make it difficult for him to match the very impressive statistics he achieved with his first five crops. The 268 foals in those five crops--all sired at fees of £6,000 or under--included 22 group winners (including one in Turkey and one in Hong Kong). This equals more than eight percent group/graded winners and his 36 stakes winners in the major racing countries from those first five crops equate to 13 percent. Excellent Art is his ninth Group 1 winner, following Kyllachy, Chorist, Golden Apples, Silvester Lady, Megahertz, Peeress, Saoire and Somnus. Kyllachy also made his mark at Royal Ascot, with his first-crop sons Tariq and Arabian Gleam taking first and third places in the G3 Jersey S.

Excellent Art's success helped Cheveley Park take the title of leading breeder at the Royal meeting, with Nannina's victory in the G2 Windsor Forest S. providing another major contribution. With both these winners being by their own stallions, the Cheveley Park team had every right to be delighted with their week's work, the only downside being that the dams of both these group winners have been sold.

Excellent Art's dam, the Seeking the Gold mare Obsessive, was sold for only 15,500gns at Tattersalls' 2004 December Sales when she was a weanling. Then 11, Obsessive's catalogue page recorded that the mare had produced three winners from five foals of racing age. Although one of them, Double Obsession, won the 2004 Ascot S. over 2½ miles at the Royal meeting, none had earned black type. As Obsessive had been sent to such as Green Desert, Danehill and Sadler's Wells (twice), no one could say that this third in the G3 Musidora S. hadn't received every chance. However, her 2004 mate was the Cheveley Park's first-season sire Carnival Dancer, a Group 3 winner whose fee was only £4,000.

Excellent Art's exploits, which also include a victory in the G2 Mill Reef S. at two, have shown that Cheveley Park's original faith in Obsessive wasn't misplaced.

The family was introduced to Cheveley Park 20 years ago when David Minton paid \$325,000 for a yearling filly by Secretariat out of the Lyphard mare Ann Stuart at Keeneland's July Selected Sale. That price made the filly, Secret Obsession, the second-highest-priced yearling by Secretariat, which reflects the high quality of her pedigree. With Secretariat as her sire and a daughter of Miss Carmie as her dam, Secret Obsession was a three-parts sister to Six Crowns, a stakes-winning mare who had recently been represented by the admirable Chief's Crown. This son of Danzig had started his stallion career at Three Chimneys in 1986, after earning the title of champion two-year-old colt in 1984 and finishing second or third in all three legs of the 1985 Triple Crown.

You'll hardly need me to remind you that Miss Carmie had already found fame as the dam of that exceptional filly Chris Evert and she was soon to add considerably to her reputation when her daughter All Rainbows became the dam of Winning Colors, the Caro filly who did "a Rags to Riches" against the colts in the 1988 Santa Anita Derby and Kentucky Derby.

The family has continued to thrive over the past 20 years. Much of the success traces to Chris Evert's broodmare daughters, whose descendants include Sightseek, Bates Creek, Etoile Montante, Pollard's Vision, Bowman's Band and Dominican. Don't forget, though, that as many as SEVEN of Miss Carmie's other daughters produced group or graded winners, which makes Miss Carmie a true blue hen.

In addition to producing Winning Colors, All Rainbows became the second dam of the Japan Cup winner Tap Dance City, while Miss Carmie's Green Dancer filly Whisper Who Dares produced the Grade I-winning Confessional. Miss Carmie's lightly raced Blushing Groom filly Missed The Wedding produced a pair of graded winners, headed by the GI Test S. heroine Missed the Storm.

Royal Ascot success runs in this family, as Excellent Art's third dam Ann Stuart produced Beyton, an Alleged colt who landed the G2 King Edward VII S. in 1992, and Miss Carmie's Vaguely Noble filly Social Column bred Two Timing, winner of the Prince of Wales's S. in 1989.

Fasig-Tipton Midlantic June Set for Today:

The one-day Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Two-Year-Olds in Training and Horses of Racing Age Sale will be held today at the Maryland State Fairgrounds in Timonium. A total of 96 lots have been catalogued, with the juveniles accounting for the first 78 hips, to be followed by 18 horses of racing age. Top sires represented include Awesome Again, Cherokee Run, Mr. Greeley, Smart Strike, Theatrical (Ire), Woodman and Yes It's True, as well as freshmen such as Harlan's Holiday, Najran, Sunday Break (Jpn) and Zavata. At yesterday's under-tack show at the Fairgrounds, a colt by Harlan's Holiday worked the fastest quarter mile of the afternoon. Hip [35](#), a bay out of River Crossing (Affirmed), herself a half to the bluehen Fall Aspen, stopped the clock in :22 flat. Stewards Fine and Suspend Molina for Kicking Incident

Philadelphia Park Casino & Racetrack stewards handed jockey Victor Molina a \$1,000 fine and 30-day suspension June 25 for his actions prior to the third race at the Bensalem, Pennsylvania, facility June 18. Molina, a 27-year veteran, was scheduled to ride Hidden Meadows Farm's two-year-old Yes Yes Ohyes in the third race June 18. The colt reared and pinned Molina briefly in the starting gate, then banged Molina's head and chest. After the horse was backed out and ordered scratched by the track veterinarian, Molina was shown kicking the colt as he went to remove his tack. Stewards said that despite Molina's clean record, they decided to impose the fine and suspension based on the case of jockey Victor Carrero in New York. In 2002, Carrero was fined \$2,000 and suspended 15 days for throwing his whip and handfuls of dirt at his mount that had just broken down and was lying on the track at Aqueduct. His actions also caused an outcry from the public. Molina has 10 days to appeal the stewards' decision. His suspension begins retroactively to June 19 and continues through July 18. Awfully Smart, a 5 1/2-length winner of the Gill Leonard Richards S. over this surface last July, subsequently missed the board in the GI Haskell Invitational and Gill Pegasus S. and was shelved. The gray opened 2007 with a fourth-place effort facing NW3X foes at Monmouth May 12 and, building off that race, made all the pace in a sharp 2 3/4-length winning performance facing similar company over trip and track June 6. Backed down to 2-5 odds here, based partly on the 103 Beyer he earned last time, Awfully Smart was once again on the lead, cutting out :24, :48 and 1:12 3/5 splits. Left with plenty in the tank, he opened up down the lane and sailed home to a handy score.
