CURLIN, STREET SENSE WORK

Triple Crown rivals **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) and **Curlin** (Smart Strike) each hit the track at Churchill Downs yesterday morning for five-furlong works. It was the first recorded move for Curlin since his stirring runner-up finish to the filly Rags to Riches in the June 9 GI Belmont S. The GI Preakness S. hero, under regular excise rider Carmen Rosas, worked five panels in 1:03 1/5, clocking fractions of

:13 4/5, :27, :38 4/5 and :51 before galloping out six furlongs in 1:17 2/5. "I asked for 1:03 and I got 1:03," said conditioner Steve Asmussen, who confirmed that the Aug. 5 GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth was Curlin's immediate target. Asmussen added that he plans to breeze Curlin once more before shipping the colt to Saratoga to join his string there July 12. About 2 1/2 hours after Curlin's 6:20 a.m. breeze, following the morning break for track maintenance, Street Sense worked in 1:02 2/5. Starting slowly before picking up the tempo, the GI Kentucky Derby winner clicked off splits of :14, :27, :39 2/5 and :51. He galloped out six furlongs in 1:14 3/5. "He relaxed early and finished well," said trainer Carl Nafzger. "He listed to [jockey] Calvin [Borel] real well this morning." Street Sense is expected to make his first start since his second to Curlin in the Preakness in either the Haskell or the July 29 GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga.

THE ECCENTRICITY OF KING EDWARD

It looked as though favored **Sky Conqueror** (Sky Classic) nabbed him at the line, but the camera told a different story as the six-year-old gelding **Eccentric** (GB) (Most Welcome {GB}) earned a narrow victory in yesterday's GII King Edward Breeders' Cup S. at Woodbine. The versatile Eccentric, winner of the GIII Fayette S. over Keeneland's Polytrack in just his second career start in the States, most recently captured Woodbine's grassy GIII Connaught Cup May 27. Off at 9-2 odds yesterday, he raced along in the clear while well back of the early leaders. A strong wide move leaving the turn put Eccentric into contention and, after establishing a narrow advantage in the lane, he proved gamest between **Jambalaya** (Langfuhr) and Sky Conqueror. The latter, last through three-quarters, seemed to duck out several times while rallying before just missing by a nose in the shadow of the wire. Afterwards, winning trainer Roger Attfield admitted to being a bit late for the winner's circle celebration. "I was talking to the owner and said, 'We just got beat,'" he said. "[Then] I saw them leading him back, so I thought I'd better come down fast." BAKER'S DOZEN LEFT IN ECLIPSE Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Champery** (Bahri) was the only addition to the G1 Coral-Eclipse at yesterday's supplementary stage and a maximum field of 13 will go postward for Sandown's annual highlight on Saturday. Added at a cost of £20,000, the Listed Premio Tullio Righetti winner has been leased to Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar and will act as pace-maker for G1 Derby hero **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}). "Sheikh Mohammed has kindly leased us Champery for the Eclipse to ensure a true and even pace and Joe Fanning will ride," the owners' Racing Manager Tony Nerses told *PA Sport*. "Authorized is well and is going to have a blow tomorrow at Newmarket, then he will be done for the race." Team Ballydoyle numbers six for the Esher test and is headed by **George Washington (Ire)** (Danehill), who is set to tackle 10 furlongs for the first time since last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic, and **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill). **Duke of Marmalade (Ire)** (Danehill), runner-up in the June 19 G1 St James's Palace S., and Epsom Derby also-rans **Admiralofthefleet** (Danehill), **Archipenko** (Kingmambo) and **Yellowstone (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) complete the Aidan O'Brien-trained sextet. Other notable entries include last year's runner-up **Notnowcato (GB)** (Inchinar {GB}) and Derby fourth **Lucarno** (Dynaformer).

TEAM VALOR'S IRWIN BUYS OUT PARTNER

Barry Irwin has bought out long-time partner Jeff Siegal's interest in Team Valor and will operate the stable as its sole owner. The name of the limited liability company will be changed to Team Valor International to reflect a shift in the direction the operation has taken in recent years. A press release stated that Siegal has decided, after 21 years of being a partner in both Team Valor and its predecessor Clover Racing Stable, to devote his energies full time to Horse Racing Television, where he has worked as an on-air personality since 2002. "I'm incredibly proud of what Barry and I accomplished since 1987," said Siegal. "Together we won 170 stakes races and 21 Grade 1s, but at this stage of my life, I'd prefer to have one full-time job, not two. Barry was kind enough to acquire my interest in Team Valor and there is no doubt the stable will continue to flourish under his leadership." Team Valor has raced seven stakes winners during the first half of 2007, including last weekend's GI Suburban H. runner-up Fairbanks.

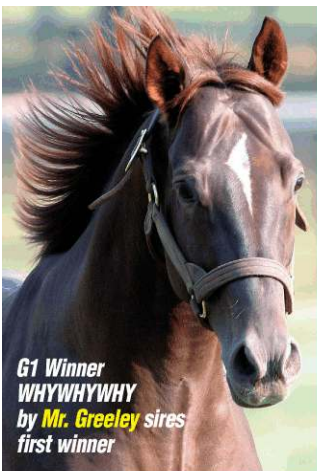

The ultra-consistent and versatile Tracatrantracatran, trained by 81-year-old Sabino Arias and campaigned by California owners Ivo and Baldo Pasetta, bounded along on the front end and never looked back to post a crowning wire-to-wire victory in Peru's flagship race. Last seen posting a victory at Monterrico on May 27, Tracatrantracatran kept finding more in the stretch under vigorous urging from former Calder Race Course-based rider Carlos Hernandez to post his most significant career victory defeating Peruvian Derby runner-up Pacasmayo and champion older mare Loca Amy, who returned from Buenos Aires after placing second in the G1 Gran Premio Internacional Asociacion Latinoamericana de Jockey Clubes. Tracatrantracatran, named after a popular Afro-Cuban rumba dance song and in memory of their late father Ivo Pasetta Bar, stamped himself as Peru's top older horse with this victory. Arias, a three-time international winner, and his son Alfonso celebrated a memorable day by saddling the top two finishers in Peru's premiere race. U.S. Ambassador Curtis Struble presented owner Ivo Pasetta with the winner's trophy. Pasetta's brother Baldo co-owns Brazilian import Nossa Cancao (Brz), runner-up in this year's GI Santa Monica H., and also campaigned Group III-placed Peruvian import Santa Monica in the U.S. The mare is the dam of two winners in the U.S.

La Soraya stamped herself as Peru's leading female on the turf with a decisive victory in the Clasico Pamplona, Peru's premiere race on the grass for fillies and mares. Fresh off a 1 1/4-length score in the Clasico Republica Argentina on May 26, the four-year-old daughter Laubali rallied determinedly in the stretch under a well-timed ride from promising Jose Retes to overhaul a tough Sza Sza Gabor in the closing meters to provide winning owner-breeder Claudia Rizo Patron with her first Group 1 score as a trainer. A granddaughter of Peru's perennial leading broodmare sire Stack, a half-brother to Forty Niner, La Soraya was bred in Peru by the Rizo Patron family's main breeding operation Rancho Fatima, breeders of U.S. graded stakes winners Stay Forever (Stack), Stokosky (Stack), Winfama (Wild Again) and Sierra Virgen (Stack). The family also breeds and races in Florida and Argentina. Laubali, by Mr. Prospector, is a half-brother to successful sire Honour and Glory from the family of Ogygian and Fappiano.

PHILLY PARK BOOSTS PURSES Reflecting an influx of revenue from slot machines, Philadelphia Park yesterday announced that, beginning Saturday, July 14, purses at the track would increase by nearly

30 percent. The move will boost daily payout from \$165,000 to \$210,000. "With this increase, we tried to address some of our key races," said Director of Racing Sal Sinatra. "For instance, the maiden special weights have gone from \$28,000 to \$34,000 and the first-level allowance races

will jump from \$30,000 to \$37,000. We're also pleased that we could bump several of our major stakes as we head toward the fall season." The Sept. 22 Gil Fitz Dixon Cotillion H. received the biggest increase, jumping to \$750,000 from \$500,000 last year. The other affected stakes are the Sept. 3 Turf Monster H. and Sept. 15 Larry Riviello Presidents Cup, the purses of which jump from \$150,000 to \$200,000; as well as two stakes run on Sept. 29, the Gallant Bob S., from \$150,000 to \$250,000; and the My Juliet S., from \$150,000 to \$300,000 (which includes a \$50,000 Breeders' Cup bonus). "Many of our horsemen have labored long and hard to have an opportunity to compete for purses like this," said Mike Ballezzi, Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association. "News like this is nothing but positive for both them and their families."

'INTEGRITY' REPORT RELEASED; REBATE SHOPS A CONCERN *By Tom LaMarra and Tom Precious, courtesy www.bloodhorse.com.*

A report by the New York Office of Inspector General to Gov. Eliot Spitzer lists four "general areas of concern" among the four entities seeking the franchise to operate Aqueduct, Belmont Park, and Saratoga, including relationships with rebate shops and bookmakers who take bets on racing from the United States. The Office of Inspector General was ordered by Spitzer to conduct a due diligence review of the ethics and integrity of the groups seeking the franchise: Capital Play, Empire Racing Associates, Excelsior Racing Associates, and the New York Racing Association, which currently holds the franchise. The report was released July 2. The four general areas of concern are all four entities have some ties to rebate shops; several individuals didn't return fingerprint packages; the report found "numerous civil lawsuits involving key persons or business entities" involved with all four bidders; and some individuals associated with the bidding groups have made legal but "sizable contributions" to New York political leaders. Spitzer didn't use the report to make any indications about who he believes should get the Thoroughbred racing franchise. **For full story, click [here](#); to read the report, click [here](#).**

RECORD PICK 6 AT HOLLYWOOD With a staggering carryover of over \$3.8 million, bettors big and small flocked to play yesterday's Pick 6 at Hollywood Park, swelling the pool to a North American record \$10,870,752. In addition, yesterday's Pick 6 handle of \$7,596,34 was a single-day record. When the dust finally settled after 18.90-1 longshot Extreme Notice won the final leg, there were a total of 13 winning tickets worth \$576,064.40 apiece. Consolation tickets with five winners each were worth \$2,240.40. The previous record Pick 6 pool of \$7,303,848 was set on Mar. 3, 2004, at Santa Anita Park when a three-day carryover of over \$1.4 million generated an additional Pick 6 handle of \$5,889,712. Monday's Pick 6 wager of \$7,596,347.12 beat the single-day North American record of \$6,494,193, set when there was a \$5-million guarantee on Breeders' Cup Day in 1998 at Churchill Downs. The other winners in the Pick 6 races were: Skipaslew (\$4.20), Pressthepace (\$11.20), Outlaw Jones (\$13.80), Lt. Lorraine (\$6.80) and Desire to Excel (\$13.20).

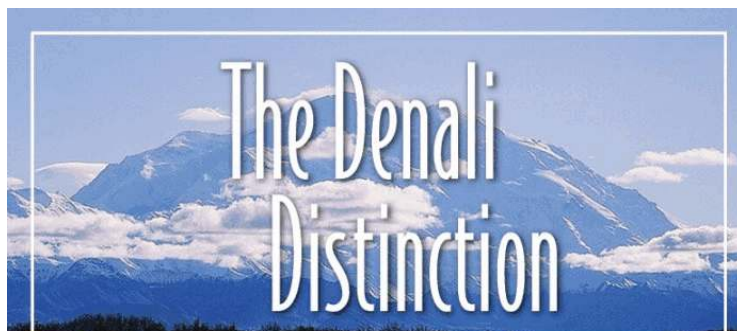
