Any Given Saturday (Distorted Humor) began the second half of his sophomore campaign with an emphatic score in yesterday's GII Dwyer S. at Belmont Park. Second choice in the wagering, Any Given Saturday stalked the pace of longshot **Believeinmenow** (Tiznow), spurred to the lead turning for home and turned back the upper-stretch challenge of favored **Nobiz Like Shobiz** (Albert the Great) to win by four lengths. "He was there for me every step of the way," said winning rider Garrett Gomez. "Today, he was like driving a car." Winning trainer Todd Pletcher knows he has an edge with Any Given Saturday.

"It's nice to have a horse that's as tactical as this," Pletcher said. "When there is not a lot of pace, he can be right there. When there is a lot of pace, he can settle. That's what makes a horse like this a little extra dangerous." **Cont. p2**

IT ALL ADDS UP FOR HIGH FINANCE

High Finance (Talk Is Money) broke through with his first graded-stakes triumph with a 2 3/4-length victory in yesterday's GII Tom Fool Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Park. The West Point colorbearer came out running from the three hole, but was taken back to stalk dueling leaders **Commentator** (Distorted Humor) and **Rondo** (Grand Slam) as they zipped through fractions of :22.07 and :43.99. "Our plan was to break, go a few strides and see what was taking shape," explained winning trainer Rick Violette, Jr. "When Rondo went up in there, Johnny [Velazquez] was content to let them fight in front of us. It looked like he had horse all the way." High Finance moved to the lead in upper stretch and pulled clear to the wire. "I sat there until the three-eighths pole and then I started getting after them," Velazquez described. "He was there for me. I was pretty confident off the turn." **Cont. p2**

Any Given Saturday Takes Dwyer (cont. from p1)

Any Given Saturday cemented his position as a legitimate Kentucky Derby contender when he battled Street Sense to a nose when runner-up in the Mar. 17 GIII Tampa Bay Derby. He was third behind Nobiz Like Shobiz and Sightseeing in the Apr. 7 GI Wood Memorial, but came home only eighth on the first Saturday in May. "He came out of the Kentucky Derby with a pretty good foot bruise," Todd Pletcher explained. "It took a while to get him over that. Then it was a matter of picking out a game plan and putting him in the best position going forward. We felt like the freshening from the Derby would be good for him and, obviously, it was." Pletcher said Any Given Saturday could start next in either the July 29 GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga or in the Aug. 5 GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park. Favored Nobiz Like Shobiz, making his first start since running 10th in the Kentucky Derby, looked to have dead aim on the winner in upper stretch, but could never get on even terms. "It's hard to beat Pletcher; wherever you go it's hard to beat him," said the favorite's trainer Barclay Tagg. "I thought they would go a little faster early on. I thought he could win this race." High Finance Wins Tom Fool (cont. from p1)

High Finance showed much promise with a 9 1/4-length maiden win at Keeneland last April and a 5 1/2-length allowance tally at Belmont in May, but he was an overmatched 10th in the GI Belmont S. After a Saratoga allowance victory, he finished his sophomore year with fourth-place efforts in the Oct. 13 GIII Perryville S. and in the Nov. 11 Mr. Leader S. at Aqueduct. High Finance returned with a promising second behind Kelly's Landing in the GIII Mr. Prospector H., but then was fourth in the GIII Deputy Minister H. and 10th in the Apr. 14 GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup. The chestnut was coming off an impressive eight-length victory in a May 27 Belmont optional claimer. He made it two in a row with his win in yesterday's Tom Fool. "This horse has run two really big races back to back," Rick Violette confirmed. "And he likes his races spaced. This is the first time he's run two really big races back to back." As for what is next for High Finance, Violette said, "We'll probably look at the [Sept. 1 GI] Forego [at Saratoga]."

Too Fast for Favorite

Commentator (Distorted Humor), the 1-2 favorite, couldn't match the winner late after battling through the torrid early splits, and tired to third. "If you look at 10,000 races, you'll never see that again," said the favorite's trainer Nick Zito. "A :21 [:21 4/5] second quarter? Have you ever heard of that?" Jockey Corey Nakatani agreed. "Our game plan never changed: we were going to the lead and try to kick clear. Unfortunately, the pace was too fast," he said. Rondo, who was also on the lead, tired to fourth. Looking for his first stakes win, Idiot Proof took the lead on the far turn and ran away from his rivals for an easy score. The bay broke his maiden in his career opener at Hollywood last June, then disappeared for

the rest of the year. He returned to be second in the Jan. 27 Sunshine Millions Dash at Gulfstream, and captured an optional claimer at Santa Anita in his second start off the layoff Mar. 16. After fading to fifth in the Apr. 8 San Pedro S., he rebounded to take a Hollywood allowance test May 23, and was the third choice to make it two in

a row. Jockey Rajiv Maragh--a late substitution for David Flores, who missed the trip to Monmouth due to a strained back--settled Idiot Proof in second through an opening quarter in :21.58. Maragh sent him to the front on the far turn, and the two were all alone down the stretch, winning easily. The final time for the six-furlong test was a track-record 1:07.47. "We blew him out over the track and, just galloping, he went a half in :47," trainer Clifford Sise Jr. said. "We knew he really liked the track, and he showed it this afternoon. Salute the Sarge, named for animated trainer Nick Hines, closed late to earn a half-length debut win sprinting five furlongs at this oval June 3. Never far back, the bay colt burst between horses with a furlong to run and outbattled Leonides in the final strides to earn the narrowest of victories. "He dug in hard there at the end," admitted winning rider Michael Baze. "Last time he had a little trouble switching leads, but today he was right on the money. I wasn't sure I was going to get there, but the last part he started digging in. It was close. I wasn't sure...I was just saying, 'Please have it, please have it, please have it.'" Winning trainer Eric Guillot wasn't sure of the finish either. "At first I thought we had him by a long head, but there were some doubts which horse won for a little bit," Guillot said. "His running style is one where he breaks sharp and pulls himself back a little, but he's a nice horse." Trainer Vladimir Cerin was not disappointed with the runner-up. "He was a little green out of the gate and during the race, but he almost got there," Cerin said of Leonides. "The winner ran super and he just out-finished him." WEATHER WREAKS ECLIPSE HAVOC Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. could lose a couple of star turns if the forecast of wet weather proves accurate. There were a raft of threatened withdrawals yesterday, with Aidan O'Brien issuing a warning regarding the participation of Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **George Washington (Ire)** (Danehill). Last year's G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. hero could be forced to sidestep the 10-furlong event, as could stable companion and G1 St James's Palace S. runner-up **Duke of Marmalade (Ire)** (Danehill). "George Washington and Duke of Marmalade are not certain to run in the Eclipse on Saturday," O'Brien told the *Racing Post*. "We're going to watch the weather forecast carefully in the Sandown area over the next few days." The current going of soft, and heavy in places, may move the connections of George Strawbridge's **Lucarno** (Dynaformer) to skip Saturday's test and instead point for Longchamp's July 14 G1 Juddmonte Grand Prix de Paris instead. Trainer John Gosden reported the G1 Epsom Derby fourth and G2 King Edward VII S. runner-up likely to swerve Saturday's race. "With these races, you know it's not going to be a field with massive depth to it in terms of numbers, so I left him in just to keep an eye on it," Gosden explained. "The more likely race for him, if we are going to run in July, would be the Grand Prix de Paris, but I've just left in the Eclipse in case there was a reason to consider declaring."

Trainer Michael Jarvis is also preparing to take Gary Tanaka's G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica runner-up **Pressing (Ire)** (Soviet Star) out of the race. "I would say it is extremely unlikely he will run at this stage because of the ground," he told *sportinglife.com*. "He is at his best on good or good to firm ground and it is going to be very testing at Sandown on Saturday. I have yet to speak to the owner but my advice will be not to run." Sandown's Director of Racing Andrew Cooper was taking stock of the heavy recent rain. "It is soft, heavy in places, after 10 millimetres on Tuesday and two millimetres of rain today," Cooper said. "It's difficult to be too precise as to what it will be like on Saturday, but it will clearly be slow ground--there's no getting away from that. We're starting to get some encouragement from the forecast and we're certainly heading into a drier spell, but it's hard to tell Aidan [O'Brien] that the conditions will be anything other than soft. It reads worryingly in terms of George Washington taking part, even allowing for a better forecast."

WIN NUMBER 4,000 FOR BRAVO Jockey Joe Bravo booted home the 4,000th winner of his career at Monmouth Park yesterday, guiding Alotofappeal to a one-length victory in the eighth race on the card.

Born in Long Branch, Bravo was just 13 when he got his start riding Quarter horses in Texas. He received his jockey's license in 1987, and broke his maiden at Calder Race

Course in 1988 on a horse called Daffy Doc. In just three years, Bravo worked his way to the top of the Monmouth jockey standings. He picked up his first title at the track in 1991, and added 11 more over the next 15 years. That 16-year reign might have been unbroken had it not been for two seasons spent riding in New York and two spent sidelined by injury. "Getting to 4,000 wins makes you stop and smell the roses," Bravo said. "It's not something I really thought about, I didn't have my eye on it, but it makes you look back and see what you've overcome, all the hard work you've put in, all the people who have supported you. It's really touching to see all the people, all the fans, rooting for you. It's awesome." As for the future, Bravo isn't focused on taking another title or getting to his 5,000th win. "I just want to keep having fun," he said. "I just want to enjoy doing what I do."

COBRA VENOM REPORTEDLY FOUND IN BIANCONE BARN

Kentucky Horse Racing Authority investigators reportedly found cobra venom during a search of trainer Patrick Biancone's barn June 22, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The venom, which can be used as a painkiller, is barred by state regulation from racetrack grounds. The barn search was ordered after one of Biancone's horses tested positive for a derivative of caffeine and for a derivative of an inhalant, both of which are banned on race day. A stewards' hearing on the case has not yet been scheduled and Biancone is free to run horses in Kentucky until the case is heard. Cobra venom is considered a Class 1 drug under the Racing Commissioners International classification system, meaning it has no therapeutic value and is highly likely to affect racetrack performance.
