Following an all-the-way success in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club, **Lawman (Fr)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) returned to Chantilly to repeat the dose in facile fashion in yesterday's G1 Prix Jean Prat. His stamina was just enough for the 1 5/16 miles of the June 3 Classic, but over this mile, the 13-10 pick was able to use his deadly cruising speed to crush his overmatched rivals.

**JRHA SALE STARTS TODAY**

The Japan Racing Horse Association's three-day July Select Sale starts today at the Northern Horse Park, with 157 yearlings and 329 foals catalogued. The sale, which celebrates its 10th anniversary this year, set a world record for a foal or weanling in 2006 when a filly from the first crop by Japanese champion King Kamehameha (Jpn) (Kingmambo) out of G1 Dubai World Cup runner-up and Japanese champion To the Victory (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) brought ¥600,000,000, approximately \$5.2 million. Tokyo-based Nobutaka Tada signed the ticket on behalf of a group of unnamed Japanese buyers. The 2006 edition of the sale also realized a Japanese record for a yearling when colt by Pivotal (GB) brought ¥200,000,000, about \$1.8 million. Out of a half-sister to champion Deep Impact (Jpn), he was also bought by Tada. The foal section established new marks for gross (¥8.34 billion, or approximately \$72.5 million) and average (¥37.7 million, or \$328,172) as well. What does JRHA Vice Chairman Teruya Yoshida expect from this year's sale? "The market is still very strong. Our economy is coming up and many people have an interest in horses," Yoshida told *The Blood-Horse*. "But since last year's sale was so overheated, maybe people will be a little more reluctant. We don't know what will happen." Today's opening session features yearlings representing sires such as Cherokee Run, Gone West, Grand Slam, King Kamehameha (Jpn), Kingmambo and a rare War Emblem. Lawman's sophomore bow came over a mile in a conditions event on Longchamp's circuit; he was a non-threatening third before being promoted to second behind Chichi Creasy (Fr). He was held up on that occasion, and those tactics were employed again when he finished fourth behind the same rival over that track and trip in the Apr. 15 G3 Prix de Fontainebleau. Olivier Peslier changed his ploy next time in the May 9 G3 Prix du Guiche at this venue and the bay duly showed his mettle when controlling affairs from the front for an easy score. It was Frankie Dettori on board for the Jockey-Club and, although he had to grip on tightly to his lead in the dying strides, his enterprise earned him the victory again. Back in the saddle this time, Peslier soon found his way to the head of affairs and it was clear with a quarter mile remaining that he had his rivals fully stretched. Quickening to put his seal on the contest, he was coasting as the line approached and was geared down to emphasize his superiority. "He was brilliant without being asked too much," Jean-Marie Beguigne added. "The plan has always been to run him in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois [at Deauville Aug. 12] before the G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 8]. We'll see what to do after those two races."

Mauralakana, a group winner in France, was transferred to the States late last summer and finished third in the Sept. 23 GIII Noble Damsel S. at Belmont in her American bow. She came up just a half-length short in her next outing, running second in the Oct. 14 GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland, but could do no better than seventh in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf and was given a vacation. Fourth in her return, the Apr. 14 GII Jenny Wiley S. on the Keeneland Polytrack, the bay followed up with a Churchill allowance score May 23. She was coming off a lackluster fourth in the June 9 GII Just a Game S. at Belmont, but was back on her game here. On the bit while pressing the early pace, Mauralakana angled wide for the stretch drive, was in front at the eighth pole and edged clear. "She's a very good filly," trainer Patrick Biancone said. "We figured she would appreciate a little more distance than a mile--last time we ran her too short, and she came in fourth. She's only been here for six months, and she really improved." **STREET SENSE SHARP AT CHURCHILL**

GI Kentucky Derby hero **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}), tuning up for a return in either the July 29 GII Jim Dandy S. or the Aug. 5 GI Haskell Invitational S., worked five furlongs in 1:00.40 at Churchill Downs yesterday morning. With Calvin Borel in the irons, the three-year-old clicked off splits of :13, :25.40, :37.60 and :49.40, and galloped out six furlongs in 1:12.60. "He's right on schedule," said trainer Carl Nafzger. "We just let him be himself and let him do what he does. We let him get into a sync of what he likes to do. We just let him take us to where he's going, and that's what he's doing." Runner-up in the May 19 GI Preakness S. last time out, Street Sense is scheduled to ship to Saratoga July 21.

**ART HAS CUP DATE** Susan Roy and Cheveley Park Stud's **Dutch Art (GB)** (Medicean {GB}) is set to line up in Friday's G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket. Conditioner Peter Chapple-Hyam announced that last year's G1 Prix Morny and G1 Middle Park S. hero, third in the May 5 G1 2000 Guineas on the Rowley Mile, will revert to six furlongs. "He gets a mile, so if it was a very fast six furlongs it could be a little bit of a worry, but the July Course is a stiff six--that will help," he commented. Chapple-Hyam also confirmed that the G2 Norfolk S. winner **Winker Watson (GB)** (Piccolo {GB}) will line up in Thursday's G2 July S. "I am very happy with Winker Watson," he said. "The step up to six furlongs should suit him. The sun is shining here in Newmarket this morning, so hopefully we'll have good ground for him." Princess Haya of Jordan's G2 King's Stand S. runner-up **Dandy Man (Ire)** (Mozart {Ire}) is also set for the July Cup. Trainer Tracey Collins issued an upbeat bulletin on the four-year-old, who will be tackling six furlongs for the first time since his two-year-old days. "The horse is very well," she said. "He has been in good form since Ascot and, assuming the ground dries out, the plan is to run him Friday. It looks a very hot race, but Dandy Man is a much stronger horse this year and he has won over six furlongs."

**WAR EMBLEM HAS ANOTHER FRUITLESS SEASON AT STUD**

After five frustrating years of trying to coax dual American Classic winner **War Emblem** (Our Emblem--Sweetest Lady, by Lord At War {Arg}) into performing regular breeding duties, Shadai Stallion Station officials may be reaching the limit of their patience with the horse they purchased for about \$17 million as a stallion prospect. Teruya Yoshida, who runs Japan's leading stud farm with his brothers Katsumi and Haruya, said Sunday that War Emblem covered no mares during the just completed breeding season. Thus, 2008 will mark the second consecutive year that there will be no foals born by the 2002 Kentucky Derby and Preakness S. winner. When asked what might be done to remedy War Emblem's lack of desire to breed, Teruya Yoshida said, "We don't have so much interest to improve him now. We have tried many things and we are tired of that. We have no plan for him." Although Yoshida indicated previously that Shadai would consider offers from American farms that might want to attempt working with War Emblem, no agreements have been reached. The nearly black son of Our Emblem is in good physical condition at age eight "but his mental condition is not so good," said Shadai spokesperson Eisuke Tokutake, referring to the stallion's lack of interest in mares. Shadai has tried many tactics, including letting War Emblem choose a mate from a large group of in-season mares presented to him simultaneously, but most efforts have been to no avail. War Emblem remains in a stall at one of the Shadai stud barns where he is stabled near Grade II winner and successful sire French Deputy. With War Emblem's largest crop now of juvenile age, Yoshida said he is hoping that at least one of that group of 34 can win a major race. War Emblem has sired only one winner, Clan Emblem (Jpn), now three and a member of his first crop, which consisted of only four foals, all colts. Clan Emblem has recorded three wins, two seconds and a third from eight starts and has earned \$285,619. War Emblem's 2006 crop consists of five registered yearlings, four colts and a filly. **Mountaineer Purses Cut 20 Percent Across the Board:**

Deductions for a new breed development program and statewide workers' compensation have led Mountaineer Race Track & Gaming Resort to cut purses 20 percent across the board beginning July 10. The West Virginia track has thousands of video lottery terminals that produce purse revenue and this fall will begin operating table games. The move wasn't unexpected. A representative of the Mountaineer Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association said June 30 the track was "scraping the bottom" to maintain purses, which have averaged about \$140,000 a night this year. The underpayment in the account has dropped to about \$2 million. Purse accounts at the four tracks in the state contribute about \$11 million a year to the state's troubled workers' comp program. Mountaineer horsemen will contribute about \$3 million of the total this year. When VLTs were legalized at the track, purses received 15.5 percent of gross gaming revenue, but workers' comp and the breed development program have reduced that percentage. For most of this year, regular purses have earned eight percent of VLT revenue, and in August, the figure could drop to 7 percent, less than half the original percentage. It could return to about 14 percent this fall. In a note to horsemen, Mountaineer Director of Racing Rose Mary Williams said the purse cut was made to avoid an overpayment in the purse account. She said she expects the reduction to be temporary, and purses would be bumped up 20 percent "when feasible." **For the complete story, click [here](#).**
