FAWNFARE

With no Kieren Fallon on board and the news that she was coming into season, the nervous crowd at The Curragh allowed **Peeping Fawn** (Danehill) to drift to 3-1 before yesterday's G1 Darley Irish Oaks. Neither factor proved a hindrance to Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's burgeoning star as she gained revenge on her G1 Epsom Oaks conqueror **Light Shift** (King-mambo) in commanding style. Always traveling like the winner, the second choice swept by her foe before the furlong marker and on to a 3 1/2-length success. "You've seen the way she is improving and thriving on her racing," commented trainer Aidan O'Brien, recording back-to-back wins after Alexandrova (Ire) provided him with his first renewal 12 months ago. "She's really good and is one of those who is starting to really progress now." **Cont. p2**

BELLE STEALS THE SHOW IN DEL 'CAP

Heading into the GII Delaware H., trainer Todd Pletcher appeared to have the race all but locked up with multiple-graded stakes-winning mare **Indian Vale** (A.P. Indy). Indian Vale was sent off the 4-5 choice and **Asi Siempre** (El Prado {Ire}) garnered significant support at 2-1 yesterday, but it was another Pletcher trainee--**Unbridled Belle** (Broken Vow)--who earned the spotlight. Largely overlooked by the betting public at a generous 8-1, Unbridled Belle was content to stalk the early pace set by **Peak Maria's Way** (Pyramid Peak). Team Valor representative powered clear of her rivals in the stretch and strode home an authoritative 7 3/4-length winner over the whopping long shot, 56-1 chance **Lila Paige** (Cryptoclearance). **Cont. p3**

FTK JULY: SUMMER SIZZLE?

A total of 582 colts and fillies are set to go under auctioneer Walt Robertson's hammer as Fasig-Tipton kicks off the yearling sales season this morning at 10 a.m. at the Newtown Paddocks in Lexington. The catalogue for the Kentucky July Yearlings sale is a full 22-percent bigger than last year's book, which produced an average of \$115,954. That was a 15-percent improvement versus 2005, when the total number of offerings was roughly comparable to this year. But toss in a dash of weakness in the two-year-old sales and the outlook for 2007 is somewhat hazy. "There are always some butterflies in your stomach when you're getting ready to kick off July, but that's the same for any sale you have," said Boyd Browning Jr., executive vice president and chief operating officer of Fasig-Tipton. "The two-year-old market wasn't great, but it wasn't disastrous overall. It was probably more in line with the historical trends over the past 10 years, and 2006 is probably a little bit of an aberration, if you look at it statistically. I think the market is going to be good. I don't think it's going to be 'runaway,' but I look for it to be stable." **Cont. p9**

It is hard to believe that it took Peeping Fawn four attempts to break her maiden, but since her graduation over a mile at Naas May 16, she has thrived on her workaholic regime. Back in action just 10 days later facing a steep class rise in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, she began a stellar spell with a third behind Finsceal Beo (Ire) before shipping to Epsom five days afterwards and finding only Light Shift a half length too strong in the Oaks. She made strides forward with every week, and O'Brien capitalised by sending her back to this track for the June 30 G1 Pretty Polly S., in which she blew by Speciosa (Ire) for an easy two-length score. Settled in mid-division early by Johnny Murtagh this time, the imposing bay stalked Light Shift and was perfectly poised as that rival struck the front passing the quarter pole. Light Shift's lead was short-lived, however, as Peeping Fawn quickened to settle the result in a matter of strides and power clear under hand riding.

"You saw how she progressed from the Irish Guineas to the Oaks, and from the Pretty Polly to here," her conditioner said. "She showed in season this morning, but had been in season before winning her maiden at Naas and was in good form, so it wasn't a problem. She is a beautiful filly and is a possible for the G1 Nassau S. [at Goodwood Aug. 4]." Henry Cecil said of the runner-up, "She's obviously better on better ground and she struggled on that, but she ran very well and, hopefully, there'll be another day." Peeping Fawn accounted for yet another Classic win for her illustrious family. She shares a second dam, G1 Kentucky Oaks heroine Blush With Pride, with G1 Belmont S. winners Rags to Riches and Jazil, while her third dam Best in Show was named Broodmare of the Year in 1982.

A \$20,459 Superfecta...

The race was billed as a re-match between **Indian Vale** (A.P. Indy) and **Asi Siempre** (El Prado {Ire}), who finished 1-2 in the GII Fleur de Lis H. at Churchill in their latest, but neither filly was able to muster much of a fight yesterday, finishing fifth and sixth, respectively. With 56-1 bomb Lila Paige, 20-1 Promenade Girl and 6-1 Peak Maria's Way completing the superfecta, the \$2 payout for the bet was a whopping \$20,459.40.

Belle of the Ball...

Unbridled Belle has come a long way since being purchased by agent Gary Capuano for \$4,000 as a Keeneland September yearling in 2004. Acquired privately by Team Valor after breaking her maiden at first asking at Laurel back in November of 2005, the filly first showed her affinity for the Delaware surface with victories in an allowance event and the Go For Wand S., both in May. She failed to make much of an impact in her next three, all at Grade I level, and went to the sidelines. Unbridled Belle suffered her first Delaware loss in her 2007 unveiling, the June 16 Obeah H., finding Peak Maria's Way two lengths too good. Breaking from post four, Unbridled Belle, who reportedly is the biggest horse in Todd Pletcher's barn at around 17 hands, secured an ideal tracking spot along the rail, just off pacesetting Peak Maria's Way and the pressing favorite Indian Vale, another Pletcher trainee. The latter was spinning her wheels as they turned into the lane, opening the door for the 8-1 chance to angle out and engage the leader. The tussle proved short, however, as Unbridled Belle powered to an easy win under jockey Ramon Dominguez.

Bad Time for Bad Weather...

After running second by a head with Winning Point in Saturday's \$500,000 GII Delaware Oaks, and second in the GIII Barbaro S. with King of the Roxy a race prior, Team Valor chief Barry Irwin was hoping his stable was due. It was, as it turned out, but Irwin didn't even realize it at first. "A storm came through here in Lexington, and the TV went out," he chuckled. "When it came back on, it was in mid-stretch, but I thought they were showing a back-track of race she'd won last year. I didn't even realize that it was the race!" Because of his secretary's wedding on Saturday and the annual picnic for the Race With Education students Sunday, at which he spoke, Irwin didn't make the trip to Delaware, but is planning another trip north this fall. "I have no idea where we're going next, but what I'm going to do is look at the [GI] Breeders' Cup [Distaff, at Monmouth Park], and go backwards from there and see how we want to map it out," said Irwin.

Sunriver emerged on the scene with third-place finish to Barbaro and Sharp Humor in last year's GI Florida Derby and, after missing the GI Kentucky Derby because of a lack of graded earnings, went on to capture the GI Peter Pan S. over Belmont's main track. The handsome dark bay, a full-brother to champion Ashado, completed the trifecta in the GI Belmont S., but was shelved off an up-the-track performance in a sloppy renewal of the GI Jim Dandy S. Two uninspired efforts on the dirt to begin his 2007 season--including a 21 1/2-length drubbing in the May 19 GI William Donald Schaefer H.--prompted a move to the grass in his next, where he opened eyes with a sharp 4 1/2-length, wire-to-wire win facing Belmont optional-claiming foes June 7. Employing the same tactics in his return to stakes company, Sunriver was well in hand as he raced up to set a sensible pace under Garrett Gomez. Fishy Advice (Woodman) moved up to press Sunriver on the backstretch, but the latter shrugged free leaving the final turn. Shaken up in upper stretch, he lengthened clear nicely and was never in danger while being kept to task late. Longshot Trippi's Storm ran on gamely to complete the exacta. "It takes a really good horse to transfer surfaces and run the way he has," said Gomez. "He absolutely just skims over the top of the grass." Todd Pletcher added, "We were just figuring out what our options would be. When we worked him on grass, it was pretty obvious. He worked fantastic on it." Favored Shakis (Machiavellain) was given too much to do after laying well off the pace and could only manage fourth. Runaway Dancer recorded both previous graded stakes victories at 12 furlongs in the GIII Carleton F. Burke H. in 2003 and the GII Jim Murray H. in 2005. In more recent times, the eight-year-old was runner up to Boboman in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup Dec. 9 before finishing off the board in his first three starts of 2007, including a fifth in this year's edition of the GII Jim Murray Memorial May 12. A closing third in his latest start in the 1 3/4-mile Round Table H. June 16, the veteran was sent off the 3-1 third choice to record his first win in almost a year. Content to let Bright Prediction (Dance Brightly) bounce out to a mammoth lead in the early going, the grey unleashed his run turning for home, cut through rivals to take over midstretch and powered clear to earn the victory.

Xchanger showed enough precocity to win his first two starts last summer, including the GIII Sapling S. at Monmouth Park before finding the move up in company too much, coming home sixth in the GI Champagne S. Third in his final two starts of 2006, including the GIII Delta Jackpot S. Dec. 1, the grey was out of the money in his initial two starts of the current season. Fifth in the Feb. 19 Southwest S. at Oaklawn Park, he tired late to be seventh in the GIII Rebel S. Mar. 17. The colt was back in the winner's circle for the Frederico Tesio S. Apr. 21, but failed to translate that form into his next start when eighth in the May 19 GI Preakness S. at Pimlico. The third choice here, he stalked the early pace, moved up to take command after six furlongs in 1:11.14 and held off the late challenge of King of the Roxy for the score. Whether being in foal to Refuse to Bend (Ire) has been the sole reason for Redstone Dancer's sudden peak in form in recent weeks is open to debate, but the chestnut's upward progression continued with a typically battling success here. Having taken the valuable Summer Fillies' H. here June 30, she followed up with her first stakes score in the July 4 G3 Brownstown S. at Leopardstown, where even a slow start could not stop her. Settled with one rival behind early here, she joined the long-time leader Hard Rock City with a quarter mile remaining and overcame his resistance at the furlong marker before digging deep to assert. "She is a good tough mare and loved this ground," trainer Sheena Collins commented. "She peaks at this time of year and may have one more run, maybe in France, before she retires." Leaner Was Meaner in '06...

Sales officials made a conscious effort to trim last year's Kentucky July catalogue, in an attempt to raise the quality of the book. By all accounts, the strategy worked swimmingly, as the sale featured a pair of horses that sold in excess of \$750,000, including a colt by Forestry--Alizea's Song which was knocked down to Darley for \$1.2 million. Can we expect another seven-figure offering this time around? Not necessarily, Browning admits. "That's not what this sale is built on," he explained. "We're a bit more forgiving on pedigree in exchange for big, strong colts and fillies that look early for the most part. Whether one brings \$1 million or not is, frankly, insignificant. Our hopes are that we have a good, active marketplace for people to buy and sell horses and the top will take care of itself." Neither is Browning overly concerned about the bump in this year's catalogue. "The reality is that you can't determine the number of horses we're going to have in the sale," he said. "We take horses from the first day we look at yearlings to the last day we look at yearlings, and how many of those actually end up in the sale varies from year to year. Because of the success of the sale last year, consignors probably sent us a few extra horses this year, so we'll see." Cont. p10

Consignor Looking to Make a 'Big' Splash...

The name Giuseppe Iadisernia is not exactly a household name--not yet in any case--but the Italian-born trainer, winning with 25 percent of his runners in South Florida, is looking to make an impact with a small, but high-quality consignment of horses at Fasig-Tipton. Located in barn 14 way at the back of the sales complex, the principals of Iadisernia's The Big Stable are looking forward to their first-ever yearling consignment. "We've had others consign for us at two-year-old sales and we're trying to branch out into different aspects of the business. We just thought that now was the time to jump in," said the trainer's son, Joe, who was also acting as interpreter for Giuseppe. For his first crack at consigning horses, Iadisernia has apparently spared no expense, as he is represented by the two most expensive weanling-to-yearling pinhooks in the catalogue. The first of those goes through the ring this morning.

[Hip 35](#) is a member of the first crop by GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner and champion Speightstown (Gone West) out of Indy Mood for Luv (A.P. Indy), a multiple stakes-placed winner of \$134,365. The handsome chestnut colt was purchased by Iadisernia for \$210,000 at last year's Keeneland November sale. "We really love his attitude and he just looks like a runner," Joe commented. "He's got good size and he's a nice physical. He's matured very well. He's gone from a little guy to this monster of a horse. It's hard enough to take him out and walk him in the morning." His father adds, "He's going to be precocious." The consignment sends [hip 294](#) into the ring tomorrow. A member of the first crop of GISW Tapit (Pulpit), the chestnut, a \$185,000 KEENOV weanling, is a son of Dorky (Flying Paster), making him a 3/4-brother to MGSP Bold Start (Jump Start). What is it that Iadisernia looks for at auction? "Conformation and pedigree, and we're looking for a horse to jump out at us," Joe says. "We love having a good feeling about a horse. We have a horse, Delosvientos, that when we saw him, my father looked and said, 'I think that's a good horse. Let's get him.' He didn't really look at the X-rays, he just wanted him."

Delosvientos, a \$15,000 Keeneland September yearling, was unsuccessfully pinhooked by The Big Stable, and that has worked in their favor. Since breaking his maiden for a \$32,000 tag May 25, the four-year-old son of Siphon (Brz) has tacked on two wins, including a 15-length victory in the July 1 Arthur L S. at Calder. "He has a good eye for horses," Joe says of his father. "If you do your job right, hopefully you come out on top."

Jazzing It Up...

Fasig-Tipton invested in itself over the recent months, sprucing up the grounds with some new landscaping and trees, but the jewel in the crown is the newly refurbished and renovated sales pavilion. The floors are handsomely tiled and carpeted and new seating has been installed. Additionally, the company now offers wireless connection to the Internet that covers the pavilion, with access points also cover the barn area. A customer business center has also been added, and the upstairs now features an updated dining area with food service. "The pavilion was over 25 years old and has always been functional, but it needed a facelift," Boyd Browning said. "It needed to get a little more modern and be made a little more comfortable. We're trying to attract a high-quality horse here several times a year and we're trying to attract the top buyers in the world. You want them to drive through the gate and walk in the front door and feel like it's a serious place to conduct business. The feedback we've gotten has been very, very positive."

Deep in the Heart of 'Tucky...

Consignor Mark Stansell says that it's a long way from Lexington to Mount Pleasant, Texas, "all night long." But he is spending this humid mid-July in the heart of the Bluegrass with his initial foray into yearling sales. The affable 43-year-old has prepared a pair of nicely-bred horses for the sale, [hip 25](#), a filly by Medaglia d'Oro--Home Together (Homebuilder) and [hip 471](#), a filly by Forest Camp out of Such Flair (Kingmambo). "The Medaglia d'Oro has got a great body, she's really got a good walk and she's well-balanced. She's a pretty individual," he explained. "The Forest Camp just caught my eye. She's got a lot of chrome on her, she's also well-balanced and very racy. They both look like they've got some 'go' in them." Stansell had to go deep to acquire the fillies, spending \$140,000 for the Medaglia d'Oro filly and \$130,000 for the Forest Camp. Both were purchased at this year's Keeneland January sale. Stansell's appetite for consigning horses was spurred by his sale of the mare Tiny Decision, which he offered in foal to Kingmambo for \$245,000 at the 1999 Keeneland November sale. He also had success in the breeding business with Nancy's Glitter. He acquired the filly, then four years old, as a broodmare prospect for \$160,000 at the 1999 Keeneland November sale. In foal to Forestry, he returned the mare to the following year's breeding stock sale at Keeneland, where she realized a bid of \$325,000. Stansell is clearly enjoying himself at Fasig-Tipton. "It's been a good experience so far," he commented. "There's a lot of good horsemen in Kentucky and it's fun to bring a couple of horses up here to see how they like them. I think they'll be well received here. It's a work-and-worry type business, and once you're done, you hope it pays off for you."

Rob Whiteley's Liberation Farm and Jim and Pam Robinson's Brandywine Farm complement each other well and the two organizations return to Fasig-Tipton with the offspring of mares they teamed to purchase at the 2005/2006 breeding stock sales. Pam Robinson explains the rationale behind pooling resources. "I think we found ourselves looking at some of the same mares and we have some of the same likes in terms of the matings," she explained. "We've known each other for a long time and worked

indirectly prior to partnering up and it just seemed like the thing to do." She continued, "We try to buy the factories and it's an extra plus if they're carrying something that we like too. But we're looking for a long-term investment, something that fits into our breeding program. We have some absolutely fantastic foals and we've been very pleased." The team went up to \$102,000 at Keeneland November in 2005 for the multiple stakes-placed mare Riviera Colleen (Dehere) carrying a foal by dual Grade I winner Lion Heart. The mare delivered a bay colt last Mar. 13, and Robinson has high hopes for him. "This Lion Heart that we have is a fantastic colt," she stated. "Everybody it seems has been here to see him and he's been scoped and heart-scanned and very well received. He's very athletic, has a great walk and you can also see a lot of the Dehere in him from the female side, so that's a fantastic combination." The Liberation/Brandywine consignment has a pair of horses set for tomorrow's session. SPLIT SAMPLES MISTAKENLY TOSSED IN KENTUCKY by Leslie Deckard

The state veterinarian for the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority mistakenly tossed out two split samples from two horses that had tested over the approved limit for the approved bleeder medication Salix. Because the samples were tossed away, the investigation into the five overages at Keeneland and Churchill Downs has been dropped. The mistake by Dr. Lafe Nichols was caused when he misinterpreted information from Iowa State University, which conducts post-race testing for the state, KHARA Executive Director Lisa Underwood said. The error has resulted in a change of procedure for the KHRA. Underwood said samples where initial testing yields a suspicious result will be segregated from other samples inside a secure refrigerator where the samples are stored. In addition, she said Iowa State would now change the wording on results reports. "We will have a different understanding of what their wording means," Underwood said. The missing samples in question were from five horses that raced during the spring with impermissible amounts of Salix. The unusual number of Salix overages has resulted in a questioning of the testing practices and Underwood, Nichols, and chief state steward John Veitch were conducting a meeting with practicing racetrack veterinarians about reasons why there were so many overages at Churchill Downs when the samples were discovered missing. The trainers whose horses tested over the approved limit for Salix during testing by Iowa State were permitted to ask for split samples to be tested at a KHRA-approved testing laboratory. If the split is returned to show more than 100 nanograms, then the trainer would be called before the stewards for a hearing. Under state regulations, horses may receive up to 10 cubic centimeters of Salix prior to racing. The medication must be administered in a single intravenous dose at least four hours before post time. In Kentucky, a first-time violation for a Salix overage calls for a \$250 fine with no suspension or loss of purse money.
