AUTHORIZED SKIPPING KING GEORGE

Peter Chapple-Hyam yesterday ruled **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) out of next Saturday's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot. Announcing that Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's G1 Epsom Derby winner would enjoy a short break before being aimed towards the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 7, Chapple-Hyam said, "I am happy with him as he seems in very good form, although he is entitled to feel slightly tired after three hard races so far this season. With that in mind, he will probably benefit from a bit of a break. He has looked after me this year, now I've got to look after him." Runner-up in Sandown's G1 Eclipse S. July 7 following his emphatic five-length success in the June 2 Blue Riband, the sophomore will be asked to tackle that trip of 10 furlongs again before his Longchamp date. "Regarding the rest of his campaign, we will build him up with the Arc as his main target," remarked Chapple-Hyam. "But he will probably run before that in the G1 Irish Champion S. [Sept. 8 at Leopardstown]. If he doesn't head to Ireland for that race, we could go for the G1 Juddmonte International S. [Aug. 21 at York]."

STREET SENSE FLIES IN BREEZE

Champion **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) sizzled five-eighths in :57.40 under the Twin Spires yesterday morning, three seconds faster than the day's next-best move. It was the colt's final drill at Churchill before shipping to Saratoga tomorrow. Off since a narrow second in the G1 Preakness S. May 19, the G1 Kentucky Derby hero will make his next appearance in either the July 29 GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga or the Aug. 5 G1 Haskell Invitational at Monmouth. "This was our major work, so we were looking for a good work," said Ian Wilkes, deputizing for vacationing trainer Carl Nafzger. "He's a fast horse and they work fast. This horse is unbelievable in the way he can do things. He does them easy. It's not like he's slowing down--he's working to the wire quicker than how he started out." Going out just before the mid-morning break, the dark bay put up splits of :12.20, :24.20, :35.60 and :47.40, and galloped out six furlongs in 1:09.80. "I had him on cruise control," said jockey Calvin Borel. "He's got so much power to him now, it's just unbelievable. He couldn't blow out a match when we got back--I just couldn't believe it, because I had let him work pretty good." Borel added, "He's happy right now. He's had a little freshening. He's put on about 50 pounds, and he's wanting to do it now. I never moved on him this morning. He kind of worked like he did going to the Breeders' Cup...the older he gets, he's getting better and better." Should Street Sense opt for the Haskell, he would have a rematch with his Preakness conqueror **Curlin** (Smart Strike), third in the Kentucky Derby; and **Hard Spun** (Danzig), the Derby runner-up and third in the Preakness.

Klarman Investments Pay Dividends...

Seth Klarman has done little wrong since joining the investment world in the early 1980s and his success in that high-risk world has carried over to the racetrack. Klarman, who along with longtime friend Jeff Ravich, races as Klaravich Stables will be sending out Summer Doldrums in Saturday's \$1-million GII Virginia Derby. Klaravich owns the colt in partnership with William Lawrence.

A 49-year-old Baltimore native, Klarman graduated from Harvard Business School with an M.B.A. in 1982. Shortly afterwards, Klarman founded The Baupost Group with \$27 million in initial investments. Today, the \$7-billion hedge fund group sports a sparkling average annual total return of 19.55 percent.

Klarman shared some of his investment secrets in his 1991 book "Margin of Safety: Risk-Averse Value Investing Strategies for the Thoughtful Investor." Although now out of print, the book has sold for \$1,200 on Amazon.com and for \$2,000 on eBay, according to a recent *New York Times* article.

Now living in Boston, Klarman has seen Klaravich's colors carried to victory by multiple Grade I winner Subordination, who captured the 1997 GI Hollywood Derby and the 1998 GI Eddie Read H., and stakes winners Swingforthefences and Outperformance. But Klaravich's biggest horse to date has been Read the Footnotes, who captured the 2004 GII Fountain of Youth S. and was seventh in that year's GI Kentucky Derby.

The stable seemed to be back on the road to Louisville earlier this year with Summer Doldrums, who was an impressive winner of Aqueduct's Whirlaway S. in February. The dark bay colt was given a break after running third in the GIII Gotham S. and fourth in the GI Wood Memorial, but came back running when switched to the turf. He'll be looking for his second straight graded-stakes triumph Saturday.

Klarman's Baupost Group has a reputation for bankruptcy investments--investing money in a company's defaulted bank debts and profiting when the company is reorganized.

Summer Doldrums may have struck out in the sophomore dirt classics, but after some reorganization, he's ready to defy his name and reward his backers with turf success.

SONGSTER SIDELINED Multiple graded stakes winner **Songster** (Songandaprayer) has been sidelined by a strained ligament, according to *Daily Racing Form*. An impressive winner of the GIII Bold Ruler H. May 12 last out, the four-year-old breezed five furlongs in 1:01.24 last Sunday at Belmont in preparation for the GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. at Saratoga July 28. "He did not come out of the work good," Godolphin's assistant trainer Rick Mettee told *DRF*. "He's got a strained ligament. He's going to be off for some time. We're going to have some scans done, redo them, and see where we are. He won't be going up to Saratoga with us. He really trained good. We're really disappointed." Mettee did mention that the mercurial **Discreet Cat** (Forestry) is headed in the right direction. Sidelined by a throat abscess following his lone career defeat in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup, the four-year-old joined Godolphin's New York string in May and began jogging two weeks ago. "He's jogging sound and we're real happy with him," Mettee continued. "He'll probably start galloping by the time we get up to Saratoga. We don't have a time frame for his first breeze. Once he gets into galloping, it won't be long until we get him into a little breeze. When he's good, he'll come to hand pretty fast."

IEAH PURCHASES INTEREST IN PAPI CHULLO International Equine Acquisitions Holdings Stable has purchased a 25-percent interest in **Papi Chullo** (Comeonmom), who is slated to make his next start in the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga July 28, reports *Daily Racing Form*. The grey was an impressive winner of the Birdstone S. at Belmont June 9 ([video](#)) in his most recent outing for Winning Move Stables, which will remain his managing partner. Gary Contessa will continue with training duties. "Right now, he's among the top five older horses in the country and he seems like he's getting better," Michael Iavarone, co-president of IEAH, told *DRF*. "This is a nice horse we wanted to be a part of." Sanford Robbins purchased an additional quarter interest in the five-year-old.

YOUMZAIN ON TRACK Jaber Abdullah's **Youmzain (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}) was the subject of an upbeat bulletin ahead of next Saturday's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot. Confirming the Mick Channon trainee for the 12-furlong contest, the owner's Racing Manager Bruce Raymond told *PA Sport*, "Youmzain is very much on song, and I know that Mick is very pleased with him." Raymond added, "He'll have a few more regular pieces of work and we are looking forward to it. It looks like cutting up a bit, so we are in with a good shout." The bay ran fifth in the June 24 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud on his latest start.

FIRST CROP STAKES SUCCESS FOR HAWK WING

Coolmore's **Hawk Wing** notched up a notable double during yesterday's evening racing, including his first Stakes winner, courtesy of **Triskel**, who lost her maiden tag in the **Listed EBF Silver Flash Stakes** at Leopardstown. The **Tommy Stack**-trained filly took the race by a comfortable two lengths. Later there was another first crop winner for the multiple Gr.1 hero, when **Richard Hannon's Maybe I Will** scored at Kempton.

**CANADIAN CHAMPION ETERNAL SEARCH

Three-time Canadian champion **Eternal Search** (Northern Answer) died late last month at Curraghmore Farm near Waterdown, Ontario, Canada. Owned by Mel Lawson, the 29-year-old mare is by Northern Answer out of the Ruritania mare Bon Debarras. A retired broodmare for six years, Eternal Search had developed cancer in her nose which caused continual bleeding, and she had to be euthanized. "It's too bad because [her death] brings back a lot of memories," said Lawson. "She was a very good racehorse. Winning three Sovereign Awards isn't that simple up here--if you get one, you're lucky." Lawson bought Eternal Search privately for \$50,000 as a juvenile in 1980. Campaigned in the name of Lawson's Jim Dandy Stable, the mare retired from racing with 15 stakes victories on the Canadian circuit. Posting a record of 18-11-2 from 44 starts, she had earnings of more than \$640,000. For her accomplishments, Eternal Search earned Sovereign Awards as Canada's champion sprinter in 1981 and older female in 1982 and 1983. Six of her nine foals to race were winners, including stakes-placed runners Young Brodie (Broad Brush), Vigorous Search (Vigors), and Stop Searching (Stop the Music). Lawson additionally owns millionaire Ginger Gold, who won the GIII Natalma S. en route to being named 2001 Canadian champion two-year-old filly. Now a broodmare and kept at Curraghmore, she has produced Pulpit fillies the last two years. Jiggs Coz, a two-time stakes winner this year at Woodbine, is Lawson's sole horse in training. The three-year-old son of Cozzene has won four of seven starts and has earned \$490,725.

Designed for Luck Returns Today:

Grade I winner **Designed for Luck** (Rahy) returns to the racetrack today at Del Mar for the first time since running second in the 2005 GII Oak Tree Breeders' Cup Mile. The 10-year-old gelding is entered for \$80,000 in the day's sixth race, a 1 1/16-mile optional claimer on the Del Mar turf. Designed for Luck has already been retired from racing three times; first after a hock injury in 2002; then a suspensory injury in 2004; and, most recently, a hind leg injury in 2005. "I've never run a 10-year-old horse, so I don't know how they're supposed to feel," trainer Vladimir Cerin admitted to *Daily Racing Form*, adding the veteran runner "is so much happier when he's at the track." Cerin is unsure how Designed for Luck will fare in Friday's race. "I haven't really pushed him that hard," he said. "I'm not sure if his works have been hard enough to win. The satisfaction has been to be part of this horse's life. I often think he's smarter than I am." Designed for Luck won the 2004 GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile, as well as the 2003 GII Oak Tree Breeders' Cup Mile and the 2000 GIII Ascot H. On the board in 19 of 27 starts, he has won 10 times and earned \$965,500.

El Roblar Injured:

El Roblar (War Chant), winner of the GIII Ack Ack H., has been sidelined by a bone chip in an ankle, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The five-year-old is owned by Jess Jackson and trained by Richard Mandella. In addition to his win in the June 9 Ack Ack at Hollywood Park, El Roblar was second in this year's GII Arcadia H. and third in the GII San Antonio H. He won a division of the Oceanside S. in 2005.
