RED GIANT SAYS NO DEAL

This time, it was a giant who did the slaying. Peachtree Stable's **Red Giant** (Giant's Causeway), the least-preferred of a trio of horses sent out by leading trainer Todd Pletcher, got his nose down on the line to hand Richard Santulli's **Strike a Deal** (Smart Strike) yet another excruciating defeat. It was another four lengths back to Florida invader **Soldier's Dancer** (Lost Soldier), who had GIII Colonial Turf Cup hero **Summer Doldrums** (Street Cry {Ire}) behind him in fourth. The

disappointment of the race was **Circular Quay** (Thunder Gulch), sent off the 19-10 post-time favorite. The slight chestnut took up his customary position towards the back of the pack and passed a few tiring horses late, finishing a non-threatening sixth. **Virginia Derby cont. p2**

OCTAVE A CAPABLE UNDERSTUDY

While GI Belmont S. winner Rags to Riches nears her return to training after spiking a temperature earlier in the week, her stablemate **Octave** (Unbridled's Song) stepped up and filled those shoes, posting a workman-like victory over a game **Lear's Princess** (Lear Fan) in the GI Coaching Club American Oaks yesterday at Belmont Park. Godolphin's **Folk** (Quiet American) set the pace and yielded grudgingly to be third in her first start in nearly four months. Odds-on Octave jumped well and was content to stalk from second, as Folk wanted to overrace in the early going. The favorite was sent up to tackle the leader in earnest turning for home, edged by and held sway late as Lear's Princess rallied belatedly. "This filly's been a gem of consistency," trainer Todd Pletcher said by phone from Chicago. "She's had a great career. I thought [jockey] Johnny [Velazquez] rode her perfectly; he didn't let Folk get away too easy, but he kept her fresh enough to hold off Lear's Princess." **Cont. p3**

Dirt to Turf...

Red Giant was something other than a complete disappointment in three tries on the main track to begin his career, finishing a midpack fifth in a six-furlong maiden at Aqueduct on Breeders' Cup day before improving to third in a one-mile test at the New York oval Nov. 25. He made one start under the auspices of Anthony Sciametta at the Gulfstream meeting, a fourth going two turns Jan. 12, but has really turned the corner with a switch in surfaces. After graduating by 5 1/2 lengths over the Aqueduct lawn Apr. 7, **Red Giant** was runner-up in a May 2 Belmont allowance, and got back in the win column with a two-length score in Elmont June 3. Wheeled back on two weeks' rest, he was sent to Monmouth for the June 17 Restoration S. and was up in the final jump to win by a nose, a trait which would serve him well yesterday.

Seltzers Bathed in Success...

Ed and Marilyn Seltzer, whose sire Greatness (Mr. Prospector) was represented by his first winner yesterday, bred **Red Giant** from the multiple stakes-placed **Beyond the Sun** (Kingmambo). The couple has sold well from the mare, including **Red Giant's** stakes-winning half-brother **Carnera** (Old Trieste), a \$550,000 Keeneland September yearling. The Seltzers tasted more success last September when their then-yearling **Shan Naa** (Forest Wildcat) was hammered down for \$600,000 to Rick Nichols representing Sheikh Hamdan's Shadwell Estate Co. Ltd. **Beyond the Sun**, barren in '06 and '07, is currently in foal to **Vindication**.

A Million Reasons to Smile...

Inca King (Sir Cat) was sent for the early lead by jockey Shaun Bridgmohan and set dead-even fractions of :24.47 and :48.91, but was never allowed a breather, as **Strike a Deal** shadowed his every move. **Blazing Dynamo** (Dynaformer) raced comfortably in third, just ahead of **Red Giant**, who always traveled smoothly in fourth. **Strike a Deal**, let go in the waginger at 9-2 despite his consistency and narrow defeat at the hands of **Summer Doldrums** in the July 16 GIII Colonial Turf Cup, turned up the pressure on the frontrunner nearing the quarter and set sail for home under a right-handed stick from jockey Ramon Dominguez. The son of **Smart Strike** stole a 1 1/2-length advantage entering the final furlong and looked to have the race in the bag, but **Red Giant**, under constant urging by jockey Horacio Karamanos, kept plugging away and was able to take a hard-fought battle as the longest shot on the board. Karamanos was not advised that he had the ride until just before the day's first race. "My agent called Todd Pletcher and he said I had a 90-percent chance to ride this horse," the veteran reinsman commented. "I got the chance. I am so happy to win."

Circular Quay Fails to Fire...

Circular Quay is bred top and bottom to handle the switch to the turf, but never did any real running, checking in sixth, beaten nearly nine lengths. He was making his first start since finishing fifth to **Curlin** in the GI Preakness S. May 19. "When he needed to make his move, there was a horse on the outside," said Ginny de Pasquale, assistant to trainer Todd Pletcher. "He does his best running when he's on the outside and he just never made it to that spot."

She missed by a head to Christmas Kid in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 7 and was closest to Rags to Riches when second in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 4. The gray filly was pounded down to 3-5 for the nine-furlong GI Mother Goose S. going this track's one-turn configuration June 30 and did not disap-

point, coming home a half-length best. She was another tick lower on the Tote this time around, but the results were just the same. "Back-to-back Grade 1 wins three weeks a part is huge," Pletcher continued. "To win the Mother Goose and come back three weeks later in the Coaching Club at a mile and a quarter is a real nice accomplishment." The winning conditioner did not specify where Octave would show up next.

Having just rejoined the jockey colony at Arlington, Robby Albarado chalked up his fifth and most important victory on Million Preview day, guiding Lattice to a clear-cut victory. The Claiborne/Dilschneider homebred made a successful racetrack debut over the Gulfstream turf Mar. 30, skimming the rail en route to a nose success. Second to Inca King in a grassy Keeneland allowance Apr. 27, the dark bay took a Churchill allowance May 18, but was coming into this off a fourth to Inca King in the GII Jefferson Cup S. in Louisville June 16. Lattice settled in midfield as Lovango (Capote) showed the way through good splits of :23.05 and :47.22. Asked for some acceleration as they raced on the far turn, Lattice overtook the pacesetter passing midstretch and held gamely as Going Ballistic found his best stride late. "I had a great trip," said Albarado. "I had an outside spot. I was able to punch on him when I needed to. They stretched the race out so much turning for home--he kicked all right. He's a nice colt. He's been getting better every time." Favored Pleasant Strike (Smart Strike), winner of the GIII Arlington Classic June 23, raced handy to the leaders, but could not summon the necessary late response and finished fourth. Trainer Mike Mitchell has done it again. Having developed the former claimers Star Over the Bay and Leprechaun Kid into graded stakes winners earlier this decade, he can now add Sun Boat to that list following his last-to-first conquest in this prep for the GI Pacific Classic. Fourth in a \$50,000 claimer over the Santa Anita turf course Mar. 17, the bay was haltered for that tag out of an eighth-place effort back at that track Apr. 12. Dropped in for \$40,000 for his first try over the Cushion Track at Hollywood May 13, he rallied from the tail of the field to win going away at 13-1. An even longer shot against Buzzards Bay (Marco Bay) and company in the GII The Californian S. at Hollywood June 2, he employed those late-running tactics yet again, though this time he missed by a nose while finishing second. The fourth choice in this field, Sun Boat raced unhurriedly for the opening six panels, as favored Buzzards Bay towed them along on a nice long hold. Whereas the chalk began to spin his wheels rounding the far turn, Sun Boat was just finding his best stride and was angled three wide for the drive by jockey Michael Baze. He responded when set down, sliced through a narrow opening between horses at midstretch and inched clear late. Awesome Gem, centerfield for most of the race, was five wide turning for home and stayed on gamely into second. The 10-furlong GI Pacific Classic is set for Sunday, Aug. 19.

How big is Clarkland?

The farm is about 400 acres, about 200 acres of which is for horses; we farm the rest of it--hay, bedding, and I've got some bird dogs in the back. We've got one client, which is

Richard, Bertram and Elaine Klein. We raise all their horses for them. We've got about 40 mares, split between us and them. Clarkland has got to be one of the oldest farms in Kentucky. The yearling barn, which we've done nothing to other than change a few windows, was used as a barracks, or something along those lines, during the Spanish-American War.

Favorite racetrack? Keeneland is home to us. If we happen to race something and can win a race there, that's home, and you never forget that.

Favorite music? Country. I really like Reba McEntire. She came and bought a really nice yearling from us one year. She's the nicest young lady. I thought she was beautiful when we saw her on the TV, but it didn't do her justice.

Favorite vacation spot? Well, my wife won't take a vacation, but I will. I love to bird hunt, so I go to Kansas, Nebraska and Texas. I do mostly quail hunting.

Best place to grab a burger? Darlin' Jeans, over in Midway.

If you weren't in racing, you'd be...? Still on the farm, just working the land. It's a very enjoyable life. You might work 17, 18 hours a day sometimes, but it's worth it. When you go down to the barn and pull a beautiful foal out of a mare, well, that's about the only time I can't sleep, when the adrenaline starts flowing. It's something you have to do to realize what it means to you.

Cosmonaut went gate to wire to win the 2006 edition of the Arlington H., and he used those exact tactics to successfully defend his title yesterday. The gray was let go at 22-1 in the GI Arlington Million, and was not disgraced when finishing just 2 1/2 lengths behind The Tin Man in fifth. Fourth in both the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland and the GI Citation H. at Hollywood, he capped off the campaign with a fifth in the Dec. 9 GI Hollywood Turf Cup. The five-year-old was back in the winner's circle in his return, a Keeneland allowance Apr. 21, and was sent off the 2-1 chalk in the May 19 GII Dixie S. at Pimlico. He had to jump a fallen rival and couldn't quite overcome that incident, but closed to be second by 3/4 of a length. Back in Grade I company last time, he was leading inside the eighth pole in the June 9 Manhattan H. at Belmont before being swarmed in the final yards. He hit the line in fourth, less than a length behind winner Better Talk Now. Bridge Game flipped no fewer than three times in the paddock, but still managed to remain undefeated at Arlington. A maiden winner in August, she added an optional-claiming victory in September. The filly followed with a second in a Keeneland allowance Oct. 19, but tired to ninth in the Nov. 18 GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill, earning a break. Making her 2007 bow at Fair Grounds, she came from just off the pace to take an allowance Jan. 26 and went gate to wire to made it two in a row in a NW3X test Mar. 4. Bridge Game finished second in the Marie Krantz Memorial H. three weeks later, then was transferred to trainer Graham Motion's barn. She made her first start under new management in the June 16 GIII All Along BC S. at Colonial Downs and showed a new dimension as she came from out of the clouds to be third. New jockey Jeremy Rose opted to take her back again yesterday, and had just enough real estate to get the job done. The Elisabeth Alexander colorbearer rated in fifth as Jennie R. cut out reasonable splits. A 2-year-old might win a stakes race with a 95 **BRIS Speed Rating** or may become a champion with a rating over 100.
