**OFF AND RUNNING AT THE SPA**

The 139th season of racing at Saratoga opens this afternoon for a 36-day meeting that offers more than \$10.3 million in stakes purses. The first of 47 stakes races, the GIII Schuylerville S. for two-year-old fillies, kicks off the festivities. Todd Pletcher, the leading trainer at the Spa the last five years, has two in the opening-day feature as he bids to win the event for the fourth time since 2003. Both of the Pletcher fillies carry the colors of Al Gold's Gold Square and come into the six-furlong race off impressive maiden victories. **New York City Girl** (Forest Camp) went gate to wire to win by 11 3/4 lengths at Monmouth Park June 14, and **Lady Chace** (Tiznow) followed with a 10 3/4-length romp over four rivals at the Jersey Shore two weeks later, which earned her **"TDN Rising Star"** status. "It was a short field, but she certainly did it the right way," Pletcher said, adding that he is likely to scratch **New York City Girl**. "I entered both to give myself some options," he said. **Schuylerville cont. p4**

**GODOLPHIN PURCHASES ADMIRE MOON**

According to *The Blood-Horse*, Godolphin has purchased Japanese star **Admire Moon (Jpn)** (End Sweep--My Katies {Jpn}, by Sunday Silence) from owner Riichi Kondo for a reported \$33 million. The four-year-old colt was unplaced in two of his country's Classics last year, but showed marked improvement at the end of the season, running third in the G1 Tenno Sho (Autumn) and second by a nose in the G1 Hong Kong Cup. The bay opened 2007 with a victory in the G2 Kyoto Kinen, then shipped to Nad Al Sheba and outran an international field in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. Third in the Apr. 29 G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup, he rebounded with a half-length tally in the June 24 G1 Takarazuka Kinen. To date, Admire Moon has compiled a record of 15-9-2-2, with earnings of \$7,877,051. His third dam is champion and Classic winner Katies (Ire) (Nonoalco), herself dam of three-time Japanese champion Hishi Amazon.

**REBEL ON THE MEND**

Trainer Geoff Huffer is pleased with the progress made by **Cockney Rebel (Ire)** (Val Royal {Fr}), who suffered a pelvic stress fracture and pulled muscles when fifth in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot. The G1 English and Irish 2000 Guineas hero is back to work, and he is slated to return in the Sept. 29 G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. "It was an absolute miracle he just got beat a length and a quarter at Ascot, and in my opinion he should have won," Huffer said. "The vets are convinced he did it coming out of the stalls in the 2000 Guineas...and that's why he was hanging left in the final furlong and again in Ireland. Now the problem's solved, you'll see the real Cockney Rebel, and he's at least five lengths better than what you've seen. If we have an Indian summer, the ground will be ideal for the QEII and he'll be back in the winner's enclosure again." Huffer also confirmed that Phil Cunningham's colt would remain in training to race in 2008. "After the QEII, I would say he won't race again this season, but he'll go on as a four-year-old," Huffer added.

**CURLIN PREPS FOR HASKELL** GI Preakness winner **Curlin** (Smart Strike) worked six furlongs in 1:14.27 on the Oklahoma training track at Saratoga yesterday. He went in company with stablemate **Zanjero** (Cherokee Run). Second in the June 9 GI Belmont S., Curlin goes next in the GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Aug. 5. "I was very pleased with his breeze," trainer Steve Asmussen said. "We're very excited and ready for the second half of the season, which we hope culminates in the Breeders' Cup Classic." The GI Breeders' Cup Classic will be run at Monmouth Oct. 27.

**NANNINA SET FOR NASSAU** Cheveley Park Stud's MG1SW **Nannina (GB)** (Medicean {GB}) has been confirmed on course for the Aug. 4 G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood. The four-year-old was third to Oujia Board (GB) and Alexander Goldrun (Ire) in the 10-furlong contest 12 months ago. "Her run last year in the Nassau S. was her best performance of the year on the ratings," trainer John Gosden said. "So I have been slightly waiting for the Nassau this year. She is in good form, and I believe she is better at 10 furlongs than a mile." But the course condition is a concern. "The ground could be a factor--if the rain keeps up and we wound up with soft ground, we are very compromised," Gosden remarked. Clerk of the Course Seamus Buckley yesterday described the official going as good to soft ahead of the five-day festival, which gets underway Tuesday. "I predict the going to be on the soft side of good come next week if we have the necessary dry days, but we are completely in the hands of the weather," Buckley said.

**SOFT GROUND LIKELY FOR KING GEORGE** Saturday's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. looks set to be staged on ground no quicker than good as Ascot prepares for a wet end to the week. With unprecedented rainfall in Britain over the past few weeks, the Berkshire venue is currently soft, and heavy in places on the round course, with little change anticipated before the feature. More rain is expected Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday. Clerk of the Course Chris Stickels told *PA Sport* yesterday, "If that forecast is correct, I would expect the ground to be similar to what we have now." That prediction will ensure the participation of Terry Cooper's marathoner **Sergeant Cecil (GB)** (King's Signet), who was given the green light by trainer Rod Millman Monday evening. "Although he likes fast ground, with the ground being so soft it's going to make it a stamina test, and anything that doesn't quite get a mile and a half is going to struggle in it," Millman commented.

**TATTS TO SPONSOR IRISH CHAMPION**

The timing is ideal in the lead up to the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, and a race of such outstanding quality provides a wonderful platform for promoting the £2.2-million Tattersalls Millions, not only in Ireland, but also to an international audience. The calibre of entries for this year's race suggests that the first running of the Tattersalls Millions Irish Champion S. will produce yet another winner worthy of one of the world's great races." Brian Kavanagh, chief executive of HRI, added, "Tattersalls and the Irish Champion S. are a perfect fit, each being associated with excellence and achievement at the highest international level. The list of winners of this race over the past 20 years reads like a parade of world champions, many having been sold as yearlings by Tattersalls. Tattersalls have been committed supporters of Irish racing for many years, and we look forward to the further growth and development which this partnership will bring to the Tattersalls Millions Irish Champion S."



**FLASHY A SERIOUS CONTENDER--NO BULL**

Following a promising two-year-old season, West Point Thoroughbred's **Flashy Bull** (Holy Bull) underperformed in 2006, failing to reach the winner's circle in seven appearances. But that is all a distant memory now, as the steel-gray has won four of his five outings this seasons and will be one of the horses to beat in Saturday's GI Whitney H. But trainer Kieran McLaughlin realizes that the task at hand is not an easy one.

"It's a strong group of contenders," said the conditioner, who won last year's Whitney with subsequent Horse of the Year Invasor (Arg). "Post position will be very important, because there's a quick run to the first turn. We hope we don't draw outside with Flashy Bull. It's an evenly matched group, but Flashy Bull has not done anything wrong this year."

What has enabled the colt to turn the corner in 2007?

"He's been a bigger, stronger, faster four-year-old, and he's really run very well," McLaughlin said. "He came back 100 pounds heavier this year--the time off is all I can attribute this to."

After clearing his first- and second-level allowance conditions in New York this year, Flashy Bull lined up in the GIII W.D. Schaefer H. on the Preakness undercard May 19 and won a scintillating ding-dong battle with Hesanoldsalt. The original plan, McLaughlin admits, was to remain in the Midlantic for the GIII Salvator Mile, but he and West Point principle Terry Finley called an audible and shipped Flashy Bull to Churchill for the \$750,000 GI Stephen Foster H.

"He couldn't have been doing any better and \$750,000s [the purse of the Foster] don't come along too often," McLaughlin explained. "I called Terry that Wednesday morning and said let's go for it."

The results pleasantly surprised connections.

"He beat a strong group and the way he did it was really impressive," the trainer said. "He opened up four lengths turning for home. I even thought the jockey moved too early."

McLaughlin's affiliation with West Point Thoroughbreds dates back to 2003, when he took over the training of Argentinian import Seattle Fitz (Arg). An allowance winner and twice graded-stakes placed that season, he annexed a trio of graded events in 2004, including a win in the Schaefer and the GII Brooklyn H. Seattle Fitz could do no better than ninth to Roses of May in the Whitney.

McLaughlin says he currently has 10 horses for West Point, including last Saturday's GI CCA Oaks runner-up Lear's Princess. He is full of praise for Finley and his team.

"Terry does a great job and he's great to work with," McLaughlin commented.

"It's really great to see him competing in Grade Is. He's got a great team working with him and he's great to work for. He puts the horses first."

And that's exactly where McLaughlin and Finley would like to see Flashy Bull on Saturday.

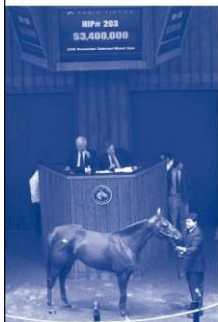

### ALL-WEATHER SIRES UPDATE

The all-weather revolution is 22 months old in North America, so we thought it a good idea to run a second quarterly update on all-weather sires. With the help of The Jockey Club Information Systems, we have refined the criteria somewhat: these statistics date from Jan. 1, 2005, and include AW racing from Britain (where we have added Southwell) and, in particular, from Deauville and Cagnes-sur-Mer in France. Run through racing of July 4, they also include Turfway (the first U.S. track to go AW), Keeneland, Hollywood, Arlington (new in 2007) and Woodbine. Because such a high percentage of North American AW racing has thus far been run at Woodbine, there is still a clear bias toward Canadian stallions. These statistics calculate a cumulative average-earnings index. At this point, five of the top 11 AW sires by cumulative average-earnings index are Canadian, and three others in the top seven (Street Cry, Stormy Atlantic and Point Given) are the sires of the top three Canadian three-year-old fillies. They, too, have been piling up Canadian dollars, and impacting their sires' AW cumulative average-earnings index.

Within the parameters cited above, there are 2,760 stallions that have sired an AW runner since Jan. 1, 2005. I'm grateful to Gary Hadden for spinning the dials to come up with a total of 31,535 AW runners in that time period, of which 7,365 (23.4 percent) were AW winners. The average earnings per AW runner in North America was \$9,378; in Europe, it converts to \$4,298. There were 166 AW stakes winners in North America (1.2 percent of runners), but only 52 AW stakes winners in Europe, just 0.3 percent of runners. Combined, there were 218 stakes winners, 0.7 percent of runners.

So there are a lot of caveats and disclaimers about these statistics; even the standard of racing is quite different--clearly a lot higher in North America, where former dirt Grade I races are now run on AW surfaces, if the particular track has converted. Also, as many have pointed out, AW racing in North America is in its infancy. Fair enough; my experience is that statistics nearly always require interpretation, so of course we need to recognize that we are likely to see rapid change as more statistics accrue. Nevertheless, this is a snapshot in time, and it tells us what sires have been successful thus far, whatever the surrounding conditions.

Of the 2,760 stallions, I thought there were two points of demarcation that could prove meaningful. A total of 946 sires have seven or more AW runners since 2005--480 sires had from seven to 19 AW runners, and 466 had 20 or more. The latter group, in particular, seems to provide a big enough sample size for each sire that the statistics could be meaningful; for the former group, we might get a good indicator, at least.

We've published four leaders' lists: leading sires by AW cumulative average-earnings index, and by percentage of AW winners to runners, both for the 466 sires with 20+ AW runners, and for the 480 with seven to 19. To some extent, the best AW sires will simply be the best sires--it may well be that a high percentage of good horses will be good horses whether they run on dirt or AW, or even turf or AW. That information will evolve as more AW racing takes place. I mentioned that Woodbine results are having a big influence on AW leading-sire lists, so it's significant that the two leading AW sires with 20+ AW runners at this point, Street Cry (3.25 AW cumulative AEI) and Stormy Atlantic (3.16), have fillies racking up the Canadian dollars. But they also have plenty of other AW form going for them. Street Cry is the sire of Street Sounds, who won Keeneland's GI Beaumont S. Third in the Woodbine Oaks, she was awarded the win in the Bison City S.

She has made over \$450,000 in AW stakes herself, and that figure is augmented by GI Kentucky Derby winner Street Sense's two AW Grade I placings at Keeneland: third in the GI Breeders' Futurity at two, and second in the GI Blue Grass in his final prep for the Kentucky Derby. Even though he didn't win, those two races netted him \$200,000 in earnings.

Stormy Atlantic is proving a formidable AW sire, with four AW stakes winners and another three stakes-placed; it looks like they handle the new surfaces particularly well. He also has one of the three top Canadian three-year-old fillies: Saskaweia, winner of the Fury S. and second in both the Selene and the Woodbine Oaks. In fact, four of Stormy Atlantic's seven AW stakes horses had black-type form at Woodbine. The others included Stormello, winner of the GI Hollywood Futurity last year; Ollie Jet, third in Keeneland's Lafayette S.; and Hot Storm, placed in three AW stakes at Turfway and Keeneland earlier this year.

Canadian stallions Kiridashi, Bold Executive and Archer's Bay occupy the next three places, followed by the remarkable Danzig. Hard Spun's win in the GI Lane's End S. at Turfway Park assured Danzig a good AW cumulative AEI, but just as remarkable is that Danzig actually tops the list of 466 sires with 20+ AW runners, by percentage of AW winners/runners. There have been 31 AW runners by Danzig, of which 17 have won--that's 54.84 percent. The average for the entire population of 35,000 runners, remember, is around 23 percent. Also besting the 50 percent AW winners/runners barrier was the otherwise undistinguished Pembroke. A son of Gone West, Pembroke has had 14 AW winners/27 starters (51.85 percent); his AW cumulative AEI, however, is just 1.10, compared to Danzig's 2.89. Point Given--yes, sire of the top Canadian three-year-old filly, Sealy Hill (winner of the Woodbine Oaks, disqualified from first in the Bison City S., and previously winner of the AW GIII Bourbonette at Turfway)--comes next, with a 2.82 AW cumulative AEI. But, like other non-Canadian sires Street Cry and Stormy Atlantic, he also has plenty of AW form in Kentucky and California. Point Given is one of three third-crop sires (first four-year-olds 2007) with an AW cumulative AEI above 2.00; the others are Tiznow (2.24) and El Corredor (2.13). Among second-crop sires (first three-year-olds 2007), Street Cry, of course, tops all sires, and another Darley America stallion, E Dubai, also hits the top 25, registering a 1.96 index. He's subsequently had a two-year-old stakes winner on the new Del Mar AW surface, so his number is improving again.

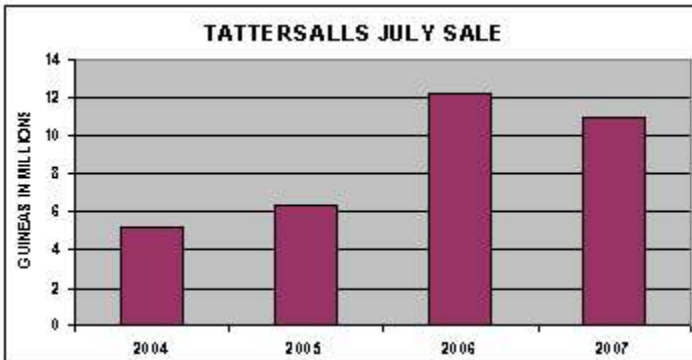
Among the sires with seven to 19 AW runners, Dubai Millennium (5.70) and, interestingly, Sunday Silence (4.39, sire of Keeneland GI Commonwealth BC S. winner Silent Name) top the charts by AW cumulative AEI, while a horse standing in New Jersey, Unbridled Jet, has compiled the remarkable record of six AW winners from seven starters (85.71 percent), and a 3.00 AW cumulative AEI. Just a winner behind him is the ex-Kentucky sire K One King, the last good horse sired by Apalachee. 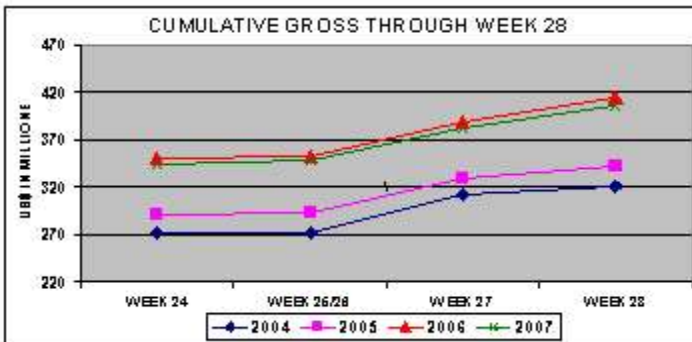

### LAUREL FALL STAKES SCHEDULE APPROVED

The Maryland Racing Commission yesterday approved a drastically reduced fall stakes schedule at Laurel Park. The Maryland Jockey Club and the Maryland Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association agreed last month that, due to a projected \$3-million shortfall in the purse account, purses would be reduced and 11 stakes cut from the fall calendar. The purses for 16 stakes, including the GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash, have been trimmed as well. Run for \$300,000 in 2006, the Dash will be worth \$250,000 this year. It is set for Nov. 24. In addition, the Maryland Horse Breeders' Association will stop paying bonuses to Maryland-bred horses that win open stakes races. "This is reality," said Lou Raffetto, president and COO of the MJC. "We avoided cutting race dates, but that is something we will do come the first of the year unless the legislature holds a special session to deal with slots and a purse subsidy. On a positive note, the accord we have reached with the MTHA is yet another sign of the harmony that exists within the industry, and shows a true willingness to work together to accomplish what needs to be achieved to survive and stay competitive." The 68-day fall meeting, featuring 32 stakes worth \$3.285 million, at Laurel begins Sept. 5.

**New Scratch Rule in Kentucky Takes Another Step**

A proposal to increase the length of time before a horse can race again after being scratched for veterinary reasons moved a step closer to reality July 23, when the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority approved a final draft version of the new regulation. Under the proposed new rule, a horse scratched for veterinary reasons could not run again for nine days. The current rule allows for a "vet-scratched" horse to run six days after being scratched. The KHRA had previously approved changing the rule to allow the scratched horse to be "entered" six days after the scratch. Due to varying entry times at the state's tracks, however, the Authority decided to stipulate the horse could not run for nine days after the scratch. Before the proposal would take effect, it must be reviewed by the Legislative Research Commission staff to determine if it complies with state statutes. Then, the proposal will be debated at a public hearing before going on to the General Assembly for action.

**Was your daughter Mily at the track Saturday to see your big win?** Yeah, she was yelling for me at the finish. She was very excited. She knew I was in the Derby and said, 'Daddy, please, please win the race,' and I said, 'I'll try, I'll try.' And I did it.

**When did you first come to the States to ride?** At the end of 2001. At the time, all of my friends thought I was crazy. I was very successful in Argentina; I'd ridden there for 10 years. They said, 'You get all the best horses, you win lots of races! Why leave?' But I said 'I'm a young man! I want to try the United States, because the best horses are there.' So why not try? I won my very first race in America, in Florida, and now I've won 1,000 races here. I'm so happy to be here – it's my second home. I want to become a citizen, because this country's given me everything. I've got to wait two more years (for citizenship).

**Of the horses you've ridden, are there any that have a special place in your heart?** There was a horse named La Reine's Terms that I won four or five stakes on. He was a nice horse.

**Favorite music?** I like country. I don't know the names too much, but I like it a lot. Rock 'n' Roll, a little bit, too.

**Favorite vacation spot?** I like to go back to Argentina, usually for a week or two at the end of the year. I have a big farm down there, with horses and cows. It's nice to go and relax and BBQ.

**What do you do in your off time?** I like to exercise – running, swimming. I go to the gym a lot. That's my hobby – exercise. I like to take care of my body, because it's all I have.

"I plan to dedicate my full energies toward helping California horse racing achieve a greater level of prominence," Amerman said. "With its current leadership, this Board has the courage, the commitment and the insight to take the necessary steps to make California the model racing jurisdiction in the United States."
