HANDICAP DIVISION UP FOR GRABS

With the recent retirement of reigning Horse of the Year Invasor (Arg), a new leader can emerge in the handicap division in today's GI Whitney H. at the Spa. **Flashy Bull** (Holy Bull) has certainly come of age this term, rattling off three straight victories, including the GIII William Donald Schaefer H. on the GI Preakness S. undercard and the GI Stephen Foster H. last time June 16. A repeat of **Papi Chullo** (Comeonmom)'s last two starts make him a contender here. The gray earned a 110 Beyer when annexing the Birdstone S. at Belmont last time June 9. Trainer Todd Pletcher sends three, headed by morning-line favorite **Magna Gradu-**

ate (Honor Grades), who finished second behind Flashy Bull in the Stephen Foster last time. Pletcher will also be represented by June 16 GI Suburban H. runner-up **Fairbanks** (Giant's Causeway) as well as June 23 GIII Salvator Mile H. second-place finisher **Lawyer Ron** (Langfuhr). Trainer Rick Dutrow, Jr. came within a quarter-length of tasting Whitney glory with Saint Liam in 2005 and will be represented today by **Diamond Stripes** (Notebook). The gray was perfect in his first four attempts before placing a close third in the Foster. **cont. p2**

MARAAHEL'S DAY?

Sir Michael Stoute first celebrated success in Ascot's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. with Shergar (Ire) back in 1981 and is looking to **Maraahel (Ire)** (Alzao) to provide number four in today's renewal. So close to an elusive win at the top when a short-head second to Notnowcato (GB) in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York last August, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's veteran comes into his 12th attempt at this level off a defeat of **Scorpion (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) when successfully defending in the June 23 G2 Hardwicke S. at the Royal meeting. "I think we've got to be realistic, as in the Hardwicke we were getting five pounds off Scorpion, so it's going to be tough to beat him at level weights," the trainer said yesterday. "He's very straightforward and has won being held up and from the front, so we have options. He had very good form last year when he won the Hardwicke and was just beaten by Notnowcato in the International. There are no three-year-olds this year, but there are some very good, solid horses in there." **cont. p3**

A REAL DANDY

Racing fans are in for a treat this Sunday at Saratoga. **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}), winner of the May 5 GI Kentucky Derby and second-place finisher in the May 19 GI Preakness S. last time, makes his long-awaited return to the races in the GII Jim Dandy S. "The decision wasn't easy, but the decision was made to end our spring campaign in the Preakness and begin our fall campaign at Saratoga," trainer Carl Nafzger said. The Jim Dandy also marks the sophomore debut of the unbeaten **Tiz Wonderful** (Tiznow). The bay was tabbed a **"TDN Rising Star"** following a 12 1/2-length victory first time out at the Spa Sept. 2, then added a pair of graded stakes at Churchill Downs, including the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. last out Nov. 25. "He's an extremely talented horse," trainer Steve Asmussen said. "The Jim Dandy is awfully deep water for him coming back off a layoff. The main thing with him is his soundness and him doing well up her last year has everything do with why he's running back here." **cont. p8**

A Truly Silver Anniversary...

The 2007 renewal of the the GI Whitney H. marks the 25th anniversary of Silver Buck's victory in the 1982 event. Fresh off his track record setting performance in the GI Suburban H. at Belmont eight weeks earlier, Silver Buck was made the 4-5 favorite in the Whitney and didn't disappoint, scoring a 1 1/2-length victory over Winters Tale. It would be the last win of his career.

Retired to stud that winter, the C.V. Whitney-bred son of Buckpasser--Silver True, by Hail to Reason was retired to Lasater Farm in Ocala, and syndicated into 40 shares for \$100,000 per share. After one year at Lasater, he was moved to Happy Valley Farm in Ocala and remained there until 1992, when he moved to Silverleaf. The sire of 417 individual winners with earnings of \$31 million, Silver Buck's highlights at

stud were undoubtedly Silver Charm's wins in the 1997 GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. en route to three-year-old championship honors. A quarter-century after his Whitney victory, and now 29, Silver Buck is

enjoying his retirement in Ocala. Pensioned from duty at Silverleaf Farm in 2001, he currently lives at Bridlewood Farm as the property of a syndicate which includes Marylou Whitney and syndicate managers Alan Briggs and Bob Cromartie. Said Briggs, "Silver Buck is responsible for bringing many great thrills and memorable moments to his owners and the Florida breeding community. He has had a long and successful life and is enjoying good health in the Florida sunshine."

Has Scorpion Got His Sting Back?...

Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's Scorpion proved victorious in Doncaster's G1 St Leger in September 2005, but it took until this year's edition of the G1 Coronation Cup for him to revisit the winner's enclosure. In that Epsom contest June 1 he had stable companion Septimus (Ire) and Maraahel back in second and third, respectively, but was the victim of his own success when succumbing to Maraahel by a half-length under a subsequently penalty in the Hardwicke. As with stable companion **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill), Aidan O'Brien is uncertain the soft ground will suit Scorpion, who bids to become the first five-year-old to take this since Daylami (Ire) in 1999. "Scorpion won the 2005 St Leger on testing ground, but he set a record time when he won the Grand Prix de Paris on fast ground at Longchamp that year, so you'd have to think that, although he handles soft, he prefers much better ground," the Ballydoyle conditioner told the *Racing Post*.

A Proven Track Record...

Lammtarra opened the scoring for Godolphin back in 1995 and the operation have been where it matters four times subsequently. This year, **Laverock (Ire)** (Octagonal {NZ}) is an outsider in the royal blue, but has claims on the very best of his form. Having beaten Manduro (Ger) in Longchamp's G1 Prix d'Ispahan last May, he ended his four-year-old campaign with a hard-fought success in the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club Italiano at the San Siro in October. Following a winless spell racing at Nad Al Sheba this spring, he returned to Europe with a vengeance when dead-heating for second behind Papal Bull (GB) under a five-pound penalty in the July 12 G2 Princess of Wales's S. at Newmarket. "Laverock ran well last time and he is in good form," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. "His work has been pleasing and he is ready for another race. Of course, it will be very tough for him in the King George, but we are looking forward to seeing him run again." **Previews cont.**

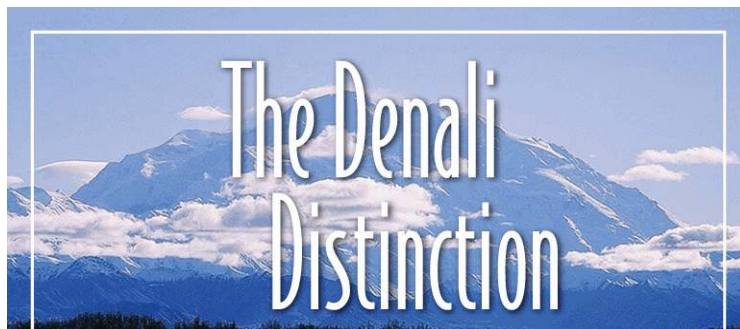
The only thing missing from **My Typhoon's** resume is a Grade I win, and, if the rains stay away long enough, she could get it here. Fourth by a length to stablemate Angara (GB) in last year's renewal, the regally bred chestnut captured a pair of graded stakes in 2006, but has come into her own this year at five, taking the off-the-turf-onto-Polytrack GII Jenny Wiley S. Apr. 14 and wiring the field in the GII Just a Game S. June 9 at Belmont in her most recent outing.

"After last year, I lobbied to keep her in training and it seems like she's better than ever now," said trainer Bill Mott. "I think as she's progressed, she's a little more rateable than she was as a two- and three-year-old, so that will help." **cont. p5**

But Mott is keeping an eye on the weather forecast. "I'm hoping for some firmer ground than we had in last year's Diana," he added. "We brought Angara in at the last minute because of the rain last year and I don't think [My Typhoon] is as good on softer turf." Weather or not, My Typhoon will have to deal with **Makderah** in the stretch. The Shadwell homebred, a listed winner in England in 2006, finished second in her U.S. opener at Keeneland Apr. 27, but used a Belmont allowance score May 31 as a springboard to a rousing four-length tally in the GII New York H. last out June 23. "She's a special filly," said trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "This is a good race, but we're very confident."

Two years ago, **Commentator** posted his biggest career victory at Saratoga with a neck-decision over subsequent Horse of the Year Saint Liam in the GI Whitney H. The speedy chestnut has made only five starts since, but has shown flashes on his best day. The chestnut made two starts last season, annexing Belmont's Mugatea S. against state-breds in July before closing out the year with a disappointing 10th-place finish as the 4-5 favorite in this track's GI Forego S. Sept. 2. Commentator beat up on state-breds once again in his 2007 debut, reporting home an 11 1/4-length winner in Belmont's Richmond Runner S. May 28. He most recently faded to finish third in the July 4 GII Tom Fool BC H. after contesting fast fractions of :22 and :43 4/5. **Diabolical** has really come of age since kept sprinting.

The 1-5 chalk in an Arlington allowance July 15, he cruised to a seven-length score. **A.P. Arrow** was third in the Feb. 3 GI Donn H. and Mar. 3 GII Gulfstream Park H. before posting a head success in the Mar. 31 GIII Skip Away H. Godolphin sends out a duo headed by **Winged Cupid**, who created a striking impression when making light of a near two-year absence and winning the June 30 Listed Midsummer S. at Windsor. His sole defeat came on his penultimate start when runner-up in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster in October 2005 and he has time yet to justify his purchase soon after that race. The operation's **Stage Gift** comes here off a success in Longchamp's G3 la Coupe June 14 and is no back number. "Winged Cupid won very well last time," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "He needed the race and has improved for it. This is his chance to go for a big prize. I think the trip will suit him and the ground will be fine. Stage Gift likes to be in front and he did it well in France last time. He is also in good form." Aidan O'Brien relies on **Eagle Mountain**, who clipped heels and lost Kieren Fallon during the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp last time July 14. Previously, he had finished fifth in Newmarket's G1 2000 Guineas May 5, runner-up in the June 2 G1 Epsom Derby and third in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh July 1 and sets a high standard.
