### THIS STREET LEADS TO THE TRAVERS

He wasn't dazzling, but he didn't need to be. Making his first start since running second to Curlin in the GI Preakness S., Jim Tafel's **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire})

posted a professional 1 1/2-length win over a game **C P West** (Came Home) in yesterday's GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga. In tight rounding the far turn, Street Sense was angled out by jockey Calvin Borel in upper stretch and outslugged C P West to the wire.

"It's great to have him

back," said Borel afterwards. "He needed this race. It's really going to move him forward. He leveled off beautifully." The GI Kentucky Derby winner's victory was the perfect prep for his next target, the GI Travers S. at Saratoga Aug. 25. "One down, three to go," said trainer Carl Nafzger, who has mapped out a course for Street Sense that includes the Travers, the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Invitational at Belmont Sept. 30, and his ultimate target, the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Monmouth Park Oct. 27. **Cont. p2**

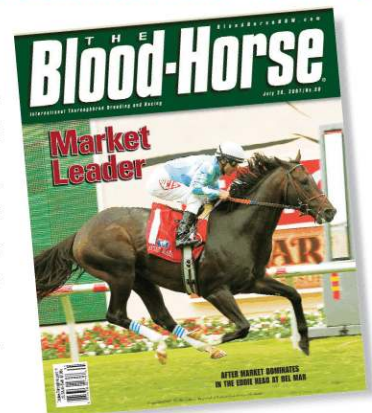
### NINE LINE UP FOR THE AMSTERDAM

**The Making of a Marquee Name...**

Despite his good third-place finish to Great Hunter in Keeneland's GI Breeders' Futurity, Street Sense was flying beneath the radar when he entered the gate as a 15-1 shot in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. But after securing end-of-year honors with a dazzling 10-length romp in the Juvenile, Street Sense would become a marquee name. He confirmed his two-year-old form with strong efforts in the Mar. 17 GIII Tampa Bay Derby, which he won by a nostril over Any Given Saturday, and a nose runner-up performance in the Apr. 14 GI Blue Grass S. at Keeneland. Favored in the May 5 GI Kentucky Derby, Street Sense put in a sensational effort, rallying from the back of the pack under a rail-skimming Borel ride to defeat Hard Spun by 2 1/4 lengths. It looked as if he had the May 19 GI Preakness S. in the bag, too, as he forged to the front in the stretch, but an ultra-game Curlin came on again in the dying strides to dash any Triple Crown dreams for Team Street Sense.

**See You on the Flip Side...**

Kicking off the second half of his season here, Street Sense settled in a good position several lengths off the pace of longshot Flashstorm (Storm Cat) and C P West. Borel had to play the waiting game while boxed in on the rail, but got his chance when daylight appeared in upper stretch. Responding to Borel's encouragement, Street Sense rallied wide and reeled in C P West before edging clear in the final sixteenth as Borel blew kisses to the crowd. "They got him in a trap and kept him there, but he got out and he responded," said trainer Carl Nafzger. "I was concerned; you're always concerned until you get out. You don't know how much that can take out of your horse. Once he got out, he came on with his run. It was a good, solid prep to get him ready for the Travers." Trainer Nick Zito was pleased with C P West's effort. "I'm excited. He ran second to a champion. We never stopped trying." The previously undefeated Tiz Wonderful (Tiznow), Stonestreet's dual graded winner who was returning from injury, pressed the pace while wide before tiring badly down the lane and finishing last of six.

Progressing from a sole-start juvenile win at Saint-Cloud last November, Darjina gave notice of her potential when garnering the one-mile G3 Prix de la Grotte at Longchamp Apr. 15 before confirming status when inching out Finsceal Beo (Ire) in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) back over that course and distance May 13. She was no match for Indian Ink (Ire) over unsuitable conditions in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 22, but bounced back under substitute Thierry Thulliez here to record a most determined victory. Settled in a prominent third after an efficient break, Darjina made solid progress to take a slender advantage from Simply Perfect into the final quarter mile. She came under increased pressure from the eighth pole, but held enough in reserve to withstand the wide bid of Missvinski and the rallying effort of Simply Perfect along the rail.

"She was a little fresh early on, but she settled very well and quickened nicely to again show what a fighter she is," explained winning trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre. "I think she stays really well as her dam was a nice 12-furlong filly. She is in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois [at Deauville Aug. 12], but I'm not sure about that race. We will definitely consider the G1 Prix de l'Opera [at Longchamp Oct. 7] for her later on." The winning rider added, "It was nice to be called in to ride such a nice filly. She was a little fresh early, but was fine once under cover. Maybe she was in front a little too soon, but I knew she would fight."

**Rouget hints at Stateside for Missvinski...**

Runner-up Missvinski, who also chased Darjina's tail in the G3 Prix de la Grotte and G1 Coronation S., might be headed for a campaign in the United States, according to trainer Jean-Claude Rouget. "I'm really pleased because that is her best race ever," Rouget commented. "We'll have to see for the future as she won't stay further than a mile. In Summation began his career with trainer Frank Gomez, who saddled the colt to a quartet of juvenile stakes at Calder in 2005. Moved to Christophe Clement's barn after going on a slump last spring, the dark bay was switched to the grass and, while his form improved, he still had some trouble finding the winner's circle. He ran second in his first three efforts for Clement--the Restoration S. at Monmouth, the GII

Nearctic S. at Woodbine, and the GIII Hollywood Turf Express H. at Hollywood last November. In Summation concluded his year with a close-up fifth in the GIII Sir Beaufort S. at Santa Anita in December, then got a few months off before returning with a fourth-place try in the GIII Shakertown S. at

Keeneland in April. He finally found the winner's circle last time, rallying to take Monmouth's Sneakbox S. June 23, a strong effort that prompted Clement to give his charge a shot at Grade I glory in this event. Partnered with Corey Nakatani, In Summation was well placed off the pace as Bordonaro dueled for the lead with Battle Won (Honour and Glory).

In Summation geared up for a three-wide run leaving the quarter pole as Battle Won began to tire, targeting a softened-up Bordonaro with Greg's Gold following just behind. It was anyone's race with a furlong left to run, but In Summation proved gamest as he and Greg's Gold hit the line together. It was another length and a half back to Bordonaro. In an evenly matched field that saw six horses go off at 8-1 or less, the three-year-old E Z Warrior (Exploit), the slight favorite returning from a freshening, stumbled at the start and never got into the race, finishing next to last.

Similarly, 2004 juvenile champ Declan's Moon (Malibu Moon), looking to build off a Hollywood allowance victory, made little impact in a sixth-place effort. Owner Eugene Melnyk completed the weekend stakes double at Woodbine yesterday when Gouldings Green successfully defended his title in this race. On Saturday, Melnyk's Sealy Hill captured the Wonder Where S. at Woodbine. Winner of the GIII Turfway Park Fall Championship S. last fall, Gouldings Green was winless in two starts this year, running third in the GIII Hanshin H. at Arlington May 26 and sixth in an optional claimer at that track June 16. Here, he rallied from a stalking position, collared Palladio and drew clear to take it by two lengths. "He broke pretty sharp," said winning jockey Patrick Husbands, who was aboard Sealy Hill Saturday. "I just sat patient and bided time until the quarter pole. When I asked him down the lane, he gave me 110 [percent]." Prior to the race, Husbands was given instructions via cell phone by trainer Tony Reinstedler. "He said 'Everything is in your hands. 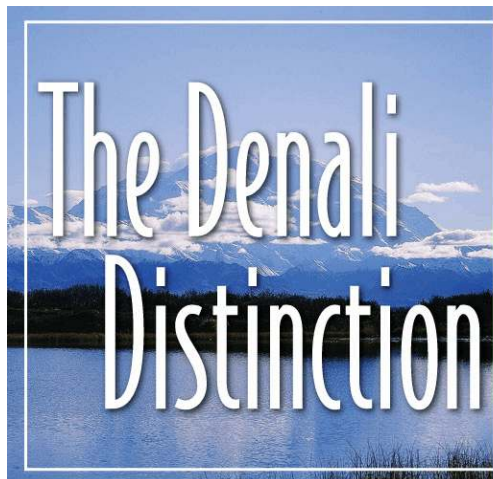

**DRF QUESTIONS LAWYER RON'S RECORD**

*Daily Racing Form* publisher Steve Crist yesterday questioned the accuracy of the timing of Saturday's G1 Whitney H., in which winner **Lawyer Ron** (Langfuhr) was given credit for a new track record at historic Saratoga Race Course. According to the chart of the race, the Hines Racing colorbearer stopped the clock in 1:46.64 for the nine furlongs, shaving nearly two ticks off the previous track record shared by two horses: Left Bank, who won the 2002 Whitney in 1:47.04, and Tri Jet, who established the mark of 1:47 in 1974. Crist said the internal fractions of the race raise a red flag. Pacesetter and eventual runner-up **Wanderin Boy** (Seeking the Gold) led the way through splits of :23.86, :47.37 and 1:10.28, meaning the third quarter of the race was run in an "unreasonably fast" 22.91 seconds, according to Crist. "We're going to take a look at it," said New York Racing Association chairman Steve Duncker told *DRF*. "We don't want to establish a major track record like this by mistake."

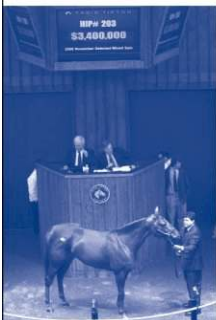

We're looking forward now--we're confident of finding a sponsor for next year's King George and prize money is on our minds in order to build on the international element. The King George is the country's top-rated and most prestigious all-aged race with a wonderful history--press comment and indeed comment from the industry as a whole has been very comforting in that it seems that we are not the only ones that want it to be the championship race it has always been."
