KNOCKOUT BLOW FOR TEOFILO

Jackie Bolger's **Teofilo (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}--Speirbhean {Ire} by Danehill), Europe's champion juvenile of 2006, has failed to win his battle with injury and has been

retired, trainer Jim Bolger announced yesterday. Stud plans have yet to be finalized. "Following an unsatisfactory scan, it has been decided to retire Teofilo from racing with immediate effect," Bolger said in a prepared statement. "Jackie and Jim Bolger would like to thank their staff who have worked tirelessly with

great dedication, making every effort to return Teofilo to the racecourse. They would also like to thank the many well-wishers who have taken such an interest in the past year. They are most grateful to the sponsors of every prestigious race Teofilo won in his short but spectacular career, in which he was unbeaten and secured the coveted title of champion European two-year-old." In a classic case of what might have been, the strapping bay entered winter quarters as ante-post favorite for both 2000 Guineas and Derby after powering through a five-race juvenile campaign unbeaten. Suggestions of an attempt at a first British Triple Crown since Nijinsky II's 1970 feat were also mooted, but the sophomore failed to meet his date with destiny after suffering a recurrence of a tendon injury on the eve of the Guineas meeting. Starting off in a Curragh maiden in July 2006, he bagged a first stakes in the Listed Tyros S. at Leopardstown the same month before garnering the G2 Futurity S. back at The Curragh in August. Engaging Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) in the G1 National S., once again at the Curragh, in September, Teofilo disposed of that rival with panache, but found him a tougher nut to crack in, ultimately, his career closer in a thrilling renewal of the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket in October. He retires with a perfect five-for-five record and earnings of £349,516.

SETTING THE TEMPO

Cheveley Park Stud's **Allegretto (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) carved her name in history yesterday, becoming the first of her sex to win the G2 Goodwood Cup. Penalised for her success in the G2 Henry II S. at Sandown May 29, the four-year-old put a poor display in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup behind her with a late show to steal the race from under the nose of **Veracity (GB)** (Lomitas {GB}) and score by a half-length. In doing so, the 8-1 shot was completing a group-race treble for jockey Ryan Moore, having scored on Hi Calypso (Ire) in the G3 Lillie Langtry S. and Moorhouse Lad (GB) in the G3 King George S. "She's really gutsy and they went very fast, so I always thought she'd pick them up as she stays very well," he said. "She had a bit to find with a few, but she's really improving." Cont. p2

Post positions were drawn yesterday for the \$1 million Haskell, with morning-line favorite **Curlin** breaking from post six. "It will be a fine draw him," said trainer Steve Asmussen, who added that he expected Curlin to do his running from off the pace in what, on paper, looks to be a race with plenty of speed. While Allegretto is not a homebred, she fits perfectly the profile of the highly progressive Cheveley Park filly, which has become almost commonplace in recent times. Having won the G2 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock last July, the chestnut was a respectable third in both the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York the following month and G2 Park Hill S. at Doncaster in September. Only fifth on her return in the May 18 G2 Yorkshire Cup, she was fitted with a visor ahead of the May 29 Henry II, and the headgear worked wonders as she returned to her winning ways. Keen early in the June 21 G1 Ascot Gold Cup, she had thrown away her chance by the time the action had heated up in the stretch. More amenable to restraint this time, she raced in rear off the solid pace and had a mountain to climb as the field straightened for home.

Picking her way past rivals one by one, she built a head of steam by the time Philip Robinson had galvanized Veracity to take a seemingly decisive advantage and swamped that foe in the final 100 yards. “We will have to think about what to do,” the Stud’s Racing Manager Chris Richardson told *PA Sport*. “After Ascot, we were thinking that could be her swansong, but she is back now, and we will look at the options. There is nothing of her, but she has a fantastic pedigree. When we bought her, we were just pleased to get into that family and she is now a proper mare for the future.” Veracity’s trainer Michael Jarvis is looking at the Sept. 15 G1 St Leger at Doncaster, while Jamie Osborne, trainer of the 6-4 pick Geordieland (Fr) (Johann Quatz {Fr}), stated that he raced too keenly before finishing fifth. Hi Calypso, who hails from the high-class family of Triptych, is typical of the type of late-improving distaffer with which Sir Michael Stoute excels. Allowed to find her rhythm in lesser company, she showed that she was prepared for a step up when taking a handicap at Newbury June 14 and underlined that impression when following up at Salisbury 13 days later. Languishing in last place early off the sensible pace set by Trick of Treat, the homebred was wound up for her challenge at the top of the straight by Ryan Moore. Despite taking time to hit top stride, she responded in game fashion and her momentum carried her past the long-time leader and Wannabe Posh in the final 100 yards. "She's really progressing and going the right way," her rider commented. "She doesn't travel great early, but as soon as they started quickening up I always felt she was going to get there. Goodwood's downhill five-furlong strip is among the fastest in Europe and Moorhouse Lad proved one of the most visually impressive to have negotiated it when recording an emphatic victory here. Favored by a quick track, the former handicapper failed by a neck in the valuable Dash H. on Epsom's Derby Day June 2 before finishing down the field in the June 19 G2 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot. He rebounded to win the Voute Sales H. on his latest outing at Newmarket July 12. Breaking best of all this time, the bay's enthusiasm was curtailed by Ryan Moore, who was keen to accept a lead until the quarter pole. Lit up passing that marker, he had cut loose in an instant and was safely clear as Enticing got the better of Tax Free on the stands' side. "He's pretty good and is one of the fastest I've ridden," commented his jockey. "He showed great speed out of the gates and relaxed in behind. He travelled well to the two-pole and when I gave him a dig one and a half down he quickened up really well."

The Need for Speed?

Not surprisingly, the draw for Sunday's Haskell raised more questions than it answered. With the unbeaten **Cable Boy** (Jump Start), who comes off an impressive wire-to-wire performance in the Coronado's Quest S. over this strip June 24, lining up in post two, just to the inside of **Stormello** (Stormy Atlantic), who was on the lead through a half in :44 4/5 in Belmont's June 9 GII Woody Stephens BC S., some are predicting something resembling a drag race in the early stages of the Haskell. But that might not be the case, according to the connections of the former. "We don't think he needs the lead," said Cable Boy's trainer Pat McBurney. "He's just been so much better than his competition, and we really don't want to be in a suicidal pace. We'll just play it by the break and see what happens." Cable Boy has led at every call in his last two, but did come from just off the pace in his maiden victory in May. All three of Stormello's victories have come on the front end, including a win in last year's GI Hollywood Futurity, and it sounded as if trainer and co-owner Bill Currin would be more than happy with the lead, should Cable Boy be taken off the pace. "Assuming he breaks alert--he typically does--[it] looks like he'll be where I want him," said Currin. "It looks like I am going to have to scoot and go, and they tell me this track is good for my horse. If that's so, we may have some fun. If it's not, we're in deep, deep trouble." A couple of hours before Monmouth's Mike Dempsey and Mike Melendez drew post positions for the Haskell, **Hard Spun** put in his final serious work. The Fox Hill Farm colorbearer, who is making his first start since running a tired fourth in the June 9 GI Belmont S., blew out three furlongs in :34 at Delaware Park. "He's done well since the Belmont--put on some weight," said trainer Larry Jones said. "I'm glad we could give him that break."

Miss Macy Sue has done nothing wrong in her last four trips to the post, winning those by a combined 17 1/4 lengths. The streak began at Oaklawn in late March, when she romped by six lengths in her four-year-old debut in the Carousel S. She won by a similar margin in a laugher in a minor stakes at Prairie Meadows, her home base, in her next outing Apr. 28, but proved she was the real deal in a smart victory in the six-furlong GIII Winning Colors S. at Churchill May 28. Her victory, which came at the expense of Cuaba, an allowance winner over this track Wednesday, established a new stakes record of 1:08.68.

Miss Macy Sue returned to Prairie Meadows to annex the \$100,000 Saylorville S. as the crowd's 3-5 pick June 29, and is once again taking her show on the road. Miss Macy Sue arrived at Saratoga last week after making the long trip from Iowa. "If we ship her for a race outside of Prairie Meadows, we need to plan for two travel days because there isn't an airport nearby to ship horses," trainer Kelly Von Hemel explained. "She spent about 9-10 hours in a van before she was put on a plane for Saratoga." Miss Macy Sue put the finishing touches on her preparations for this with a three-furlong blowout in :34 4/5 on this main track July 30, the fastest of 17 works at the distance.

"The trip hasn't really bother her," added her trainer. "I think her workout proved that." The nicely bred **Indian Flare**, a half to Latent Heat, captured her first graded win in the June 17 GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont, but was well beaten over a drying-out track in the GI Princess Rooney H. at Calder July 7. She looks to rebound off that effort with a pair of very good four-furlong works to her credit, including a :48 4/5 drill (4/21) over the Oklahoma surface July 28.

Peter Chapple-Hyam has collected two of the last three renewals courtesy of Montgomery's Arch in 2004 and Hamoodly 12 months ago, having already won with Polaris Flight during his first spell in England back in 1995. **Western Art** shed his maiden tag in the Listed Dragon S. at Sandown July 6 and his connections are hoping he can build on that effort. "I think he is a very nice horse in the making, a horse who could grow into a decent Classic horse next year," owner Matthew Green's Racing manager Jimmy Lindley told the *Racing Post*. "He found a second gear to win at Sandown and never lost a kilo," the former jockey added. Aidan O'Brien relies on **One Great Cat**, who followed a promising debut third behind subsequent G3 Anglesey S. winner Myboycharlie (Ire) at The Curragh June 30 with a game success in the mud at Fairyhouse 12 days ago. John Gosden saddled Bachir (Ire) to win in 1999 and the subsequently disqualified Endless Summer (GB) to double up a year later and puts forward **Master Chef**. He took four outings to break his maiden, but his display at Ascot July 13 stamped him as a colt to follow. "Master Chef won in good style at Ascot the other day," his trainer commented. "I just popped on a little semi-blinker which concentrated his mind. He had previously run a bit timidly, being more worried about the other horses rather than getting on with the job--he has always shown speed. He is genuine--it is just a question of helping him to concentrate." Gosden is also represented by **Legal Eagle**, who showed a smart turn of foot in desperate conditions when taking a Newbury maiden July 5.

Better Talk Now Confirmed for Sword Dancer:

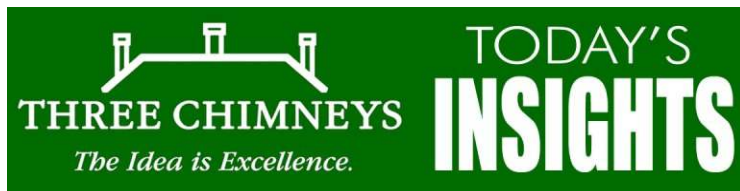

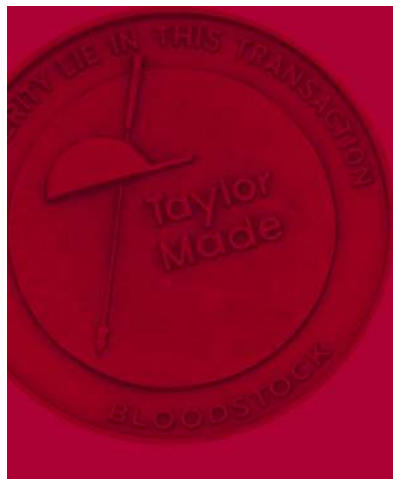
