**IT'S SHOWTIME IN SARATOGA**

A total of 214 yearlings are set to go under auctioneer Walter Robertson's hammer as the yearling sales scene shifts to Saratoga Springs, New York, for the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Selected Yearlings Sale. With its clientele in mind, officials at the auction house have shifted the two-day event to Monday and Tuesday, beginning each night at 7 p.m. "We have a very professional buying base," commented Fasig-Tipton Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer Boyd Browning Jr. "Our buyers come in and they have the weekend to look at horses, and by doing this, we can enable them to get back home just a little bit sooner." With the discontinuation of the Keeneland July Sale, the Saratoga sale remains the lone boutique sale, and buyers from all over the world have their choice among youngsters by sires such as A.P.

Indy, Awesome Again, Distorted Humor, Dynaformer, El Prado (Ire), Elusive Quality, Forestry, Fusaichi Pegasus, Giant's Causeway, Gone West, Grand Slam, Johannesburg, Malibu Moon, Maria's Mon, More Than Ready, Mr. Greeley, Officer, Pulpit, Smart Strike, Songandaprayer, Storm Cat, Street Cry (Ire), Successful Appeal, Tale of the Cat, Thunder Gulch, Touch Gold, Unbridled's Song and Yes It's True. Stallions with first or second-crop yearlings include Aldebaran, Empire Maker, Harlan's Holiday, Lion Heart, Medaglia d'Oro, Mineshaft, Pleasantly Perfect, Smarty Jones, Strong Hope, Tapit, The Cliff's Edge and Vindication. Last year's Saratoga sale was highlighted by the sale of an Empire Maker--Sluice filly for \$1.6 million, one of five seven-figure offerings over the two sessions. Browning is hopeful of even better results this time around. "I think the catalogue is a little better [than last year], in terms of physicals and conformation," he stated. "It's a very, very good group of horses and the buyers have indicated they really like what they've seen, so I think it'll be very positive."

**MARCHAND DE GHEEST**

**Marchand d'Or (Fr)** (Marchand de Sable) left no doubt that he was the best on the day in last year's G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest and the grey was similarly demonstrative as he secured back-to-back successes at Deauville yesterday. "I think he's still learning and there might be better to come," trainer Freddie Head commented. The plan is to go for the [Sept. 8] G1 Haydock Sprint Cup and then the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 6] and see from there."



**JUST ABOUT ANY GIVEN DAY**

**Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor) continued to lay claim to leader of the second half of the sophomore season with a dominant 4 1/2-length win in yesterday's GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park. The dark bay colt was knocking on the door on the Triple Crown trail, battling subsequent Kentucky Derby winner Street Sense to a head loss in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby and running third in the GI Wood Memorial S. Given time to regroup after an eighth-place finish in the Kentucky Derby, Any Given Saturday returned with a vengeance, taking the July 4 GII Dwyer S. by an expanding four lengths. Second choice behind Preakness S. winner **Curlin** (Smart Strike) in yesterday's Haskell, the Todd Pletcher trainee settled into third as local favorite **Cable Boy** (Jump Start) led the field through moderate fractions. As Cable Boy tired, **Hard Spun** (Danzig) inherited the lead, but was soon overtaken by Any Given Saturday, who surged to the lead and drew clear authoritatively. Curlin, making his first start since a runner-up effort in the June 9 GI Belmont S., closed late and just missed catching Hard Spun for second. "The way he ran today, the Breeders' Cup Classic at Monmouth Park is our goal," Pletcher confirmed. *Cont. p2*

More at home over seven furlongs in the G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot June 25, he scored a comfortable success before finishing fourth behind **Sakhee's Secret (GB)** in the G1 July Cup July 13. Held up towards the rear by **Davy Bonilla** early, the four-year-old swept widest of all the runners spread across the track to inhale **Dutch Art** with a furlong remaining and quickly asserted to take command. "He ran a great race in the July Cup over a trip a shade too short for him, but won this in great style as he did last year," trainer **Freddie Head** said. Nashoba's Key didn't make her first start until she was already four, but the bay filly has quickly made up for lost time. After beating up on state-bred foes over the winter and spring, Nashoba's Key jumped into the graded stakes ranks and promptly won the June 3 GII Milady Breeders' Cup H. She returned to prove that effort was no fluke with a win in the July 7 GI Vanity H. The heavy favorite to go six for six, Nashoba's Key was bumped at the break and tried the footing inside and out under jockey Joe Talamo. Boxed in between foes in the four-horse field, the determined four-year-old eased to the outside at midstretch and willingly overtook Bai and Bai to win going away. "I knew they were crawling up front and I knew I was going to have to deal with that," Talamo explained after the race. "And then Victor [Espinoza on Balance] was race riding like crazy on the backside. I knew what he was doing but I had to be patient. I was sitting there with my filly with her ears up and I could feel I had so much horse under me. So even though it looked like I might have been in trouble, I was confident. Velazquez isn't concerned with that loss. "That day was a completely different scenario," Velazquez said. "My horse was hooked up on the lead with another horse and it kind of set up a lot better for Marcavelly. Hopefully, we will be able to settle and then it will be a different race."

Breeder Mueller Farms purchased Queen is Money for \$125,000 at the 2004 KEENOV sale while in foal to Aldebaran, and earned that back and more when that foal, a filly named Crowninshief, made \$220,000 at last year's FTKJUL sale. They hope this fellow can outdo his year-older half-sister. "He's a very good colt out of a good stakes-producing, Grade I-placed mare, and he really looks like his sire," said consignor John Stuart. "He really looks the part."

**Hip 85, f, Strong Hope--Restored Hope, by He's Bad**

Strong Hope was a strapping, handsome son of Grand Slam who brought \$1.7 million at this sale in 2001, and ran to his good looks, securing wins in the GII Dwyer S. and GII Jim Dandy S., the latter coming at the expense of Empire Maker. Now standing stud at Claiborne Farm, he is represented by five catalogued horses here, including this filly, a half to GSW Sabellina (Langfuhr). "I really like these Strong Hopes and I think he's going to be a very popular sire," said consignor John Stuart. "They really sold well. This is the first mare I've bred to him and I haven't had a filly this good off my farm in five or six years. The mare was a New York graded stakes winner and I like to take a mare like that and breed to a real popular first-year stallion. I wanted a big, strong horse for her. He's got the big body and bone. This filly has that big, strong body."
