**THE ORIGINAL MILLION-DOLLAR BABY**

While races with high seven-figure purse money now dot the Thoroughbred racing landscape, the GI Arlington Million is the original McCoy. Some of the greats of the turf have won it, including John Henry, Perrault, Teleprompter, Estrapade, Steinlen, Manila, Star of Cozzene and Paradise Creek. This afternoon, a field of nine older turf males will face the starter for the 25th

running of the Million--the race was not contested in 1998 and 1999--and favored to add his name to the honor roll is Martin and Pam Wygod's **After Market** (Storm Cat). The son of the couple's wonderful racemare Tranquility Lake (Rahy) carries a three-race winning streak into today's 10-furlong affair, including victories in the June 9 GI Charles Whittingham Memorial H. and the GI Eddie Read H. July 22. "That's probably the only concern is the short time between races, but the Arlington Million is such a prestigious race and it'd be a great race to win and After Market is doing very well and he's just got that explosive kick," trainer John Shirreffs commented. But is After Market a beatable favorite? Steady rains in Greater Chicago this week will lead to yielding raceday conditions underfoot and, in his lone appearance over an off turf course, After Market was last at even money in last year's GII Kent Breeders' Cup S. at Delaware Park. That fact likely contributed to the colt's move to the West Coast this season, as he appears to like the top of the ground. Shirreffs is impressed with After Market as a physical specimen. "He's deceptively tall, because he's so large," he explained. "He's got a big, thick body and he's very muscular. And so you don't realize how tall he is until you get next to him, but he's just a big, robust horse that feels excellent."

**The Tin Man All Heart...**

Ralph and Aury Todd's **The Tin Man** (Affirmed) is back at age nine to defend his championship. Drawn just outside the morning-line favorite, the on-pace runner has three starts to his credit since last year's victory, including a game success in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile May 28. He was most recently beaten by a head when runner-up in the GI American Invitational H. June 30, a race in which he was victorious prior to last year's Million. Some cut in the ground will not inconvenience The Tin Man. The dark bay was a close fourth in the 2002 GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Arlington over yielding going and he took the 2005 running of the GI San Luis Obispo H. over a yielding Santa Anita turf course. Victor Espinoza has a return call.

**Quality Over Quantity...**

With just eight runners signed on for the \$600,000 first prize, the Million doesn't exactly have strength in numbers, but is deep in quality. English Channel remains in New York for today's GI Sword Dancer H., but the Todd Pletcher barn is represented by Aaron and Marie Jones's **Sunriver** (Saint Ballado). A perfect two-for-two on the lawn, the four-year-old can be expected to tussle on the front end with The Tin Man. The foreign contingent is not as strong as years past, but is not without its chances. **Danak (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) is an unknown on these shores, but won his first five career starts, including the G3 Amethyst S. at The Curragh May 13. He returned two weeks later and was fourth, beaten 5 1/2 lengths by Notnowcato (GB), in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup. The Aga Khan homebred breezed a easy three furlongs on the soft Arlington turf in :40 4/5 yesterday morning and gets Mick Kinane in the saddle. **Doctor Dino (Fr)** (Muhtathir {GB}), third to Dylan Thomas (Ire) in the G1 Prix Ganay Apr. 29, was most recently a good third in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji Racecourse May 20.

at Arlington. Six for seven since being switched to the grass, the four-year-old Citronnade does her best work on the engine and was not headed in winning the GII San Gorgonio H., the GII Santa Ana H., the GI Gamely S. and the July 1 GII Beverly Hills H. Trainer Bobby Frankel knows his way to the Beverly D. winner's circle, having saddled Possibly Perfect to an impressive victory in 1995 and Heat Haze (GB) in 2003. Honey Ryder is back, looking to improve on her

fourth-place effort to Gorella (Fr) in last year's 'D.' Winner of the GII Sheepshead Bay H. at Belmont Park May 26, the gray mare enters the race off an excellent runner-up finish to stablemate English Channel in the GI United Nations S. at Monmouth Park July 7. Garrett Gomez, a one-time fan favorite in Chicago, is in to pilot Honey Ryder for trainer Todd Pletcher. **Lady of Venice (Fr)** (Loup Solitaire) aims to give trainer Patrick Biancone and owner Marty Schwartz an unprecedented three straight wins in the Beverly D. Victorious in the GIII Ouija Board Distaff H. over a soft Lone Star turf May 28, she exhibited a turn of foot reminiscent of ex-stablemate Gorella when rallying from eighth to take the \$1-million GII CashCall Mile at Hollywood Park July 6. She must prove that she can handle the extra 1 1/2 furlongs this afternoon. **Irridescence (SAf)** (Caesour) is a Group 1 winner in her native country as well as Hong Kong, and looms a threat today. At her best on or near the lead, she, along with longshot local **Jennie R.** (Awesome Again) could cause some headaches for Citronnade. "With seven runners, there shouldn't be much difference, but Citronnade is probably the horse to beat and she drew post one, so we'll be able to keep an eye on her," said trainer Mike de Kock. "I'd imagine we'll be in the top three during the early stages of the race."

Multi-millionaire **English Channel** had traded decisions with Better Talk Now this year, finishing second to that gelding in the GI Manhattan H. June 9 before turning the tables with a score in the GI United Nations July 7 at Monmouth. His job here becomes easier after **Better Talk Now** was scratched yesterday morning with an ankle wound. "He exited the United Nations with a nasty wound on his ankle and, although it healed in recent weeks, it began to flare up again," explained trainer Graham Motion. "I had to treat him with antibiotics and he's going to need to walk for a week, maybe two." Motion added, "He's got a tendency to hit himself when he's running; that's why I put the bandages on him. He caught himself pretty badly in the UN. He went right through the bandage. This is a temporary thing, but the timing is terrible. I don't want the same scenario a month from now, so we're going to give him the time and treat it. I want him to heal so he's fine the rest of the year. I'm disappointed for the owners and the horse, but more disappointed for the fans of Saratoga. It was such a big day and it would have been a great race with him and English Channel." **Always First** does his best running at this 12-furlong distance. Second in both the GIII Elkhorn S. Apr. 27 and GIII Louisville H. May 26, the six-year-old stepped up with a game effort over a soft Arlington course to land the GIII Stars and Stripes H. July 4 last out.

**EUROS HOLD A STRONG HAND IN SECRETARIAT**

For the most part, European-based three-year-olds have run well in the GI Secretariat S. without making much of a winning impact. Trainer Aidan O'Brien is responsible for having sent out Europe's lone winner of the race--Jayeff 'B' Stables' **Ciro** in 2000--but the

**Admiralofthefleet** (Danehill). A Group 2 winner over a mile at two, the homebred colt posted his best performance of this season in the 10 1/2-furlong G3 Dee S. at Chester May 11, scoring by two

solid lengths. He failed to see out the 1 1/2 miles of the G1 Epsom Derby June 2, finishing 10<sup>th</sup>, and was most recently fifth to Notnowcato (GB) and Derby hero Authorized (GB) in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 7. The bay colt two-minute-licked over the soft turf yesterday, covering his final eighth of a mile in :12.20 and adds blinkers today.

Heavy ground was likely his undoing when ninth at 15-2 in the G1 Irish Derby July 1 and the footing is likely to be sounder this afternoon. Shamdinan breezed three furlongs on the Polytrack in :40 yesterday morning. Peachtree Stable's **Red Giant** (Giant's Causeway) seeks a fourth consecutive victory, and to prove that his 37-1 upset of the GII Virginia Derby is something other than a fluke. The form of the GII American Derby, the local prep for the Secretariat, is represented by winner **Lattice** (Arch) and runner-up **Going Ballistic** (Lite the Fuse).

Sangster's Swettenham Stud was widely heralded as one of the first truly global breeding and racing operations, responsible for luminaries such as Sadler's Wells, Storm Bird, Alleged, The Minstrel, Golden Fleece, El Gran Senor, Dr Devious (Ire) and Rodrigo de Triano. The leading owner in Britain five times, Sangster expanded his operations to the Southern Hemisphere in the 1970s, beginning the widespread shuttling of stallions between hemispheres. With the late legendary trainer Colin Hayes, he established Collingrove Stud in Australia in 1995; it was renamed Swettenham Stud in 2005. The family continued his legacy after Sangster passed away in 2004 at age 67; Sangster's son Ben, who lives at the Marlborough Estate with brother Guy, is committed to remaining in the bloodstock business, while brother Adam will continue to play a major role in the Australian racing and breeding scene. "The racehorses in both hemispheres will continue in training and will run in the family colours," the statement clarified. "In the UK, Manton, the premier private training establishment in Europe, will continue to be owned by the family, who remain fully committed to working closely with Brian Meehan and his staff. It is Ben Sangster's intention to increase his bloodstock interests in the Northern Hemisphere, as is Adam's in the Southern Hemisphere." Trainer Brian Meehan's presence at the family's 2,800-acre estate is set to continue, with the family pledging full support. "I guess, realistically, it takes the pressure off," Meehan commented. "It's a public set-up open to whoever wishes to use our services--I have a dozen or more in training for the Sangster family and hopefully, we'll have a similar number next year."

**CURLIN CO-OWNERS ORDERED JAILED** Three lawyers, including two of the co-owners of GI Preakness S. winner Curlin, have been remanded to jail after a federal judge agreed with lawyers' requests to delay their trial date, but simultaneously elected to revoke their bail, *Kentucky.com* reports. Shirley Cunningham Jr. and William Gallion, who face the prospect of 20 years in prison, are accused of having pocketed \$64 million of a \$200-million settlement involving the drug Fen-Phen. The criminal trial had been set for Oct. 15, but lawyers asked for a continuation, explaining they had not had a chance to review more than 200,000 documents connected to the case. However, Judge William Bertelsman said that a civil lawsuit involving these same allegations had been put on hold, pending resolution of the criminal trial and warned lawyers that any request to delay the trial would result in a revocation of bond. The new trial is set for Jan. 7, 2008.

**Student Council Sold, to Run at Del Mar:**

**Student Council** (Kingmambo), winner of this year's Maxxam Gold Cup H., has been sold to owner Ro Parra, who intends on running the five-year-old against Lava Man and company in the GI Pacific Classic, *Daily Racing Form* reports. "Mr. Parra has been looking at him for quite a while," trainer Vladimir Cerin told the publication. A homebred for William S. Farish, Student Council was scratched from Friday's fifth race at Saratoga. He was also entered for the GI Whitney H., but was withdrawn from that event as well. "He's so consistent that he's more than an outsider," Cerin said. "It looks like he has a good chance to hit the board." In his most recent appearance, Student Council was second by a head to Brass Hat in a Churchill allowance test July 8.

**Fernando Jara Relocating to California:**

Fernando Jara, the regular rider of Horse of the Year Invasor (Arg) and GI Belmont S. winner Jazil, will move his tack to California, according to *Daily Racing Form*. His business will be handled by agent Bob Meldahl, who said that Jara will begin riding in earnest at the Oak Tree meeting in late September. Meldahl said that Hall of Famer Laffit Pincay Jr. has encouraged the move. "Laffit thought it would be a good fit for him to come out," he told the *Form*.

**All Indicators Up at Del Mar:**

As the current Del Mar meeting reaches its midpoint this afternoon, the track boasts increases in handle and attendance while heralding the success of their newly installed synthetic surface. Through Thursday's racing, Del Mar was showing a 3.1-percent increase in on-track handle from \$2,300,444 to \$2,372,737. Overall handle figures are even better, posting an increase of 5.8 percent from last year. On-track attendance is also better versus 2006, posting a 2.6-percent gain to 16,233 from 15,822. "We're always pleased when the handle and attendance numbers come in on the plus side," said Del Mar Thoroughbred Club President and General Manager Joe Harper, "but we're even more pleased this year with what's happening on the race-track." Track officials announced that through the opening three weeks of the meet, there had been no catastrophic injuries as compared to nine horses which were euthanized during the same period last summer. "I'm very pleased with what we've seen so far," said Dr. Rick Arthur, California Equine Medical Director. "I've spoken to many of my veterinarian colleagues on the backstretch and most of them are cautiously optimistic. We are still early in this process, but so far the results are very encouraging."

**ASCOT STAGES NEW-LOOK SHERGAR CUP**

Four teams will contest today's revamped Dubai Duty Free Shergar Cup at Ascot. Previously characterised by a straight match between a team of jockeys from Great Britain and Ireland combined, and a team of riders from the "Rest of the World," the six-race competition now features four squads of three riders from Great Britain, Ireland, Europe and the Rest of the World. "With four teams, there is a much better chance of the competition running to the end," Ascot's Head of PR Nick Smith explained. "We've got to keep regenerating this event." Among the international names this year is the leading Australian jockey Darren Beadman, who is paying his first visit to England. "There are some great riders here--some of the best in the world," Beadman said. "Back in Australia there is a lot of coverage of Royal Ascot, especially with the sprinters coming over for the meeting now. To be here at Ascot is a big thrill." Jason Weaver, who has been at the forefront of the Shergar Cup in recent times, believes the redesigned system will be a success. "The new format will make the Dubai Duty Free Shergar Cup much more competitive," Weaver said. "In some of the previous years, we have got to the third race and we basically knew which team was going to win, whereas this time around I think it will be competitive until the end." Team Ireland is the early 13-8 favourite on Ladbrokes, with Team Europe at 2-1 and Teams Britain and Rest of the World at 4-1. Also taking part are top riders Frankie Dettori (EUR), Yutaka Take (ROTW), Jimmy Fortune (IRE) and Andreas Suborics (EUR), who is the early individual favourite at 9-2. Points are awarded on a 15-10-7-5-3 basis.
