**CURLIN TO BYPASS TRAVERS**

Curlin (Smart Strike) will not contest the GI Travers S. at Saratoga, according to trainer Steve Asmussen yesterday. Instead, Asmussen will train the GI

Preakness S. winner up to the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Invitational Sept. 30 before a tilt at the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Monmouth Oct. 27. "After the [GI] Belmont S. [second to Rags to Riches, June 9], the Classic was the major goal for the second half of the season," said Asmussen. "Running him back in the Travers and keeping him at that level for another 60 days,

I think, is unrealistic." The handsome colt finished third behind Any Given Saturday and Hard Spun most recently in the GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Aug. 5. "I thought the opportunity was to run him at Monmouth over the racetrack and see how he would respond," said Asmussen. "With that in the bank, we can be at our best [for the Classic]." Possible to take Curlin's spot in the 10-furlong Travers is stablemate **Tiz Wonderful** (Tiznow), who breezed six furlongs in 1:14.22 over the Saratoga main track yesterday. "I thought he went excellent," said Asmussen. "He showed what I wanted. He went off nice and smooth, he picked it up nicely and galloped out good." The Stonestreet Stable representative finished last of six in the GII Jim Dandy S. July 28. "Three or four days [after the Jim Dandy], he bounced back nicely," said Asmussen. "I haven't ruled him out of the Travers. I'll have to see how he comes out of this work."

**KOWBOY AIMS TO BE SPECIAL**

**Kodiak Kowboy** (Posse), at the vanguard of Posse's impressive first crop, will aim for his second graded-stakes triumph Thursday in the GII Saratoga Special S. Trained by Steve Asmussen, who also conditioned Posse, Kodiak Kowboy won Woodbine's Victoria S.

June 17 and returned to capture the July 7 GIII Bashford Manor S. at Churchill last time out. "When he came back to the barn after winning the stakes race at Woodbine, we knew he had quality," said Asmussen. "For him to go up there and do that, then come back to the barn like he just

got off the track, there's a lot of substance to him." It's hard to imagine there is a two-year-old race at Saratoga that Todd Pletcher hasn't won, but the champion trainer will be seeking his first Special victory when he saddles **The Roundhouse** (Fusaichi Pegasus) Thursday. The Roundhouse was a late-running third behind stablemate Ready's Image in the GII Sanford S. "I'm trying to keep some of these colts separated," Pletcher admitted. "I don't think waiting around and waiting to run against Ready's Image again was as good of a plan as being the only stable representative in the Saratoga Special." Pletcher was satisfied with The Roundhouse's effort in the Sanford. "He had some traffic issues around the far turn," the trainer explained. "The horse on the inside bumped him three or four times. That probably cost him second." The seven-horse Special field also includes **Riley Tucker** (Harlan's Holiday), who romped home by six lengths in his July 20 debut at Belmont.

**WILKO AND CASH INCLUDED RETIRED** A pair of J. Paul Reddam-owned performers--**Wilko** (Awesome Again--Native Roots {Ire}, by Indian Ridge {Ire}) and **Cash Included** (Include--Henderson Band, by Chimes Band)--have been retired, according to published reports. At two, Wilko ran second in Goodwood's G2 Vintage S. for Susan Roy, before Reddam bought into the colt. For the new partnership, Wilko won the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and was third in the GI Hollywood Futurity. Conditioned by Craig Dollase, the colt finished third to champion Declan's Moon in the Eclipse balloting for two-year-old colts in 2004. Third in the GI Santa Anita Derby the following season, the chestnut failed to win at four, but did finish second in last year's G1 Dubai World Cup and third in the GI Santa Anita H. and GI San Antonio H. Wilko, who retires with \$2,435,136 in earnings, was out of the money in his final start in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup June 30. Also trained by Dollase, Cash Included won last year's GI Oak Leaf S. and came back at three to be third in the GI Santa Anita Oaks and GI Fantasy S. before finishing out of the money in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 4. The dark bay retires with two wins from eight starts and \$316,872 in earnings.

**NEW PARTNER FOR MANDURO?** Baron Georg von Ullmann's triple Group 1 winner **Manduro (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) will require a new partner if jockey Stephane Pasquier is claimed to ride Zambezi Sun in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, it was announced yesterday. Pasquier is the retained jockey for Prince Khalid Abdullah in France and will be obliged to ride the Pascal Bary-trained **Zambezi Sun (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) if the G1 Grand Prix de Paris winner lines up in Longchamp's Oct. 7 highlight. "Stephane Pasquier is retained by us and if Zambezi Sun runs in the Arc Pasquier, will ride him," Racing Manager Lord Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*. "Zambezi Sun is very well and will run in the [G2] Prix Niel at Longchamp Sept. 16, taking a near-identical path to Rail Link last year. He's in very good form, is pleasing Pascal in everything he is doing and he is developing, so we live in hope."

**COTTON BLOSSOM RETIRED** Dogwood Stable's **Cotton Blossom** (Broken Vow--For Dixie, by Dixieland Band) has been retired from racing following an injury sustained in the running of the GI Test S. at Saratoga

Aug. 4, Cot Campbell, Dogwood Stable President, announced yesterday. "Cotton Blossom was shipped to Kentucky after she exhibited lameness following the race, and ultrasounds there have confirmed that there is significant damage in the sesamoidian ligaments, along with bone chips in the ankle," explained Campbell.

"Her future in racing would be very bleak, and it is clearly indicated that she be retired." Cotton Blossom will be sold at Fasig-Tipton's Selected Mixed Sale on November 4 in Lexington, and will be handled by Three Chimneys Farm. Trained throughout her career by Todd Pletcher, the half-sister to graded stakes winner Vicarage collected four wins, two seconds, and two thirds from 11 career starts for earnings of \$724,987. During her juvenile season, she won Saratoga's GIII Schuylerville S. and was runner up in the GI Spinaway S. She capped off the year with a third-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Churchill Downs. At three, she took Belmont's GI Acorn S. and the Florida Oaks at Tampa Bay Downs, and was second in the GII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Park and third in the GII Delaware Oaks.

**NAKATANI TO RIDE RUTHERIENNE IN OAKS** **Rutherie** (Pulpit) will be ridden by Corey Nakatani instead of regular pilot Garrett Gomez in Saturday's GI Del Mar Oaks. Trained by Christophe Clement, the dark bay, who most recently scored in Saratoga's GIII Lake George S. July 27, will be partnered by Nakatani for the first time while Gomez honors an engagement in Saratoga the same afternoon. Nakatani has ridden two Oaks winner--Sicy D'Alsace in 1998 and Dessert in 2003.

Who's the best horse in the world now that Invasor has had to be retired? If you were thinking of nominating Street Sense, Curlin or Any Given Saturday--or even Lawyer Ron or Lava Man--you would be a few pounds wide of the mark according to the World Rankings Supervisory Committee. The Committee agrees with the Racing Post handicappers that the most formidable performer currently in action is Manduro, a German-bred five-year-old who has reeled off G1 victories by margins of five lengths, 1¼ lengths and three lengths. His narrowest winning margin was gained at the expense of Dylan Thomas, who took the King George by four lengths on his next start.

Manduro's victory in Sunday's Prix Jacques le Marois means that he is now unbeaten in four starts during 2007. His current campaign represents a sharp contrast to 2006, when he followed up a win in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt with a frustrating sequence of seven seconds or thirds.

So what has transformed Manduro from talented supporting act into the star of the show? One inescapable fact is that he has now been ridden by Stephane Pasquier on five occasions and has won every time. Another possibility is that it took Andre Fabre--genius though he is--a little while to work out Manduro's exact needs after his arrival from Germany at the end of his sophomore season, but Fabre insists that Manduro is easy to train.

The Arc in October is now his next major target and a win there would cement Manduro's superstar status, as he would have won Group 1s over a mile, a mile and an eighth, a mile and a quarter and a mile and a half. Such versatility is rare in a top-notch European performer, and Manduro can also produce his form on a wide variety of ground. We may even see his versatility put to the ultimate test on dirt, as Fabre has the Breeders' Cup Classic in mind as a possible end-of-season target.

Manduro has already done enough to confirm that his sire Monsun belongs among the superstar stallions in Europe. The Gestut Schlenderhan resident earned that

status through some very solid achievements, most notably those of his son Shirocco, who numbered the Breeders' Cup Turf and Coronation Cup among his Grade/Group I wins.

Monsun began his career at a fee of 15,000 Deutsche Mark (approximately \$10,500) in 1996, but his

reputation has grown to such an extent that his fee had risen to €60,000 by 2006 before doubling to €120,000 (roughly \$160,000) this year.

Monsun has justified this price rise with three Group 1 winners in 2007, including Royal Highness--a member of the same crop as Manduro--who forced her head in front in the last strides of Saturday's Beverly D. S. to initiate a great weekend Grade/Group I double for her sire. Monsun's other Group 1 winner of 2007 is Schiaparelli, who last year became his third winner of the Deutsches Derby. Monsun has also sired a winner of the Derby Italiano (Gentlewave), two winners of the German Oaks (Salve Regina and Amarette) and one of the Oaks d'Italia (Guadalupe). He has also made his mark in the U.S. via the multiple graded winner Noble Stella.

Clearly Monsun is perfectly equipped to sire top-class winners over a mile and a half--a distance which Manduro has yet to tackle. Monsun himself raced mainly over a mile and a half after the age of two, when he was officially rated around 23lb inferior to his stable-mate Lando. Monsun's second to Lando in the 1993 Deutsches Derby was one of only two defeats he suffered during an impressive eight-race three-year-old campaign. The handicappers considered him to be less than 7lb inferior to the year's best British middle-distance three-year-olds, headed by Commander In Chief and White Muzzle.

Monsun vindicated the handicappers' judgement as a four-year-old in 1994, which he ended officially rated only 4lb below Hernando and White Muzzle, the top older performers in the 11 furlong-plus category. He owed his high rating to a series of very smart efforts over a mile and a half, including a second decisive victory in the G1 Europa-Preis.

A brief five-year-old campaign boosted Monsun's total of group victories to eight, after which he retired to the Gestut Schlenderhan of his owner, Baron Georg von Ullman, who also owns Manduro. Monsun's racing record bore some similarities to that of his admirable sire Konigsstuhl, winner of the 1979 German Triple Crown. Whereas Monsun retired as a winner of 12 of his 23 starts, Konigsstuhl won 11 of his 20 races. Both won the Aral-Pokal and the Hansa-Preis.

Konigsstuhl landed the title of champion sire in 1988, 1994 and 1996 and rarely finished out of the top two stallions once he had established himself. Monsun has now surpassed Konigsstuhl's feat, taking the championship in 2000, 2002, 2004 and 2006.

Monsun's grandsire, the champion German two-year-old Dschingis Khan, was conceived in Ireland but his male line, descending from Blandford, had virtually died out in the flat-racing sector in Britain and Ireland until Shirocco joined the Darley team this year.

This means that Monsun, with daughters of Surumu, Authi and Kaiseradler as his first three dams, is an outcross for many European mares and he has flourished with mares from the Northern Dancer line, which have supplied most of his Group 1 winners. This combination has provided not only Manduro, but also Shirocco, Samum, Schiaparelli, Salve Regina, Anna Monda, Amarette, Floriot and Guadalupe.

**Mitchell Duo Ready for Pacific Classic...**

A pair of Mike Mitchell-trained pupils took to the Del Mar Polytrack Monday in preparation for a tilt at Sunday's GI Pacific Classic. **Big Booster** (Accelerator), ridden by Juan Dominguez, covered six furlongs in 1:14.20, while **Sun Boat** (GB) (Machiavellian), with jockey Michael Baze, completed five panels in 1:02.20, galloping out three quarters in 1:15. Garret Gomez will ride GI Hollywood Gold Cup third-place finisher Big Booster in Sunday's race. "Big Booster went in company [with stablemate Imitation] like he always does," said Mitchell. "He was really strong in his workout and galloped out great." Mitchell was equally pleased with Sun Boat, winner of his latest start in the July 21 GII San Diego H. "I told Michael [Baze] we needed to go a little slower with him and he worked well," said Mitchell, adding, "Actually, Sun Boat was ready last week. He worked in 1:01 breezing and that showed he's ready. Now, I just have to try and keep him sound and happy."

Manduro's broodmare sire Be My Guest made his name as a high-class miler, which helps explain why Manduro is so effective at around a mile. Incidentally, one of Be My Guest's best daughters, Luth Enchantee, won the Jacques le Marois and another of France's top mile events, the Prix du Moulin, before being thrown in at the deep end over a mile and a half in the Arc. She ran remarkably well to finish a close third, which must be encouraging to Manduro's connections.

Manduro follows the Preis der Diana third Mandela as the second good winner out of the listed-placed Mandellicht. The next dam, Mandelaugue, was a half-sister to Mandelbaum, a very smart winner of the German 2,000 Guineas who was also a Group-2 winner over 1 3/8 miles. Mandelaugue was by Elekrant, a durable performer who won nothing more important than a pair of listed races in a 31-race career. However, Elekrant was by Dschingis Khan, which means that Manduro is inbred 3x4 to this very influential German stallion.

This inbreeding, combined with the fact that Manduro was the best two-year-old in Germany in 2004, is sure to add to his appeal when the time comes for this formidable performer to retire to stud.
