

“SHOP” RINGS THE BELLE

Miss Shop (Deputy Minister) doesn't always fire her best shot, but she certainly felt like running yesterday, drawing away to an authoritative three-length victory over favored **Unbridled Belle** (Broken Vow) in the GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga. Allowed to trail the field of six through fractions of :23.64, :47.70 and 1:11.81, the Hobeau Farm homebred began to hit her best stride on the turn for home and came flying down the center of the course in the

stretch to win going away. “I didn't know if she could go this far,” said Hall of Fame trainer H. Allen Jerkens. “She has never shown that she could go that far. She trained good and she ran good. It's amazing how many times she has run as a four-year-old, in this day and age.” Miss Shop failed to get her picture taken in four starts following a 6 3/4-length victory in Gulfstream's GI Rampart H. Mar. 11. The bay finished a well-beaten fourth in Belmont's GI Ogden Phipps H. June 16, then was second-best in Saratoga's GI Go For Wand H. last out July 28. C P West (Came Home) gave **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) all he could handle in the GI Jim Dandy S. July 29, but still fell 1 1/2 lengths short to the GI Kentucky Derby hero. The Robert LaPenta colorbearer takes another crack at James Tafel's homebred in today's GI Travers S. at the Spa. “I've got a fighting chance,” trainer Nick Zito said. “If we have a great day and Street Sense has an off one, maybe you have a chance at beating him. Obviously, it's not going to be easy, but we'll take a shot.” Phipps

"I'd expect Street Sense to improve off the Jim Dandy, too," McGaughey continued. "I've always believed Sightseeing is a true staying horse and I'm hoping he's improved enough to catch up to this bunch." Sightseeing won the GI Peter Pan S. by a nose May 20, then finished a well-beaten third behind subsequent GI Haskell Invitational S. winner Any Given Saturday in the GI Dwyer S. July 4. Two horses enter the Travers off 104 Beyer Speed Figures. Street Sense earned that number in the Jim Dandy, but the second horse is a little bit harder to come up with. **Grasshopper** stepped up with a career best when stretched to nine furlongs in an allowance at Saratoga July 30, scoring by six lengths. The lightly raced runner should relish the extra furlong here. "We've worked on his stamina and going a mile and a quarter," trainer Neil Howard said. "He loves the long stuff. We want to make sure that he has enough stamina, but we don't want him so strung out that he thinks he's running 2 3/8 miles when they are loping along." The Travers is Grasshopper's first attempt versus stakes company. "It's all a matter if any of us are good enough to match strides with Street Sense," Howard continued. "We really think we have an improving three-year-old. At the same time, we are realistic about the task at hand. Still, he's doing well and he's ready to step up."

From Partner to Powerhouse...

Twenty-two years and three days ago, on Aug. 22, 1985, a son of Blushing Groom (Fr) named Nassipour won the \$96,000 Seneca H. over the turf course at Saratoga. The five-year-old was a 5-1 shot when he won that day for Cot Campbell's Dogwood Stable, the racing syndicate that owned the horse. One of the members of that syndicate was a newly retired publisher from Illinois named Jim Tafel. Two months later, Campbell, Tafel and the rest of the group that

owned Nassipour watched as the chestnut carried Dogwood's green and yellow colors to a much bigger upset, this time as a 27-1 shot in the GI Rothmans International at Woodbine.

Fast forward 22 years, and it will be another horse owned by Tafel--this one--that will be looking to find the winner's circle at Saratoga. The chance of 5-1 odds are nil, however, when the reigning juvenile champ and GI Kentucky Derby winner **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) steps into the gate as the odds-on favorite to give Tafel his second GI Travers S., following Unshaded's win in 2000.

Tafel reports that Street Sense is coming into the race in good order.

"I went over to see him yesterday and today, and he stood there half asleep the first time, and had his head in the feed tub this morning and never raised it to say hello," a bemused Tafel said Friday. "He's doing just great. He's not stall walking, he's not upset, oh, he just fine."

While Nassipour was Tafel's first runner to enjoy success at the sport's highest levels, the Dogwood partnership wasn't his first foray into owning horses. By the time he had retired as board chairman and chief executive officer of Dun & Bradstreet Technical Publishing Co. in 1983, Tafel was already dabbling in racing.

He began attending Keeneland sales in late 1970s--"I was astounded at the staggering prices," he laughed--and soon joined with a group of three friends to buy a few horses that Hall of Fame trainer Phil Johnson had acquired in Europe. Two of those runners become minor stakes winners, according to Tafel, further whetting his appetite for racing and leading to his involvement with Dogwood.

He now boasts a racing and breeding operation that, despite being modest in numbers, has produced a number of top runners, including two champion homebreds in Street Sense and Banshee Breeze. Tafel credits Campbell as a "mentor" and touts the idea of racing partnerships like Dogwood.

"It's an excellent way to get into the business," Tafel said yesterday. "It's great particularly for people who don't know anything about it. It gives people the opportunity to get involved and learn something, but with less risk because you're just one of many partners. And Cot, who's a dear friend of mine, invented the partnership concept--he's the genesis of this whole deal--and he really deserves a lot of credit."

The kind sentiments are reciprocated by Campbell, who says that he'll be cheering for his old friend, with whom he had dinner Wednesday night in Saratoga.

"I'm gonna be pulling for him, for sure" said Campbell. "I got a big kick out of his Derby victory, and Lord knows he has. He was kind enough to mention my name, and I really appreciated that. We have a very warm relationship, and I'm a Tafel man."

From 1997 to 2000, the King's Bishop S. was won by three horses who had participated in the GI Haskell Invitational: Tale of the Cat in 1997, Forestry in 1999 and More Than Ready in 2000. Fox Hill Farm's **Hard Spun**, this year's Haskell runner-up, will look to follow in those footsteps as he embarks on a journey to culminate in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. "I feel like it'll just be an easy progression for him," said trainer Larry Jones. "We'll do the seven-eighths. Hopefully the next race will be at a mile, mile and an eighth. With Monmouth

playing speed the way it does, we feel like we really want him for Breeder's Cup time to be ready to show some speed and then just see how far he can carry that speed." The bay won his first three career outings, all at sprint distances, by a combined 21 1/2 lengths. He played the two-turn game with success this spring, winning the GII Lane's End S. in March before finishing second to Street Sense in the GI Kentucky Derby and third to Curlin in the GI Preakness S. after a premature move. Fourth in the GI Belmont S., Hard Spun was no match for Any Given Saturday in the Haskell, but should improve for that effort. **Cont. p5**

June 9 with a solid one-length victory in this track's GII Amsterdam S. July 30. "He is doing extremely well," Zito said. "The King's Bishop is an extremely tough race, but we should be fine with him." **King of the Roxy** can be the exotics kicker. He is three-for-five at one turn, including a career-best effort when winning the GII Hutcheson S. over 7 1/2 panels Mar. 3. He was most recently second as the favorite in the GIII Barbaro S. July 15.

Flying Zee Stables' **Cosmonaut** leads the way in this wide-open affair. The five-year-old posted a breakthrough performance last time, annexing the GIII Arlington H. July 21 for the second straight year. "He ran a very good race," Patrick Biancone said of the Arlington. "We were really pleased with his effort. After it, we were hoping to run him in the GI Arlington Million, but he had an abscess on his foot and he missed a week of work. But he has been training well here, and we are looking forward to running him. He is ready."

Silver Whistle hit the board behind Sunriver in his last two starts, including a third-place finish in the GII Bowling Green H. most recently July 15. The gray is winless in three attempts at the Spa, but has several close calls to his credit. He finished second, beaten in a nose, in the 2005 GII Hall of Fame S., and repeated that effort in that season's GIII Saranac S. Silver Whistle also placed a good second in last term's GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. **Shakis**, fourth as the 6-5 chalk in the Bowling Green last out, can be tough if he runs back to his third-place finish in the GI Manhattan H. June 9. **Linda's Lad**, winner of the 2005 G1 Criterium de Saint Cloud, makes the trip across the pond for this. He enters off a fifth-place finish in the G2 Jockey Club S. May 6.

One-time Canadian Classic winner and champion three-year-old **Le Cinquieme Essai** is back to defend his title in this prep for the GI Woodbine Mile Sept. 16. The 2-1 favorite in 2006, he bested Becrux (Ity), who would come back to upset the Woodbine Mile. Now eight years of age, the chestnut gelding went missing for 11 months following last year's success, returning to be third to **Awesome Action** in the Ontario Jockey Club S. over course and distance July 21. **Leonnatus Anteas**, the reigning Sovereign Award-winning two-year-old, is perfect in two starts on the turf, including a 1 1/2-length victory in a seven-furlong test Aug. 5. **Purim**, a two-time stakes winner on the grass, was a close third to Kip Deville in the GII Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland Apr. 13, but was last seen finishing eighth in the GIII Hanshin H. over Arlington's Polytrack May 26.

Cesare bids to defy a penalty for his success in the G2 Summer Mile at Ascot last time July 14, a fluent performance which underlined his rate of improvement this term. Earlier this year, he recorded a four-length success in the May 2 Listed Paradise S. and was a close-up fifth in the June 19 G1 Queen Anne S.; he sets the standard on that form. Godolphin, bidding for their fourth victory in this event in the last 11 years, rely on **Blue Ksar**. He also has a progressive profile, having followed a second to **Blythe Knight** in Epsom's G3 Diomed S. June 2 with success in the Listed Pomfret S. at Pontefract July 29. "Blue Ksar came out of his last race well," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "He is in good form and ready for this step up to Group 2 level. It's a tough race, but he deserves to take his chance. Although he has won over 10 furlongs, he shows plenty of speed and we are happy to run him at a mile. He always gives his best." CAPOTE DIES Capote (Seattle Slew--Too Bald, by Bald Eagle), the champion two-year-old of 1986, died yesterday and was buried at his home for the last 16 years, Three Chimneys Farm near Lexington. He was 23 years old. Bred in Kentucky by North Ridge Farm, the dark bay was purchased by D. Wayne Lukas for \$800,000 at the 1985 Keeneland July Sale and shot to the head of his class the following season in the span of 29 days. A maiden winner at second asking for the partnership of Eugene Klein, L.R. French Jr. and B.A. Beal, he returned eight days later to best Gulch in the GI Norfolk S. and capped his championship season with a 1 1/4-length victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile over a field that included Alysheba, Bet Twice and Gulch. One of the leading stallion sons of Seattle Slew, Capote first retired to Calumet Farm, and his first four crops (1989-1992) were sired there. The relocation to Three Chimneys occurred on Christmas Eve 1991, after Calumet Farm's 50-percent interest in the stallion was sold to co-owners French and Beal, who chose to exercise their right of first refusal. A majority interest was later sold to John Kluge's Morven Stud. Capote is the sire of Boston Harbor, champion two-year-old of 1996, who set a then-juvenile earnings record of \$1,934,605. From 16 crops to race, Capote has been represented by 845 foals and 498 winners, 61 of those in black-type events, including Grade I winners such as South African champion Surfing Home, Capote Belle, Matty G, Agincourt and Lambent Light. His progeny have earned \$48,461,793. Capote was retired in November 2003 after showing signs of neurological difficulty earlier that year. He was ultimately diagnosed with spinal cord compression. "While his appetite and spirits were remarkably good to his last day, Capote's coordination had declined to the point that he presented a danger to himself and others," said Three Chimneys President Dan Rosenberg. "The spinal cord problems finally became too much for him to deal with, but he lived with that condition for four years without surgery. Capote had a good life."

Sandy Hatfield, stallion manager for the farm, added, "Nobody would ever call Capote a sweetheart, but he had a strong will and I'm sure that determination gets some of the credit for his longevity."

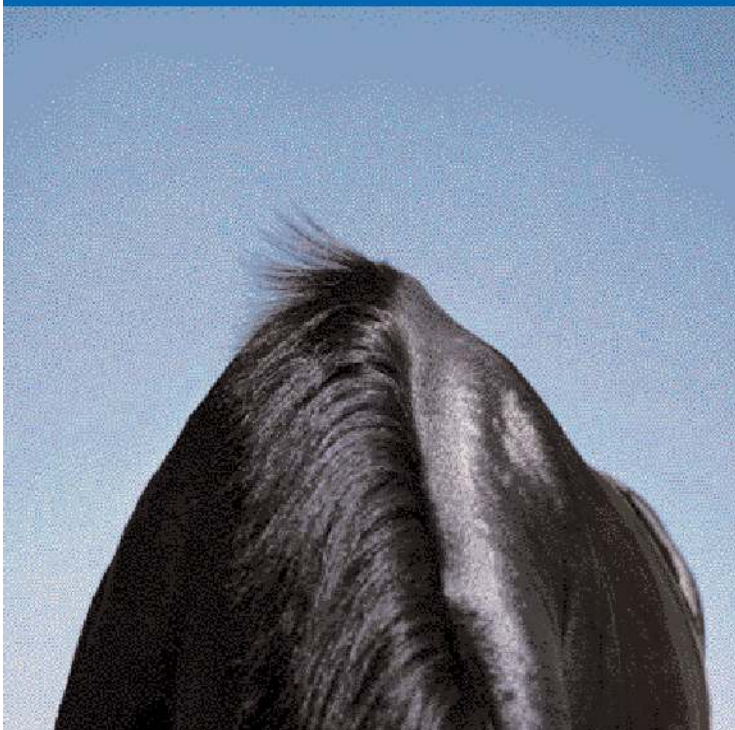

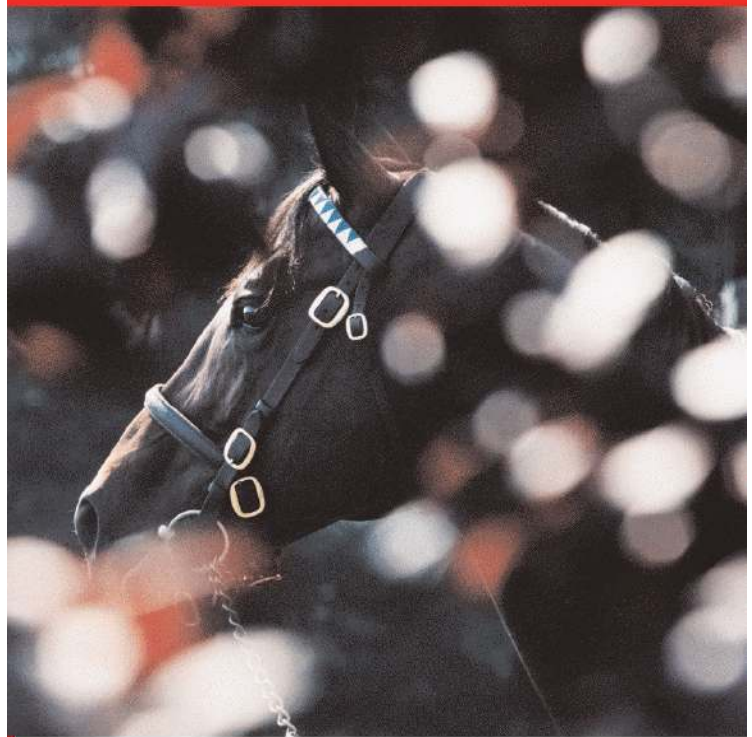
