AFTER MARKET GETS IT DONE AT DEL MAR

It wasn't flashy. It wasn't sparkling. Smoking favorite **After Market** (Storm Cat) didn't have to be either of those things to collect his fourth consecutive victory in Sunday's GII Del Mar H. Content to track the early pace set by **Obrigado (Fr)** (Enrique {GB}), the handsome dark bay forged to the front in the final sixteenth and was well within himself to post a 3/4-length victory over the rail-skimming closer **Runaway Dancer** (Runaway Groom). **cont. p2**

FLU COULD FORCE MELBOURNE CUP MOVE

The equine influenza crisis that has resulted in a total ban on the movement of horses in Australia could force Racing Victoria to change the date of the A\$5-million G1 Melbourne Cup for the first time in its 120-year history. The Cup, which attracts at least 10 international horses each year, has traditionally been run on the first Tuesday of November, but could be pushed back two weeks this year. Peter McGauran, the federal minister for Fisheries and Agriculture, confirmed in a press conference Sunday that the race may be moved if racing doesn't commence in Victoria before the end of the month. "It is better to have a deferred Cup than no Cup at all," McGauran said. The gambling agencies in Australia estimate that more than A\$290 million will be lost if tracks are still closed next Saturday, but that is small compared to the money the breeding industry could lose. September 1st is the official start of the breeding season, and major farms like Coolmore, Arrowfield, Vinery and Darley are located in New South Wales, where, at the moment, there is a total Federal Government blanket ban on movement of horses. The ban will be in force until next weekend at the least. Currently, stallions can serve only those mares that are in residence on the same farm. The Federal Government is militant in its quest to keep the lockdown in place, but Ian McDonald, the Federal Primary Industries Minister, has been impressed by how the Thoroughbred industry has responded to the ban. "They have been exceptional and there hasn't been one incident of anyone in that industry breaking the lockdown ban at this point," McDonald said. "That is just as well, as the government has imposed a A\$44,000 fine and a jail term of 12 months should there be any movement while the lockdown is in place." The number of horses that have tested positive rose from 11 Saturday morning to 47 in NSW and three in Queensland as of Sunday evening in Australia.

MARYFIELD UPSETS IN BALLERINA

Maryfield (Elusive Quality) made the most of a salty early pace to collect her first Grade I victory in Sunday's GI Ballerina S. at Saratoga. Settled in a stalking fifth while **Indian Flare** (Cherokee Run) and **Baroness**

Thatcher (Johannesburg) slugged it out through early splits of :22.27 and :44.57, the strapping bay closed ground on Baroness Thatcher, who was now at the head of affairs as Indian Flare began to falter. With a head of steam, Maryfield battled on, while Baroness Thatcher put up a gallant fight, but it was the towering six-year-old who

won the day by a flared nostril. "We'll go for the BC Filly & Mare Sprint [Oct. 26, Monmouth]," said winning owner Mark Gorman. "We'll probably go straight to that race. I don't think [trainer] Doug [O'Neill] has anything else planned for her." Favored at 6-5, Godolphin's **Burmilla** (Storm Cat) was never in the hunt and came home sixth. "She broke good, but she didn't have the speed I needed," explained Rafael Bejarano. "Since she was off the lead [yesterday], she seemed intimidated." The race was marred by an unfortunate event when Juddmonte Farm's Indian Flare, who set the early fractions before fading to last, collapsed soon after the race and died of cardio-vascular shock. **cont. p2&3**

After Market kicked off his career with four straight victories along the New York circuit last year, including the GIII Lexington S. at Belmont and Saratoga's GII Hall of Fame BC S. Well beaten over the soft turf in his seasonal finale in the GIII Kent BC S. at Delaware Sept. 9, the dark bay capped off his tenure with trainer Bill Mott with an eighth in a \$100,000 optional claimer over a mile at Gulfstream Jan. 31. Sixth in the mile GI Frank Kilroe H. at Santa Anita Mar. 3, the Wygod homebred had to settle for fifth against allowance foes there Mar. 31. An easy winner in the GIII Inglewood H. Apr. 28, he followed that effort with an equally professional score in the GI Charles Whittingham H. June 9 and added the GI Eddie Read H.--over the Del Mar turf July 22--for good measure. After Market was shipped to Arlington Park for that track's marquee event--the GI Arlington Million Aug. 18--but was scratched after week long rains hit the Chicago-area track. "I rode him with confidence all the way," said rider Alex Solis. "As far as the finish, he only does what he has to do to beat horses. He's one of those. Maryfield, winner of the Very Subtle S. at Churchill Downs and the Flower Girl H. at Santa Anita last term, also managed a pair of graded-stakes placings, including a second in last July's seven-furlong GII A Gleam H. jogged across the wire under her own power, but collapsed and died shortly after being pulled up by jockey Javier Castellano. "She fractured her pelvis, probably at the break," explained Dr. Anthony Verderosa, NYRA chief examining veterinarian. "She died of cardio-vascular shock. It's not uncommon for a horse to run their race and come back like that." Winner of last year's Kalookan Queen H. and third in the GII Chilukki S., the bay bumped up her game a notch this term, taking the GII Vagrancy H. and Flower Girl H., while finishing runner-up in the GII Honorable Miss H. and GIII Las Cinegas H. Out of the two-time graded stakes winner True Flare, the five-year-old was a half sister to GIII Poker H. victor Art Master, also a

group winner in France; and Latent Heat, victorious in the GI Malibu S.

Last Answer hadn't recorded a victory since romping in a Woodbine allowance last November, but returned to the winner's circle in style with a front-running score, while collecting his first graded-stakes victory. A well-beaten 11th in the 12-furlong GIII Elkhorn S. at Keeneland Apr. 27, the gelding appreciated the drop in class for his next outing, finishing third in a nine-furlong allowance on the Woodbine Polytrack June 8. Fourth after tracking the early pace when switched back to the turf for the Singspiel S. June 24, the seven-year-old showed the way early in his latest, the 12-panel GII Northern Dancer H. July 22, but weakened in the late going to be fourth behind classy foes Sky Conqueror and Jambalaya. Overlooked at generous odds to try and hold his speed longer this time, the bay shot out to an unchallenged early advantage, opened up by 10 lengths after a pedestrian mile 1:40.69 and was still comfortably in front turning for home. Irish Wells saw off the two Andre Fabre representatives here to record back-to-back successes and join a select group of dual winners which only Snurge (Ire) has joined since 1980. Following his 2 1/2-length success in this contest 12 months ago, the bay was sixth, before being promoted to fifth, in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp in October and returned there on his four-year-old bow with a third under a penalty in the Apr. 1 G2 Prix d'Harcourt. Beaten two lengths by Dylan Thomas (Ire) when runner-up in that track's G1 Prix Ganay four weeks later, he was fourth in the June 3 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly and in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud on his last start June 24. "He was very well coming into the race and to win back-to-back renewals is a big achievement. We are finalising plans for him to enter stud in 2008 and I'd love him to win a Group 1 before then. Being realistic, the Arc is a little bit too difficult, but he could go for the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club [at the San Siro Oct. 14]." Breaking through at stakes level in the Listed Prix Altipan at Saint-Cloud Mar. 17, Kavafi doubled that tally three starts later in the June 30 Listed Prix d'Anjou Bretagne at Nantes. Closing 2006 with victory in the G3 Sprint Cup at Baden-Baden last October, Garnica came back this term with a victory in the G3 Prix du Palais Royal at Longchamp May 28. "We'll try again to win a Group 1, and target the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 6]."

SARATOGA WEEKEND WRAP UP

La Traviata Heads Straight to Breeders' Cup...

La Traviata (Johannesburg), winner of Saturday's GIII Victory Ride S. at Saratoga, will head straight to the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint at Monmouth Park Oct. 26, according to trainer Patrick Biancone. "There are no six-furlong races for her," he said yesterday, explaining the decision. "She's been running 5 1/2 to six furlongs, I don't want to go seven furlongs in her next race and then have to bring her back to six furlongs for the Breeders' Cup. That would mess her up." Also trained by Biancone, **Cosmonaut** (Lemon Drop Kid), who finished fifth in the GII Bernard Baruch H. Saturday, is expected to make his next start in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland Oct. 6. "He ran his race, he just had to give a lot of weight," Biancone said of Cosmonaut, who had to carry 122 pounds, spotting five to eight pounds to his rivals. "He's very consistent. He ran the same numbers as usual. He gives you his all, all the time. Sometimes, all is enough and sometimes all is not good enough."

Lawyer Ron & Political Force Prep for Woodward...

Lawyer Ron (Langfuhr) breezed four furlongs in :49.54 over a muddy Oklahoma training track at Saratoga Sunday. Partnered by Hall of Fame jockey Angel Cordero Jr., the winner of the July 28 GI Whitney H. is expected to make his next start in Saturday's GI Woodward S. "Lawyer Ron went off nice and relaxed," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "He finished up well and galloped out strong." Also working ahead of a possible tilt at the Woodward, **Magna Graduate** (Honor Grades) completed five panels in 1:00.15, with Cordero in the irons. The five-year-old is still unconfirmed for Saturday's nine-furlong test, but Pletcher added that the bay still appears likely to make the line-up. "I believe [owner Mrs. Elisabeth Alexander] will be leaning to running him in the Woodward, as opposed to the Mass Cap or some other alternative," he said. GI Suburban H. hero **Political Force** (Unbridled's Song) readied for an intended date in the Woodward with a mile work in 1:41.12 over Saratoga's main track Sunday. Also likely to face the Allen Jerkens trainee is GI Met Mile winner **Corinthian** (Pulpit).

IMAGINE TO YELLOW RIBBON **Imagine** (Giant's Causeway), winner of three of her last four starts, will make her next appearance in the GI Yellow Ribbon S. at Santa Anita's Oak Tree meeting Sept. 29, according to trainer John Shirreffs. The four-year-old was a good-looking winner in her stakes debut in Friday's California Thoroughbred Trainers and Thoroughbred Owners of California H. at Del Mar. A winner of four of seven lifetime starts, the attractive bay has earned \$199,059 to date.

TIAGO AND LAVA MAN PREP IN GOODWOOD

Tiago (Pleasant Tap) and **Lava Man** (Slew City Slew) appear headed for a showdown in the Sept. 29 GII Goodwood S. at Oak Tree, with both campaigns looking likely to culminate at Monmouth Park for the Breeders' Cup. Tiago, who was scratched out of the GI Pacific Classic Aug. 19, is headed toward the GI BC Classic Oct. 27, while Lava Man, sixth in Del Mar's Classic, may line up in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile Oct. 26. Lava Man, winner of last year's Goodwood, finished seventh in the 2006 Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Downs.

GINGER PUNCH TO RUFFIAN

Ginger Punch (Awesome Again), winner of July 28 GI Go For Wand S. most recently, will make her next start in the GI Ruffian H. at Belmont Park Sept. 8. According to trainer Bobby Frankel, the four-year-old passed on Friday's GI Personal Ensign S., in which stablemate Sugar Shake ultimately finished fifth as a 5-1 chance. "I thought after watching [Friday's Personal Ensign], that Ginger Punch would probably have won," Frankel told *Daily Racing Form*. "I just felt she'd already run several races pretty close to one another and that it would be best to give her a little break." The Stronach Stables-owned filly previously won the GII First Flight H. July 8 following a second-place finish in the GI Ogden Phipps H. June 16. Frankel added, however, while the Ruffian is penciled in for the bay, it is not etched in stone. A start in the 1 1/16-mile test is largely dependant on the presence of GI Belmont S. heroine Rags to Riches in the line up. "We've always got the GI Beldame H. [Sept. 30] three weeks later," Frankel told *DRF*. "Ginger Punches next race is important because it will probably determine her status as far as the Breeders' Cup is concerned." To compete on Breeders' Cup day, the filly would have to be supplemented at a cost of \$180,000.
