After recording a 116 Beyer in a track-record setting performance in the GI Whitney H. July 28, **Lawyer Ron** (Langfuhr) figures to be awfully tough to beat in today's GI Woodward S. at the Spa. The chestnut has posted three workouts since the Whitney, including a five-furlong move in :59 3/5 Aug. 12. High Finance, 10th in last year's GI Belmont S., has really started to put it together in his last two starts. The West Point Stable colorbearer earned a 115 Beyer in an eight-length victory versus \$75,000 optional claimers at Belmont May 27, then posted a razor-sharp victory in that track's GII Tom Fool Breeders' Cup H. last time July 4. "He's a fast grinder and it takes a very good horse to do what he did at Belmont Park," said trainer Rick Violette, Jr. "The last few weeks with him have been great. He really came out of the Tom Fool in terrific shape. There's no question he runs huge off a little bit of a layoff or with plenty of time between his races." **Benny the Bull**, purchased privately by IEAH Stables, et al, following a victory in the Iowa Sprint H. June 30, rallied to finish fourth over a speed-favoring track in the GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. last out July 28. "He will be pushed to the limit against top horses going seven furlongs, but he ran well last time and has trained well since," IEAH Stables' Mike Sherack said. "There is some speed in the race to set him up, hopefully, but sometimes at the Grade I level they just don't come back to you in the stretch. We'll see what happens. He should run well, and we'll hope for the best." **Attila's Storm** has only made three starts this season, but has finished no worse than second. The speedy bay followed a victory in Aqueduct's GIII Toboggan H. Mar. 10 with a game second in the Vanderbilt.

Trainer Bobby Frankel will run just one of his two entries, and it looks likely that **Price Tag** will get the call. The bay attracted a lot of attention when she came out of nowhere to win the Nov. 26 GI Matriach S. in her U.S. bow. She returned to take a Santa Anita allowance test in March, but finished 3/4 of a length behind stablemate Citronnade when second in the May 28 GI Gamely S. The Juddmonte homebred raced close to a swift pace in her latest, the July 6 GII CashCall Mile, but faded late



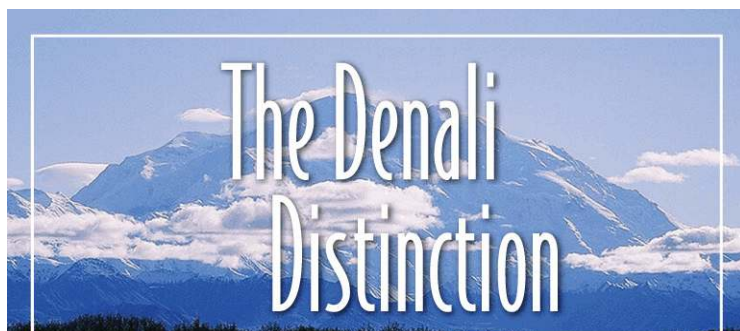

to be third. "She was too aggressive," assistant trainer Humberto Ascanio told *Daily Racing Form*. "When [jockey Edgar Prado] wanted to take her back, it was too late. I don't think she needs to be close. When she won the Matriarch, she was next to last turning for home." Frankel's **Precious Kitten** has been first or second in every start since she captured the Martha Washington BC S. at Laurel last September. Second in the CashCall Mile, she will look to add to victories in the GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill in November, the May 19 GIII Gallorette H. at Pimlico and the Aug. 4 GI John C. Mabee H. at Del Mar if she starts. **Dream's** is a perfect three-for-three on the Del Mar turf course, but she hasn't been out since finishing third in the Jan. 24 Tuzla H. at Santa Anita.

CURTAINS GO UP AT PRESQUE ISLE DOWNS

Nestled in the northwestern corner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania lies Erie, population just over 100,000, and not exactly a hotbed of Thoroughbred racing. That is until tonight, when Presque Isle Downs kicks off a historic month-long meeting, with an average daily purse distribution of more than \$500,000.

So, why Erie?

"We actually did some research and we thought that the area would do well with both casino gaming and horse racing," explained Rose Mary Williams, director of racing for MTR Gaming Incorporated, also the parent company of Mountaineer Race Track and Gaming Resort in West Virginia. "The previous track, Erie Downs, tried to race during the winter months and it was a lower tier of racing and it wasn't very well thought out. Our May to September schedule [for 2008] should work perfectly."



MTR opened the adjoining casino at Presque Isle Downs Feb. 28, 2007, and customers have put nearly \$1 billion into the 2,000 slot machines at the facility, of which over \$92 million belongs to the house. Of that amount, 12 percent has been earmarked for Thoroughbred purses and, by Pennsylvania law, all of that money must be disbursed during this meeting.

But trainer Graham Motion, who has 10 horses stabled at Presque Isle and will ship others in from his Fair Hill base, is seeing something other than green.

"The money is appealing, but the allure is the surface," he commented.

He is referring to the Tapeta synthetic surface, which was selected by Presque Isle. Motion is intimately acquainted with Tapeta, as his horses routinely train over it at Fair Hill.

Motion is not the only recognizable face who will be stabled at Presque Isle or will run horses during the meeting. Well-known conditioners Steve Asmussen,

Scott Lake, Tom Amoss, Todd Beattie, Niall O'Callaghan, Greg Fox, Wally Bindner and Ken McPeck have all entered horses for the first three days of the meeting. **cont. p7**

The fact that such noteworthy outfits will test out Presque Isle is certainly not lost on track officials.

"We are absolutely thrilled with that," Williams commented. "When you give away \$500,000 daily on average, you hope for those kinds of trainers, but until they actually show up, you sort of hold your breath."

Not only the overnight purses are outstanding. Particularly strong is the stakes schedule, which will feature 13 events worth \$1.7 million. The highlight of the meet is set to come Sept. 15 when the track hosts the inaugural running of the \$400,000 Presque Isle Downs Masters S. Contested at six furlongs over the all-weather surface, the race is intended to serve as a prep for the newly created Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint at Monmouth Park Oct. 26. It is the third-richest race of its kind in the country, behind the GI Princess Rooney H. The Presque Isle Mile and Karl Boyes North-western PA S. each carry purse money of \$175,000 and will be run the same night as the Masters. There are six Pennsylvania-bred stakes worth \$90,000 carded for Friday, Sept. 21.

While the 2007 race meeting at Presque Isle is somewhat anomalous given the inflated purse structure, there is little fear of failure going forward. During their 2008 race meeting, officials are aiming for daily purses to hover around the \$300,000 level, on par with Midlantic rivals Monmouth Park, Delaware Park and Philadelphia Park.

"I think we'll be really competitive next year," Williams submitted. "The fact that the trainers are going to leave here with a positive feeling is going to encourage them to come back. Also, everybody wants to run and train over synthetic surfaces."

Motion concurs.

"It's a very safe surface, much kinder on the horses to train over, and it will be interesting to see how it functions as a racing surface," Motion added. "When people get used to it, I really think they're going to like it, and the horses are going to be around longer. I am going to find it difficult to go back to a conventional dirt track. For me it's a no-brainer."

While some trainers were shut out and wait-listed for stalls this year, that should not be the case come next spring.

"We currently have five barns with 100 stalls each and we had a waiting list this year," Williams said. "Next year we will have another five barns."

Situated nearly equidistant from the population centers of Cleveland, Pittsburgh and Buffalo, anticipation for the inaugural meet is high.

"There's definitely a lot of buzz about racing around here," Williams said. "We're very, very excited."

Post time at Presque Isle Downs is 5:30 p.m. daily.

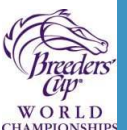

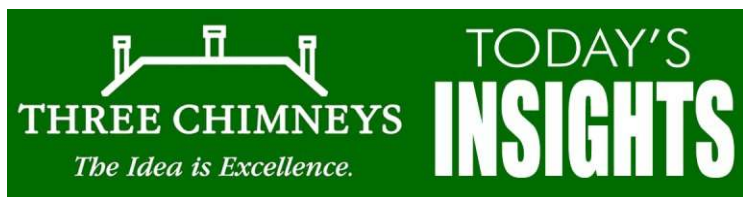
