Why was **Saoirse Abu** (Mr. Greeley) allowed to start at 13-2 for yesterday's G1 Moyglare Stud S.? It's a mystery, but the G1 Phoenix S. heroine provided a generous return with a 1 1/2-length defeat of **Listen (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in their Curragh clash. Ennistown Stud's blinkered raider belied her 25-1 odds when upsetting Henrythenavigator in the six-furlong Phoenix three weeks ago, and she was in irresistible form again here, seizing the initiative approaching the furlong marker and turning down the late challenge of 4-5 Listen. **Cont. p2-3**

The accomplished **Ready's Image** (More Than Ready) will face a trio of runners coming off sharp maiden wins, including **Maimonides** (Vindication), who romped by 11 1/2 lengths Aug. 8. Produced by a full sister to graded-stakes winner Added Gold, Irish Smoke was secured by bloodstock agent Buzz Chace for \$285,000 at the OBS March sale earlier this year, the 12th-highest price at that auction. The grey filly had garnered enough attention in the morning to go postward at 5-2 in her Aug. 2 career debut at Saratoga and she lived up to the billing, coming from off the pace to win under her own steam ([video](#)). Sent back to Keeneland to train over Polytrack, she returned to post a local drill in :47 Aug. 27 and was favored here despite the presence of **More Happy** (Vindication), winner of the GI Adirondack S. Jockey Julien Leparoux allowed her to settle into stride in midpack as More Happy flew through a half in :44.82. That took its toll on her, and Irish Smoke came three wide, assumed command with a furlong to run and opened up late. "She's a very talented horse," said Biancone. "This is the right way to go on 'holiday.'" On Sept. 6, Biancone will begin a 15-day suspension for positive test for a bronchial dilator. "I am going to enjoy tonight and see how she comes out." **A to the Croft** (Menifee), who came from off the pace to take her July 8 debut at Churchill before missing by 3/4 of a length in the Adirondack, came on belatedly for second. "She's just all class," said trainer Ken McPeck. "She doesn't want anything to do with six or seven furlongs. It was a little frustrating to run second in such a big race. She'll go next in the [GI Darley] Alcibiades [at Keeneland Oct. 5]." Rider Kent Desormeaux added, "I think she is begging for more ground. This is not her niche, and she still competed. It's going to be one of those things when they add more real estate to these races. You're going to really read about her." After piloting Saoirse Abu to victory in her second straight Group 1 score, jockey Kevin Manning said, "When she won the Phoenix, she was doing her best work at the finish after a slog on heavy ground. Seven furlongs was always going to suit her best, and she's done it well--I was very impressed with her. She's raced on all types of ground and that's not an issue with her. She's just very smart and I have no doubts about her getting further." Whether blinkers have transformed Saoirse Abu is open to question, as she showed excellent form with no aids when besting yesterday's G3 Round Tower S. winner Norman Invader (*see p6*) by four lengths in a course-and-distance maiden on debut May 27. Connections believed that lack of forcing tactics were to blame when the filly ran second in the G3 Swordlestown Stud Sprint S. at Naas June 4; fifth in the Listed Saoire S. here June 29; and third in Leopardstown's July 18 Listed Silver Flash S. The chestnut took the battle to Henrythenavigator in the Phoenix, where the mixture of an enterprising ride and first-time blinkers worked the oracle, and she was positioned close to the early pace again here. Asked to stretch inside the final quarter as Kieren Fallon angled Listen wide for her rally, she had inflicted the damage by the time that foe arrived with her challenge and quickly snuffed out any threat with an extra surge close home. "She is hardy and very professional, but is not certain to run again this season as the G1 1000 Guineas is the real target," said trainer Jim Bolger, who was recording his third success in this prestigious prize. Saoirse Abu's dam, Out Too Late, is a half-sister to Morning Devotion (Affirmed), who has produced the likes of MG1SW Balanchine (Storm Bird) and GSWs Red Slippers (Nureyev) and Romanov (Ire) (Nureyev). Red Slippers, in turn, is the dam of this year's G1 Prix de Diane heroine West Wind (Machiavellian). Out Too Late produced an Indian Charlie colt in 2006; he is slated to sell at Keeneland September as hip 1544 from the Dromoland Farm consignment.

Quijano's connections had to survive a lengthy stewards inquiry before he was confirmed the winner of Germany's premier contest, emulating his sire in the process for owner/breeder Gestut Fahrhof. Under the radar until 2006, he captured four handicaps and the Listed Erinnerungsrennen at Cologne Aug. 6 before establishing his reputation at Dubai's Spring Carnival. Extending his sequence in handicaps at Nad Al Sheba Jan. 25 and Feb. 9, the gelding proved his worth at a higher level when capturing the Mar. 1 G3 Dubai City of Gold S. Seventh in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic 30 days later, he reemerged from a freshener to be unplaced in the July 18 G3 Grand Prix de Vichy on his European return, but was back in the winner's circle in the Listed Ittlingen-Pokal at Cologne last time Aug. 5. Switched off in mid-division early, he loomed alongside the G1 Deutsches Derby winner Adlerflug at the top of the stretch and was in front when lugging right, away from the whip, inside the final quarter. Despite causing interference to Axxos (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) and the fading Mountain High (Ire) (Danehill), he was corrected in time and was always holding the runner-up as the pair drew clear in the closing stages. Lantana Mob kicked off his career with a second-place finish at 11-1 over Keeneland's Polytrack Apr. 12,

but that effort was overlooked due to the fact that the winner, One Hot Wish, sizzled 4 1/2 furlongs in a world-record :48 4/5. Trainer Steve Asmussen opted to give the colt some time, and the bay returned to graduate by 3 3/4 lengths in his next outing June 9 at Churchill. He stepped up in company for the Tremont S. at Belmont

July 1, but wound up a distant fourth to Ready's Image. Lantana Mob rebounded with a 1 1/2-length score in the Tyro S. July 28 over this surface, but went postward here as the second choice in deference to the Zayat colorbearer Z Humor, a first-out winner at Saratoga Aug. 8. However, the betting public didn't get it quite right. Lantana Mob was away alertly and pressed the pace set by Evenings End (Evening Kris) and Preachin Man. Preachin Man had the lead after a half in :45.10, but Lantana Mob ranged up alongside turning for home, put his rival away midstretch and came home smartly to become the second graded winner from his sire's first crop. "He broke sharply and relaxed very well," said winning rider Stewart Elliott. "We were able to sit just off the pace and behind a couple of horses. Once I eased him out, he knew exactly what to do and just took off." Z Humor bobbed at the start and was last through the opening half, but rallied in the lane to round out through the trifecta.

Medici Code missed by a head in the Oceanside S. on opening day and captured the GII La Jolla H. July 18, but the horse-for-the-course angle apparently wasn't attractive enough to the wagering public, which allowed the gelding to go postward at a generous 5-1. His career has, admittedly, had its ups and downs. Following three unplaced efforts as a juvenile for trainer

Henry Morrison in Britain, Medici Code rattled off a hat trick of all-weather scores Jan. 23, Jan. 28 and Feb. 1 and found himself on a plane bound for Darrell Vienna's barn. He never got involved in his U.S. bow, finishing a distant sixth in the GI Santa

Anita Derby Apr. 7, and was given some time to regroup. He resurfaced in the Oceanside prior to securing the La Jolla, and Vienna was confident the chestnut could continue the good work despite drawing post 10. "I think you're foolhardy if you aren't concerned about other horses in the race, but he was going from strength to strength," said Vienna. "He was training better and better. He's an improving horse. He's grown a lot since he's been here and he's very composed." Medici Code tracked the pace while three wide under Martin Pedroza, angled out a bit further to deliver his run in the stretch and finished up gamely to deny Augment in the final strides. "The plan was to try and get in and save some ground," admitted Pedroza. "But it just couldn't happen. I looked over my left shoulder and just saw a whole bunch of horses over there, and I knew I wasn't going to get it. So I went around there wide, because I didn't have any choice. But he's got that great kick and I knew we'd be firing. That was the fun part. Polytrack is good, but I love this turf course."

Mission Approved scored at first asking Mar. 10 over Aqueduct's inner track and, three starts later, cleared his first state-bred condition with a front-running score going a flat mile on the dirt at Belmont May 24. The New York-bred captured his turf bow, a two-other-than optional claimer at Belmont June 15, but faded to finish a distant fifth in the Lexington S. won by Distorted Reality. The bay never saw the lead when off the board in the Glow S. at a mile over this course, and wasn't given much of a prayer to turn things around here. Jockey Eibar Coa let his mount roll immediately from the start, and the pair sailed along through splits of :24.30, :49.23 and 1:12.67. Favored Distorted Reality took a run at him in the stretch, but Mission Approved held him safely all the way to the wire. "I left it up to Coa," commented winning trainer Gary Contessa. "He never had it so easy on the lead...they just let him go out there and steal it, and he's a New York-bred, too. It's a beautiful thing!" Contessa added, "In the Lexington, he was bad in the paddock and washed out. [Today] he came out of the paddock high, but we had schooled him." Click for the [brisnet.com chart](#). "He has always shown a lot of ability and is Breeders' Cup-nominated, so we'll look at that now." The inaugural \$1-million Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf will be contested at Monmouth Oct. 26. Norman Invader is the third foal from the Niarchos Family's Enthused, who captured the G2 Lowther S. and G3 Princess Margaret S. at in 2000. Stavros Niarchos acquired Norman Invader's second dam, Magic of Life, as a weanling for \$2.5 million at the 1985 Newstead Farm dispersal. She captured the 1988 G1 Coronation S. while winning four of seven career starts.

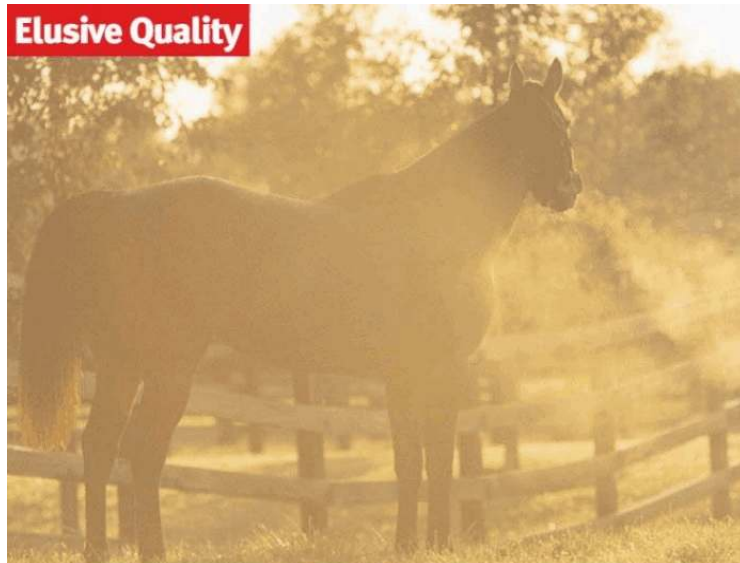

"We knew we had talented horses and we brought the good ones here," Baffert said. "These

horses can fool you. Until you put them in the gate and put them in a race, you don't know what you have. We knew J Be K could run, but we didn't think he would break the track record. We've been lucky no one got sick or hurt. We could have brought more, but there was no room." Kinsman homebred Majestic Warrior came from

off the pace to post an eye-catching debut success Aug. 4 ([video](#)), and could seal a meet title for trainer Bill Mott. "For a big horse, he broke well," Mott told *Daily Racing Form*. "He sat right in behind them, he ate a little dirt, he was responsive." Mott hasn't saddled a Hopeful runner since Paradise Creek finished fourth to Salt Lake in 1991, and acknowledges it is asking a lot to cede so much seasoning to Ready's Image, "unless you've got a superior horse, which maybe we do or maybe we don't," Mott added. "We're getting an opportunity to run and, hopefully, there's more to come."

**PRADO SIDELINED FOR SIX WEEKS** Jockey Edgar Prado will be sidelined for at least six weeks after sustaining a fractured ankle in a post-race spill Saturday at Saratoga, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The 40-year-old rider finished second aboard Admiral Bird in Saturday's seventh race on the turf and was galloping out between horses when, according to agent Bob Frieze, Good Going Darl bolted and hit Admiral Bird, unseating Prado. Winner of the last two riding titles at the Spa, Prado underwent surgery Saturday night at Albany Medical Center, with screws inserted in an effort to stabilize the ankle. "They put a cast on him; they thought they were going to have to put a plate on the right side, but they only put in a couple of screws on the left side," Frieze told *DRF*. 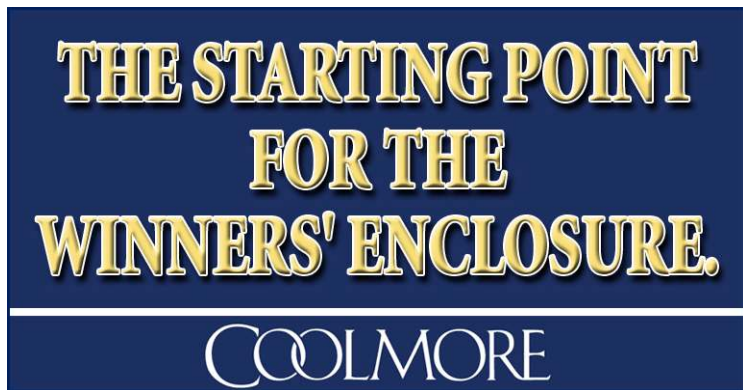
