THE STAGE IS SET

Leopardstown's G1 Tattersalls Millions Irish Champion S. has become a vital staging post for racing's heavyweights in recent times, and today's edition sees another titan step into the arena in **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill). Ballydoyle's giant conquered the great **Ouija Board (GB)** 12 months ago and, while he does not face anything of her status on paper, the nature of this contest tends to demand a bruising finale. Breeders' Cup Turf winner **Red Rocks (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and Michael Ryan's stellar filly **Finsceal Beo (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley) are two that could make it tough for the favorite. "This race has traditionally delivered great finishes over the years, and it's a terrific line-up again," the track's General Manager Tom Burke said. "When you look at the line-up, it's a really interesting contest and we've got the quality there." **Cont. p4**

'EVIE READY TO DEFEND MATRON CROWN

Red Evie (Ire) (Intikhab) returns to the scene of her finest hour last term when holding on grimly to deny **Peeress (GB)** in a thrilling G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown. That was the first of her two wins at the highest level, and her defeat of the colts in the G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury May 19 was another nail biter. Her last-gasp style is perfect for jockey Jamie Spencer, who has been on board for all of her starts at this level, including Newbury's G2 Hungerford S. last time Aug. 18. "She has been an exciting filly to ride

over the last couple of seasons and she should have a good chance," Spencer commented. "She's a star and I'll find it hard to find another like her again. My only concern would be if the ground was very fast--it was good ground when she won last year--but this would be the icing on the cake." **Cont. p5**

Ruthienne (Pulpit) is a worthy headliner in today's GI Garden City Breeders' Cup S. at Belmont. The neatly made filly is riding a five-race winning streak compiled over four different turf courses, including the GI Del Mar Oaks last out Aug. 18. She returns to where it all began in the May 12 Sugar Plum Time S. "She keeps winning, which is great," said trainer Christophe Clement. "I've been very aggressive with her. I've been running her all the time, but she's taken it well." While Virginia Kraft Payson's homebred hasn't breezed since returning to New York, Clement isn't too concerned. "I haven't worked her since Del Mar," he said. "She looked fit and with the trip back to New York, I didn't think she needed to work. We've just kept her cantering. She's trained well and she looks well. She's very healthy, and there's no reason not to run her." **Cont. p2**

A Host of Challengers...

Rutherford will have to be at her best to keep her streak alive. **Valbenny (Ire)** (Val Royal {Fr}), a multiple graded-stakes winner in California, will take another shot at the favorite after settling for the runner-up spot at Del Mar. And, of course, there are several fillies shipping from across the Atlantic to keep an eye on. A listed winner on turf and Polytrack, **Missvinski** (Stravinsky) has chased home top French filly Darjina (Fr) twice this spring, running her to a neck in the G3 Prix de la Grotte Apr. 15 and a half-length in the G1 Prix d'Astarte July 29 at Deauville. In between those outings, the bay filly ran fifth, beaten 1 1/2 lengths for second, in the G1 Coronation S. June 22 at Royal Ascot over softish ground. Finishing behind her in eighth that day was dual Classic heroine Finsceal Beo (Ire), and Clement

knows she's one to watch. "My brother [trainer Nicholas Clement] told me Missvinski's last race in France was very, very good," Clement said. **Bit of Whimsy** dead-heated with Rutherford to share success in the GIII Sands Point S. June 2 ([video](#)) over course and distance. The chestnut has made just one start since, finishing a

troubled fourth as the favorite in Dreaming of Anna's Virginia Oaks July 21 at Colonial Downs.

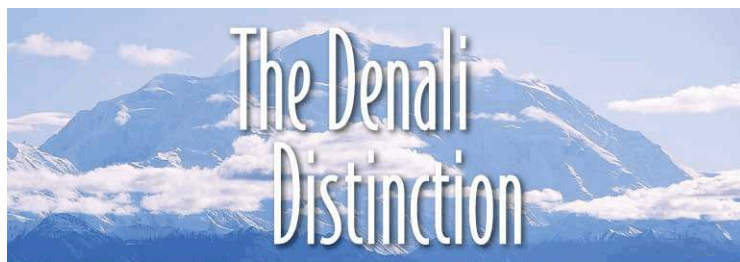

Stepping up from a debut score at Clairefontaine July 4, Coastal Path doubled up at Deauville last time Aug. 8 and continued on an upward curve with this decisive first pattern win. Shuffled back to fourth after taking an early lead, he responded to urging off the home turn to reclaim the initiative approaching the final eighth and was pushed out late to secure an easy success. "He's a lovely, long-striding horse and I like him a lot," commented winning rider Stephane Pasquier. "When he quickened turning for home he just flew by the others, and some of them are useful horses. I think he is a horse with a future." Dylan Thomas, who will be contesting his sixth Group 1 since late April--with victories in the G1 Prix Ganay in April and the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 28--looks certain to give his very best once again. However, he came up second best to Authorized (Ire) in the Aug. 21 G1 Juddmonte International S. at York last out. It was his third reversal over a distance short of a mile and a half, which provides a glimmer of hope to his rivals, as does the dismal record of short-priced favorites Galileo (Ire), Hawk Wing, Azamour (Ire) and Alamshar (Ire), all of whom tasted defeat here. No three-year-old filly has won this contest since Park Express (Ire) captured the 1986 renewal staged at Phoenix Park. That luminary's trainer Jim Bolger is hoping to buck history with the G1 English and Irish 1000 Guineas heroine **Finsceal Beo**. Having set a new all-Guineas record time at Newmarket May 6, the chestnut was denied a special place in the history books by Darjina (Fr) a week later when a head second in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches. Back to her winning ways in the Curragh version a fortnight later, she was undone by the rain-softened ground when down the field in Royal Ascot's G1 Coronation S. on her last start June 22. She arrives here fresh and ready to do battle. "It will be her first time over 10 furlongs, but I've no reservations about her getting that trip [today]," Bolger told *Racing Post*. "She wants good ground, and she should get that." **Red Rocks** is bidding to defy an 80-day break as he builds toward a repeat bid in the Breeders' Cup. "You would not run unless he was in top condition--this is always a great race, one of the best in the world," the owner's Racing Manager Jamie McCalmont told *PA Sport*. "Dylan Thomas and Finsceal Beo are there and it will be tough off a layoff. The Breeders' Cup is the goal, but we're hopeful he'll run well." Tom Burke reports conditions to be drying all the time. "We've got beautiful weather and haven't had rain in quite a while," Burke explained. "We watered the track yesterday and at the moment we are calling it good ground, but it will probably dry up to be good to firm."

Sunriver is a perfect two-for-two on the Belmont turf, taking an optional claimer in June and the GII Bowling Green H. in July. The four-year-old set an easy pace in the Aug. 11 GI Arlington Million, but tired late to be fourth. "I thought he ran well in the Million," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "We were a little unfortunate to catch a soft turf course, which [jockey Garrett Gomez] felt he didn't handle as well as firm ground. He ran hard and wasn't beaten far." **Doctor Dino**, a Group 3 winner in France last year, has filled the show spot in all three **Sunriver** starts this term. The chestnut opened the season in the Apr. 20 G1 Prix Ganay, then travelled to the Far East for the May 20 G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup. Making his U.S. bow in the Arlington Million, he was briefly caught in traffic, but finished well to be beaten just 3/4 of a length by Jambalaya. Three-year-old **Shamdinan** was running on late in the June 3 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly, getting up for third. He showed little over a boggy course in the July 1 G1 Budweiser Irish Derby. Sold privately after that race, he made his debut for owner Triple B Farms and trainer Doug O'Neill in the Aug. 11 GI Secretariat S. at Arlington and got up for a half-length score. He has a trend to buck here, however, as it has been 17 years since the last sophomore beat his elders in this event; Juddmonte's Defensive Play got the job done in 1990. Ballydoyle inmate **Yellowstone**, also three, captured the G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood in July and followed with a second in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York Aug. 21. He was out on the Belmont turf yesterday morning, breezing seven panels in 1:30.20.

GI Odgen Phipps H. Second behind Pool Land in this race in 2006, Take D' Tour makes only her fourth start of the season here. Second-best in the Sunshine Millions Distaff S. at Santa Anita Jan. 27 and the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Apr. 7, she most recently won by a neck in Belmont's

GI Odgen Phipps H. June 16. "We absolutely would have run against Rags to Riches," trainer David Fawkes said. "This is a pretty strong mare, and she is usually feeling pretty good all the time. She is really coming into this race fine, and we're looking forward to running. The break seemed to do her good." **Ginger Punch** has really come into her own since turning four. The Stronach Stables' colorbearer finished a game second behind Take D'Tour in the Ogden Phipps and has gone on to add victories in the GII First Flight H. July 8 and the GI Go For Wand H. July 28. **Miss Shop**, a distant second behind Ginger Punch in the Go For Wand, enters off a smart win in the GI Personal Ensign S. Aug. 24. That victory was part of the new Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In Challenge." While Ginger Punch has a spot reserved for her in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff Oct. 27 at Monmouth, she hasn't yet been nominated to the program.

John Oxx relies on **Arch Swing**, who took the G3 1000 Guineas Trial S. over seven furlongs here Apr. 7 before finding only Finsceal Beo (Ire) too strong in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 6. Injured when trailing in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh three weeks later, she suffered a troubled trip when fourth in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 22 before finishing third in the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket last time July 11. Her conditioner is expecting this livelier ground to hold the key in reviving her fortunes. "She hasn't been that lucky, despite running well," Oxx told *PA Sport*. "She could have done a bit better in a couple of them, and her last three races had a hard-luck story each time. Also, before the Guineas at Newmarket she had an interrupted preparation, so things haven't quite gone her way since winning at Leopardstown in April. While Arch Swing handles the softer ground, she is definitely better on this quicker ground." **Echelon** represents the Sir Michael Stoute stable, successful with Favourable Terms (GB) in 2003, and she is coming here off a career-best success in the G2 Celebration Mile at Goodwood Aug. 25. "She's in good form and the ground should be ideal for her," Cheveley Park Stud's Managing Director Chris Richardson said. "This is the natural progression for her."

Bridget Swire's **Sakhee's Secret** generated new life into the sprinting scene when capturing the G1 July Cup July 13, and he bids to complete this unique double. Since Ajdal achieved the feat in 1987, a handful have tried and failed, including Oasis Dream (GB), who

came unstuck on deep ground as the runner-up here in 2003, but the homebred has conditions in his favor, and his half-length defeat of Dutch Art (GB) in Newmarket's July 13 contest makes him the one to beat. "We're very hopeful he'll replicate the form he showed in the July Cup," trainer Hughie Morrison told *PA Sport*. "Obviously, I gave him a bit of time off as this has always been the real target for him. I suppose my

only concern would be that I had him a little underdone." Behind Sakhee's Secret at Newmarket were a clutch of very smart sprinters headed by Ronald Arculli's **Red Clubs**, who was third. Despite having visited the winner's circle only once since last April, that was in Ascot's G2 Diadem S.

in September, and he has come agonizingly close to winning at this level. Fourth in the June 23 G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot and Aug. 23 G1 Nunthorpe S. at York either side of his July Cup effort, the four-year-old Red Clubs needs a slither of improvement to break through. "He is in very good order and I hope the ground is on the fast side," trainer Barry Hills told *PA Sport*. "I do think he is better at six furlongs and I think he will run well, as he has done in all the big sprints."

A LOOK AT THE FRESHMEN OF 2008

FRESHMEN OF 2008: WHAT TO SHOP FOR AT KEENELAND SEPTEMBER

By Robert D. Fierro, DataTrack International

We've had three major sales where stallions with first yearlings have been represented in one degree of abundance (or acceptance) or another: Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July and Saratoga Select, and OBS August. Now it's time for Keeneland September, which is the ultimate dog-and-pony show. This is the place where both pinhookers and serious racehorse buyers swarm to spend their money and read the tea leaves, especially concerning new sires, to whom we refer as the Freshmen of 2008.

Since they entered stud in 2005, my associates Jay Kilgore, Frank Mitchell and I have biomechanically analyzed over 50 of this crop in Kentucky, Florida, New York, California and a couple of other places, in order to project which are likely to be successful by physically matching as many mares in the breeding population as possible.

This process involves two programs: one matches physical characteristics of stallion and mare to determine if they are a good match for racing success; and another compares a stallion's size and physical attributes to those stallions that have a viable record as sires of racehorses. We then do some mathematical permutations and, voila!, stand or fall on our projections.

We provide this information to our clients so they can better plan their matings, matching them with the best stallion prospects. For those who prefer to buy rather than breed, we point out the sires to watch at the first sales.

That said, here's the way we see things going into Keeneland September. Our prognostications are based, first and foremost, on what our programs told us in 2005, and on our observations of first foals, privately and at sales. In 2005, we thought that this could be one of the best crops to come along in quite some time--it's going to be tough for those stallions who might have had a shot in another year to get the recognition short-term that they warrant, and deserve. After looking at offspring of many of these stallions, our original conclusions have not changed all that much--we still think the horse we believed would top the crop and the one we thought would surprise a lot of people will do so.

"Top of the Crop" For Long-Term Success...

Like Posse among the Freshmen of 2007, the one stallion that kept coming up consistently as among the "best physical matches" for most of our clients' mares was **Lion Heart** (Tale of the Cat). Nothing we've seen to date changes our opinion. Lion Heart has a superior profile and is at the epicenter of the way the breed is shaping up physically--he is powerful with good balance and should be around a long time, getting early winners, top middle-distance runners and an occasional Classic horse as well. He will kill 'em at the two-year-old sales. He may not be the leading freshman sire, but it'll be close.

That honor could fall to our "surprise" horse, **Champali** (Glitterman), who is as close to Lion Heart in biomechanical efficacy as one could wish; they are almost the same horse in many respects, though Champali is better balanced. By Glitterman, and much like him in race record, Champali is likely to get a flexible bunch of runners.

We have some doubts as to whether, collectively, they can help him be on the top at the end of his first year, because the Glittermans like to mature a little later. But long term, and especially if he was supported with good mares early, he should be a piece of cake.

Two others that might surprise are **Soto** (Dehere) and **Congaree** (Arazi). The former was very talented and offers mares more speed than might be expected--after all, he is by an exceptional two-year-old out of a mare by Crafty Prospector.

Congaree could very well go a long way in rehabilitating the reputation of his sire, Arazi. A large horse with great speed, he offers exceptional balance and solid Classic speed, a tough combination to beat.

The last two in this group tell us a lot about what is emerging as the most important branch of the Mr. Prospector sire-line, that of Gone West, for they are grandsons **Strong Hope** (Grand Slam) and **Smarty Jones** (Elusive Quality), who look like they should give their sires legs up on mini-branch success. Neither one of them is likely to fight for the freshman sire title, though one good horse can sometimes bring those honors, but they are likely to be heard from late in the year and early into the three-year-old campaign, and from then on should be solid members of the Leading Sire lists.

Juvenile Sales Stars/Leading Freshman Sire Candidates...

Aforementioned Champali and Soto might be in the mix here, along with several others, the most likely of which is **Speightstown** (Gone West). He appears to get a uniform type, the kind pinhookers love, the downhill speedball, and he is likely to be represented by a ton of runners, so he should keep his sire in the spotlight.

His sire also has a potential surprise in **Canadian Frontier** (Gone West), who really has a speedball sire profile and might be able to better his rating over the long term with a big horse or two.

Florida-based **Alke** (Grand Slam) is likely to be a pinhookers' delight, and one trainers looking for early winners might pounce on.

Other Mr. Prospector-line pretenders to the throne are likely to be headed by **Cuvee** (Carson City), who had a lot of zip at two and has a biomechanical profile that says catch-me-if-you-can. **Scrimshaw** (Gulch) could help his sire expand his scope as a sire-of-sires, but he will need to get them out there early and often, which is not beyond the realm of possibility.

Eavesdropper (Kingmambo) might very well be able to move his sire up the ladder a bit as a sire-of-sires--he's just solid all around with the same kind of profile as Lion Heart in many respects.

Rubiano might have a very big surprise in his son **Burning Roma**, whose racing career was a bit under the radar, but whose stallion profile places him in a very good biomechanical position. They might wait until the late summer to come to hand, but they should be real runners and he is likely to compete for Florida freshman honors.

Forestry might come up with his first good son at stud if the offspring of **Teton Forest** run to their daddy's profile. He, like Eavesdropper, has a lot of the Lion Heart "look" about him on our charts, and he wouldn't surprise us if he came out of the box strong and maintained that status all year. You also have to consider **Chapel Royal** (Montbrook) as a contender in this group if only because of history. His sire is well-known as a super two-year-old sales and winners spinner, and the fact that he was a fast bugger himself as a juvenile and should have been very well supported in Kentucky gives him a shot at carrying on the tradition.

The Classic Look...

If you are looking for the break-out two-turn horse, or one that can throw out winners on a wide variety of surfaces and distances in many countries, there are seven in this crop who could fill the bill. Two of them, Congaree and Smarty Jones, have already been discussed. The other five nicely represent the Classic sire lines from which they spring.

For example, **Johar** (Gone West), who was a truly superior turf runner, has an extraordinary family and biomechanical fluidity behind him, and should throw more speed in a racehorse than many might otherwise expect.

He is likely to make a lot of noise overseas.

Olmodavor (A. P. Indy), and **Tapit** (Pulpit) each have qualities that bring out the best from their respective sires. You may have to wait a bit on the progeny of Olmodavor, but the Tapits ought to surprise here and there with their precocity.

Finally, the Sadler's Wells line has two completely different individuals who look like they could make some impression as sires of quality Classic-oriented runners. **Perfect Soul (Ire)**, a son of the great sire, was purely turf and shows a biomechanical profile that is not likely to deviate from that in the main, though he is eligible to get some decent two-turn dirt horses.

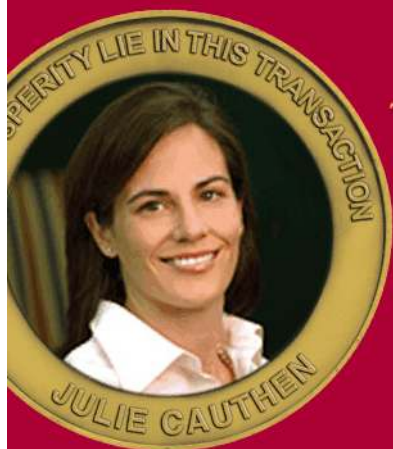
Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado {Ire}), on the other hand, is more than likely to emulate his sire in versatility at stud, but might not get many that look like him--he certainly doesn't resemble his own sire or much of his up-front pedigree. He looks like he's getting a Damascus type (which comes from his broodmare sire, Bailjumper) that might like a mile or so, but the ones with more scope could develop into solid two-turn runners.

We'll see how these predictions turn out come January 2009 and January 2010.
