STEADY AS SHE GOES AT KEENELAND

The 2006 version of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale was remarkable on many accounts. It saw the sale of an eight-figure yearling and nearly \$400 million of gross receipts were rung up. While those two benchmarks won't be reached this year, Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell has been overwhelmed with the performance of this year's market.

"This year's sale is probably more impressive than last year's sale," he stated. "Everyone is concentrating on the top end of the market, but the middle is phenomenal. This is day eight of the sale, and buyers are still very enthusiastic to purchase a top quality horse." As the sale

passed its midway point yesterday afternoon, there was plenty of competition for the day's best offerings, much to the pleasure of Jim and Pam Robinson of Brandywine Farm and Rob Whiteley of Liberation Farm. The two organizations pooled their resources nearly two years ago to snap up 11 reasonably priced mares at the 2005 Keeneland November sale and are now returning those foals to the auction ring. One of their purchases was Proper Dance (Nureyev), a half-sister to MGSW Doneraile Court, which the Robinsons and Whiteley secured for \$72,000 carrying a foal by Cape Town. Consigned by Brandywine on behalf of the partnership, the dark bay colt, consigned as hip 2745, was hammered down to the bid of Marsha Naify for \$260,000. Proper Dance is not represented by a foal of 2007 and was bred this past season to Claiborne Farm's Strong Hope. While the cumulative average continues to show the scars of thinness at the very top of the market, the median remains the bright point of the sale, as it is ahead by 11.1 percent over last year. The session average of \$55,837 advanced by 8.6 percent versus 2006 while the session median of \$40,000 was unchanged. "The sale continues along very successfully," Russell said. *Cont. p2*



Trainer John Ward, Jr. has never been to Boston and, as of yesterday, wasn't sure that he would make it there this weekend since he's been busy at the Keeneland September sale. But **Dr. Pleasure** (Thunder Gulch), a four-year-old Ward trains for owner/breeder John Oxley, will be making the trip up from Kentucky for sure, accompanied by Ward's wife, Donna. "It would be nice to see it first hand," Ward said during a teleconference yesterday.

As a son of Oxley's champion Beautiful Pleasure (Maudlin), there were always high expectations for Dr. Pleasure. The bay colt aired by 7 1/4 lengths in his debut at Saratoga in 2005 and followed that with a runner-up effort in the Cowdin S., but finished seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and didn't make it back to the races until the following April. After a pair of thirds in allowance company, he had the misfortune of running into Bernardini twice, finishing fourth to the champion in the GI Jim Dandy S. and third in the GI Travers S. in what would be his seasonal finale.

"We stopped on him because of some small microfractures in his hind ankles, at the top of the pastern," Ward explained. "We decided to give him all the time he needed. There was no rush to get him back to the big handicap races. Our goal with him is to have a good four-year-old season and a great five-year-old season."

Dr. Pleasure made it back to the races Aug. 4 at Saratoga, putting in a solid late run before finishing second by 3/4 of a length in a nine-furlong optional claimer ([video](#)). "We've been very, very cautious with him," Ward said. "That was a bang-up race at Saratoga." *Cont. p2*

Gentry Goes for More Greeley...

After purchasing a pair of colts by Gainesway's outstanding sire Mr. Greeley in Book 2, agent Tom Gentry found another of the sire's offerings to his liking late in the session yesterday, going to \$260,000 for a filly from the consignment of Highclere Sales, agent. Bred in Kentucky by Curtis Green, hip 2873 is the first foal produced by Wild Crazy Lady (Touch Gold), an unraced half-sister to MGSW Hot Novel, the dam of dual Grade I winner Behrens and GSW Legislator. The chestnut, foaled May 24, also hails from the extended female family of the excellent sprinter Commentator.

Smooth as Glass...

It is buyers like Gary and Mary West that allow the middle market to thrive at the September sale. Through their bloodstock agent Ben Glass, the couple has purchased some 23 horses, each one a colt, for gross receipts of \$4.68 million, and added two more youngsters yesterday. Glass was extended to \$250,000 for hip 2598, a chestnut colt by Johannesburg which was consigned to the sale by the Elm Tree Farm agency of Mr. and Mrs. Jody Huckabay. The Mar. 2 foal is a son of Falun Dafa (Editor's Note), a half-sister to four-time graded-stakes winner During and to GSP Oakhurst. Glass's purchases have run the gamut, from the \$500,000 he gave for a son of Vindication--Western Sarah (GB) (Gone West) on day three of the sale to the mere \$25,000 he paid for a chestnut son of the late Maria's Mon--That's It Doc (Crafty Prospector) during Monday's round of bidding.

Dr. Pleasure Returns cont.

Ward didn't want to throw Dr. Pleasure to the wolves straight away, which is why the revival of the "MassCap" was appealing. "It's great that racing is being rejuvenated up there," he said. "Even though it [the MassCap] isn't graded this year, it's a chance to run for a nice purse." Dr. Pleasure has been assigned 112 pounds for the nine-furlong MassCap.

Ward had also nominated **Minister's Bid** (Deputy Minister), another Ward colorbearer, to the MassCap, but has other things in mind for that colt. Second in last year's Jim Dandy, the \$750,000 KEESEP purchase is perfect in three 2007 starts, including an optional-claiming score last out at Saratoga Aug. 10 ([video](#)).

"We have to be careful with him because of his quarter cracks," Ward said. "He's doing great." Ward wants to run the four-year-old in the inaugural Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile Oct. 26 at Monmouth. "Our goal is to get one more start for him," he added. Ward mentioned the GII Kentucky Cup Classic at Turfway or the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup, both Sept. 29, as possible targets.

**MARTHA GERRY DIES** Martha F. Gerry, who owned and bred three-time Horse of the Year Forego, passed away in New York City Sept. 17 following heart surgery. She was 88 years old. Born in Houston, Gerry was the daughter of William Stamps Farish, the founder of Humble Oil Company (later Exxon) and Standard Oil of New Jersey, and of Lazy F Ranch in Texas. Upon the death of her father in 1942, Gerry and her mother Libbie Rice Farish carried on with Lazy F Ranch and were represented the following year by their first stakes winner Cocopet. But Forego was far and away the best horse campaigned by Gerry. The son of \*Forli was a 24-time stakes winner in five years at the races, with 14 of those coming in Grade I company. He took the GI Metropolitan H. twice (in 1976 and 1977) and the GI Woodward H. on three occasions (1974, 1976 and 1977). He retired with earnings in excess of \$1.9 million. Forego lived out his days at the Kentucky Horse Park near Lexington, where he died in 2005 at the age of 27. Gerry's other stakes winners included Tally, Cavaldos, Out Point, Coveted, Stroke and Auntie Mame. One of the first three women elected to The Jockey Club in 1983 along with Penny Chenery and Allaire du Pont, Gerry remained active in the Thoroughbred business even in her advancing age and was represented in early 2007 by GIII Hal's Hope H. winner Chatain (Forest Wildcat). In partnership with her nephew, Lane's End Farm owner William S. Farish III, Gerry races English Colony (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), undefeated in four starts sprinting on the turf, including a pair of stakes at Belmont Park. The three-year-old colt is conditioned by Gerry's long-time trainer Angel Penna Jr. Gerry became the first woman to be named Exemplar of Racing in August and was on hand to receive the honor at the Racing Hall of Fame induction ceremony. "Martha was a friend. She was candid, enthusiastic and caring," said Joseph E. Aulisi, acting director of the National Museum of Racing. "Her passing is a great loss for Thoroughbred racing, the National Museum of Racing and the Saratoga Springs community, where she very quietly made so many contributions." Gerry was also sighted at last month's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale. Sitting alongside Penna, she signed a ticket on a filly by Dynaformer for \$700,000.

**COOLMORE STALLIONS RETURN TO U.S.**

Coolmore Australia will send three of its star stallions back to the U.S. in a preemptive move to protect them in the event the equine influenza outbreak spreads to Coolmore. The three stallions currently in the NSW Hunter Valley--Tale of the Cat, Johannesburg and Lion Heart--will be sent back to America to avoid any chance of them being stranded in Australia at the end of the breeding season," said Coolmore media representative James Bester. Bester further explained, "American importation rules insist that no horse can come into the country unless it has been on a disease-free farm for at least 60 days prior. While Coolmore at Jerrys Plains is to this point free of equine influenza, it was regarded as a prudent decision to send some of the horses back to America." Coolmore was granted a special permit to move the horses to Sydney to board a waiting plane as the stud has been free from equine influenza, is outside any current restriction zone and the horses were not remaining in Australia. Coolmore Australia general manager Michael Kirwan added: "It was a compromise that had to be made for Ashford Farm in America. We're between a rock and a hard place. It's impossible to keep everyone happy, although in retaining Fusaichi Pegasus, Dehere and Royal Academy, we still have some high-profile horses for Australian breeders. The Americans have Tale of the Cat and his son Lion Heart, plus Johannesburg: so it's an even split, with three each."

**'DIVA' SWITCHED TO FUSAICHI PEGASUS**

Australian star **Makybe Diva (GB)** (Desert King {Ire}) had been scheduled to be bred to Encosta de Lago (Aus) this season, but, with that stallion stuck in El quarantine, the decision was made to instead breed her to Fusaichi Pegasus, according to *racingsports.com.au*. A three-time winner of the G1 Melbourne Cup, the nine-year-old mare produced her first foal last month at Coolmore Stud in Jerrys Plains, a colt by Galileo (Ire). "Encosta de Lago was the first choice and, obviously, it would have been nice to go to him, but with him not likely to be out until November--if at all--we then decided on Fusaichi Pegasus," owner Tony Santic explained. "He has been going pretty well this year and, with Haradasun (Aus) doing what he's done this year, he was our second choice." After compiling a record of 34-15-4-3, Makybe Diva was retired after her 2005 Melbourne Cup victory with record Australasian earnings of A\$14,526,685 (\$10,767,186). She was a two-time Horse of the Year, champion stayer three times and was also named champion older mare.

**BIANCONE HEARING SCHEDULED** The Kentucky Horse Racing Authority has scheduled a stewards' hearing in the continuing investigation of trainer Patrick Biancone, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Biancone's Keeneland barn was searched June 22 and three vials of the substance, prohibited under Kentucky rules as a Class A drug with "high potential to impact racing performance," were discovered. Lisa Underwood, executive director of the KHRA, told the *Form* that a hearing had been set, without revealing the date, pursuant to Authority constructs. Underwood declined to go into any additional details on the matter, telling *DRF* that the matter is "still ongoing." Biancone has been serving an unrelated 15-day suspension, scheduled to end today, for the finding of two stimulants in horses he trains. Earlier this week, Kentucky stewards suspended one of Biancone's veterinarians, Dr. Rodney Stewart, for five years for the possession of cobra venom and a pair of other drugs, levodopa and carbidopa, the *Form* reports.

**SUN BOAT EUTHANIZED** Graded-stakes winner **Sun Boat (GB)** (Machiavellian--One So Wonderful {GB}, by Nashwan) was euthanized yesterday due to complications from laminitis, according to *The Blood-Horse*.

The five-year-old gelding had been turned out at Bonnie Acres Farm in Hemet, California, following a 12th-place finish in the GI Pacific Classic Aug. 19, the only time he

was worse than second in four all-weather tries. "He had an ankle that was a little rough and we gave him a few days after the Pacific Classic and, then Bobby [Mitchell] took him [to Bonnie Acres]," trainer Mike Mitchell told the publication. "He was doing good, and then his feet started to get really sore. He had an abscess

that busted out on one foot, and it was just one thing after the other." Hailing from a top Meon Valley Stud family and the son of Group 1 winner One So Wonderful, Sun Boat was purchased by Darley for 525,000gns as a yearling at the 2003 Tattersalls Houghton sale. The lightly raced bay won twice for trainer Eoin Harty before being claimed for \$50,000 on behalf of Bongo Racing Stable out of an eighth-place finish on the grass at Santa Anita Apr. 12. He immediately captured a \$40,000 over Hollywood's Cushion Track May 13, then ran second by a nose in the GII Californian S. over the same surface June 2. The five-year-old rebounded to win the GII San Diego H. on the Polytrack at Del Mar before his Pacific Classic run. Sun Boat's record stands at 13-4-3-1 with a bankroll of \$334,344.
