## MANDURO FINE AFTER SURGERY

**Manduro (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}--Mandellicht {Ire}, by Be My Guest) has come out of the surgery to his hind leg without any complications, with vets satisfied with the procedure. Newmarket-based vet Ian Wright performed the operation on the five-year-old's off-hind to repair the fracture sustained during Sunday's G2 Prix Foy at Longchamp. John Ferguson, bloodstock advisor to the stallion's owner Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, told the *Racing Post*, "Manduro sustained a fracture to the lateral condial of his off-hind cannon, which basically means he suffered a fracture to his right hind leg. Surgery took place on Monday afternoon and, during an operation that lasted less than two hours, four screws were inserted across the fracture area. Ian Wright has reported himself pleased with the outcome."

## STREET SENSE WORKS

Jim Tafel's **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) worked five furlongs beneath Calvin Borel in 1:00.60 at Churchill Downs yesterday. The GI Travers S. hero also turned in a four-furlong move in :48 3/5 at Churchill Sunday. "I always do that when I want to get a good work in and sharpen him up," trainer Carl Nafzger said of the GI Kentucky Derby winner's quick return. "All you do with that half-mile is just tune him up, like you're going to run a race. We just wanted a good work, and he worked like clockwork [yesterday] morning." A decision on Street Sense's next start will be made next week.

## DISTORTED HUMOR FILLY TOPS KEESEP

A filly by Distorted Humor out of the group-stakes placed Seattle Slew mare Mysteries topped the action at Keeneland September yesterday, selling to McCarthy & Hertrich Livestock for \$475,000. Bred in Kentucky by Kennelot Stables, hip 3113 is a half-sister to My Sea Castles (Polish Navy), MSW, \$173,503; Hishi Akebono (Woodman), Ch. Sprinter & MSW-Jpn, \$3,237,510; and Agnes World (Danzig), MSW-Jpn, G1SW-Fr & Eng, \$3,117,740. She is also from the family of G1SWs Dubai Destination (Kingmambo) and Librettist (Danzig). The bay was consigned by Calumet Farm.

A colt by Jump Start out of the unraced mare Heythisis Sarah was the second-highest yearling to go through the ring yesterday, selling for \$260,000. B Wayne Hughes purchased the Kentucky-bred from the consignment of Dromoland Farm Inc, Agent XXIII. Hip 3016 was bred by Kerry L Zeigler VMD.

**Session Figures Up...**

Wednesday's session saw increases across the board. A total of 286 yearlings sold for \$14,670,600. In 2006, 293 sold for \$12,112,700. The average was up 24 percent to \$51,296 and the median rose 40 percent to \$42,000. Through Wednesday's session, 2,269 yearlings have sold for \$354,731,200. "It was an exceptional sale [Wednesday] with great depth to the market," said Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "Consignors reported that they were very busy in the barn area showing horses that sell today and tomorrow."

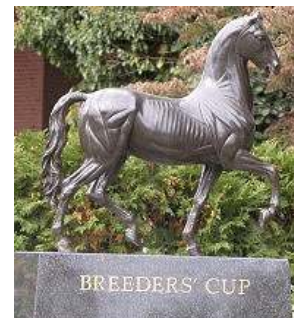

**AUTHORIZED PREPARES** Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's **Authorized (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) has started his preparation for the Oct. 7 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam announced yesterday. The G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Juddmonte International S. hero was taken to Newmarket's Limekilns gallops for his first serious workout over 7 1/2 furlongs and he pleased his conditioner in the spin alongside Striving Storm. Regular partner Noel O'Connor was in the irons. "That was Authorized's first bit of work since York and I was very pleased with him," Chapple-Hyam said. "We will start building him up in earnest now for the Arc." Frankie Dettori, who has ridden Europe's current top-rated sophomore every time this season, is likely to team up with Authorized next week.

**NJ RACING APPROVES EPO & TCO2 TESTING**

Out of competition testing for Epogen and TCO2 was approved by the New Jersey Racing Commission Sept. 17. Random out of competition EPO testing for horses pre-entered in the Breeders' Cup will take place prior to the Oct. 26-27 World Thoroughbred Championships. The TCO2 testing for Breeders' Cup entrants will be taken at random approximately 45 minutes before post time. The new regulations have been sent to the Attorney General's office for review, and will become effective upon publication in the *New Jersey Register* Oct. 15.

**CHEVELEY DUO TO QEII** Cheveley Park Stud will send both **Cesare (GB)** (Machiavellian) and **Nannina (GB)** (Medicean {GB}) to Ascot for next Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. The Stud's Managing Director Chris Richardson confirmed that the former, who took the July 14 G2 Summer Mile S. at the Berkshire venue and G2 Windsor Forest S. winner Nannina would line up for the mile contest. "All is well with Cesare and we are hoping to run Nannina, too," he told *PA Sport*. "Both have gone well at Ascot this summer." Richardson added that the G1 Matron S. scorer **Echelon (GB)** (Danehill) may take in the G1 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket Oct. 6.

## NTRA REPORT FROM Capitol Hill

**More Members Announce Their Retirements**

On Monday, Minnesota Representative Jim Ramstad (R-3rd) became the seventh Republican to announce his retirement in the last few months. The nine-term Ramstad served on the House Ways and Means Committee. Republicans and Democrats alike claim the district, in suburban Minneapolis, is theirs to win. President Bush carried Minnesota's third district in 2000 and 2004, posting a 51-48 margin in the last election.

Ramstad's retirement hardly signals a trend. More than 20 Republicans retired or sought higher office in the last election cycle.

NTRA's political action committee, Horse PAC, has disbursed more than \$200,000 to federal political candidates thus far in 2007, evenly divided between Democrats and Republicans.

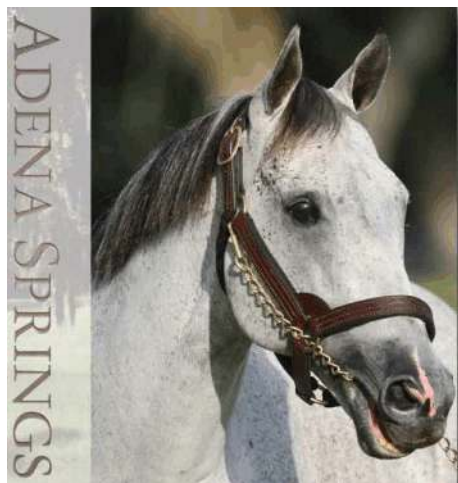
